Cried Out To The Lord

This poor man <u>cried</u> out, and the \underline{LORD} heard *him*, And saved him out of all his troubles. Fsalms 34:6

Believers in the Bible cried out to Yahweh for relief from all their troubles and to praise Him for His solutions. Even if we are wary of Him, Immanuel hears our hearts as we cry out to Him. He builds capacity until we are willing to receive His gracious provision. He knows. He hears. He is the only One who truly understands what, why and where the pain is and what to do about it.

Cried Out For Miracles

Exodus 8:12 Then Moses and Aaron went out from Pharaoh. And Moses <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> concerning the frogs which He had brought against Pharaoh.

Cried Out For Direction

Exodus 15:25 So he <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, and the <u>LORD</u> showed him a tree. When he cast *it* into the waters, the waters were made sweet. There He made a statute and an ordinance for them. And there He tested them.

Exodus 17:4 So Moses <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, saying, "What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me!"

Cried Out For Protection

Exodus 14:10 And when Pharaoh drew near, the children of Israel lifted their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians marched after them. So they were very afraid, and the children of Israel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>.

Joshua 24:7 'So they <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>; and He put darkness between you and the Egyptians, brought the sea upon them, and covered them. And your eyes saw what I did in Egypt. Then you dwelt in the wilderness a long time.

1 Samuel 7:9 And Samuel took a suckling lamb and offered *it as* a whole burnt offering to the <u>LORD</u>. Then Samuel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> for Israel, and the <u>LORD</u> answered him.

Cried Out For Deliverance/Salvation

- Exodus 2:23 Now it happened in the process of time that the king of Egypt died. Then the children of Israel groaned because of the bondage, and they <u>cried</u> out; and their cry came up to <u>God</u> because of the bondage.
- Numbers 11:2 Then the people <u>cried</u> out to Moses, and when Moses prayed to the <u>LORD</u>, the fire was quenched.
- Numbers 20:16 'When we <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, He heard our voice and sent the Angel and brought us up out of Egypt; now here we are in Kadesh, a city on the edge of your border.
- Deuteronomy 26:7 'Then we <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> God of our fathers, and the <u>LORD</u> heard our voice and looked on our affliction and our labor and our oppression.
- Judges 3:9 When the children of Israel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, the <u>LORD</u> raised up a deliverer for the children of Israel, who delivered them: Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother.
- Judges 3:15 But when the children of Israel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, the <u>LORD</u> raised up a deliverer for them: Ehud the son of Gera, the Benjamite, a left–handed man. By him the children of Israel sent tribute to Eglon king of Moab.
- Judges 4:3 And the children of Israel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>; for Jabin had nine hundred chariots of iron, and for twenty years he harshly oppressed the children of Israel.
- Judges 6:6-7 So Israel was greatly impoverished because of the Midianites, and the children of Israel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>. And it came to pass, when the children of Israel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> because of the Midianites,
- 1 Samuel 12:8 When Jacob had gone into Egypt, and your fathers <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, then the <u>LORD</u> sent Moses and Aaron, who brought your fathers out of Egypt and made them dwell in this place.
- 2 Chronicles 13:14 And when Judah looked around, to their surprise the battle line *was* at both front and rear; and they <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, and the priests sounded the trumpets.
- 2 Chronicles 14:11 And Asa <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> his God, and said, "<u>LORD</u>, *it is* nothing for You to help, whether with many or with those who have no power; help us, O <u>LORD</u> our God, for we rest on You, and in Your name we go against this multitude. O <u>LORD</u>, You *are* our God; do not let man prevail against You!"
- 2 Chronicles 18:31 So it was, when the captains of the chariots saw Jehoshaphat, that they said, "It is the king of Israel!" Therefore they surrounded him to attack; but Jehoshaphat <u>cried</u> out, and the <u>LORD</u> helped him, and God diverted them from him.
- Psalms 18:41 They <u>cried</u> out, but *there was* none to save; *Even* to the <u>LORD</u>, but He did not answer them.
- Psalms 34:6 This poor man <u>cried</u> out, and the <u>LORD</u> heard *him*, And saved him out of all his troubles. Psalms 88:1 A Song. A Psalm of the sons of Korah. To the Chief Musician. Set to "Mahalath Leannoth." A Contemplation of Heman the Ezrahite. O <u>LORD</u>, God of my salvation, I have <u>cried</u> out day and night before You.

