From Above (Spiritual)

- Genesis 27:39 Then Isaac his father answered and said to him: "Behold, your dwelling shall be of the fatness of the earth, And of the dew of heaven <u>from above</u>."
- 2 Samuel 22:17 He sent from above, He took me, He drew me out of many waters.
- Job 31:2 For what is the allotment of God from above, And the inheritance of the Almighty from on high?
- Psalms 18:16 He sent from above, He took me; He drew me out of many waters.
- Psalms 50:4 He shall call to the heavens from above, And to the earth, that He may judge His people.
- Psalms 144:7 Stretch out Your hand from above; Rescue me and deliver me out of great waters, From the hand of foreigners.
- Proverbs 14:14 The backslider in heart will be filled with his own ways, But a good man *will be satisfied* from above.

- John 3:31 He who comes <u>from above</u> is above all; he who is of the earth is earthly and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all.
- John 8:23 And He said to them, "You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world."
- John 19:11 Jesus answered, "You could have no power at all against Me unless it had been given you <u>from</u> <u>above</u>. Therefore the one who delivered Me to you has the greater sin."
- Romans 10:6 But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?" (that is, to bring Christ down *from above*).
- James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is <u>from above</u>, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

- Exodus 40:36 Whenever the cloud was taken up <u>from above</u> the tabernacle, the children of Israel would go onward in all their journeys.
- Numbers 7:89 Now when Moses went into the tabernacle of meeting to speak with Him, he heard the voice of One speaking to him <u>from above</u> the mercy seat that *was* on the ark of the Testimony, from between the two cherubim; thus He spoke to him.
- Numbers 9:17 Whenever the cloud was taken up <u>from above</u> the tabernacle, after that the children of Israel would journey; and in the place where the cloud settled, there the children of Israel would pitch their tents.

- Genesis 49:25 By the God of your father who will help you, And by the Almighty who will bless you *With* blessings of <u>heaven</u> above, Blessings of the deep that lies beneath, Blessings of the breasts and of the womb.
- Exodus 20:4 You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness *of anything* that *is* in <u>heaven</u> <u>above</u>, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth.
- Deuteronomy 4:39 Therefore know this day, and consider *it* in your heart, that the LORD Himself *is* God in <u>heaven above</u> and on the earth beneath; *there is* no other.
