- 1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.
- Galatians 5:5 For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
- Ephesians 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the <u>hope</u> of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.
- Ephesians 2:12 That at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no <u>hope</u> and without God in the world.
- Ephesians 4:4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling.

- Philippians 1:20 According to my earnest expectation and <u>hope</u> that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death.
- Colossians 1:5 Because of the <u>hope</u> which is laid up for you in heaven, of which you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel.

- Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- 1 Peter 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living <u>hope</u> through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.
- 1 Peter 1:13 Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest *your* hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- 1 Peter 1:21 Who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and <u>hope</u> are in God.
- 1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always *be* ready to *give* a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the <u>hope</u> that is in you, with meekness and fear.
- 1 John 3:3 And everyone who has this <u>hope</u> in Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.
