Due Time

- Deuteronomy 32:35 Vengeance is Mine, and recompense; Their foot shall slip in <u>due</u> time; For the day of their calamity *is* at hand, And the things to come hasten upon them.'
- Romans 5:6 For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
- 1 Corinthians 15:8 Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.
- 1 Timothy 2:6 Who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in <u>due time</u>.
- Titus 1:3 But has in <u>due time</u> manifested His word through preaching, which was committed to me according to the commandment of God our Savior.
- 1 Peter 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time.

- Genesis 18:14 Is anything too hard for the LORD? At the <u>appointed time</u> I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.
- Exodus 34:18 The Feast of Unleavened Bread you shall keep. Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, as I commanded you, in the <u>appointed time</u> of the month of Abib; for in the month of Abib you came out from Egypt.

Numbers 9:2 Let the children of Israel keep the Passover at its appointed time.

- Numbers 9:3 On the fourteenth day of this month, at twilight, you shall keep it at its <u>appointed time</u>. According to all its rites and ceremonies you shall keep it.

- Esther 9:31 to confirm these days of Purim at their <u>appointed time</u>, as Mordecai the Jew and Queen Esther had prescribed for them, and as they had decreed for themselves and their descendants concerning matters of their fasting and lamenting.
- Jeremiah 46:17 They cried there, 'Pharaoh, king of Egypt, *is but* a noise. He has passed by the <u>appointed</u> <u>time</u>!'
- Daniel 8:19 And he said, "Look, I am making known to you what shall happen in the latter time of the indignation; for at the <u>appointed time</u> the end *shall be*.
- Daniel 10:1 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a message was revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar. The message *was* true, but the <u>appointed time</u> *was* long; and he understood the message, and had understanding of the vision.
- Daniel 11:27 Both these kings' hearts *shall be* bent on evil, and they shall speak lies at the same table; but it shall not prosper, for the end *will* still *be* at the <u>appointed time</u>.

Hebrews 1:1 God, who at various <u>times</u> and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets.

All Times

- Exodus 18:22 And let them judge the people at all <u>times</u>. Then it will be *that* every great matter they shall bring to you, but every small matter they themselves shall judge. So it will be easier for you, for they will bear *the burden* with you.
- Exodus 18:26 So they judged the people at all <u>times</u>; the hard cases they brought to Moses, but they judged every small case themselves.
- Exodus 21:29 But if the ox tended to thrust with its horn in <u>times</u> past, and it has been made known to his owner, and he has not kept it confined, so that it has killed a man or a woman, the ox shall be stoned and its owner also shall be put to death.
- Numbers 24:1 Now when Balaam saw that it pleased the LORD to bless Israel, he did not go as at other <u>times</u>, to seek to use sorcery, but he set his face toward the wilderness.
- Psalms 34:1 *A Psalm* of David when he pretended madness before Abimelech, who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all <u>times</u>; His praise *shall* continually *be* in my mouth.
- Psalms 62:8 Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; God *is* a refuge for us. Selah
- Psalms 106:3 Blessed are those who keep justice, And he who does righteousness at all times!
- Psalms 119:20 My soul breaks with longing For Your judgments at all times.

Former Times

- Deuteronomy 2:10 (The Emim had dwelt there in <u>times</u> past, a people as great and numerous and tall as the Anakim.
- Joshua 24:2 And Joshua said to all the people, "Thus says the LORD God of Israel: 'Your fathers, *including* Terah, the father of Abraham and the father of Nahor, dwelt on the other side of the River in old <u>times</u>; and they served other gods.
- Ruth 4:7 Now this *was the custom* in former <u>times</u> in Israel concerning redeeming and exchanging, to confirm anything: one man took off his sandal and gave *it* to the other, and this *was* a confirmation in Israel.
- 1 Samuel 19:7 Then Jonathan called David, and Jonathan told him all these things. So Jonathan brought David to Saul, and he was in his presence as in <u>times</u> past.
- 2 Samuel 20:18 So she spoke, saying, "They used to talk in former times, saying, "They shall surely seek *guidance* at Abel,' and so they would end *disputes*."
- 2 Kings 19:25 Did you not hear long ago *How* I made it, From ancient <u>times</u> that I formed it? Now I have brought it to pass, That you should be For crushing fortified cities *into* heaps of ruins.

- Ezra 4:15 That search may be made in the book of the records of your fathers. And you will find in the book of the records and know that this city *is* a rebellious city, harmful to kings and provinces, and that they have incited sedition within the city in former <u>times</u>, for which cause this city was destroyed.
- Ezra 4:19 And I gave the command, and a search has been made, and it was found that this city in former times has revolted against kings, and rebellion and sedition have been fostered in it.
- Psalms 77:5 I have considered the days of old, The years of ancient times.
- Ecclesiastes 1:10 Is there anything of which it may be said, "See, this *is* new"? It has already been in ancient <u>times</u> before us.
- Isaiah 37:26 Did you not hear long ago *How* I made it, From ancient <u>times</u> that I formed it? Now I have brought it to pass, That you should be For crushing fortified cities *into* heaps of ruins.
- Isaiah 41:26 Who has declared from the beginning, that we may know? And former <u>times</u>, that we may say, '*He is* righteous'? Surely *there is* no one who shows, Surely *there is* no one who declares, Surely *there is* no one who hears your words.
- Isaiah 46:10 Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient <u>times</u> things that are not yet done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,'
- Ezekiel 36:11 I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bear young; I will make you inhabited as in former times, and do better *for you* than at your beginnings. Then you shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- 1 Peter 3:5 For in this manner, in former <u>times</u>, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands,

Last/Latter Times

- 1 Peter 1:20 He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last <u>times</u> for you.
- 1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter <u>times</u> some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons.

