Often when I am in my Immanuel sessions, the Holy Spirit reveals Jesus next to me, standing with His hand on my shoulder to strengthen me as I revisit traumatic memories.

Hand of the Lord

- Exodus 9:3 Behold, the <u>hand of the LORD</u> will be on your cattle in the field, on the horses, on the donkeys, on the camels, on the oxen, and on the sheep—a very severe pestilence.
- Exodus 16:3 And the children of Israel said to them, "Oh, that we had died by the <u>hand of the LORD</u> in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the pots of meat *and* when we ate bread to the full! For you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger."
- Deuteronomy 2:15 For indeed the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was against them, to destroy them from the midst of the camp until they were consumed.
- Joshua 4:24 That all the peoples of the earth may know the <u>hand of the LORD</u>, that it *is* mighty, that you may fear the LORD your God forever.
- Joshua 22:31 Then Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest said to the children of Reuben, the children of Gad, and the children of Manasseh, "This day we perceive that the LORD is among us, because you have not committed this treachery against the LORD. Now you have delivered the children of Israel out of the hand-of-the-LORD."
- Judges 2:15 Wherever they went out, the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was against them for calamity, as the LORD had said, and as the LORD had sworn to them. And they were greatly distressed.
- Ruth 1:13 Would you wait for them till they were grown? Would you restrain yourselves from having husbands? No, my daughters; for it grieves me very much for your sakes that the <u>hand of the LORD</u> has gone out against me!

- 1 Samuel 5:6 But the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was heavy on the people of Ashdod, and He ravaged them and struck them with tumors, *both* Ashdod and its territory.
- 1 Samuel 5:9 So it was, after they had carried it away, that the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was against the city with a very great destruction; and He struck the men of the city, both small and great, and tumors broke out on them.
- 1 Samuel 7:13 So the Philistines were subdued, and they did not come anymore into the territory of Israel. And the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel.
- 1 Samuel 12:15 However, if you do not obey the voice of the LORD, but rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then the <u>hand of the LORD</u> will be against you, as *it was* against your fathers.

- 1 Kings 18:46 Then the <u>hand of the LORD</u> came upon Elijah; and he girded up his loins and ran ahead of Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.
- 2 Kings 3:15 "But now bring me a musician." Then it happened, when the musician played, that the <u>hand of</u> the <u>LORD</u> came upon him.
- 1 Chronicles 21:13 And David said to Gad, "I am in great distress. Please let me fall into the <u>hand of the LORD</u>, for His mercies *are* very great; but do not let me fall into the hand of man."
- Ezra 7:6 This Ezra came up from Babylon; and he *was* a skilled scribe in the Law of Moses, which the LORD God of Israel had given. The king granted him all his request, according to the <u>hand of the LORD</u> his God upon him.
- Ezra 7:28 And has extended mercy to me before the king and his counselors, and before all the king's mighty princes. So I was encouraged, as the <u>hand of the LORD</u> my God *was* upon me; and I gathered leading men of Israel to go up with me.
- Job 12:9 Who among all these does not know That the hand of the LORD has done this.
- Psalms 75:8 For in the <u>hand of the LORD</u> there is a cup, And the wine is red; It is fully mixed, and He pours it out; Surely its dregs shall all the wicked of the earth Drain and drink down.
- Psalms 118:15 The voice of rejoicing and salvation *Is* in the tents of the righteous; The right <u>hand of the LORD</u> does valiantly.
- Psalms 118:16 The right hand of the LORD is exalted; The right hand of the LORD does valiantly.
- Proverbs 21:1 The king's heart is in the <u>hand of the LORD</u>, *Like* the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes.
- Isaiah 19:16 In that day Egypt will be like women, and will be afraid and fear because of the waving of the hand of the LORD of hosts, which He waves over it.
- Isaiah 25:10 For on this mountain the <u>hand of the LORD</u> will rest, And Moab shall be trampled down under Him, As straw is trampled down for the refuse heap.

