Job 4:6 *Is* not your reverence your confidence? And the integrity of your ways [your hope](#)?

Proverbs 23:18 For surely there is a hereafter, And [your hope](#) will not be cut off.

Proverbs 24:14 So *shall* the knowledge of wisdom *be* to your soul; If you have found *it*, there is a prospect, And [your hope](#) will not be cut off.

1 Peter 1:13 Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and rest [your hope](#) fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

Hoped

Esther 9:1 Now in the twelfth month, that *is*, the month of Adar, on the thirteenth day, *the time* came for the king's command and his decree to be executed. On the day that the enemies of the Jews had hoped to overpower them, the opposite occurred, in that the Jews themselves overpowered those who hated them.

Psalms 119:43 And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth, For I have hoped in Your ordinances.

Psalms 119:74 Those who fear You will be glad when they see me, Because I have hoped in Your word.

Jeremiah 3:23 Truly, in vain *is salvation hoped for* from the hills, *And from* the multitude of mountains; Truly, in the LORD our God *Is* the salvation of Israel.

Luke 23:8 Now when Herod saw Jesus, he was exceedingly glad; for he had desired for a long *time* to see Him, because he had heard many things about Him, and he hoped to see some miracle done by Him.
