King of Glory

Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah Isalms 24:10

"Glory" is sometimes interpreted as "light" or "weight", but the sense most often used is "essence." God in His fullness cannot be comprehended, but He is knowable. He reveals Himself through His creation, His goodness, His Son and His Holy Spirit in a way that accommodates our humanity.

- Luke 2:9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid.
- Acts 7:2 And he said, "Brethren and fathers, listen: **The God of glory** appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Haran.
- Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw **the glory of God**, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.
- Romans 1:23 And changed **the glory of the incorruptible God** into an image made like corruptible man—and birds and four—footed animals and creeping things.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
- Romans 5:2 Through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
- Romans 6:4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- Romans 9:4 Who are Israelites, to whom pertain the adoption, **the glory**, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service of God, and the promises.
- Romans 15:7 Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.
- 1 Corinthians 10:31 Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
- 1 Corinthians 11:7 For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, since he is the image and **glory of God**; but woman is the glory of man.
- 2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to **the glory of God** through us.
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 Whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of **the glory of Christ**, who is the image of God, should shine on them.
- 2 Corinthians 4:6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of **the glory of God** in the face of Jesus Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 4:15 For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to **the glory of God**.
- 2 Corinthians 8:19 And not only that, but who was also chosen by the churches to travel with us with this gift, which is administered by us to the glory of the Lord Himself and to show your ready mind.
- 2 Corinthians 8:23 If anyone inquires about Titus, he is my partner and fellow worker concerning you. Or if our brethren are inquired about, they are messengers of the churches, the glory of Christ.

- Philippians 1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.
- Philippians 2:11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to **the glory of God the**Father.
- Revelation 15:8 The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.
- Revelation 21:11 Having **the glory of God**. Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal.
- Revelation 21:23 The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for **the glory of God** illuminated it. The Lamb is its light.

The Glory of The LORD Is Seen

- Exodus 16:7 And in the morning **you shall see the glory of the LORD**; for He hears your complaints against the LORD. But what are we, that you complain against us?
- Exodus 16:10 Now it came to pass, as Aaron spoke to the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness, and behold, the glory of the LORD appeared in the cloud.
- Exodus 24:16 Now the glory of the LORD rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days. And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud.
- Exodus 24:17 **The sight of the glory of the LORD** was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.
- Leviticus 9:6 Then Moses said, "This is the thing which the LORD commanded you to do, and **the glory of** the LORD will appear to you."
- Leviticus 9:23 And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of meeting, and came out and blessed the people. Then **the glory of the LORD appeared** to all the people.
- Numbers 14:10 And all the congregation said to stone them with stones. Now the glory of the LORD appeared in the tabernacle of meeting before all the children of Israel.
- Numbers 16:19 And Korah gathered all the congregation against them at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. Then **the glory of the LORD appeared** to all the congregation.
- Numbers 16:42 Now it happened, when the congregation had gathered against Moses and Aaron, that they turned toward the tabernacle of meeting; and suddenly the cloud covered it, and **the glory of the LORD** appeared.
- Numbers 20:6 So Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly to the door of the tabernacle of meeting, and they fell on their faces. And **the glory of the LORD appeared** to them.

- Isaiah 35:2 It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, Even with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. **They shall see the glory of the LORD**, The excellency of our God.
- Isaiah 40:5 **The glory of the LORD shall be revealed**, And all flesh shall see it together; For the mouth of the LORD has spoken.