- Isaiah 41:20 That they may see and know, And consider and understand together, That the <u>hand of the LORD</u> has done this, And the Holy One of Israel has created it.
- Isaiah 51:17 Awake, awake! Stand up, O Jerusalem, You who have drunk at the <u>hand of the LORD</u> The cup of His fury; You have drunk the dregs of the cup of trembling, *And* drained *it* out.
- Isaiah 62:3 You shall also be a crown of glory In the <u>hand of the LORD</u>, And a royal diadem In the hand of your God.
- Isaiah 66:14 When you see *this*, your heart shall rejoice, And your bones shall flourish like grass; The <u>hand of</u> the <u>LORD</u> shall be known to His servants, And *His* indignation to His enemies.
- Ezekiel 1:3 The word of the LORD came expressly to Ezekiel the priest, the son of Buzi, in the land of the Chaldeans by the River Chebar; and the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was upon him there.
- Ezekiel 3:14 So the Spirit lifted me up and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was strong upon me.
- Ezekiel 3:22 Then the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was upon me there, and He said to me, "Arise, go out into the plain, and there I shall talk with you."
- Ezekiel 8:1 And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth *month*, on the fifth *day* of the month, as I sat in my house with the elders of Judah sitting before me, that the <u>hand of the Lord</u> GOD fell upon me there.
- Ezekiel 33:22 Now the <u>hand of the LORD</u> had been upon me the evening before the man came who had escaped. And He had opened my mouth; so when he came to me in the morning, my mouth was opened, and I was no longer mute.
- Ezekiel 37:1 The <u>hand of the LORD</u> came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it *was* full of bones.
- Ezekiel 40:1 In the twenty–fifth year of our captivity, at the beginning of the year, on the tenth *day* of the month, in the fourteenth year after the city was captured, on the very same day the <u>hand of the LORD</u> was upon me; and He took me there.
- Luke 1:66 And all those who heard *them* kept *them* in their hearts, saying, "What kind of child will this be?" And the hand of the Lord was with him.
- Acts 11:21 And the <u>hand of the Lord</u> was with them, and a great number believed and turned to the Lord.
- Acts 13:11 "And now, indeed, the <u>hand of the Lord</u> is upon you, and you shall be blind, not seeing the sun for a time." And immediately a dark mist fell on him, and he went around seeking someone to lead him by the hand.

Lord's Hand

Isaiah 40:2 Speak comfort to Jerusalem, and cry out to her, That her warfare is ended, That her iniquity is pardoned; For she has received from the <u>LORD'S hand</u> Double for all her sins.

- Isaiah 59:1 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear.
- Jeremiah 25:17 Then I took the cup from the <u>LORD'S</u> hand, and made all the nations drink, to whom the LORD had sent me.
- Jeremiah 51:7 Babylon *was* a golden cup in the <u>LORD'S</u> <u>hand</u>, That made all the earth drunk. The nations drank her wine; Therefore the nations are deranged.

Hand of His God

Ezra 7:9 On the first *day* of the first month he began *his* journey from Babylon, and on the first *day* of the fifth month he came to Jerusalem, according to the good <u>hand of</u> his God upon him.

Hand of Our God

- Ezra 8:18 Then, by the good <u>hand of</u> our God upon us, they brought us a man of understanding, of the sons of Mahli the son of Levi, the son of Israel, namely Sherebiah, with his sons and brothers, eighteen men;
- Ezra 8:22 For I was ashamed to request of the king an escort of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy on the road, because we had spoken to the king, saying, "The <u>hand of</u> our God is upon all those for good who seek Him, but His power and His wrath *are* against all those who forsake Him."
- Ezra 8:31 Then we departed from the river of Ahava on the twelfth *day* of the first month, to go to Jerusalem. And the <u>hand of</u> our God was upon us, and He delivered us from the <u>hand of</u> the enemy and from ambush along the road.

Hand of My God

- Nehemiah 2:8 "And a letter to Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he must give me timber to make beams for the gates of the citadel which *pertains* to the temple, for the city wall, and for the house that I will occupy." And the king granted *them* to me according to the good <u>hand of</u> my God upon me.
- Nehemiah 2:18 And I told them of the <u>hand of</u> my God which had been good upon me, and also of the king's words that he had spoken to me. So they said, "Let us rise up and build." Then they set their hands to *this* good *work*.

His Hand

- Joshua 5:13 And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a Man stood opposite him with His sword drawn in <u>His hand</u>. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?"
- Judges 6:21 Then the Angel of the LORD put out the end of the staff that *was* in <u>His hand</u>, and touched the meat and the unleavened bread; and fire rose out of the rock and consumed the meat and the unleavened bread. And the Angel of the LORD departed out of his sight.

