To whom He also presented Himself <u>alive</u> after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God. Acts 1:3

Living God (30x's)

- Deuteronomy 5:26 For who *is there* of all flesh who has heard the voice of the <u>living God</u> speaking from the midst of the fire, as we *have*, and lived?
- Joshua 3:10 And Joshua said, "By this you shall know that the <u>living God</u> is among you, and that He will without fail drive out from before you the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Hivites and the Perizzites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Jebusites."
- 1 Samuel 17:26 Then David spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, "What shall be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach from Israel? For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the <u>living God?"</u>
- 1 Samuel 17:36 Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the <u>living God</u>.
- 2 Kings 19:4 'It may be that the LORD your God will hear all the words of *the* Rabshakeh, whom his master the king of Assyria has sent to reproach the <u>living God</u>, and will rebuke the words which the LORD your God has heard. Therefore lift up *your* prayer for the remnant that is left.'
- 2 Kings 19:16 Incline Your ear, O LORD, and hear; open Your eyes, O LORD, and see; and hear the words of Sennacherib, which he has sent to reproach the <u>living God</u>.
- Psalms 42:2 My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?
- Psalms 84:2 My soul longs, yes, even faints For the courts of the LORD; My heart and my flesh cry out for the <u>living God</u>.

- Isaiah 37:4 'It may be that the LORD your God will hear the words of *the* Rabshakeh, whom his master the king of Assyria has sent to reproach the <u>living God</u>, and will rebuke the words which the LORD your God has heard. Therefore lift up *your* prayer for the remnant that is left.'
- Isaiah 37:17 Incline Your ear, O LORD, and hear; open Your eyes, O LORD, and see; and hear all the words of Sennacherib, which he has sent to reproach the <u>living God</u>.
- Jeremiah 10:10 But the LORD *is* the true God; He *is* the <u>living God</u> and the everlasting King. At His wrath the earth will tremble, And the nations will not be able to endure His indignation.
- Jeremiah 23:36 And the oracle of the LORD you shall mention no more. For every man's word will be his oracle, for you have perverted the words of the <u>living God</u>, the LORD of hosts, our God.
- Daniel 6:20 And when he came to the den, he cried out with a lamenting voice to Daniel. The king spoke, saying to Daniel, "Daniel, servant of the <u>living God</u>, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to deliver you from the lions?"
- Daniel 6:26 I make a decree that in every dominion of my kingdom *men must* tremble and fear before the God of Daniel. For He *is* the <u>living God</u>, And steadfast forever; His kingdom *is the one* which shall not be destroyed, And His dominion *shall endure* to the end.
- Hosea 1:10 Yet the number of the children of Israel Shall be as the sand of the sea, Which cannot be measured or numbered. And it shall come to pass In the place where it was said to them, 'You are not My people,' *There* it shall be said to them, 'You are sons of the <u>living God</u>.'
- Matthew 16:16 Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."
- Matthew 26:63 But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, "I put You under oath by the living God: Tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God!"
- John 6:69 Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.
- Acts 14:15 and saying, "Men, why are you doing these things? We also are men with the same nature as you, and preach to you that you should turn from these useless things to the <u>living God</u>, who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and all things that are in them."
- Romans 9:26 "And it shall come to pass in the place where it was said to them, 'You are not My people,' There they shall be called sons of the <u>living God</u>."
- 2 Corinthians 3:3 Clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh, *that is*, of the heart.
- 2 Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the <u>living God</u>. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among *them*. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."
- 1 Timothy 3:15 But if I am delayed, *I write* so that you may know how you ought to conduct yourself in the house of God, which is the church of the <u>living God</u>, the pillar and ground of the truth.
- 1 Timothy 4:10 For to this *end* we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the <u>living God</u>, who is *the* Savior of all men, especially of those who believe.

- 1 Timothy 6:17 Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the <u>living God</u>, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.
- Hebrews 3:12 Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the <u>living God</u>.
- Hebrews 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the <u>living God</u>?
- Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the <u>living God</u>.
- Hebrews 12:22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the <u>living God</u>, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels.
- Revelation 7:2 Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the <u>living God</u>. And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea.

Lives Forever (God)

- Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the time I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my understanding returned to me; and I blessed the Most High and praised and honored Him who <u>lives forever</u>: For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His kingdom is from generation to generation.
- Daniel 12:7 Then I heard the man clothed in linen, who *was* above the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who <u>lives forever</u>, that *it shall be* for a time, times, and half *a time*; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these *things* shall be finished.
- Revelation 4:9 Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who <u>lives forever</u> and ever.
- Revelation 4:10 The twenty–four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying.
- Revelation 5:14 Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" And the twenty–four elders fell down and worshiped Him who <u>lives forever</u> and ever.
- Revelation 10:6 And swore by Him who <u>lives forever</u> and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer.
- Revelation 15:7 Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who <u>lives forever</u> and ever.

As The Lord Lives (Oath 32x's)

Judges 8:19 Then he said, "They were my brothers, the sons of my mother. <u>As</u> the <u>LORD lives</u>, if you had let them live, I would not kill you."

