# Hope In

- Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart, All you who hope in the LORD.
- Psalms 33:18 Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, On those who hope in His mercy.
- Psalms 33:22 Let Your mercy, O LORD, be upon us, Just as we hope in You.
- Psalms 42:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And *why* are you disquieted within me? <u>Hope in</u> God, for I shall yet praise Him *For* the help of His countenance.
- Psalms 42:11 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? <u>Hope in</u> God; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.
- Psalms 43:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? <u>Hope in God</u>; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.
- Psalms 62:10 Do not trust in oppression, Nor vainly <u>hope in</u> robbery; If riches increase, Do not set *your* heart on them.
- Psalms 78:7 That they may set their <u>hope in</u> God, And not forget the works of God, But keep His commandments.

- Psalms 119:81 KAPH. My soul faints for Your salvation, But I hope in Your word.
- Psalms 119:114 You are my hiding place and my shield; I hope in Your word.

- Job 8:13 So are the paths of all who forget God; And the hope of the hypocrite shall perish.
- Job 14:19 As water wears away stones, And as torrents wash away the soil of the earth; So You destroy the hope of man.
- Job 27:8 For what is the <u>hope of</u> the hypocrite, Though he may gain *much*, If God takes away his life?
- Job 41:9 Indeed, any hope of overcoming him is false; Shall one not be overwhelmed at the sight of him?

- Ephesians 4:4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling.
- Colossians 1:23 If indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the <u>hope of</u> the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.
- Colossians 1:27 To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:8 But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation.
- Titus 1:2 In hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began.
- Titus 3:7 That having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the <u>hope of</u> eternal life.

- Hosea 2:15 I will give her her vineyards from there, And the Valley of Achor as a door of hope; She shall sing there, As in the days of her youth, As in the day when she came up from the land of Egypt.
- Zechariah 9:12 Return to the stronghold, You prisoners of hope. Even today I declare *That* I will restore double to you.
- Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Colossians 1:5 Because of the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, of which you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father.
- Hebrews 3:6 But Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end.
- Hebrews 6:11 And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end.
- Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us.

- Luke 6:34 And if you lend *to those* from whom you <u>hope to</u> receive back, what credit is that to you? For even sinners lend to sinners to receive as much back.
- Acts 26:7 To this *promise* our twelve tribes, earnestly serving *God* night and day, <u>hope to</u> attain. For this hope's sake, King Agrippa, I am accused by the Jews.
- Romans 15:24 Whenever I journey to Spain, I shall come to you. For I hope to see you on my journey, and to be helped on my way there by you, if first I may enjoy your *company* for a while.
- 1 Corinthians 16:7 For I do not wish to see you now on the way; but I <u>hope to</u> stay a while with you, if the Lord permits.
- Philippians 2:23 Therefore I hope to send him at once, as soon as I see how it goes with me.
- 1 Timothy 3:14 These things I write to you, though I hope to come to you shortly.
- 2 John 1:12 Having many things to write to you, I did not wish *to do so* with paper and ink; but I hope to come to you and speak face to face, that our joy may be full.
- 3 John 1:14 but I hope to see you shortly, and we shall speak face to face. Peace to you. Our friends greet you. Greet the friends by name.

- 2 Thessalonians 2:16 Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given *us* everlasting consolation and good <u>hope by</u> grace.

- Job 6:19 The caravans of Tema look, The travelers of Sheba hope for them.
- Job 14:7 For there is <u>hope for</u> a tree, If it is cut down, that it will sprout again, And that its tender shoots will not cease.

- Psalms 33:17 A horse is a vain hope for safety; Neither shall it deliver any by its great strength.
- Psalms 119:166 LORD, I hope for Your salvation, And I do Your commandments.
- Proverbs 26:12 Do you see a man wise in his own eyes? There is more hope for a fool than for him.
- Proverbs 29:20 Do you see a man hasty in his words? There is more hope for a fool than for him.
- Ecclesiastes 9:4 But for him who is joined to all the living there is <u>hope</u>, <u>for</u> a living dog is better than a dead lion.
- Isaiah 38:18 For Sheol cannot thank You, Death cannot praise You; Those who go down to the pit cannot hope for Your truth.
- Romans 8:24 For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not <u>hope</u>; <u>for</u> why does one still <u>hope</u> for what he sees?

- Galatians 5:5 For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
- 1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always *be* ready to *give* a defense to everyone who asks you a reason <u>for the hope</u> that is in you, with meekness and fear.

## Hope Through

- Hebrews 7:19 For the law made nothing perfect; on the other hand, *there is the* bringing in of a better <u>hope</u>, through which we draw near to God.
- 1 Peter 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living <u>hope through</u> the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

Colossians 1:23 if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.

## No Hope

- Isaiah 57:10 You are wearied in the length of your way; *Yet* you did not say, 'There is <u>no hope</u>.' You have found the life of your hand; Therefore you were not grieved.
- Jeremiah 2:25 Withhold your foot from being unshod, and your throat from thirst. But you said, 'There is no hope. No! For I have loved aliens, and after them I will go.'
- Ephesians 2:12 That at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:13 But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have <u>no hope</u>.

## Not Hope

Romans 8:24 For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is <u>not hope</u>; for why does one still hope for what he sees?

## Without Hope

- 1 Chronicles 29:15 For we *are* aliens and pilgrims before You, As *were* all our fathers; Our days on earth *are* as a shadow, And without hope.
- Job 7:6 My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle, And are spent without hope.
