Amazing Jesus

Matthew 12:23 And all the multitudes were amazed and said, "Could this be the Son of David?"

Mark 1:27 Then they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? What new doctrine *is* this? For with authority He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him."

Mark 2:12 Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw *anything* like this!"

Mark 6:51 Then He went up into the boat to them, and the wind ceased. And they were greatly amazed in themselves beyond measure, and marveled.

Mark 9:15 Immediately, when they saw Him, all the people were greatly amazed, and running to *Him*, greeted Him.

Mark 10:32 Now they were on the road, going up to Jerusalem, and Jesus was going before them; and they were amazed. And as they followed they were afraid. Then He took the twelve aside again and began to tell them the things that would happen to Him.

Mark 16:8 So they went out quickly and fled from the tomb, for they trembled and were [amazed](#). And they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

Luke 2:48 So when they saw Him, they were [amazed](#); and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You done this to us? Look, Your father and I have sought You anxiously."

Luke 4:36 Then they were all [amazed](#) and spoke among themselves, saying, "What a word this is! For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits, and they come out."

Luke 5:26 And they were all [amazed](#), and they glorified God and were filled with fear, saying, "We have seen strange things today!"

Luke 9:43 And they were all [amazed](#) at the majesty of God. But while everyone marveled at all the things which Jesus did, He said to His disciples.

Amazing Work of Jesus (Holy Spirit) Through His Disciples

Acts 2:7 Then they were all [amazed](#) and marveled, saying to one another, "Look, are not all these who speak Galileans?"

Acts 2:12 So they were all [amazed](#) and perplexed, saying to one another, "Whatever could this mean?"

Acts 3:10-11 Then they knew that it was he who sat begging alms at the Beautiful Gate of the temple; and they were filled with [wonder](#) and amazement at what had happened to him. Now as the lame man who was healed held on to Peter and John, all the people ran together to them in the porch which is called Solomon's, greatly [amazed](#).

Acts 8:13 Then Simon himself also believed; and when he was baptized he continued with Philip, and was [amazed](#), seeing the miracles and signs which were done.

Acts 9:21 Then all who heard were [amazed](#), and said, "Is this not he who destroyed those who called on this name in Jerusalem, and has come here for that purpose, so that he might bring them bound to the chief priests?"

Jesus' Astonishing Teaching

Matthew 7:28 And so it was, when Jesus had ended these sayings, that the people were [astonished](#) at His teaching.

Matthew 13:54 And when He had come to His own country, He taught them in their synagogue, so that they were [astonished](#) and said, "Where did this *Man* get this wisdom and *these* mighty works?"

Matthew 19:25 When His disciples heard *it*, they were greatly [astonished](#), saying, "Who then can be saved?"

Matthew 22:33 And when the multitudes heard *this*, they were [astonished](#) at His teaching.

Mark 1:22 And they were [astonished](#) at His teaching, for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

Mark 6:2 And when the Sabbath had come, He began to teach in the synagogue. And many hearing *Him* were [astonished](#), saying, "Where *did* this Man *get* these things? And what wisdom *is* this which is given to Him, that such mighty works are performed by His hands!

Mark 10:24 And the disciples were [astonished](#) at His words. But Jesus answered again and said to them, "Children, how hard it is for those who trust in riches to enter the kingdom of God!

Mark 10:26 And they were greatly [astonished](#), saying among themselves, "Who then can be saved?"

Mark 11:18 And the scribes and chief priests heard it and sought how they might destroy Him; for they feared Him, because all the people were [astonished](#) at His teaching.

Luke 2:47 And all who heard Him were [astonished](#) at His understanding and answers.

Luke 4:32 And they were [astonished](#) at His teaching, for His word was with authority.

Jesus' Astonishing Acts

Mark 7:37 And they were [astonished](#) beyond measure, saying, "He has done all things well. He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak."

Luke 5:9 For he and all who were with him were [astonished](#) at the catch of fish which they had taken.

Luke 8:56 And her parents were [astonished](#), but He charged them to tell no one what had happened.

Acts 9:6 So he, trembling and [astonished](#), said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?" Then the Lord *said* to him, "Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do."

Jesus' Marvelous Acts

Matthew 8:27 So the men [marveled](#), saying, "Who can this be, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?"

Matthew 9:8 Now when the multitudes saw *it*, they [marveled](#) and glorified God, who had given such power to men.

Matthew 9:33 And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes [marveled](#), saying, "It was never seen like this in Israel!"

Matthew 15:31 So the multitude [marveled](#) when they saw *the* mute speaking, *the* maimed made whole, *the* lame walking, and *the* blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Matthew 21:20 And when the disciples saw *it*, they [marveled](#), saying, "How did the fig tree wither away so soon?"

Matthew 22:22 When they had heard *these words*, they [marveled](#), and left Him and went their way.

Matthew 27:14 But He answered him not one word, so that the governor [marveled](#) greatly.

Mark 5:20 And he departed and began to proclaim in Decapolis all that Jesus had done for him; and all [marveled](#).

Mark 6:51 Then He went up into the boat to them, and the wind ceased. And they were greatly amazed in themselves beyond measure, and [marveled](#).

Mark 12:17 And Jesus answered and said to them, "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." And they [marveled](#) at Him.

Mark 15:5 But Jesus still answered nothing, so that Pilate [marveled](#).

Luke 2:33 And Joseph and His mother [marveled](#) at those things which were spoken of Him.

John 4:27 And at this *point* His disciples came, and they [marveled](#) that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her?"

John 7:15 And the Jews [marveled](#), saying, "How does this Man know letters, having never studied?"

1 Peter 2:9 But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His [marvelous](#) light.

Revelation 15:3 They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: "Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints!

Psalms 17:7 Show Your marvelous lovingkindness by Your right hand, O You who save those who trust *in You* From those who rise up *against them*.

Psalms 31:21 Blessed *be* the LORD, For He has shown me His marvelous kindness in a strong city!

Psalms 78:12 Marvelous things He did in the sight of their fathers, In the land of Egypt, *in* the field of Zoan.

Psalms 98:1 A Psalm. Oh, sing to the LORD a new song! For He has done marvelous things; His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him the victory.

Psalms 105:5 Remember His marvelous works which He has done, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth.

Psalms 118:23 This was the LORD'S doing; It *is* marvelous in our eyes.

Psalms 139:14 I will praise You, for I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And *that* my soul knows very well.
