Grace To You

<u>Grace to you</u> and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ. Galatians 1:3

During an Immanuel prayer session, Jesus grants us grace to face ourselves and our past trauma. Jesus Himself is right there with us. He "gets" me; His attunement is perfect. As we receive His presence, we also receive His peace. From the Aaronic blessing [Numbers 6:24-26] to Paul and other New Testament writers, greetings (salutations) and closings (benedictions) of grace and peace are used together to bring us into shalom or wholeness.

Grace To You Salutations

- Romans 1:7 To all who are in Rome, beloved of God, called *to be* saints: <u>Grace to you</u> and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 1:3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Galatians 1:3 Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Ephesians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Philippians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Colossians 1:2 To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ *who are* in Colosse: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:1 Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: <u>Grace to you</u> and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 1 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, a true son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 2 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, a beloved son: <u>Grace</u>, mercy, *and* peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Titus 1:4 To Titus, a true son in *our* common faith: <u>Grace</u>, mercy, *and* peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior.

Philemon 1:3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

- 1 Peter 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: <u>Grace to you</u> and peace be multiplied.
- 2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.
- 2 John 1:3 <u>Grace</u>, mercy, *and* peace will be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.
- Revelation 1:4 John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: <u>Grace to you</u> and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne.

Benedictions of Grace

- Romans 16:20 And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly. The <u>grace</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.
- Ephesians 6:24 Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.
- Colossians 4:18 This salutation by my own hand-Paul. Remember my chains. Grace be with you. Amen.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:28 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given *us* everlasting consolation and good hope by <u>grace</u>, comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.
- 1 Timothy 6:21 By professing it some have strayed concerning the faith. Grace be with you. Amen.
- 2 Timothy 4:22 The Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Grace be with you. Amen.
- Philemon 1:25 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.
- Hebrews 13:25 Grace be with you all. Amen.
- 1 Peter 5:10 But may the God of all <u>grace</u>, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle *you*.
- 2 Peter 3:18 but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory both now and forever. Amen.
- Jude 1:4 For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn <u>the grace of our</u> God into lewdness and deny the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ.

Revelation 22:21 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.
