Anthropomorphisms of the Lord

His head and hair *were* white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire. Revelation 1:14

While it is easy for the majority of receivers to see Jesus in memories, it seems to be more difficult to see Him in the present, with them in an interactive connection. Perhaps this is because it feels more intensely intimate and more real when one can see Him with us in the now. If we communicate with each other to a much greater degree nonverbally (90% +), then we receive much greater fellowship when we can see Him rather than just hearing Him or sensing Him. It happens that some receivers report seeing only part of Immanuel. It is possible for receivers to see only His hands, His chest, His feet, His eyes or even His smile. As we continue to get healing in Immanuel sessions, many receivers who couldn't see Him well before, report being able to see Him more fully and more clearly.