- 1 Samuel 5:7 And when the men of Ashdod saw how *it was*, they said, "The ark of the God of Israel must not remain with us, for <u>His hand</u> is harsh toward us and Dagon our god."
- 1 Samuel 6:3 So they said, "If you send away the ark of the God of Israel, do not send it empty; but by all means return *it* to Him *with* a trespass offering. Then you will be healed, and it will be known to you why <u>His hand</u> is not removed from you."
- 1 Samuel 6:5 "Therefore you shall make images of your tumors and images of your rats that ravage the land, and you shall give glory to the God of Israel; perhaps He will lighten <u>His hand</u> from you, from your gods, and from your land.
- 1 Samuel 6:9 And watch: if it goes up the road to its own territory, to Beth Shemesh, *then* He has done us this great evil. But if not, then we shall know that *it is* not <u>His hand</u> *that* struck us—it happened to us by chance.
- 2 Samuel 24:16 And when the angel stretched out <u>His hand</u> over Jerusalem to destroy it, the LORD relented from the destruction, and said to the angel who was destroying the people, "It is enough; now restrain your hand." And the angel of the LORD was by the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite.
- 1 Kings 8:15 And he said: "Blessed *be* the LORD God of Israel, who spoke with His mouth to my father David, and with <u>His hand</u> has fulfilled *it*, saying."
- 1 Chronicles 28:19 "All *this," said David*, "the LORD made me understand in writing, by *His* hand upon me, all the works of these plans."
- Job 6:9 That it would please God to crush me, That He would loose His hand and cut me off!
- Job 12:6 The tents of robbers prosper, And those who provoke God are secure—In what God provides by His hand.
- Job 26:13 By His Spirit He adorned the heavens; His hand pierced the fleeing serpent.
- Job 30:24 Surely He would not stretch out <u>His</u> hand against a heap of ruins, If they cry out when He destroys it.
- Psalms 37:24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; For the LORD upholds him with His hand.
- Psalms 95:4 In His hand are the deep places of the earth; The heights of the hills are His also.
- Psalms 95:7 For He is our God, And we are the people of His pasture, And the sheep of His hand. Today, if you will hear His voice.
- Psalms 106:26 Therefore He raised up <u>His hand</u> in an oath against them, To overthrow them in the wilderness.
- Isaiah 5:25 Therefore the anger of the LORD is aroused against His people; He has stretched out His hand against them And stricken them, And the hills trembled. Their carcasses were as refuse in the midst of the streets. For all this His anger is not turned away, But His hand is stretched out still.
- Isaiah 9:12 The Syrians before and the Philistines behind; And they shall devour Israel with an open mouth. For all this His anger is not turned away, But <u>His hand</u> is stretched out still.

