## Hiding Place

## Refuge

Deuteronomy 33:27 **The eternal God is your refuge,** And underneath are the everlasting arms; He will thrust out the enemy from before you, And will say, 'Destroy!'

Ruth 2:12 The LORD repay your work, and a full reward be given you by **the LORD God of Israel, under whose wings you have come for refuge.**

2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, **My stronghold and my refuge;** My Savior, You save me from violence.

Psalm 9:9 **The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, A refuge in times of trouble.**

Psalm 59:16 But I will sing of Your power; Yes, I will sing aloud of Your mercy in the morning; For You have been my defense **And refuge in the day of my trouble.**

Psalm 62:7 In God is my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, **And my refuge, is in God.**

Psalm 62:8 Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; **God is a refuge for us.**

## Shield

Psalms 18:2 The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; **My shield and the horn of my salvation**, my stronghold.

Psalms 28:7 **The LORD is my strength and my shield**; My heart trusted in Him, and I am helped; Therefore my heart greatly rejoices, And with my song I will praise Him.

Psalms 119:114 You are my hiding place and **my shield**; I hope in Your word.

## Buckler

Psalms 35:2 **[O Lord] Take hold of shield and buckler**, And stand up for my help.

Ezekiel 23:24 And they shall come against you With chariots, wagons, and war-horses, With a horde of people. They shall array against you **Buckler, shield, and helmet** all around. 'I will delegate judgment to them, And they shall judge you according to their judgments.

## His/Her Wings

Psalms 91:4 He shall cover you with His feathers, And **under His wings you shall take refuge**; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.

Isaiah 8:8 He will pass through Judah, He will overflow and pass over, He will reach up to the neck; **And the stretching out of his wings Will fill the breadth of Your land, O Immanuel**.

Jeremiah 49:22 Behold, He shall come up and fly like the eagle, **And spread His wings over Bozrah**; The heart of the mighty men of Edom in that day shall be Like the heart of a woman in birth pangs.

## Shade