- Ruth 3:13 "Stay this night, and in the morning it shall be *that* if he will perform the duty of a close relative for you—good; let him do it. But if he does not want to perform the duty for you, then I will perform the duty for you, <u>as the LORD lives!</u> Lie down until morning."
- 1 Samuel 14:39 "For <u>as</u> the <u>LORD</u> lives, who saves Israel, though it be in Jonathan my son, he shall surely die." But not a man among all the people answered him.
- 1 Samuel 14:45 But the people said to Saul, "Shall Jonathan die, who has accomplished this great deliverance in Israel? Certainly not! <u>As the LORD lives</u>, not one hair of his head shall fall to the ground, for he has worked with God this day." So the people rescued Jonathan, and he did not die.
- 1 Samuel 19:6 So Saul heeded the voice of Jonathan, and Saul swore, "As the LORD lives, he shall not be killed."
- 1 Samuel 20:3 Then David took an oath again, and said, "Your father certainly knows that I have found favor in your eyes, and he has said, 'Do not let Jonathan know this, lest he be grieved.' But truly, <u>as the LORD lives</u> and <u>as your soul lives</u>, <u>there is but a step between me and death."</u>
- 1 Samuel 20:21 And there I will send a lad, *saying*, 'Go, find the arrows.' If I expressly say to him, 'Look, the arrows *are* on this side of you; get them and come' —then, <u>as the LORD lives</u>, *there is* safety for you and no harm.
- 1 Samuel 25:26 Now therefore, my lord, <u>as the LORD lives</u> and <u>as your soul lives</u>, since the LORD has held you back from coming to bloodshed and from avenging yourself with your own hand, now then, let your enemies and those who seek harm for my lord be as Nabal.
- 1 Samuel 25:34 For indeed, <u>as the LORD God of Israel lives</u>, who has kept me back from hurting you, unless you had hastened and come to meet me, surely by morning light no males would have been left to Nabal!
- 1 Samuel 26:10 David said furthermore, "<u>As the LORD lives</u>, the LORD shall strike him, or his day shall come to die, or he shall go out to battle and perish."
- 1 Samuel 26:16 "This thing that you have done is not good. As the LORD lives, you deserve to die, because you have not guarded your master, the LORD'S anointed. And now see where the king's spear is, and the jug of water that was by his head."
- 1 Samuel 28:10 And Saul swore to her by the LORD, saying, "As the LORD lives, no punishment shall come upon you for this thing."
- 1 Samuel 29:6 Then Achish called David and said to him, "Surely, <u>as the LORD lives</u>, you have been upright, and your going out and your coming in with me in the army <u>is good</u> in my sight. For to this day I have not found evil in you since the day of your coming to me. Nevertheless the lords do not favor you."
- 2 Samuel 4:9 But David answered Rechab and Baanah his brother, the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, and said to them, "As the LORD lives, who has redeemed my life from all adversity."
- 2 Samuel 12:5 So David's anger was greatly aroused against the man, and he said to Nathan, "As the LORD lives, the man who has done this shall surely die!"
- 2 Samuel 14:11 Then she said, "Please let the king remember the LORD your God, and do not permit the avenger of blood to destroy anymore, lest they destroy my son." And he said, "<u>As</u> the <u>LORD lives</u>, not one hair of your son shall fall to the ground."

- 2 Samuel 15:21 And Ittai answered the king and said, "<u>As the LORD lives</u>, and as my lord the king lives, surely in whatever place my lord the king shall be, whether in death or life, even there also your servant will be."
- 1 Kings 1:29 And the king took an oath and said, "<u>As the LORD lives</u>, who has redeemed my life from every distress."
- 1 Kings 2:24 "Now therefore, <u>as the LORD lives</u>, who has confirmed me and set me on the throne of David my father, and who has established a house for me, as He promised, Adonijah shall be put to death today!"
- 1 Kings 22:14 And Micaiah said, "As the LORD lives, whatever the LORD says to me, that I will speak."
- 2 Kings 2:2 Then Elijah said to Elisha, "Stay here, please, for the LORD has sent me on to Bethel." But Elisha said, "As the LORD lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you!" So they went down to Bethel.
- 2 Kings 2:4 Then Elijah said to him, "Elisha, stay here, please, for the LORD has sent me on to Jericho." But he said, "<u>As the LORD lives</u>, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you!" So they came to Jericho.
- 2 Kings 2:6 Then Elijah said to him, "Stay here, please, for the LORD has sent me on to the Jordan." But he said, "<u>As the LORD lives</u>, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you!" So the two of them went on.
- 2 Kings 4:30 And the mother of the child said, "<u>As the LORD lives</u>, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you." So he arose and followed her.
- 2 Kings 5:16 But he said, "As the LORD lives, before whom I stand, I will receive nothing." And he urged him to take it, but he refused.
- 2 Kings 5:20 But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, said, "Look, my master has spared Naaman this Syrian, while not receiving from his hands what he brought; but <u>as the LORD lives</u>, I will run after him and take something from him."
- 2 Chronicles 18:13 And Micaiah said, "As the LORD lives, whatever my God says, that I will speak."
- Jeremiah 5:2 Though they say, 'As the LORD lives,' Surely they swear falsely.
- Jeremiah 12:16 And it shall be, if they will learn carefully the ways of My people, to swear by My name, 'As the LORD lives,' as they taught My people to swear by Baal, then they shall be established in the midst of My people.
- Jeremiah 23:7 Therefore, behold, *the* days are coming," says the LORD, "that they shall no longer say, 'As the LORD lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of Egypt.'
- Jeremiah 23:8 But, 'As the LORD lives who brought up and led the descendants of the house of Israel from the north country and from all the countries where I had driven them.' And they shall dwell in their own land.
- Jeremiah 38:16 So Zedekiah the king swore secretly to Jeremiah, saying, "As the LORD lives, who made our very souls, I will not put you to death, nor will I give you into the hand of these men who seek your life."

Hosea 4:15 Though you, Israel, play the harlot, Let not Judah offend. Do not come up to Gilgal, Nor go up to Beth Aven, Nor swear an oath, *saying*, 'As the LORD lives'—