- Isaiah 9:17 Therefore the Lord will have no joy in their young men, Nor have mercy on their fatherless and widows; For everyone *is* a hypocrite and an evildoer, And every mouth speaks folly. For all this His anger is not turned away, But His hand *is* stretched out still.
- Isaiah 9:21 Manasseh *shall devour* Ephraim, and Ephraim Manasseh; Together they *shall be* against Judah. For all this His anger is not turned away, But <u>His hand</u> is stretched out still.
- Isaiah 10:4 Without Me they shall bow down among the prisoners, And they shall fall among the slain." For all this His anger is not turned away, But <u>His hand is stretched out still.</u>
- Isaiah 11:11 It shall come to pass in that day *That* the Lord shall set <u>His hand</u> again the second time To recover the remnant of His people who are left, From Assyria and Egypt, From Pathros and Cush, From Elam and Shinar, From Hamath and the islands of the sea.
- Isaiah 14:27 For the LORD of hosts has purposed, And who will annul *it*? His hand is stretched out, And who will turn it back?
- Isaiah 23:11 He stretched out <u>His hand</u> over the sea, He shook the kingdoms; The LORD has given a commandment against Canaan To destroy its strongholds.
- Isaiah 28:2 Behold, the Lord has a mighty and strong one, Like a tempest of hail and a destroying storm, Like a flood of mighty waters overflowing, Who will bring *them* down to the earth with *His* hand.
- Isaiah 31:3 Now the Egyptians *are* men, and not God; And their horses are flesh, and not spirit. When the LORD stretches out <u>His hand</u>, Both he who helps will fall, And he who is helped will fall down; They all will perish together.
- Isaiah 34:17 He has cast the lot for them, And <u>His hand</u> has divided it among them with a measuring line. They shall possess it forever; From generation to generation they shall dwell in it.
- Isaiah 40:12 Who has measured the waters in the hollow of <u>His hand</u>, Measured heaven with a span And calculated the dust of the earth in a measure? Weighed the mountains in scales And the hills in a balance?
- Isaiah 49:2 And He has made My mouth like a sharp sword; In the shadow of <u>His hand</u> He has hidden Me, And made Me a polished shaft; In His quiver He has hidden Me.
- Isaiah 53:10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put *Him* to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see *His* seed, He shall prolong *His* days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.
- Jeremiah 1:9 Then the LORD put forth <u>His hand</u> and touched my mouth, and the LORD said to me: "Behold, I have put My words in your mouth."
- Lamentations 2:8 The LORD has purposed to destroy The wall of the daughter of Zion. He has stretched out a line; He has not withdrawn <u>His hand</u> from destroying; Therefore He has caused the rampart and wall to lament; They languished together.
- Lamentations 3:3 Surely He has turned His hand against me Time and time again throughout the day.
- Daniel 4:35 All the inhabitants of the earth *are* reputed as nothing; He does according to His will in the army of heaven And *among* the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain <u>His hand</u> Or say to Him, "What have You done?"

- Daniel 5:23 And you have lifted yourself up against the Lord of heaven. Deuteronomy 33:3 Yes, He loves the people; All His saints *are* in <u>Your hand</u>; They sit down at Your feet; *Everyone* receives Your words.

- 2 Samuel 24:17 Then David spoke to the LORD when he saw the angel who was striking the people, and said, "Surely I have sinned, and I have done wickedly; but these sheep, what have they done? Let <u>Your hand</u>, I pray, be against me and against my father's house."
- 1 Chronicles 4:10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, "Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep *me* from evil, that I may not cause pain!" So God granted him what he requested.

- Acts 4:28 To do whatever Your hand and Your purpose determined before to be done.
- Acts 4:30 By stretching out <u>Your hand</u> to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.

My Hand

- Exodus 3:20 So I will stretch out My hand and strike Egypt with all My wonders which I will do in its midst; and after that he will let you go.
- Exodus 7:4 But Pharaoh will not heed you, so that I may lay My hand on Egypt and bring My armies and My people, the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments.
- Exodus 7:5 And the Egyptians shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring out the children of Israel from among them."
- Exodus 9:15 Now if I had stretched out My hand and struck you and your people with pestilence, then you would have been cut off from the earth.
- Exodus 15:9 The enemy said, 'I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil; My desire shall be satisfied on them. I will draw my sword, My hand shall destroy them.'
- Exodus 33:22 So it shall be, while My glory passes by, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by.
- Exodus 33:23 Then I will take away My hand, and you shall see My back; but My face shall not be seen.
- Deuteronomy 32:39 Now see that I, even I, am He, And there is no God besides Me; I kill and I make alive; I wound and I heal; Nor is there any who can deliver from My hand.