The Glory of The Lord Filled The Tabernacle, The Temple, The Earth

- Exodus 40:34 Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.
- Exodus 40:35 And Moses was not able to enter the tabernacle of meeting, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.
- Numbers 14:21 But truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD—
- 1 Kings 8:11 So that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for **the glory of the LORD**.
- 2 Chronicles 5:14 So that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for **the glory of the LORD** filled the house of God.
- 2 Chronicles 7:1 When Solomon had finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the LORD filled the temple.
- 2 Chronicles 7:2 And the priests could not enter the house of the LORD, because **the glory of the LORD** had filled the **LORD'S house**.
- 2 Chronicles 7:3 When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD on the temple, they bowed their faces to the ground on the pavement, and worshiped and praised the LORD, saying: "For He is good, For His mercy endures forever."
- Ezekiel 10:4 Then **the glory of the LORD** went up from the cherub, and paused over the threshold of the temple; and the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was full of the brightness of **the LORD'S glory**.
- Ezekiel 10:18 Then **the glory of the LORD departed** from the threshold of the temple and stood over the cherubim.
- Ezekiel 11:23 And **the glory of the LORD** went up from the midst of the city and stood on the mountain, which is on the east side of the city.
- Ezekiel 43:4 And **the glory of the LORD** came into the temple by way of the gate which faces toward the east.
- Ezekiel 43:5 The Spirit lifted me up and brought me into the inner court; and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the temple.

- Ezekiel 44:4 Also He brought me by way of the north gate to the front of the temple; so I looked, and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD; and I fell on my face.
- Habakkuk 2:14 For the earth will be filled With the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, As the waters cover the sea.

Jesus' (Son of Man) Glory

- Matthew 6:13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For **Yours is the** kingdom and the power and **the glory forever**. Amen.
- Matthew 16:27 For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.
- Matthew 19:28 So Jesus said to them, "Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration, when **the Son of**Man sits on the throne of His glory, you who have followed Me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Matthew 24:30 Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see **the Son of Man coming** on the clouds of heaven with power and **great glory**.
- Matthew 25:31 When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory.
- Mark 8:38 For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.
- Mark 10:37 They said to Him, "Grant us that we may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on Your left, in Your glory."
- Mark 13:26 Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory.
- Luke 2:32 A light to bring revelation to the Gentiles, And the glory of Your people Israel.
- Luke 9:26 For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, of him the Son of Man will be ashamed when He comes in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the holy angels.
- Luke 9:31 **Who appeared in glory** and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.
- Luke 9:32 But Peter and those with him were heavy with sleep; and when they were fully awake, they saw **His glory** and the two men who stood with Him.
- Luke 19:38 Saying: "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the LORD!' Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- Luke 21:27 Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.

- Luke 24:26 Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?
- John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.
- John 2:11 This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and **manifested His glory**; and His disciples believed in Him.
- John 7:18 He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but **He who seeks the glory of the One who sent Him** is true, and no unrighteousness is in Him.
- Luke 17:18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?"
- John 8:50 And I do **not seek My own glory**; there is One who seeks and judges.
- John 9:24 So they again called the man who was blind, and said to him, "Give God the glory! We know that this Man is a sinner."
- John 11:4 When Jesus heard that, He said, "This sickness is not unto death, but for **the glory of God**, that **the Son of God** may be glorified through it."
- John 11:40 Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?"
- John 12:41 These things Isaiah said when he saw His glory and spoke of Him.
- John 17:5 And now, O Father, **glorify Me together with Yourself**, **with the glory** which I had with You before the world was.
- John 17:22 And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one.
- John 17:24 Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
- Acts 22:11 And since I could not see for **the glory of that light[Jesus]**, being led by the hand of those who were with me, I came into Damascus.

The Glory of The Lord Personalized: Is This Jesus?

Ezekiel 1:26-28 And above the firmament over their heads was the likeness of a throne, in appearance like a sapphire stone; on the likeness of the throne was a likeness with the appearance of a man high above it. Also from the appearance of His waist and upward I saw, as it were, the color of amber with the appearance of fire all around within it; and from the appearance of His waist and downward I saw, as it were, the appearance of fire with brightness all around. Like the appearance of a rainbow in a cloud on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the brightness all around it. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. So when I saw it, I fell on my face, and I heard a voice of One speaking.

- Ezekiel 3:12 Then the Spirit lifted me up, and I heard behind me a great thunderous voice: "Blessed is the glory of the LORD from His place!"
- Ezekiel 3:23 So I arose and went out into the plain, and behold, the glory of the LORD stood there, like the glory which I saw by the River Chebar; and I fell on my face.

