God Made Me

- Genesis 21:6 And Sarah said, "God has made me laugh, and all who hear will laugh with me."
- Genesis 41:51 Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh: "For God has <u>made me</u> forget all my toil and all my father's house."
- Genesis 45:8 So now *it was* not you *who* sent me here, but God; and He has <u>made me</u> a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.
- Genesis 45:9 Hurry and go up to my father, and say to him, 'Thus says your son Joseph: "God has <u>made me</u> lord of all Egypt; come down to me, do not tarry."
- 2 Samuel 22:36 You have also given me the shield of Your salvation; Your gentleness has made me great.
- 1 Chronicles 28:19 "All this," said David, "the LORD <u>made me</u> understand in writing, by His hand upon me, all the works of these plans."
- 2 Chronicles 1:8 And Solomon said to God: "You have shown great mercy to David my father, and have made me king in his place."
- 2 Chronicles 1:9 "Now, O LORD God, let Your promise to David my father be established, for You have made me king over a people like the dust of the earth in multitude."

God Made (Genesis)

- Genesis 1:7 Thus <u>God made</u> the firmament, and divided the waters which *were* under the firmament from the waters which *were* above the firmament; and it was so.
- Genesis 1:16 Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. *He made* the stars also.
- Genesis 1:25 And <u>God made</u> the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth according to its kind. And <u>God</u> saw that *it was* good.
- Genesis 1:31 Then <u>God</u> saw everything that He had <u>made</u>, and indeed *it was* very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day.
- Genesis 2:3 Then <u>God</u> blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which <u>God</u> had created and <u>made</u>.
- Genesis 2:4 This *is* the history of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.
- Genesis 2:9 And out of the ground the LORD <u>God made</u> every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight and good for food. The tree of life *was* also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
- Genesis 2:22 Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man.
- Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD <u>God</u> had <u>made</u>. And he said to the woman, "Has <u>God</u> indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?"
- Genesis 3:21 Also for Adam and his wife the LORD God made tunics of skin, and clothed them.
- Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that <u>God</u> created man, He <u>made</u> him in the likeness of <u>God</u>.
- Genesis 8:1 Then <u>God</u> remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the animals that *were* with him in the ark. And <u>God</u> <u>made</u> a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided.
- Genesis 9:6 Whoever sheds man's blood, By man his blood shall be shed; For in the image of <u>God</u> He <u>made</u> man.
- Genesis 21:6 And Sarah said, "God has made me laugh, and all who hear will laugh with me."
- Genesis 31:13 I am the God of Bethel, where you anointed the pillar and where you made a vow to Me. Now arise, get out of this land, and return to the land of your family.
- Genesis 41:51 Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh: "For God has made me forget all my toil and all my father's house."
- Genesis 45:8 So now *it was* not you *who* sent me here, but <u>God</u>; and He has <u>made</u> me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.

- Genesis 45:9 Hurry and go up to my father, and say to him, 'Thus says your son Joseph: "God has made me lord of all Egypt; come down to me, do not tarry."
- Genesis 49:24 But his bow remained in strength, And the arms of his hands were <u>made</u> strong By the hands of the Mighty *God* of Jacob (From there *is* the Shepherd, the Stone of Israel).

God Made (Ecclesiastes)

- Ecclesiastes 3:11 He has <u>made</u> everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that <u>God</u> does from beginning to end.
- Ecclesiastes 7:13 Consider the work of God; For who can make straight what He has made crooked?
- Ecclesiastes 7:29 Truly, this only I have found: That <u>God made</u> man upright, But they have sought out many schemes."

God Made (Isaiah)

- Isaiah 37:16 O LORD of hosts, <u>God</u> of Israel, *the One* who dwells *between* the cherubim, You *are* <u>God</u>, You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have <u>made</u> heaven and earth.
- Isaiah 45:18 For thus says the LORD, Who created the heavens, Who is <u>God</u>, Who formed the earth and <u>made</u> it, Who has established it, Who did not create it in vain, Who formed it to be inhabited: "I *am* the LORD, and *there is* no other.
- Isaiah 52:10 The LORD has <u>made</u> bare His holy arm In the eyes of all the nations; And all the ends of the earth shall see The salvation of our God.