- Deuteronomy 32:40 For I raise My hand to heaven, And say, "As I live forever..."
- Deuteronomy 32:41 If I whet My glittering sword, And My hand takes hold on judgment, I will render vengeance to My enemies, And repay those who hate Me.
- Job 23:2 Even today my complaint is bitter; My hand is listless because of my groaning.
- Psalms 77:2 In the day of my trouble I sought the Lord; My hand was stretched out in the night without ceasing; My soul refused to be comforted.
- Psalms 81:14 I would soon subdue their enemies, And turn My hand against their adversaries.
- Psalms 89:21 With whom My hand shall be established; Also My arm shall strengthen him.
- Isaiah 1:25 I will turn My hand against you, And thoroughly purge away your dross, And take away all your alloy.
- Isaiah 10:14 My hand has found like a nest the riches of the people, And as one gathers eggs *that are* left, I have gathered all the earth; And there was no one who moved *his* wing, Nor opened *his* mouth with even a peep.
- Isaiah 36:19 Where *are* the gods of Hamath and Arpad? Where *are* the gods of Sepharvaim? Indeed, have they delivered Samaria from my hand?
- Isaiah 43:13 Indeed before the day was, I am He; And there is no one who can deliver out of My hand; I work, and who will reverse it?
- Isaiah 48:13 Indeed My hand has laid the foundation of the earth, And My right hand has stretched out the heavens; When I call to them, They stand up together.
- Isaiah 49:22 Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, I will lift My hand in an oath to the nations, And set up My standard for the peoples; They shall bring your sons in *their* arms, And your daughters shall be carried on *their* shoulders."
- Isaiah 50:2 Why, when I came, *was there* no man? *Why*, when I called, *was there* none to answer? Is My hand shortened at all that it cannot redeem? Or have I no power to deliver? Indeed with My rebuke I dry up the sea, I make the rivers a wilderness; Their fish stink because *there is* no water, And die of thirst.
- Isaiah 50:11 Look, all you who kindle a fire, Who encircle *yourselves* with sparks: Walk in the light of your fire and in the sparks you have kindled—This you shall have from My hand: You shall lie down in torment.
- Isaiah 51:16 And I have put My words in your mouth; I have covered you with the shadow of My hand, That I may plant the heavens, Lay the foundations of the earth, And say to Zion, 'You are My people.'
- Isaiah 66:2 "For all those *things* My hand has made, And all those *things* exist," Says the LORD. "But on this *one* will I look: On *him who is* poor and of a contrite spirit, And who trembles at My word."
- Jeremiah 6:12 "And their houses shall be turned over to others, Fields and wives together; For I will stretch out My hand Against the inhabitants of the land," says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 15:6 "You have forsaken Me," says the LORD, "You have gone backward. Therefore I will stretch out My hand against you and destroy you; I am weary of relenting!"

- Jeremiah 16:21 Therefore behold, I will this once cause them to know, I will cause them to know My hand and My might; And they shall know that My name is the LORD.
- Jeremiah 18:6 "O house of Israel, can I not do with you as this potter?" says the LORD. "Look, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are you in My hand, O house of Israel!"
- Jeremiah 25:15 For thus says the LORD God of Israel to me: "Take this wine cup of fury from My hand, and cause all the nations, to whom I send you, to drink it."
- Jeremiah 51:25 "Behold, I *am* against you, O destroying mountain, Who destroys all the earth," says the LORD. "And I will stretch out My hand against you, Roll you down from the rocks, And make you a burnt mountain."
- Ezekiel 6:14 So I will stretch out My hand against them and make the land desolate, yes, more desolate than the wilderness toward Diblah, in all their dwelling places. Then they shall know that I am the LORD.
- Ezekiel 13:9 My hand will be against the prophets who envision futility and who divine lies; they shall not be in the assembly of My people, nor be written in the record of the house of Israel, nor shall they enter into the land of Israel. Then you shall know that I *am* the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 14:9 And if the prophet is induced to speak anything, I the LORD have induced that prophet, and I will stretch out My hand against him and destroy him from among My people Israel.
- Ezekiel 14:13 Son of man, when a land sins against Me by persistent unfaithfulness, I will stretch out My hand against it; I will cut off its supply of bread, send famine on it, and cut off man and beast from it.
- Ezekiel 16:27 Behold, therefore, I stretched out My hand against you, diminished your allotment, and gave you up to the will of those who hate you, the daughters of the Philistines, who were ashamed of your lewd behavior.
- Ezekiel 20:5 "Say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "On the day when I chose Israel and raised My hand in an oath to the descendants of the house of Jacob, and made Myself known to them in the land of Egypt, I raised My hand in an oath to them, saying, 'I am the LORD your God.'
- Ezekiel 20:6 On that day I raised My hand in an oath to them, to bring them out of the land of Egypt into a land that I had searched out for them, 'flowing with milk and honey,' the glory of all lands.
- Ezekiel 20:15 So I also raised My hand in an oath to them in the wilderness, that I would not bring them into the land which I had given *them*, 'flowing with milk and honey,' the glory of all lands.
- Ezekiel 20:22 Nevertheless I withdrew My hand and acted for My name's sake, that it should not be profaned in the sight of the Gentiles, in whose sight I had brought them out.
- Ezekiel 20:23 Also I raised My hand in an oath to those in the wilderness, that I would scatter them among the Gentiles and disperse them throughout the countries.
- Ezekiel 20:28 When I brought them into the land *concerning* which I had raised My hand in an oath to give them, and they saw all the high hills and all the thick trees, there they offered their sacrifices and provoked Me with their offerings. There they also sent up their sweet aroma and poured out their drink offerings.