- Psalms 88:13 But to You I have <u>cried</u> out, O <u>LORD</u>, And in the morning my prayer comes before You.
- Jonah 2:2 And he said: "I <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> because of my affliction, And He answered me. Out of the belly of Sheol I <u>cried</u>, *And* You heard my voice."
- Matthew 14:30 But when he saw that the wind *was* boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he <u>cried</u> out, saying, "<u>Lord</u>, save me!"
- Matthew 15:22 And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and <u>cried</u> out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O <u>Lord</u>, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon–possessed."

Cried Out For Healing

Numbers 12:13 So Moses <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, saying, "Please heal her, O God, I pray!"

- 1 Kings 17:21 And he stretched himself out on the child three times, and <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> and said, "O <u>LORD</u> my God, I pray, let this child's soul come back to him."
- Psalms 30:2 O <u>LORD</u> my God, I <u>cried</u> out to You, And You healed me.
- Matthew 20:30 And behold, two blind men sitting by the road, when they heard that Jesus was passing by, cried out, saying, "Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David!"
- Matthew 20:31 Then the multitude warned them that they should be quiet; but they <u>cried</u> out all the more, saying, "Have mercy on us, O <u>Lord</u>, Son of David!"

Cried Out During Battle

- Judges 7:20 Then the three companies blew the trumpets and broke the pitchers—they held the torches in their left hands and the trumpets in their right hands for blowing—and they <u>cried</u>, "The sword of the <u>LORD</u> and of Gideon!"
- 1 Chronicles 5:20 And they were helped against them, and the Hagrites were delivered into their hand, and all who *were* with them, for they <u>cried</u> out to <u>God</u> in the battle. He heeded their prayer, because they put their trust in Him.

Cried Out In Repentance

- Judges 10:10 And the children of Israel <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, saying, "We have sinned against You, because we have both forsaken our God and served the Baals!"
- 1 Samuel 12:10 Then they <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, and said, 'We have sinned, because we have forsaken the <u>LORD</u> and served the Baals and Ashtoreths; but now deliver us from the hand of our enemies, and we will serve You.'

Cried Out In Need

- Judges 15:18 Then he became very thirsty; so he <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> and said, "You have given this great deliverance by the hand of Your servant; and now shall I die of thirst and fall into the hand of the uncircumcised?"
- 2 Kings 4:1 A certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets <u>cried</u> out to Elisha, saying, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the <u>LORD</u>. And the creditor is coming to take my two sons to be his slaves."
- Psalms 30:8 I <u>cried</u> out to You, O <u>LORD</u>; And to the <u>LORD</u> I made supplication:
- Mark 9:24 Immediately the father of the child <u>cried</u> out and said with tears, "<u>Lord</u>, I believe; help my unbelief!"

Cried Out In Sorrow

- 1 Samuel 15:11 I greatly regret that I have set up Saul *as* king, for he has turned back from following Me, and has not performed My commandments." And it grieved Samuel, and he <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> all night.
- Lamentations 2:18 Their heart <u>cried</u> out to the <u>Lord</u>, "O wall of the daughter of Zion, Let tears run down like a river day and night; Give yourself no relief; Give your eyes no rest."

Cried Out In Distress

- 2 Samuel 22:7 In my distress I called upon the <u>LORD</u>, And <u>cried</u> out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry *entered* His ears.
- 1 Kings 17:20 Then he <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> and said, "O <u>LORD</u> my God, have You also brought tragedy on the widow with whom I lodge, by killing her son?"
- 2 Kings 6:26 Then, as the king of Israel was passing by on the wall, a woman <u>cried</u> out to him, saying, "Help, my <u>lord</u>, O king!"
- Psalms 3:4 I cried to the LORD with my voice, And He heard me from His holy hill. Selah
- Psalms 18:6 In my distress I called upon the <u>LORD</u>, And <u>cried</u> out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry came before Him, *even* to His ears.
- Psalms 77:1 To the Chief Musician. To Jeduthun. A Psalm of Asaph. I <u>cried</u> out to <u>God</u> with my voice—To <u>God</u> with my voice; And He gave ear to me.
- Psalms 107:6 Then they <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> in their trouble, *And* He delivered them out of their distresses.
- Psalms 107:13 Then they <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> in their trouble, *And* He saved them out of their distresses.

