Determined By God

Job 14:5 Since his days are determined, The number of his months is with You; You have appointed his limits, so that he cannot pass.

Job 38:5 Who determined its measurements? Surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it?

Isaiah 10:23 For the Lord GOD of hosts Will make a determined end In the midst of all the land.

Isaiah 19:17 And the land of Judah will be a terror to Egypt; everyone who makes mention of it will be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the LORD of hosts which He has determined against it.

Isaiah 28:22 Now therefore, do not be mockers, Lest your bonds be made strong; For I have heard from the Lord GOD of hosts, A destruction determined even upon the whole earth.

Daniel 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined For your people and for your holy city, To finish the transgression, To make an end of sins, To make reconciliation for iniquity, To bring in everlasting righteousness, To seal up vision and prophecy, And to anoint the Most Holy.

Daniel 9:26 And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it shall be with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined.

Daniel 9:27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; But in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, Is poured out on the desolate.

Daniel 11:36 Then the king shall do according to his own will: he shall exalt and magnify himself above every god, shall speak blasphemies against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the wrath has been accomplished; for what has been determined shall be done.

Zechariah 1:6 Yet surely My words and My statutes, Which I commanded My servants the prophets, Did they not overtake your fathers? "So they returned and said: 'Just as the LORD of hosts determined to do to us, According to our ways and according to our deeds, So He has dealt with us.'"

Zechariah 8:14 For thus says the LORD of hosts: 'Just as I determined to punish you When your fathers provoked Me to wrath,' Says the LORD of hosts, 'And I would not relent.'

Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His Servant Jesus, whom you delivered up and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let Him go.

Acts 11:29 Then the disciples, each according to his ability, determined to send relief to the brethren dwelling in Judea.

Acts 15:2 Therefore, when Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and dispute with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas and certain others of them should go up to Jerusalem, to the apostles and elders, about this question.

Acts 15:37 Now Barnabas was determined to take with them John called Mark.

Acts 16:4 And as they went through the cities, they delivered to them the decrees to keep, which were determined by the apostles and elders at Jerusalem.

1 Corinthians 2:2 For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.

1 Corinthians 7:37 Nevertheless he who stands steadfast in his heart, having no necessity, but has power over his own will, and has so determined in his heart that he will keep his virgin, does well.

2 Corinthians 2:1 But I determined this within myself, that I would not come again to you in sorrow.

Set By God

Genesis 9:13 I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth.

Genesis 28:12 Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder *was* set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.

Deuteronomy 7:7 The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples.

Deuteronomy 11:26 Behold, I set before you today a blessing and a curse.

Deuteronomy 11:32 And you shall be careful to observe all the statutes and judgments which I set before you today.

Deuteronomy 30:15 See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil.

Deuteronomy 30:19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live.

2 Chronicles 20:3 And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah.

Psalms 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me; Because *He is* at my right hand I shall not be moved.

Psalms 78:7 That they may set their hope in God, And not forget the works of God, But keep His commandments.

Psalms 78:8 And may not be like their fathers, A stubborn and rebellious generation, A generation *that* did not set its heart aright, And whose spirit was not faithful to God.

Psalms 84:5 Blessed *is* the man whose strength *is* in You, Whose heart *is* set on pilgrimage.

Psalms 86:14 O God, the proud have risen against me, And a mob of violent *men* have sought my life, And have not set You before them.

Psalms 91:14 Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.

2 Samuel 6:21 So David said to Michal, "*It was* before the LORD, who chose me instead of your father and all his house, to appoint me ruler over the people of the LORD, over Israel. Therefore I will play *music* before the LORD.

2 Samuel 7:10 Moreover I will appoint a place for My people Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own and move no more; nor shall the sons of wickedness oppress them anymore, as previously.

1 Chronicles 17:9 Moreover I will appoint a place for My people Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own and move no more; nor shall the sons of wickedness oppress them anymore, as previously.