- Ezekiel 20:42 Then you shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I bring you into the land of Israel, into the country *for* which I raised My hand in an oath to give to your fathers.
- Ezekiel 25:7 Indeed, therefore, I will stretch out My hand against you, and give you as plunder to the nations; I will cut you off from the peoples, and I will cause you to perish from the countries; I will destroy you, and you shall know that I am the LORD.
- Ezekiel 25:13 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "I will also stretch out My hand against Edom, cut off man and beast from it, and make it desolate from Teman; Dedan shall fall by the sword."
- Ezekiel 25:16 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "I will stretch out My hand against the Philistines, and I will cut off the Cherethites and destroy the remnant of the seacoast."
- Ezekiel 35:3 And say to it, "Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, O Mount Seir, I am against you; I will stretch out My hand against you, And make you most desolate"
- Ezekiel 36:7 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "I have raised My hand in an oath that surely the nations that *are* around you shall bear their own shame."
- Ezekiel 37:19 "Say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Surely I will take the stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel, his companions; and I will join them with it, with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they will be one in My hand."
- Ezekiel 39:21 I will set My glory among the nations; all the nations shall see My judgment which I have executed, and My hand which I have laid on them.
- Ezekiel 44:12 Because they ministered to them before their idols and caused the house of Israel to fall into iniquity, therefore I have raised My hand in an oath against them," says the Lord GOD, "that they shall bear their iniquity.
- Ezekiel 47:14 You shall inherit it equally with one another; for I raised My hand in an oath to give it to your fathers, and this land shall fall to you as your inheritance.
- Hosea 2:10 Now I will uncover her lewdness in the sight of her lovers, And no one shall deliver her from My hand.
- Amos 1:8 "I will cut off the inhabitant from Ashdod, And the one who holds the scepter from Ashkelon; I will turn My hand against Ekron, And the remnant of the Philistines shall perish," Says the Lord GOD.
- Amos 9:2 Though they dig into hell, From there my hand shall take them; Though they climb up to heaven, From there I will bring them down.
- Zephaniah 1:4 I will stretch out My hand against Judah, And against all the inhabitants of Jerusalem. I will cut off every trace of Baal from this place, The names of the idolatrous priests with the pagan priests—
- Zechariah 2:9 For surely I will shake My hand against them, and they shall become spoil for their servants. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me.
- Zechariah 13:7 "Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, Against the Man who is My Companion," Says the LORD of hosts. "Strike the Shepherd, And the sheep will be scattered; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones."

- John 10:28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.
- John 20:25 The other disciples therefore said to him, "We have seen the Lord." So he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."

Acts 7:50 Has My hand not made all these things?

Finger of God

- Exodus 8:19 Then the magicians said to Pharaoh, "This is the <u>finger of God</u>." But Pharaoh's heart grew hard, and he did not heed them, just as the LORD had said.
- Exodus 31:18 And when He had made an end of speaking with him on Mount Sinai, He gave Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone, written with the <u>finger of God</u>.
- Deuteronomy 9:10 Then the LORD delivered to me two tablets of stone written with the <u>finger of God</u>, and on them *were* all the words which the LORD had spoken to you on the mountain from the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly.

Luke 11:20 But if I cast out demons with the finger of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Fingers (of God)

- Psalms 8:3 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained.
- Daniel 5:5 In the same hour the <u>fingers</u> of a man's hand appeared and wrote opposite the lampstand on the plaster of the wall of the king's palace; and the king saw the part of the hand that wrote.

Daniel 5:24 Then the <u>fingers</u> of the hand were sent from Him, and this writing was written.

Fingers of Jesus

Mark 7:33 And He took him aside from the multitude, and put His <u>fingers</u> in his ears, and He spat and touched his tongue.
