God's Abundant Attributes

- Numbers 14:18 'The LORD is longsuffering and abundant in mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression; but He by no means clears the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation.'
- Nehemiah 9:17 They refused to obey, And they were not mindful of Your wonders That You did among them. But they hardened their necks, And in their rebellion They appointed a leader To return to their bondage. But You are God, Ready to pardon, Gracious and merciful, Slow to anger, **Abundant in kindness**, And did not forsake them.
- Nehemiah 9:27 Therefore You delivered them into the hand of their enemies, Who oppressed them; And in the time of their trouble, When they cried to You, You heard from heaven; And according to **Your abundant mercies** You gave them deliverers who saved them From the hand of their enemies.
- Job 37:23 As for the Almighty, we cannot find Him; He is excellent in power, In judgment and **abundant justice**; He does not oppress.
- Psalm 86:5 For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in mercy to all those who call upon You.
- Psalm 86:15 But You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and gracious, Longsuffering and abundant in mercy and truth.
- Psalm 130:7 O Israel, hope in the LORD; For with the LORD there is mercy, And with Him is **abundant** redemption.
- Jonah 4:2 So he prayed to the LORD, and said, "Ah, LORD, was not this what I said when I was still in my country? Therefore I fled previously to Tarshish; for I know that You are a gracious and merciful God, slow to anger and **abundant in lovingkindness**, One who relents from doing harm.
- 1 Timothy 1:14 And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to **His abundant mercy** has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

God Gives Abundantly

- Isaiah 55:7 Let the wicked forsake his way, And the unrighteous man his thoughts; Let him return to the LORD, And He will have mercy on him; And to our God, For **He will abundantly pardon.**
- Ephesians 3:20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,
- Titus 3:6 Whom [Holy Spirit] He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior.
- Hebrews 6:17 Thus God, determining to show more abundantly to the heirs of promise the immutability of His counsel, confirmed it by an oath.
- 2 Peter 1:11 For so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

God's Exceeding Gifts

- Psalm 43:4 Then I will go to the altar of God, **To God my exceeding joy**; And on the harp I will praise You, O God, my God.
- Malachi 3:10 Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this," Says the LORD of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven **And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it.**
- Luke6:38 Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.
- 2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory.
- 2 Corinthians 9:14 And by their prayer for you, who long for you because of **the exceeding grace of God** in you.
- Ephesians 1:19 And what is **the exceeding greatness of His power** toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power.
- Ephesians 2:7 That in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

- 1 Timothy 6:17 Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.
- 1 Peter 4:13 But rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad **with exceeding joy**.
- Jude 1:24 Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, And to present you faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy.

God Causes Us To Abound

- Deuteronomy 30:9 **The LORD your God will make you abound** in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For the LORD will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers.
- Proverb 28:20 **A faithful man will abound with blessings**, But he who hastens to be rich will not go unpunished.
- Romans 5:15 But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.
- Romans 5:20 Moreover the law entered that the offense might abound. But where sin abounded, **grace abounded** much more.
- Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that **you may abound** in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 1:5 For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so **our consolation also abounds through Christ**.
- 2 Corinthians 4:15 For all things are for your sakes, that **grace**, having spread through the many, **may cause** thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God.
- 2 Corinthians 8:2 that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality.
- 2 Corinthians 8:7 But as **you abound in everything**—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us—see that you **abound in this grace** also.
- 2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.
- Ephesians 1:8 [The riches of His grace] which **He made to abound toward us** in all wisdom and prudence.
- Philippians 1:9 And this I pray, that **your love may abound still more and more** in knowledge and all discernment.

- Philippians 4:12 I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need.
- Philippians 4:18 **Indeed I have all and abound. I am full,** having received from Epaphroditus the things sent from you, a sweet–smelling aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:12 And may the Lord make you **increase and abound in love** to one another and to all, just as we do to you.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:1 Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus that **you should abound more and more**, just as you received from us how you ought to walk and to please God.

Living In Abundance

- Deuteronomy 28:47 Because you did not serve the LORD your God with joy and gladness of heart, for the abundance of everything.
- 2 Chronicles 32:29 Moreover he provided cities for himself, and possessions of flocks and herds in abundance; for God had given him very much property.
- Job 36:31 For by these He judges the peoples; **He gives food in abundance**.
- Psalm 37:11 But the meek shall inherit the earth, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.
- Psalm 65:11 You crown the year with Your goodness, And Your paths drip with abundance.
- Psalm 72:7 In His days the righteous shall flourish, And abundance of peace, Until the moon is no more.
- Isaiah 55:2 Why do you spend money for what is not bread, And your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen carefully to Me, and eat what is good, And let **your soul delight itself in abundance.**
- Isaiah 60:5 Then you shall see and become radiant, And your heart shall swell with joy; Because **the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you**, The wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you.
- Jeremiah 31:14 I will satiate the soul of the priests **with abundance**, And My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 33:6 Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them **the abundance** of peace and truth.
- Matthew 13:12 For whoever has, to him more will be given, and **he will have abundance**; but whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him.
- Matthew 25:29 For to everyone who has, more will be given, and **he will have abundance**; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away.

- Romans 5:17 For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive **abundance of grace** and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have **an abundance for every good work**.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure by **the abundance of the revelations**, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure.