Job 9:19 If *it is a matter* of strength, indeed *He is* strong; And if of justice, who will appoint my day *in court*?

Job 14:13 Oh, that You would hide me in the grave, That You would conceal me until Your wrath is past, That You would appoint me a set time, and remember me!

Jeremiah 51:27 Set up a banner in the land, Blow the trumpet among the nations! Prepare the nations against her, Call the kingdoms together against her: Ararat, Minni, and Ashkenaz. [Appoint](#) a general against her; Cause the horses to come up like the bristling locusts.

Zephaniah 3:19 Behold, at that time I will deal with all who afflict you; I will save the lame, And gather those who were driven out; I will [appoint](#) them for praise and fame In every land where they were put to shame.

Matthew 24:51 And will cut him in two and [appoint](#) *him* his portion with the hypocrites. There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Luke 12:46 The master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for *him*, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and [appoint](#) *him* his portion with the unbelievers.

1 Thessalonians 5:9 For God did not [appoint](#) us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Appoint (By People)

Genesis 41:34 Let Pharaoh do *this*, and let him [appoint](#) officers over the land, to collect one-fifth *of the produce* of the land of Egypt in the seven plentiful years.

Exodus 21:13 However, if he did not lie in wait, but God delivered *him* into his hand, then I will [appoint](#) for you a place where he may flee.

Exodus 30:16 And you shall take the atonement money of the children of Israel, and shall [appoint](#) it for the service of the tabernacle of meeting, that it may be a memorial for the children of Israel before the LORD, to make atonement for yourselves.

Numbers 1:50 But you shall [appoint](#) the Levites over the tabernacle of the Testimony, over all its furnishings, and over all things that belong to it; they shall carry the tabernacle and all its furnishings; they shall attend to it and camp around the tabernacle.

Numbers 3:10 So you shall [appoint](#) Aaron and his sons, and they shall attend to their priesthood; but the outsider who comes near shall be put to death."

Numbers 4:19 But do this in regard to them, that they may live and not die when they approach the most holy things: Aaron and his sons shall go in and [appoint](#) each of them to his service and his task.

Numbers 4:27 Aaron and his sons shall assign all the service of the sons of the Gershonites, all their tasks and all their service. And you shall [appoint](#) to them all their tasks as their duty.

Numbers 35:6 Now among the cities which you will give to the Levites *you shall* [appoint](#) six cities of refuge, to which a manslayer may flee. And to these you shall add forty-two cities.

Numbers 35:11 "Then you shall [appoint](#) cities to be cities of refuge for you, that the manslayer who kills any person accidentally may flee there.

Numbers 35:14 "You shall [appoint](#) three cities on this side of the Jordan, and three cities you shall [appoint](#) in the land of Canaan, *which* will be cities of refuge.

Deuteronomy 16:18 You shall [appoint](#) judges and officers in all your gates, which the LORD your God gives you, according to your tribes, and they shall judge the people with just judgment.

Joshua 20:2 Speak to the children of Israel, saying: '[Appoint](#) for yourselves cities of refuge, of which I spoke to you through Moses.

1 Samuel 8:11 And he said, "This will be the behavior of the king who will reign over you: He will take your sons and [appoint](#) *them* for his own chariots and *to be* his horsemen, and *some* will run before his chariots."

1 Samuel 8:12 He will [appoint](#) captains over his thousands and captains over his fifties, *will set some* to plow his ground and reap his harvest, and *some* to make his weapons of war and equipment for his chariots.

1 Chronicles 15:16 Then David spoke to the leaders of the Levites to [appoint](#) their brethren *to be* the singers accompanied by instruments of music, stringed instruments, harps, and cymbals, by raising the voice with resounding joy.

Nehemiah 7:3 And I said to them, "Do not let the gates of Jerusalem be opened until the sun is hot; and while they stand *guard*, let them shut and bar the doors; and [appoint](#) guards from among the inhabitants of Jerusalem, one at his watch station and another in front of his own house."

