Savior

2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My [Savior](#), You save me from violence.

Psalms 106:21 They forgot God their [Savior](#), Who had done great things in Egypt.

Isaiah 19:20 And it will be for a sign and for a witness to the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt; for they will cry to the LORD because of the oppressors, and He will send them a [Savior](#) and a Mighty One, and He will deliver them.

Isaiah 43:3 For I *am* the LORD your God, The Holy One of Israel, your [Savior](#); I gave Egypt for your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba in your place.

1 Samuel 14:6 Then Jonathan said to the young man who bore his armor, "Come, let us go over to the garrison of these uncircumcised; it may be that the LORD will work for us. For nothing restrains the LORD from [saving](#) by many or by few."

Psalms 20:6 Now I know that the LORD saves His anointed; He will answer him from His holy heaven
With the [saving](#) strength of His right hand.

Psalms 28:8 The LORD *is* their strength, And He *is* the [saving](#) refuge of His anointed.

Hebrews 10:39 But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the [saving](#)
of the soul.

Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared
an ark for the [saving](#) of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the
righteousness which is according to faith.

Be Saved

Isaiah 45:22 Look to Me, and be [saved](#), All you ends of the earth! For I *am* God, and *there is* no other.

Acts 4:12 Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by
which we must be [saved](#).

Matthew 19:25 When His disciples heard *it*, they were greatly astonished, saying, "Who then can be [saved](#)?"

Mark 10:26 And they were greatly astonished, saying among themselves, "Who then can be [saved](#)?"

Luke 8:12 Those by the wayside are the ones who hear; then the devil comes and takes away the word out of
their hearts, lest they should believe and be [saved](#).

Luke 18:26 And those who heard it said, "Who then can be [saved](#)?"

Isaiah 64:5 You meet him who rejoices and does righteousness, *Who* remembers You in Your ways. You are
indeed angry, for we have sinned—In these ways we continue; And we need to be [saved](#).

Jeremiah 8:20 "The harvest is past, The summer is ended, And we are not [saved](#)!"

Acts 15:1 And certain *men* came down from Judea and taught the brethren, "Unless you are circumcised
according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be [saved](#)."

Saved By The Lord

Exodus 14:30 So the LORD [saved](#) Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the
Egyptians dead on the seashore.

Numbers 10:9 When you go to war in your land against the enemy who oppresses you, then you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets, and you will be remembered before the LORD your God, and you will be saved from your enemies.

Deuteronomy 33:29 Happy *are* you, O Israel! Who *is* like you, a people saved by the LORD, The shield of your help And the sword of your majesty! Your enemies shall submit to you, And you shall tread down their high places."

Judges 7:2 And the LORD said to Gideon, "The people who *are* with you *are* too many for Me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel claim glory for itself against Me, saying, 'My own hand has saved me.'

1 Samuel 10:19 But you have today rejected your God, who Himself saved you from all your adversities and your tribulations; and you have said to Him, 'No, set a king over us!' Now therefore, present yourselves before the LORD by your tribes and by your clans.

1 Samuel 14:23 So the LORD saved Israel that day, and the battle shifted to Beth Aven.

2 Kings 14:27 And the LORD did not say that He would blot out the name of Israel from under heaven; but He saved them by the hand of Jeroboam the son of Joash.

2 Chronicles 32:22 Thus the LORD saved Hezekiah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem from the hand of Sennacherib the king of Assyria, and from the hand of all *others*, and guided them on every side.

Psalms 34:6 This poor man cried out, and the LORD heard *him*, And saved him out of all his troubles.

Psalms 44:7 But You have saved us from our enemies, And have put to shame those who hated us.

Psalms 106:8 Nevertheless He saved them for His name's sake, That He might make His mighty power known.

Psalms 106:10 He saved them from the hand of him who hated *them*, And redeemed them from the hand of the enemy.

Psalms 107:13 Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, *And* He saved them out of their distresses.

Psalms 107:19 Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, *And* He saved them out of their distresses.

Psalms 116:6 The LORD preserves the simple; I was brought low, and He saved me.

Isaiah 43:12 I have declared and saved, I have proclaimed, And *there was* no foreign *god* among you; Therefore you *are* My witnesses," Says the LORD, "that I *am* God.

Isaiah 45:17 *But* Israel shall be saved by the LORD With an everlasting salvation; You shall not be ashamed or disgraced Forever and ever.

Isaiah 63:9 In all their affliction He was afflicted, And the Angel of His Presence saved them; In His love and in His pity He redeemed them; And He bore them and carried them All the days of old.

Matthew 27:42 He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him.

Mark 15:31 Likewise the chief priests also, mocking among themselves with the scribes, said, "He saved others; Himself He cannot save.

Luke 7:50 Then He said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you. Go in peace."

Luke 23:35 And the people stood looking on. But even the rulers with them sneered, saying, "He saved others; let Him save Himself if He is the Christ, the chosen of God."

Acts 2:40 And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation."

Romans 8:24 For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?

1 Corinthians 15:2 By which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.

Ephesians 2:5 Even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved).