God Made (Jonah)

- Jonah 1:9 So he said to them, "I am a Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the <u>God</u> of heaven, who <u>made</u> the sea and the dry *land*."
- Jonah 4:6 And the LORD <u>God</u> prepared a plant and <u>made</u> it come up over Jonah, that it might be shade for his head to deliver him from his misery. So Jonah was very grateful for the plant.

New Testament Made Heaven And Earth

- Acts 4:24 So when they heard that, they raised their voice to <u>God</u> with one accord and said: "Lord, You *are* <u>God</u>, who <u>made</u> heaven and earth and the sea, and all that is in them,
- Acts 14:15 and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men with the same nature as you, and preach to you that you should turn from these useless things to the living <u>God</u>, who <u>made</u> the heaven, the earth, the sea, and all things that are in them.

- Acts 17:24 <u>God</u>, who <u>made</u> the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples <u>made</u> with hands.
- Hebrews 9:24 For Christ has not entered the holy places <u>made</u> with hands, *which are* copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of <u>God</u> for us.
- Hebrews 11:3 By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of <u>God</u>, so that the things which are seen were not <u>made</u> of things which are visible.
- Revelation 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, "Fear <u>God</u> and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who <u>made</u> heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."

Made People

Mark 10:6 But from the beginning of the creation, <u>God</u> 'made them male and female'.

- Romans 9:20 But indeed, O man, who are you to reply against <u>God?</u> Will the thing formed say to him who formed *it*, "Why have you <u>made</u> me like this?"
- 2 Corinthians 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house, *this* tent, is destroyed, we have a building from <u>God</u>, a house not <u>made</u> with hands, eternal in the heavens.
- James 3:9 With it we bless our <u>God</u> and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been <u>made</u> in the similitude of <u>God</u>.

People Made

- Matthew 15:6 'Then he need not honor his father or mother.' Thus you have <u>made</u> the commandment of God of no effect by your tradition.
- Acts 7:43 You also took up the tabernacle of Moloch, And the star of your god Remphan, Images which you made to worship; And I will carry you away beyond Babylon.
- Romans 1:23 And changed the glory of the incorruptible <u>God</u> into an image <u>made</u> like corruptible man—and birds and four–footed animals and creeping things.

Healing (God Made Whole)

- Matthew 15:31 So the multitude marveled when they saw *the* mute speaking, *the* maimed <u>made</u> whole, *the* lame walking, and *the* blind seeing; and they glorified the <u>God</u> of Israel.
- Luke 13:13 And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

Appointed (God Made)

- John 19:7 The Jews answered him, "We have a law, and according to our law He ought to die, because He made Himself the Son of God."
- Acts 2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that <u>God</u> has <u>made</u> this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.
- Acts 7:35 This Moses whom they rejected, saying, 'Who <u>made</u> you a ruler and a judge?' is the one <u>God</u> sent *to be* a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the Angel who appeared to him in the bush.
- Acts 20:28 Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has <u>made</u> you overseers, to shepherd the church of <u>God</u> which He purchased with His own blood.
- Romans 4:17 (As it is written, "I have <u>made</u> you a father of many nations") in the presence of Him whom he believed—<u>God</u>, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did.
- 2 Corinthians 5:21 For He <u>made</u> Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of <u>God</u> in Him.
- Hebrews 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was <u>made</u> a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of <u>God</u>, might taste death for everyone.
- Hebrews 2:17 Therefore, in all things He had to be <u>made</u> like *His* brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things *pertaining* to <u>God</u>, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.
- Hebrews 7:3 Without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but <u>made</u> like the Son of <u>God</u>, remains a priest continually.

Made Law/Covenant

- Acts 3:25 You are sons of the prophets, and of the covenant which <u>God made</u> with our fathers, saying to Abraham, 'And in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed.'
- Hebrews 7:19 For the law <u>made</u> nothing perfect; on the other hand, *there is the* bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to <u>God</u>.

Made Promise

- Acts 26:6 And now I stand and am judged for the hope of the promise made by God to our fathers.
- Romans 15:8 Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the truth of <u>God</u>, to confirm the promises <u>made</u> to the fathers.
- Hebrews 6:13 For when <u>God made</u> a promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself.

Made Able

Romans 14:4 Who are you to judge another's servant? To his own master he stands or falls. Indeed, he will be <u>made</u> to stand, for <u>God</u> is able to make him stand.

