Father God

No one has seen <u>God</u> at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the <u>Father</u>, He has declared *Him*. John 1:18

While Scripture is clear that the full glory of the Father cannot be experienced by humans, it is equally clear that we can experience Him in a lesser form. Humans experienced Him because Jesus, the Son, declared Him by coming in the form of a human. We too can see the Father in the same way Jesus did while He was on earth-through the Spirit. The term "father" tells us that we are to be like Him. Jesus calls Him "My Father" and also "Your Father". As we experience Immanuel in our prayer sessions, we get to know Our Father and become more and more like Him.

- Hebrews 12:8 But if you are without <u>chastening</u>, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons.
- Hebrews 12:11 Now no <u>chastening</u> seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

Adopted Sons

- Romans 8:15 For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father."
- Romans 8:23 Not only *that*, but we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the <u>adoption</u>, the redemption of our body.

2 Corinthians 6:18 "I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty."

Sons of God

- Genesis 6:2 that the <u>sons of God</u> saw the daughters of men, that they *were* beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose.
- Genesis 6:4 There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the <u>sons of God</u> came in to the daughters of men and they bore *children* to them. Those *were* the mighty men who *were* of old, men of renown.
- Job 1:6 Now there was a day when the <u>sons</u> of <u>God</u> came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them.

- Proverbs 4:10 Hear, my son, and receive my sayings, And the years of your life will be many.
- Proverbs 4:20 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.
- Proverbs 5:1 My son, pay attention to my wisdom; Lend your ear to my understanding,
- Proverbs 5:20 For why should you, my son, be enraptured by an immoral woman, And be embraced in the arms of a seductress?
- Proverbs 6:1 My son, if you become surety for your friend, If you have shaken hands in pledge for a stranger,

- Proverbs 6:3 So do this, my son, and deliver yourself; For you have come into the hand of your friend: Go and humble yourself; Plead with your friend.
- Proverbs 6:20 My son, keep your father's command, And do not forsake the law of your mother.
- Proverbs 7:1 My son, keep my words, And treasure my commands within you.
- Proverbs 19:27 Cease listening to instruction, my son, And you will stray from the words of knowledge.
- Proverbs 23:15 My son, if your heart is wise, My heart will rejoice—indeed, I myself;
- Proverbs 23:19 Hear, my son, and be wise; And guide your heart in the way.
- Proverbs 23:26 My son, give me your heart, And let your eyes observe my ways.
- Proverbs 24:13 My son, eat honey because it is good, And the honeycomb which is sweet to your taste;
- Proverbs 24:21 My son, fear the LORD and the king; Do not associate with those given to change;
- Proverbs 27:11 My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, That I may answer him who reproaches me.
- Proverbs 31:2 What, my son? And what, son of my womb? And what, son of my vows?
- Ecclesiastes 12:12 And further, my son, be admonished by these. Of making many books *there is* no end, and much study *is* wearisome to the flesh.

Earthly Fathers

- Genesis 2:24 Therefore a man shall leave his <u>father and mother</u> and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.
- Exodus 20:12 <u>Honor your</u> father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.
- Deuteronomy 5:16 'Honor your father and your mother, as the LORD your God has commanded you, that your days may be long, and that it may be well with you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 'Why do you kick at My sacrifice and My offering which I have commanded *in My* dwelling place, and <u>honor your</u> sons more than Me, to make yourselves fat with the best of all the offerings of Israel My people?'
- Psalms 27:10 When my father and my mother forsake me, Then the LORD will take care of me.
- Proverbs 1:8 My son, hear the instruction of your father, And do not forsake the law of your mother;
- Proverbs 6:20 My son, keep your father's command, And do not forsake the law of your mother.
- Proverbs 13:24 He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him <u>disciplines</u> him promptly.

- Proverbs 23:22 Listen to your father who begot you, And do not despise your mother when she is old.
- Proverbs 23:25 Let your father and your mother be glad, And let her who bore you rejoice.
- Proverbs 27:10 Do not forsake your own friend or <u>your father</u>'s friend, Nor go to your brother's house in the day of your calamity; Better *is* a neighbor nearby than a brother far away.
- Isaiah 49:23 Kings shall be your foster <u>fathers</u>, And their queens your nursing mothers; They shall bow down to you with *their* faces to the earth, And lick up the dust of your feet. Then you will know that I *am* the LORD, For they shall not be ashamed who wait for Me.
- Malachi 4:6 And he will turn The hearts of the <u>fathers</u> to the children, And the hearts of the children to their <u>fathers</u>, Lest I come and strike the earth with a curse.
- Matthew 7:11 If you then, <u>being evil</u>, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!
- Matthew 15:4 For God commanded, saying, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.'
- Matthew 19:19 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'
- Mark 7:10 For Moses said, 'Honor <u>your father</u> and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.'
- Mark 10:19 You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Do not defraud,' 'Honor <u>your father</u> and your mother.'
- Luke 1:17 He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the <u>fathers</u> to the children,' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.
- Luke 11:13 If you then, <u>being evil</u>, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!
- Luke 18:20 You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Honor your father and your mother.'
- John 8:38 I speak what I have seen with My Father, and you do what you have seen with your father.
- John 8:41-42 You do the deeds of <u>your father</u>." Then they said to Him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one Father—God. Jesus said to them, "If God were <u>your Father</u>, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me.
- John 8:44 "You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of <u>your</u> father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a liar and the father of it.
- Ephesians 6:2 "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise:
- Ephesians 6:4 And you, <u>fathers</u>, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

- Colossians 3:21 Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.
- 1 Timothy 1:9-10 Knowing this: that the law is not made for a righteous person, but for the lawless and insubordinate, for the ungodly and for sinners, for the unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, for fornicators, for sodomites, for kidnappers, for liars, for perjurers, and if there is any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine.
- Hebrews 12:9 Furthermore, we have had human <u>fathers</u> who corrected *us*, and we paid *them* respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live?

Like Father, Like Son <u>Iesus</u>

John 8:19 Then they said to Him, "Where is Your Father?" Jesus answered, "You know neither Me nor My Father. If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also."

John 5:19 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner."

John 5:30 I can of Myself do nothing. As I <u>hear</u>, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me.

John 6:38 "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

- John 14:24 He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you <u>hear</u> is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me.
- John 14:8-9 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?
- Hebrews 10:7 Then I said, 'Behold, I have come—In the volume of the book it is written of Me—To do Your will, O God.'"
- Hebrews 10:9 then He said, "Behold, I have come to do <u>Your will</u>, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second.

Christians

Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify <u>your Father in heaven</u>.

Matthew 5:44-45 But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, that you may be sons of <u>your Father in heaven</u>; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust.

Matthew 5:48 Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect.

Pharisees

John 8:41, 44 "You do the deeds of your father." Then they said to Him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one <u>Father—God"</u>...