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God.

2 Timothy 1:9 Who has saved us and called *us* with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began.

Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit.

2 Peter 2:5 And did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, *one of eight people*, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly.

Jude 1:5 But I want to remind you, though you once knew this, that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed those who did not believe.

1 Timothy 2:4 Who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

1 Peter 3:20 Who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while *the* ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.

1 Peter 4:18 Now If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?

Revelation 21:24 And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.

May/Might Be Saved

Jeremiah 4:14 O Jerusalem, wash your heart from wickedness, That you may be saved. How long shall your evil thoughts lodge within you?

Luke 13:23 Then one said to Him, "Lord, are there few who are saved?" And He said to them.

John 3:17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

John 5:34 Yet I do not receive testimony from man, but I say these things that you may be saved.

Romans 10:1 Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved.

1 Corinthians 5:5 Deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

1 Corinthians 10:33 Just as I [Paul] also please all *men* in all *things*, not seeking my own profit, but the *profit* of many, that they may be saved.

1 Thessalonians 2:16 Forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles that they may be saved, so as always to fill up *the measure of* their sins; but wrath has come upon them to the uttermost.

2 Thessalonians 2:10 And with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Will Be Saved

2 Samuel 22:4 I will call upon the LORD, *who is worthy* to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies.

Psalms 18:3 I will call upon the LORD, *who is worthy* to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies.

Psalms 80:3 Restore us, O God; Cause Your face to shine, And we shall be saved!

Psalms 80:7 Restore us, O God of hosts; Cause Your face to shine, And we shall be saved!

Psalms 80:19 Restore us, O LORD God of hosts; Cause Your face to shine, And we shall be saved!

Proverbs 28:18 Whoever walks blamelessly will be saved, But *he who is* perverse *in his* ways will suddenly fall.

Isaiah 30:15 For thus says the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel: "In returning and rest you shall be saved; In quietness and confidence shall be your strength." But you would not.

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; Save me, and I shall be saved, For You *are* my praise.

Jeremiah 23:6 In His days Judah will be saved, And Israel will dwell safely; Now this *is* His name by which He will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Jeremiah 30:7 Alas! For that day *is* great, So that none *is* like it; And it *is* the time of Jacob's trouble, But he shall be saved out of it.

Mark 13:13 And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end shall be saved.

Mark 16:16 He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

Luke 1:71 That we should be saved from our enemies And from the hand of all who hate us.

John 10:9 I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass *That* whoever calls on the name of the LORD Shall be saved.'

Acts 11:14 'Who will tell you words by which you and all your household will be saved.'

Acts 15:11 "But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved in the same manner as they."

Acts 16:30-31 And he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."

Romans 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

Romans 5:10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Romans 9:27 Isaiah also cries out concerning Israel: "Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, The remnant will be saved."

Romans 10:9 That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Romans 10:13 For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

Romans 11:26 And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob;

1 Corinthians 3:15 If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

1 Timothy 2:15 Nevertheless she will be saved in childbearing if they continue in faith, love, and holiness, with self-control.

Being Saved

Acts 2:47 Praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

1 Corinthians 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

2 Corinthians 2:15 For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

Saved Physically

Genesis 47:25 So they said, "You have saved our lives; let us find favor in the sight of my lord, and we will be Pharaoh's servants."

Exodus 1:17 But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive.

Exodus 1:18 So the king of Egypt called for the midwives and said to them, "Why have you done this thing, and saved the male children alive?"

Judges 21:14 So Benjamin came back at that time, and they gave them the women whom they had saved alive of the women of Jabesh Gilead; and yet they had not found enough for them.

1 Samuel 23:5 And David and his men went to Keilah and fought with the Philistines, struck them with a mighty blow, and took away their livestock. So David saved the inhabitants of Keilah.

2 Samuel 19:5 Then Joab came into the house to the king, and said, "Today you have disgraced all your servants who today have saved your life, the lives of your sons and daughters, the lives of your wives and the lives of your concubines."

2 Samuel 19:9 Now all the people were in a dispute throughout all the tribes of Israel, saying, "The king saved us from the hand of our enemies, he delivered us from the hand of the Philistines, and now he has fled from the land because of Absalom."

Nehemiah 9:27 Therefore You delivered them into the hand of their enemies, Who oppressed them; And in the time of their trouble, When they cried to You, You heard from heaven; And according to Your abundant mercies You gave them deliverers who saved them From the hand of their enemies.

Job 26:2 How have you helped *him who is* without power? *How* have you saved the arm *that has* no strength?

Psalms 33:16 No king is saved by the multitude of an army; A mighty man is not delivered by great strength.

Matthew 24:22 And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

Mark 13:20 And unless the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake, whom He chose, He shortened the days.

Acts 27:20 Now when neither sun nor stars appeared for many days, and no small tempest beat on us, all hope that we would be saved was finally given up.

Acts 27:31 Paul said to the centurion and the soldiers, "Unless these men stay in the ship, you cannot be saved."
