Genesis 40:8 And they said to him, "We each have had a dream, and *there is* no interpreter of it." So Joseph said to them, "Do not interpretations [belong](#) to God? Tell *them* to me, please."

Deuteronomy 10:14 Indeed heaven and the highest heavens [belong](#) to the LORD your God, *also* the earth with all that *is* in it.

Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret *things* [belong](#) to the LORD our God, but those *things which are* revealed [belong](#) to us and to our children forever, that *we* may do all the words of this law.

Job 25:2 Dominion and fear [belong](#) to Him; He makes peace in His high places.

Psalms 47:9 The princes of the people have gathered together, The people of the God of Abraham. For the shields of the earth [belong](#) to God; He is greatly exalted.

John 12:49 For I have not spoken on [My own authority](#); but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak.

John 14:10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on [My own authority](#); but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.

John 8:50 And I do not seek [My own](#) glory; there is One who seeks and judges.

Psalms 35:13 But as for me, when they were sick, My clothing *was* sackcloth; I humbled myself with fasting; And my prayer would return to [my own heart](#).

Acts 13:22 "And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, 'I have found David the *son* of Jesse, a man after [My own heart](#), who will do all My will.'

Philemon 1:12 I am sending him back. You therefore receive him, that is, [my own heart](#),

My Own Righteousness

Philippians 3:9 And be found in Him, not having [my own](#) righteousness, which *is* from the law, but that which *is* through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith.

His Own

John 1:11 He came to [His own](#), and [His own](#) did not receive Him.

John 13:1 Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved [His own](#) who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

His Own Son

Malachi 3:17 "They shall be Mine," says the LORD of hosts, "On the day that I make them My jewels. And I will spare them As a man spares [his own son](#) who serves him."

Romans 8:3 For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God *did* by sending [His own Son](#) in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh,

Hebrews 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with [His own blood](#) He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Hebrews 13:12 Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with [His own blood](#), suffered outside the gate.

Revelation 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in [His own blood](#).

His Own People

Psalms 78:52 But He made [His own people](#) go forth like sheep, And guided them in the wilderness like a flock.

Mark 3:21 But when [His own people](#) heard *about this*, they went out to lay hold of Him, for they said, "He is out of His mind."

Luke 18:7 And shall God not avenge [His own elect](#) who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them?

1 Samuel 18:3 Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his [own soul](#).

1 Samuel 20:17 Now Jonathan again caused David to vow, because he loved him; for he loved him as he loved his [own soul](#).

Proverbs 6:32 Whoever commits adultery with a woman lacks understanding; He *who* does so destroys his [own soul](#).

Proverbs 8:36 But he who sins against me wrongs his [own soul](#); All those who hate me love death."

Proverbs 11:17 The merciful man does good for his [own soul](#), But *he who is* cruel troubles his own flesh.

Proverbs 15:32 He who disdains instruction despises his [own soul](#), But he who heeds rebuke gets understanding.

Proverbs 19:8 He who gets wisdom loves his [own soul](#); He who keeps understanding will find good.

Matthew 16:26 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his [own soul](#)? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

Genesis 15:4 And behold, the word of the LORD *came* to him, saying, "This one shall not be your heir, but one who will come from your [own body](#) shall be your heir."

Deuteronomy 28:53 "You shall eat the fruit of your [own body](#), the flesh of your sons and your daughters whom the LORD your God has given you, in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you.

2 Samuel 16:11 And David said to Abishai and all his servants, "See how my son who came from my [own body](#) seeks my life. How much more now *may this* Benjamite? Let him alone, and let him curse; for so the LORD has ordered him.

Job 19:17 My breath is offensive to my wife, And I am repulsive to the children of my [own body](#).

Romans 4:19 And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his [own body](#), already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb.

1 Corinthians 6:18 Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his [own body](#).

1 Corinthians 7:4 The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband *does*. And likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife *does*.

1 Corinthians 15:38 But God gives it a body as He pleases, and to each seed its own body.

1 Peter 2:24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

Own Spirit

Proverbs 25:28 Whoever *has* no rule over his own spirit *Is like* a city broken down, without walls.

Ezekiel 13:3 Thus says the Lord GOD: "Woe to the foolish prophets, who follow their own spirit and have seen nothing!