Made Known

- Romans 16:26 But now <u>made</u> manifest, and by the prophetic Scriptures <u>made</u> known to all nations, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, for obedience to the faith—
- 1 Corinthians 1:20 Where *is* the wise? Where *is* the scribe? Where *is* the disputer of this age? Has not <u>God</u> made foolish the wisdom of this world?
- 1 Corinthians 4:9 For I think that <u>God</u> has displayed us, the apostles, last, as men condemned to death; for we have been <u>made</u> a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men.
- Ephesians 3:10 To the intent that now the manifold wisdom of <u>God</u> might be <u>made</u> known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly *places*.
- Philippians 4:6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be <u>made</u> known to <u>God</u>.

Made Subject

- 1 Corinthians 15:28 Now when all things are <u>made</u> subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that <u>God</u> may be all in all.
- 1 Peter 3:22 Who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of <u>God</u>, angels and authorities and powers having been <u>made</u> subject to Him.

Made Perfect

- Hebrews 11:40 God having provided something better for us, that they should not be <u>made</u> perfect apart from us.
- Hebrews 12:23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn *who are* registered in heaven, to <u>God</u> the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men <u>made</u> perfect.

Made Us Kings and Priests

- Revelation 1:6 And has <u>made</u> us kings and priests to His <u>God</u> and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.
- Revelation 5:10 And have <u>made</u> us kings and priests to our <u>God</u>; And we shall reign on the earth.

Made Alive By The Spirit

1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to <u>God</u>, being put to death in the flesh but <u>made</u> alive by the Spirit.

Made A Liar

1 John 5:10 He who believes in the Son of <u>God</u> has the witness in himself; he who does not believe <u>God</u> has <u>made</u> Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that <u>God</u> has given of His Son.

Maker

- Job 4:17 Can a mortal be more righteous than God? Can a man be more pure than his Maker?
- Job 32:22 For I do not know how to flatter, *Else* my <u>Maker</u> would soon take me away.
- Job 35:10-11 But no one says, 'Where is God my Maker, Who gives songs in the night, Who teaches us more than the beasts of the earth, And makes us wiser than the birds of heaven?'
- Job 36:3 I will fetch my knowledge from afar; I will ascribe righteousness to my Maker.
- Psalms 95:6 Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.
- Psalms 149:2 Let Israel rejoice in their Maker; Let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.
- Proverbs 14:31 He who oppresses the poor reproaches his <u>Maker</u>, But he who honors Him has mercy on the needy.
- Proverbs 17:5 He who mocks the poor reproaches his <u>Maker</u>; He who is glad at calamity will not go unpunished.
- Proverbs 22:2 The rich and the poor have this in common, The LORD is the maker of them all.
- Isaiah 17:7 In that day a man will look to his <u>Maker</u>, And his eyes will have respect for the Holy One of Israel.
- Isaiah 22:11 You also made a reservoir between the two walls For the water of the old pool. But you did not look to its Maker, Nor did you have respect for Him who fashioned it long ago.
- Isaiah 45:9 Woe to him who strives with his <u>Maker</u>! Let the potsherd strive with the potsherds of the earth! Shall the clay say to him who forms it, 'What are you making?' Or shall your handiwork say, 'He has no hands'?
- Isaiah 45:11 Thus says the LORD, The Holy One of Israel, and his Maker: "Ask Me of things to come concerning My sons; And concerning the work of My hands, you command Me."

- Isaiah 51:13 And you forget the LORD your <u>Maker</u>, Who stretched out the heavens And laid the foundations of the earth; You have feared continually every day Because of the fury of the oppressor, When *he has* prepared to destroy. And where *is* the fury of the oppressor?
- Isaiah 54:5 For your Maker is your husband, The LORD of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth.
- Jeremiah 10:16 The Portion of Jacob *is* not like them, For He *is* the <u>Maker</u> of all *things*, And Israel *is* the tribe of His inheritance; The LORD of hosts *is* His name.
- Jeremiah 51:19 The Portion of Jacob *is* not like them, For He *is* the <u>Maker</u> of all things; And *Israel is* the tribe of His inheritance. The LORD of hosts *is* His name.

- Psalms 119:73 YOD. Your hands have made me and <u>fashioned</u> me; Give me understanding, that I may learn Your commandments.
- Psalms 139:16 Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed. And in Your book they all were written, The days <u>fashioned</u> for me, When *as yet there were* none of them.
- Isaiah 22:11 You also made a reservoir between the two walls For the water of the old pool. But you did not look to its Maker, Nor did you have respect for Him who <u>fashioned</u> it long ago.