Other Times

- Judges 16:20 And she said, "The Philistines *are* upon you, Samson!" So he awoke from his sleep, and said, "I will go out as before, at other <u>times</u>, and shake myself free!" But he did not know that the LORD had departed from him.
- Judges 20:30 And the children of Israel went up against the children of Benjamin on the third day, and put themselves in battle array against Gibeah as at the other <u>times</u>.

- Judges 20:31 So the children of Benjamin went out against the people, *and* were drawn away from the city. They began to strike down *and* kill some of the people, as at the other <u>times</u>, in the highways (one of which goes up to Bethel and the other to Gibeah) and in the field, about thirty men of Israel.
- 1 Samuel 3:10 Now the LORD came and stood and called as at other <u>times</u>, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel answered, "Speak, for Your servant hears."
- 1 Samuel 18:10 And it happened on the next day that the distressing spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied inside the house. So David played *music* with his hand, as at other <u>times</u>; but *there was* a spear in Saul's hand.
- 1 Samuel 20:25 Now the king sat on his seat, as at other <u>times</u>, on a seat by the wall. And Jonathan arose, and Abner sat by Saul's side, but David's place was empty.
- 1 Kings 22:16 So the king said to him, "How many <u>times</u> shall I make you swear that you tell me nothing but the truth in the name of the LORD?"

Times (Definite)

- 1 Chronicles 12:32 Of the sons of Issachar who had understanding of the <u>times</u>, to know what Israel ought to do, their chiefs were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their command.
- 2 Chronicles 15:5 And in those <u>times</u> *there was* no peace to the one who went out, nor to the one who came in, but great turmoil *was* on all the inhabitants of the lands.
- Esther 1:13 Then the king said to the wise men who understood the <u>times</u> (for this *was* the king's manner toward all who knew law and justice.
- Job 24:1 Since times are not hidden from the Almighty, Why do those who know Him see not His days?
- Daniel 2:21 And He changes the <u>times</u> and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise And knowledge to those who have understanding.
- Daniel 11:6 And at the end of *some* years they shall join forces, for the daughter of the king of the South shall go to the king of the North to make an agreement; but she shall not retain the power of her authority, and neither he nor his authority shall stand; but she shall be given up, with those who brought her, and with him who begot her, and with him who strengthened her in *those* times.
- Daniel 11:14 Now in those <u>times</u> many shall rise up against the king of the South. Also, violent men of your people shall exalt themselves in fulfillment of the vision, but they shall fall.
- Matthew 16:3 And in the morning, '*It will be* foul weather today, for the sky is red and threatening.' Hypocrites! You know how to discern the face of the sky, but you cannot *discern* the signs of the <u>times</u>.
- Luke 21:24 And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the <u>times</u> of the Gentiles are fulfilled.
- Acts 17:30 Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent.

Ephesians 1:10 that in the dispensation of the fullness of the <u>times</u> He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.

Many Times

- 2 Chronicles 18:15 So the king said to him, "How many <u>times</u> shall I make you swear that you tell me nothing but the truth in the name of the LORD?"
- Nehemiah 9:28 But after they had rest, They again did evil before You. Therefore You left them in the hand of their enemies, So that they had dominion over them; Yet when they returned and cried out to You, You heard from heaven; And many <u>times</u> You delivered them according to Your mercies.
- Psalms 106:43 Many <u>times</u> He delivered them; But they rebelled in their counsel, And were brought low for their iniquity.

- Daniel 9:25 Know therefore and understand, *That* from the going forth of the command To restore and build Jerusalem Until Messiah the Prince, *There shall be* seven weeks and sixty–two weeks; The street shall be built again, and the wall, Even in troublesome <u>times</u>.
- 2 Timothy 3:1 But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come:

Ephesians 1:9-10 Having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, that in the dispensation of the <u>fullness</u> of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.

Process of Time

- Genesis 4:3 And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to the LORD.
- Genesis 38:12 Now in the process of time the daughter of Shua, Judah's wife, died; and Judah was comforted, and went up to his sheepshearers at Timnah, he and his friend Hirah the Adullamite.
- Exodus 2:23 Now it happened in the <u>process of time</u> that the king of Egypt died. Then the children of Israel groaned because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry came up to God because of the bondage.
- 1 Samuel 1:20 So it came to pass in the process of time that Hannah conceived and bore a son, and called his name Samuel, *saying*, "Because I have asked for him from the LORD."

Course of Time

2 Chronicles 21:19 Then it happened in the course <u>of time</u>, after the end of two years, that his intestines came out because of his sickness; so he died in severe pain. And his people made no burning for him, like the burning for his fathers.