Esther 2:3 And let the king [appoint](#) officers in all the provinces of his kingdom, that they may gather all the beautiful young virgins to Shushan the citadel, into the women's quarters, under the custody of Hegai the king's eunuch, custodian of the women. And let beauty preparations be given *them*.

Ezekiel 21:19 And son of man, [appoint](#) for yourself two ways for the sword of the king of Babylon to go; both of them shall go from the same land. Make a sign; put *it* at the head of the road to the city.

Ezekiel 21:20 [Appoint](#) a road for the sword to go to Rabbah of the Ammonites, and to Judah, into fortified Jerusalem.

Ezekiel 45:6 You shall [appoint](#) as the property of the city *an area* five thousand *cubits* wide and twenty-five thousand long, adjacent to the district of the holy *section*; it shall belong to the whole house of Israel.

Hosea 1:11 Then the children of Judah and the children of Israel Shall be gathered together, And [appoint](#) for themselves one head; And they shall come up out of the land, For great *will be* the day of Jezreel!

Acts 6:3 Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of *good* reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may [appoint](#) over this business.

1 Corinthians 6:4 If then you have judgments concerning things pertaining to this life, do you [appoint](#) those who are least esteemed by the church to judge?

Titus 1:5 For this reason I left you in Crete, that you should set in order the things that are lacking, and [appoint](#) elders in every city as I commanded you—

Appoints

Daniel 5:21 "Then he was driven from the sons of men, his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling *was* with the wild donkeys. They fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till he knew that the Most High God rules in the kingdom of men, and [appoints](#) over it whomever He chooses.

Hebrews 7:28 For the law [appoints](#) as high priests men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, [appoints](#) the Son who has been perfected forever.

Appointed Time

Genesis 18:14 Is anything too hard for the LORD? At the [appointed time](#) I will return to you, according to the [time](#) of life, and Sarah shall have a son.

Exodus 9:5 Then the LORD [appointed](#) a set [time](#), saying, "Tomorrow the LORD will do this thing in the land."

Exodus 23:15 You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread (you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, at the [time appointed](#) in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt; none shall appear before Me empty).

Exodus 34:18 The Feast of Unleavened Bread you shall keep. Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, as I commanded you, in the [appointed time](#) of the month of Abib; for in the month of Abib you came out from Egypt.

Numbers 9:2 Let the children of Israel keep the Passover at its [appointed time](#).

Numbers 9:3 On the fourteenth day of this month, at twilight, you shall keep it at its [appointed time](#). According to all its rites and ceremonies you shall keep it."

Numbers 9:7 And those men said to him, "We *became* defiled by a human corpse. Why are we kept from presenting the offering of the LORD at its [appointed time](#) among the children of Israel?"

Numbers 9:13 'But the man who *is* clean and is not on a journey, and ceases to keep the Passover, that same person shall be cut off from among his people, because he did not bring the offering of the LORD at its [appointed time](#); that man shall bear his sin.

Numbers 28:2 Command the children of Israel, and say to them, 'My offering, My food for My offerings made by fire as a sweet aroma to Me, you shall be careful to offer to Me at their [appointed time](#).'

Deuteronomy 31:10 And Moses commanded them, saying: "At the end of *every* seven years, at the appointed time in the year of release, at the Feast of Tabernacles,

1 Samuel 20:35 And so it was, in the morning, that Jonathan went out into the field at the time appointed with David, and a little lad *was* with him.

2 Samuel 20:5 So Amasa went to assemble *the men of* Judah. But he delayed longer than the set time which David had appointed him.

2 Samuel 24:15 So the LORD sent a plague upon Israel from the morning till the appointed time. From Dan to Beersheba seventy thousand men of the people died.

2 Kings 4:17 But the woman conceived, and bore a son when the appointed time had come, of which Elisha had told her.

Nehemiah 12:44 And at the same time some were appointed over the rooms of the storehouse for the offerings, the firstfruits, and the tithes, to gather into them from the fields of the cities the portions specified by the Law for the priests and Levites; for Judah rejoiced over the priests and Levites who ministered.

