And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, "<u>He has done</u> all things well. He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak." Mark 7:37

Jesus's record is established. He does all things well. I can place my full confidence in Him. I choose Him to run my Immanuel sessions whether I am receiving or coaching. He Has Done

- Joshua 24:20 If you forsake the LORD and serve foreign gods, then He will turn and do you harm and consume you, after <u>He has done</u> you good.
- 1 Samuel 6:9 And watch: if it goes up the road to its own territory, to Beth Shemesh, *then* <u>He has done</u> us this great evil. But if not, then we shall know that *it is* not His hand *that* struck us—it happened to us by chance.
- 1 Samuel 12:24 Only fear the LORD, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things <u>He has done</u> for you.
- 1 Chronicles 16:12 Remember His marvelous works which <u>He has done</u>, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth,
- Psalms 22:31 They will come and declare His righteousness to a people who will be born, That <u>He has done *this*</u>.
- Psalms 66:16 Come and hear, all you who fear God, And I will declare what He has done for my soul.
- Psalms 78:4 We will not hide *them* from their children, Telling to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, And His strength and His wonderful works that <u>He has done</u>.
- Psalms 98:1 A Psalm. Oh, sing to the LORD a new song! For <u>He has done</u> marvelous things; His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him the victory.
- Psalms 105:5 Remember His marvelous works which <u>He has done</u>, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth,

Isaiah 12:5 Sing to the LORD, For He has done excellent things; This is known in all the earth.

Jeremiah 30:24 The fierce anger of the LORD will not return until <u>He has done</u> it, And until He has performed the intents of His heart. In the latter days you will consider it.

- Lamentations 2:6 <u>He has done</u> violence to His tabernacle, *As if it were* a garden; He has destroyed His place of assembly; The LORD has caused The appointed feasts and Sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion. In His burning indignation He has spurned the king and the priest.
- Mark 7:37 And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, "<u>He has done</u> all things well. He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak."

He Did

- Genesis 4:5 But He did not respect Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.
- Exodus 24:11 But on the nobles of the children of Israel <u>He did</u> not lay His hand. So they saw God, and they ate and drank.
- Deuteronomy 1:30 The LORD your God, who goes before you, He will fight for you, according to all <u>He</u> <u>did</u> for you in Egypt before your eyes.
- Deuteronomy 11:3 His signs and His acts which <u>He did</u> in the midst of Egypt, to Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to all his land.
- Deuteronomy 11:4 What <u>He did</u> to the army of Egypt, to their horses and their chariots: how He made the waters of the Red Sea overflow them as they pursued you, and *how* the LORD has destroyed them to this day.

Deuteronomy 11:5 What <u>He did</u> for you in the wilderness until you came to this place.

- Deuteronomy 11:6 And what <u>He did</u> to Dathan and Abiram the sons of Eliab, the son of Reuben: how the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them up, their households, their tents, and all the substance that *was* in their possession, in the midst of all Israel—
- Deuteronomy 11:7 But your eyes have seen every great act of the LORD which He did.
- Deuteronomy 25:18 How he met you on the way and attacked your rear ranks, all the stragglers at your rear, when you *were* tired and weary; and <u>he did</u> not fear God.
- Deuteronomy 31:4 And the LORD will do to them as <u>He did</u> to Sihon and Og, the kings of the Amorites and their land, when He destroyed them.
- Joshua 8:14 Now it happened, when the king of Ai saw *it*, that the men of the city hurried and rose early and went out against Israel to battle, he and all his people, at an appointed place before the plain. But <u>he did</u> not know that *there was* an ambush against him behind the city.
- Joshua 9:9 So they said to him: "From a very far country your servants have come, because of the name of the LORD your God; for we have heard of His fame, and all that <u>He did</u> in Egypt."
- Joshua 9:10 And all that <u>He did</u> to the two kings of the Amorites who *were* beyond the Jordan—to Sihon king of Heshbon, and Og king of Bashan, who was at Ashtaroth.

He Does

Job 9:10 He does great things past finding out, Yes, wonders without number.

Job 23:13 But He is unique, and who can make Him change? And whatever His soul desires, that He does.

