Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." John 14:6

The Truth

- Mark 12:32 So the scribe said to Him, "Well said, **Teacher. You have spoken the truth**, for there is one God, and there is no other but He.
- John 5:33 You have sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth.
- John 8:32 "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."
- John 8:40 But now you seek to kill Me, **a Man who has told you the truth** which I heard from God. Abraham did not do this.
- John 8:45 But because I tell the truth, you do not believe Me.
- John 8:46 Which of you convicts Me of sin? And if I tell the truth, why do you not believe Me?
- John 16:7 Nevertheless **I tell you the truth**. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.
- John 17:19 And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.
- John 18:37 Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to **the truth**. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

Truly

Matthew 9:37 Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.

- Matthew 14:33 Then those who were in the boat came and worshiped Him, saying, "Truly You are the Son of God."
- Matthew 27:54 So when the centurion and those with him, who were guarding Jesus, saw the earthquake and the things that had happened, they feared greatly, saying, **"Truly this was the Son of God**!"

- Mark 15:39 So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!"
- Luke 4:25 "But **I tell you truly**, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, and there was a great famine throughout all the land;
- Luke 9:27 "But **I tell you truly**, there are some standing here who shall not taste death till they see the kingdom of God."
- Luke 10:2 Then He said to them, "The **harvest truly is great**, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.
- Luke 12:44 "Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has.
- Luke 21:3 So He said, "Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all;
- Luke 22:22 "And **truly the Son of Man goes** as it has been determined, but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!"
- John 6:14 Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, "This is **truly the Prophet** who is to come into the world."
- John 7:26 "But look! He speaks boldly, and they say nothing to Him. Do the rulers know indeed that this is **truly the Christ**?
- John 7:40 Therefore many from the crowd, when they heard this saying, said, "Truly this is the Prophet."
- Acts 3:22 "For Moses truly said to the fathers, "The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. **Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you.**

True

- 2 Samuel 7:28 And now, O Lord GOD, You are God, and Your words are true, and You have promised this goodness to Your servant.
- 2 Chronicles 15:3 For a long time Israel has been without **the true God**, without a teaching priest, and without law.
- Jeremiah 10:10 But **the LORD is the true God**; He is the living God and the everlasting King. At His wrath the earth will tremble, And the nations will not be able to endure His indignation.
- Jeremiah 42:5 So they said to Jeremiah, "Let **the LORD be a true and faithful witness** between us, if we do not do according to everything which the LORD your God sends us by you."
- Mark 12:14 When they had come, they said to Him, "Teacher, **we know that You are true,** and care about no one; for You do not regard the person of men, but teach the way of God in truth. Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?"

John 1:9 That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world.

- John 3:33 "He who has received His testimony has certified that God is true.
- John 4:23 "But the hour is coming, and now is, when **the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth;** for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.
- John 5:32 "There is another who bears witness of Me, and I know that **the witness which He witnesses of Me is true.**
- John 6:32 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but My Father gives you **the true bread from heaven**.
- John 7:18 He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who seeks the glory of **the One who** sent Him is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him.
- John 7:28 Then Jesus cried out, as He taught in the temple, saying, "You both know Me, and you know where I am from; and I have not come of Myself, but **He who sent Me is true**, whom you do not know.
- John 8:14 Jesus answered and said to them, "Even if I bear witness of Myself, **My witness is true**, for I know where I came from and where I am going; but you do not know where I come from and where I am going.
- John 8:16 And yet if I do judge, **My judgment is true**; for I am not alone, but I am with the Father who sent Me.
- John 8:26 I have many things to say and to judge concerning you, but **He who sent Me is true**; and I speak to the world those things which I heard from Him.
- John 15:1 I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.
- John 17:3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, **the only true God**, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
- Romans 3:4 Certainly not! Indeed, let **God be true** but every man a liar. As it is written: "That You may be justified in Your words, And may overcome when You are judged."
- Ephesians 4:24 and that you put on the new man which was created **according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.**
- 1 Thessalonians 1:9 For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve **the living and true God**.
- Hebrews 8:2 a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.
- 1 Peter 5:12 By Silvanus, our faithful brother as I consider him, I have written to you briefly, exhorting and testifying that this is **the true grace of God** in which you stand.

- 1 John 2:27 But **the anointing** which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and **is true**, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.
- 1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know **Him who is true**; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is **the true God** and eternal life.
- Revelation 3:7 "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, "These things says He who is holy, He who is true, "He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens."
- Revelation 3:14 "And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, 'These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God.
- Revelation 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"
- Revelation 15:3 They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: "Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and **true are Your ways**, O King of the saints!
- Revelation 16:7 And I heard another from the altar saying, "Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments."
- Revelation 19:2 For **true and righteous are His judgments**, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her.
- Revelation 19:9 Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!'" And he said to me, "These are **the true sayings of God**."
- Revelation 19:11 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.
- Revelation 21:5 Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are **true and faithful**."

God of Truth

- Deuteronomy 32:4 He is the Rock, His work is perfect; For all His ways are justice, **A God of truth** and without injustice; Righteous and upright is He.
- Psalm 31:5 Into Your hand I commit my spirit; You have redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.
- Isaiah 65:16 So that he who blesses himself in the earth Shall bless himself in **the God of truth**; And he who swears in the earth Shall swear by **the God of truth**; Because the former troubles are forgotten, And because they are hidden from My eyes.