Created By God

- Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- Genesis 1:21 So God <u>created</u> great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good.
- Genesis 1:27 So God <u>created</u> man in His *own* image; in the image of God He <u>created</u> him; male and female He <u>created</u> them.
- Genesis 2:3 Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had <u>created</u> and made.
- Genesis 2:4 This *is* the history of the heavens and the earth when they were <u>created</u>, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,

- Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God <u>created</u> man, He made him in the likeness of God.
- Genesis 5:2 He <u>created</u> them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created.
- Genesis 6:7 So the LORD said, "I will destroy man whom I have <u>created</u> from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."
- Deuteronomy 4:32 "For ask now concerning the days that are past, which were before you, since the day that God <u>created</u> man on the earth, and *ask* from one end of heaven to the other, whether *any* great *thing* like this has happened, or *anything* like it has been heard.

- Psalms 104:30 You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; And You renew the face of the earth.
- Psalms 148:5 Let them praise the name of the LORD, For He commanded and they were created.
- Isaiah 40:26 Lift up your eyes on high, And see who has <u>created</u> these *things*, Who brings out their host by number; He calls them all by name, By the greatness of His might And the strength of *His* power; Not one is missing.

- Isaiah 43:7 Everyone who is called by My name, Whom I have <u>created</u> for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him."
- Isaiah 45:8 "Rain down, you heavens, from above, And let the skies pour down righteousness; Let the earth open, let them bring forth salvation, And let righteousness spring up together. I, the LORD, have <u>created</u> it.
- Isaiah 45:12 I have made the earth, And <u>created</u> man on it. I—My hands—stretched out the heavens, And all their host I have commanded.
- Isaiah 45:18 For thus says the LORD, Who <u>created</u> the heavens, Who is God, Who formed the earth and made it, Who has established it, Who did not create it in vain, Who formed it to be inhabited: "I *am* the LORD, and *there is* no other.

- Isaiah 48:7 They are <u>created</u> now and not from the beginning; And before this day you have not heard them, Lest you should say, 'Of course I knew them.'
- Isaiah 54:16 Behold, I have <u>created</u> the blacksmith Who blows the coals in the fire, Who brings forth an instrument for his work; And I have <u>created</u> the spoiler to destroy.
- Jeremiah 31:22 How long will you gad about, O you backsliding daughter? For the LORD has <u>created</u> a new thing in the earth—A woman shall encompass a man."
- Ezekiel 21:30 Return it to its sheath. I will judge you In the place where you were <u>created</u>, In the land of your nativity.
- Ezekiel 28:13 You were in Eden, the garden of God; Every precious stone *was* your covering: The sardius, topaz, and diamond, Beryl, onyx, and jasper, Sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes Was prepared for you on the day you were <u>created</u>.
- Ezekiel 28:15 You were perfect in your ways from the day you were <u>created</u>, Till iniquity was found in you.
- Malachi 2:10 Have we not all one Father? Has not one God <u>created</u> us? Why do we deal treacherously with one another By profaning the covenant of the fathers?
- Mark 13:19 For *in* those days there will be tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be.
- Romans 8:39 nor height nor depth, nor any other <u>created</u> thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 11:9 Nor was man <u>created</u> for the woman, but woman for the man.
- Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, <u>created</u> in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
- Ephesians 3:9 And to make all see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who <u>created</u> all things through Jesus Christ;
- Ephesians 4:24 And that you put on the new man which was <u>created</u> according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.
- Colossians 1:16 For by Him all things were <u>created</u> that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were <u>created</u> through Him and for Him.
- Colossians 3:10 And have put on the new *man* who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who <u>created</u> him.
- 1 Timothy 4:3 Forbidding to marry, *and commanding* to abstain from foods which God <u>created</u> to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth.
- Revelation 4:11 "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You <u>created</u> all things, And by Your will they exist and were <u>created</u>."

Revelation 10:6 and swore by Him who lives forever and ever, who <u>created</u> heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer,

Isaiah 40:28 Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The <u>Creator</u> of the ends of the earth, Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.

Isaiah 43:15 I am the LORD, your Holy One, The Creator of Israel, your King.

Romans 1:25 Who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the <u>Creator</u>, who is blessed forever. Amen.

1 Peter 4:19 Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls *to Him* in doing good, as to a faithful <u>Creator</u>.
