Honor All

Leviticus 19:32 'You shall rise before the gray headed and <u>honor</u> the presence of an old man, and fear your God: I *am* the LORD.

Romans 12:10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another.

1 Timothy 5:3 Honor widows who are really widows.

Honored

- 2 Samuel 23:19 Was he not the most <u>honored</u> of three? Therefore he became their captain. However, he did not attain to the *first* three.
- 2 Samuel 23:23 He was more <u>honored</u> than the thirty, but he did not attain to the *first* three. And David appointed him over his guard.
- 1 Chronicles 11:21 Of the three he was more <u>honored</u> than the other two men. Therefore he became their captain. However he did not attain to the *first* three.
- 1 Chronicles 11:25 Indeed he was more <u>honored</u> than the thirty, but he did not attain to the *first* three. And David appointed him over his guard.
- 2 Chronicles 32:33 So Hezekiah rested with his fathers, and they buried him in the upper tombs of the sons of David; and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>honored</u> him at his death. Then Manasseh his son reigned in his place.

- Proverbs 13:18 Poverty and shame *will come* to him who disdains correction, But he who regards a rebuke will be honored.
- Proverbs 27:18 Whoever keeps the fig tree will eat its fruit; So he who waits on his master will be honored.
- Isaiah 43:4 Since you were precious in My sight, You have been <u>honored</u>, And I have loved you; Therefore I will give men for you, And people for your life.
- Isaiah 43:23 You have not brought Me the sheep for your burnt offerings, Nor have you <u>honored</u> Me with your sacrifices. I have not caused you to serve with grain offerings, Nor wearied you with incense.
- Lamentations 1:8 Jerusalem has sinned gravely, Therefore she has become vile. All who <u>honored</u> her despise her Because they have seen her nakedness; Yes, she sighs and turns away.
- Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the time I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my understanding returned to me; and I blessed the Most High and praised and <u>honored</u> Him who lives forever: For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His kingdom is from generation to generation.
- Acts 28:10 They also <u>honored</u> us in many ways; and when we departed, they provided such things as were necessary.
- 1 Corinthians 12:26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with *it*; or if one member is <u>honored</u>, all the members rejoice with *it*.