- Psalms 107:19 Then they <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> in their trouble, *And* He saved them out of their distresses.
- Psalms 120:1 A Song of Ascents. In my distress I cried to the LORD, And He heard me.
- Matthew 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus <u>cried</u> out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My <u>God</u>, My <u>God</u>, why have You forsaken Me?"
- Mark 15:34 And at the ninth hour Jesus <u>cried</u> out with a loud voice, saying, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which is translated, "My <u>God</u>, My <u>God</u>, why have You forsaken Me?"

Cried Out Prophetically

- 1 Kings 13:2 Then he <u>cried</u> out against the altar by the word of the <u>LORD</u>, and said, "O altar, altar! Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: 'Behold, a child, Josiah by name, shall be born to the house of David; and on you he shall sacrifice the priests of the high places who burn incense on you, and men's bones shall be burned on you."
- 1 Kings 13:21 And he <u>cried</u> out to the man of God who came from Judah, saying, "Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: Because you have disobeyed the word of the <u>LORD</u>, and have not kept the commandment which the <u>LORD</u> your God commanded you."
- 1 Kings 13:32 For the saying which he <u>cried</u> out by the word of the <u>LORD</u> against the altar in Bethel, and against all the shrines on the high places which *are* in the cities of Samaria, will surely come to pass.
- 2 Kings 20:11 So Isaiah the prophet <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u>, and He brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down on the sundial of Ahaz.
- Isaiah 21:8 Then he <u>cried</u>, "A lion, my <u>Lord</u>! I stand continually on the watchtower in the daytime; I have sat at my post every night.
- Jeremiah 20:8 For when I spoke, I <u>cried</u> out; I shouted, "Violence and plunder!" Because the word of the <u>LORD</u> was made to me A reproach and a derision daily.

Cried Out For Forgiveness

- Ezekiel 9:8 So it was, that while they were killing them, I was left *alone*; and I fell on my face and <u>cried</u> out, and said, "Ah, <u>Lord</u> GOD! Will You destroy all the remnant of Israel in pouring out Your fury on Jerusalem?"
- Ezekiel 11:13 Now it happened, while I was prophesying, that Pelatiah the son of Benaiah died. Then I fell on my face and <u>cried</u> with a loud voice, and said, "Ah, <u>Lord</u> GOD! Will You make a complete end of the remnant of Israel?"
- Jonah 1:14 Therefore they <u>cried</u> out to the <u>LORD</u> and said, "We pray, O <u>LORD</u>, please do not let us perish for this man's life, and do not charge us with innocent blood; for You, O <u>LORD</u>, have done as it pleased You."

Acts 7:60 Then he knelt down and <u>cried</u> out with a loud voice, "<u>Lord</u>, do not charge them with this sin." And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

Cried Out For Vengeance

Revelation 6:10 And they <u>cried</u> with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O <u>Lord</u>, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

Cried Out Praise

- Nehemiah 9:4 Then Jeshua, Bani, Kadmiel, Shebaniah, Bunni, Sherebiah, Bani, *and* Chenani stood on the stairs of the Levites and <u>cried</u> out with a loud voice to the <u>LORD</u> their God.
- Psalms 142:5 I cried out to You, O LORD: I said, "You are my refuge, My portion in the land of the living."
- Isaiah 6:3 And one <u>cried</u> to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the <u>LORD</u> of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"
- Matthew 21:9 Then the multitudes who went before and those who followed <u>cried</u> out, saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed *is* He who comes in the name of the <u>LORD</u>!' Hosanna in the highest!"
- Mark 11:9 Then those who went before and those who followed <u>cried</u> out, saying: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the <u>LORD</u>!'
- John 12:13 Took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and <u>cried</u> out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the <u>LORD</u>!' The King of Israel!"

Cried Out In Recognition

- Matthew 8:29 And suddenly they <u>cried</u> out, saying, "What have we to do with You, Jesus, You Son of <u>God?</u> Have You come here to torment us before the time?"
- Mark 3:11 And the unclean spirits, whenever they saw Him, fell down before Him and <u>cried</u> out, saying, "You are the Son of God."
- Mark 5:7 And he <u>cried</u> out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High <u>God</u>? I implore You by <u>God</u> that You do not torment me."
- Mark 15:39 So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He <u>cried</u> out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the Son of <u>God!"</u>
- Luke 8:28 When he saw Jesus, he <u>cried</u> out, fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High <u>God</u>? I beg You, do not torment me!"