- Job 37:5 God thunders marvelously with His voice; He does great things which we cannot comprehend.
- Psalms 115:3 But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases.
- Psalms 135:6 Whatever the LORD pleases <u>He does</u>, In heaven and in earth, In the seas and in all deep places.
- Daniel 4:35 All the inhabitants of the earth *are* reputed as nothing; <u>He does</u> according to His will in the army of heaven And *among* the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand Or say to Him, "What have You done?"
- Daniel 9:14 Therefore the LORD has kept the disaster in mind, and brought it upon us; for the LORD our God *is* righteous in all the works which <u>He does</u>, though we have not obeyed His voice.
- John 5:19 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever <u>He does</u>, the Son also does in like manner."

Hebrews 2:16 For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham.

He Does Not

- Job 33:13 Why do you contend with Him? For He does not give an accounting of any of His words.
- Job 35:12 There they cry out, but <u>He does</u> not answer, Because of the pride of evil men.
- Job 36:6 He does not preserve the life of the wicked, But gives justice to the oppressed.
- Job 36:7 <u>He does</u> not withdraw His eyes from the righteous; But *they are* on the throne with kings, For He has seated them forever, And they are exalted.
- Job 37:4 After it a voice roars; He thunders with His majestic voice, And <u>He does</u> not restrain them when His voice is heard.
- Job 37:23 As *for* the Almighty, we cannot find Him; *He is* excellent in power, *In* judgment and abundant justice; <u>He does</u> not oppress.

Job 39:7 He scorns the tumult of the city; <u>He does</u> not heed the shouts of the driver.

Psalms 9:12 When He avenges blood, He remembers them; He does not forget the cry of the humble.

Psalms 107:38 He also blesses them, and they multiply greatly; And He does not let their cattle decrease.

Psalms 147:10 He does not delight in the strength of the horse; He takes no pleasure in the legs of a man.

Lamentations 3:33 For He does not afflict willingly, Nor grieve the children of men.

- Micah 7:18 Who *is* a God like You, Pardoning iniquity And passing over the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? <u>He does</u> not retain His anger forever, Because He delights *in* mercy.
- Malachi 2:13 And this is the second thing you do: You cover the altar of the LORD with tears, With weeping and crying; So <u>He does</u> not regard the offering anymore, Nor receive *it* with goodwill from your hands.
- John 9:16 Therefore some of the Pharisees said, "This Man is not from God, because <u>He does</u> not keep the Sabbath." Others said, "How can a man who is a sinner do such signs?" And there was a division among them.
- Galatians 3:16 Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. <u>He does</u> not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ.

Zephaniah 3:5 The LORD *is* righteous in her midst, <u>He will do</u> no unrighteousness. Every morning He brings His justice to light; He never fails, But the unjust knows no shame.

He Will Not

- Exodus 23:21 Beware of Him and obey His voice; do not provoke Him, for <u>He will not</u> pardon your transgressions; for My name *is* in Him.
- Deuteronomy 4:31 (For the LORD your God *is* a merciful God), <u>He will not</u> forsake you nor destroy you, nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore to them.
- Deuteronomy 7:10 And He repays those who hate Him to their face, to destroy them. <u>He will not</u> be slack with him who hates Him; He will repay him to his face.
- Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the LORD your God, He *is* the One who goes with you. <u>He will not</u> leave you nor forsake you.
- Deuteronomy 31:8 And the LORD, He *is* the one who goes before you. He will be with you, <u>He will not</u> leave you nor forsake you; do not fear nor be dismayed.
- Joshua 24:19 But Joshua said to the people, "You cannot serve the LORD, for He *is* a holy God. He *is* a jealous God; <u>He will not</u> forgive your transgressions nor your sins."
- 1 Chronicles 28:20 And David said to his son Solomon, "Be strong and of good courage, and do *it*; do not fear nor be dismayed, for the LORD God—my God—*will be* with you. <u>He will not</u> leave you nor forsake you, until you have finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD."

- Psalms 132:11 The LORD has sworn *in* truth to David; <u>He will not</u> turn from it: "I will set upon your throne the fruit of your body."
- Isaiah 42:2 He will not cry out, nor raise His voice, Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street.
- Isaiah 42:3 A bruised reed <u>He will not</u> break, And smoking flax <u>He will not</u> quench; He will bring forth justice for truth.
- Isaiah 42:4 <u>He will not</u> fail nor be discouraged, Till He has established justice in the earth; And the coastlands shall wait for His law.
- Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden *His* face from you, So that <u>He will not</u> hear.
- Jeremiah 12:4 How long will the land mourn, And the herbs of every field wither? The beasts and birds are consumed, For the wickedness of those who dwell there, Because they said, "<u>He will not</u> see our final end."