Esther 9:31 To confirm these days of Purim at their appointed time, as Mordecai the Jew and Queen Esther had prescribed for them, and as they had decreed for themselves and their descendants concerning matters of their fasting and lamenting.

Jeremiah 8:7 Even the stork in the heavens Knows her appointed times; And the turtledove, the swift, and the swallow Observe the time of their coming. But My people do not know the judgment of the LORD.

Jeremiah 46:17 They cried there, 'Pharaoh, king of Egypt, *is but* a noise. He has passed by the appointed time!'

Daniel 1:5 And the king appointed for them a daily provision of the king's delicacies and of the wine which he drank, and three years of training for them, so that at the end of *that time* they might serve before the king.

Daniel 8:19 And he said, Look, I am making known to you what shall happen in the latter time of the indignation; for at the appointed time the end *shall be*.

Daniel 10:1 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a message was revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar. The message *was* true, but the appointed time *was* long; and he understood the message, and had understanding of the vision.

Daniel 11:27 Both these kings' hearts *shall be* bent on evil, and they shall speak lies at the same table; but it shall not prosper, for the end *will still be* at the appointed time.

Daniel 11:29 At the appointed time he shall return and go toward the south; but it shall not be like the former or the latter.

Daniel 11:35 And *some* of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify *them*, and make *them* white, *until* the time of the end; because *it is* still for the appointed time.

Habakkuk 2:3 For the vision *is* yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry.

Galatians 4:2 But is under guardians and stewards until the [time appointed](#) by the father.

Set Time

Genesis 17:21 But My covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this [set time](#) next year.

Genesis 21:2 For Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age, at the [set time](#) of which God had spoken to him.

Exodus 9:5 Then the LORD appointed a [set time](#), saying, "Tomorrow the LORD will do this thing in the land."

2 Samuel 20:5 So Amasa went to assemble *the men of* Judah. But he delayed longer than the [set time](#) which David had appointed him.

Job 14:13 Oh, that You would hide me in the grave, That You would conceal me until Your wrath is past, That You would appoint me a [set time](#), and remember me!

Psalms 102:13 You will arise *and* have mercy on Zion; For the time to favor her, Yes, the [set time](#), has come.

Ordained

Numbers 28:6 *It is* a regular burnt offering which was [ordained](#) at Mount Sinai for a sweet aroma, an offering made by fire to the LORD.

1 Kings 12:32 Jeroboam [ordained](#) a feast on the fifteenth day of the eighth month, like the feast that *was* in Judah, and offered sacrifices on the altar. So he did at Bethel, sacrificing to the calves that he had made. And at Bethel he installed the priests of the high places which he had made.

1 Kings 12:33 So he made offerings on the altar which he had made at Bethel on the fifteenth day of the eighth month, in the month which he had devised in his own heart. And he [ordained](#) a feast for the children of Israel, and offered sacrifices on the altar and burned incense.

2 Kings 23:5 Then he removed the idolatrous priests whom the kings of Judah had [ordained](#) to burn incense on the high places in the cities of Judah and in the places all around Jerusalem, and those who burned incense to Baal, to the sun, to the moon, to the constellations, and to all the host of heaven.

Psalms 8:2 Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have [ordained](#) strength, Because of Your enemies, That You may silence the enemy and the avenger.

Psalms 8:3 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have [ordained](#).

Jeremiah 1:5 Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I [ordained](#) you a prophet to the nations.

Acts 10:42 And He commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that it is He who was ordained by God *to be* Judge of the living and the dead.

Acts 17:31 Because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead.

1 Corinthians 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden *wisdom* which God ordained before the ages for our glory.

Ordain

1 Corinthians 7:17 But as God has distributed to each one, as the Lord has called each one, so let him walk. And so I ordain in all the churches.
