Healed And Delivered Of Demons

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn, To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified. Isaiah 61:1-3

The element of deliverance is included in Dr. Karl's Opening and Closing Immanuel Prayers. Wounds, sin and lies, create openings or footholds for demons. They have a legal right to attack the person. When Jesus heals the wound, forgives the sins, and establishes the truth, the opening is closed and demons must go.

Possessed

- Matthew 4:24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon–possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.
- Matthew 8:16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon–possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick.
- Matthew 8:28 When He had come to the other side, to the country of the Gergesenes, there met Him two demon–possessed men, coming out of the tombs, exceedingly fierce, so that no one could pass that way.
- Matthew 8:33 Then those who kept them fled; and they went away into the city and told everything, including what had happened to the demon–possessed men.
- Matthew 12:22 Then one was brought to Him who was demon–possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw.

- Matthew 15:22 And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon–possessed."
- Mark 1:32 At evening, when the sun had set, they brought to Him all who were sick and those who were demon–possessed.
- Mark 5:15 Then they came to Jesus, and saw the one who had been demon–possessed and had the legion, sitting and clothed and in his right mind. And they were afraid.
- Mark 5:16 And those who saw it told them how it happened to him who had been demon–possessed, and about the swine.
- Mark 5:18 And when He got into the boat, he who had been demon–possessed begged Him that he might be with Him.
- Luke 8:36 They also who had seen it told them by what means he who had been demon–possessed was healed.
- Acts 4:32 Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common.
- Acts 7:45 Which our fathers, having received it in turn, also brought with Joshua into the land possessed by the Gentiles, whom God drove out before the face of our fathers until the days of David.
- Acts 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were healed.
- Acts 16:16 Now it happened, as we went to prayer, that a certain slave girl possessed with a spirit of divination met us, who brought her masters much profit by fortune–telling.

Tormented

Matthew 8:6 Saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented."

- Luke 6:18 ... As well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed.
- Acts 5:16 Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.

Oppressed

Luke 4:18 "The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed."

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Deliver His People

- 2 Corinthians 1:10 who delivered us from so great a death, and does deliver us; in whom we trust that He will still deliver us.
- Galatians 1:4 who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father.
- 2 Timothy 4:18 And the Lord will **deliver me from every evil work and preserve me** for His heavenly kingdom. To Him be glory forever and ever. Amen!
- 2 Peter 2:9 then the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment.

Healed And Delivered

- Matthew 4:24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon–possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.
- Matthew 12:22 Then one was brought to Him who was demon–possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw.
- Mark 1:34 Then He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him.
- Mark 6:13 And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them.
- Luke 6:18 as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed.
- Luke 8:2 and certain women who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities—Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come seven demons.
- Luke 8:36 They also who had seen it told them by what means he who had been demon–possessed was healed.
- Luke 9:42 And as he was still coming, the demon threw him down and convulsed him. Then Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, healed the child, and gave him back to his father.
- Acts 5:16 Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and they were all healed.
- Acts 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were healed.

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Instances Where All Were Healed

- Matthew 4:23-24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon–possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.
- Matthew 8:14-18 Now when Jesus had come into Peter's house, He saw his wife's mother lying sick with a fever. So He touched her hand, and the fever left her. And she arose and served them. When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon–possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses. And when Jesus saw great multitudes about Him, He gave a command to depart to the other side.
- Matthew 9:35 Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.
- Matthew 11:5 The blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them.
- Matthew 12:15 But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.
- Matthew 14:14 And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.
- Matthew 14:35-36 And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into all that surrounding region, brought to Him all who were sick, and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched it were made perfectly well.
- Matthew 15:30 Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them.
- Matthew 19:2 And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them there.
- Matthew 21:14 Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them.
- Mark 1:32-35, 39 At evening, when the sun had set, they brought to Him all who were sick and those who were demon–possessed. And the whole city was gathered together at the door. Then He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him. Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed...And He was preaching in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and casting out demons.

- Mark 3:10 For He healed many, so that as many as had afflictions pressed about Him to touch Him.
- Mark 6:5 Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.
- Mark 6:56 Wherever He entered into villages, cities, or in the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched Him were made well.
- Mark 7:37 And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, "He has done all things well. He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak."
- Luke 4:40 When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.
- Luke 5:15, 17 However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities...Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was [present] to heal them.
- Luke 6:17-19 And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.
- Luke 7:21-23 And that very hour He cured many of infirmities, afflictions, and evil spirits; and to many blind He gave sight. Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things you have seen and heard: that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the gospel preached to them. And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me.
- Luke 9:6 So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.
- Luke 9:11 But when the multitudes knew it, they followed Him; and He received them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who had need of healing.
- Luke 17:17 So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine?"

Prevention Against Demonization of Any Sort:

- Proverb 26:2 Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, So a curse without cause shall not alight.
- Matthew 6:13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.
- Luke 11:4 And forgive us our sins, For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one."
- John 14:30 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and <u>he has nothing in</u> Me.

John 17:15 I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one.

Ephesians 4:27 Nor give place to the devil.

Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Ephesians 5:11, 15-16 And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them... See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

- 2 Corinthians 2:11 Lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one.