The Riches of His Glory

- Romans 9:23 And that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had prepared beforehand for glory.
- Ephesians 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what **are the riches of the glory** of His inheritance in the saints.
- Ephesians 3:16 That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man.
- Colossians 1:27 To them God willed to make known what are **the riches of the glory** of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, **the hope of glory**.

Light Or Bright Glory

- Hebrews 1:3 Who being **the brightness of His glory** and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.
- Revelation 21:23 The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for **the glory of God** illuminated it. The Lamb is its light.

Crowned With Glory

- Hebrews 2:7 You have made him a little lower than the angels; You have **crowned** him **with glory** and honor, And set him over the works of Your hands.
- Hebrews 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death **crowned with glory** and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.
- Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many **sons to glory**, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

More Glory

- Romans 8:18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the **glory** which shall be revealed in us.
- 2 Corinthians 3:9 For if the ministry of condemnation had **glory**, the ministry of righteousness exceeds much **more in glory**.
- 2 Corinthians 3:10 For even what was made glorious had **no glory** in this respect, because of **the glory** that excels.
- 2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a **far more** exceeding and eternal weight of glory.
- Hebrews 3:3 For this One has been counted worthy of **more glory** than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house.

In Glory

1 Corinthians 15:43 It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.

Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to **His riches in glory** by Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:4 When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifested in the flesh, Justified in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world, **Received up in glory.**

To Glory (verb)

- Romans 3:7 For if the truth of God has increased through my lie to **His glory**, why am I also still judged as a sinner?
- Romans 5:3 And not only that, but **we also glory** in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance.
- Romans 15:17 Therefore I have reason to glory in Christ Jesus in the things which pertain to God.
- 1 Corinthians 1:29 That no flesh should **glory** in His presence
- 1 Corinthians 1:31 That, as it is written, "He who glories, let him glory in the LORD."
- 2 Corinthians 10:17 But "he who glories, let him **glory in the LORD**."
- James 1:9 Let the lowly brother glory in his exaltation.

Glory of Others

- Luke 4:6 And the devil said to Him, "All this authority I will give You, and their [the kingdoms of the world] glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish."
- Luke 12:27 Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; and yet I say to you, even **Solomon** in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
- Luke 14:10 But when you are invited, go and sit down in the lowest place, so that when he who invited you comes he may say to you, 'Friend, go up higher.' Then you will have glory in the presence of those who sit at the table with you.
- Romans 2:7 Eternal life to those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality.
- Romans 2:10 But **glory**, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
- 1 Corinthians 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for **our glory**.
- 1 Corinthians 11:15 But if a woman has long hair, it is a **glory** to her; for her hair is given to her for a covering.
- 1 Corinthians 15:40 There are also celestial bodies and terrestrial bodies; but **the glory of the celestial** is one, and **the glory of the terrestrial** is another.
- 1 Corinthians 15:41 There is one glory of the sun, another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for one star differs from another star in glory.
- 2 Corinthians 3:7 But if the ministry of death, written and engraved on stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of **Moses** because of **the glory of his countenance**, which glory was passing away.
- Ephesians 3:13 Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is **your glory**.
- Philippians 3:19 Whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame—who set their mind on earthly things.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:6 Nor did we seek **glory from men**, either from you or from others, when we might have made demands as apostles of Christ.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:20 For you are **our glory** and joy.
- Hebrews 9:5 And above it were **the cherubim of glory** overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail.
- 1 Peter 1:24 Because All flesh is as grass, And all **the glory of man** as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away.

- 1 Peter 5:1 The elders who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed.
- 1 Peter 5:4 And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive **the crown of glory** that does not fade away.
- Revelation 21:24 And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring **their glory** and honor into it.

Revelation 21:26 And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it.

Called To Glory

- 1 Thessalonians 2:12 That you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:14 To which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 1 Peter 5:10 But may the God of all grace, who **called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus**, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.
- 2 Peter 1:3 As His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him **who called us by glory** and virtue.
- Jude 1:24 Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, And to present you faultless Before the **presence of His glory** with exceeding joy.
- Revelation 18:1 After these things I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, and the earth was illuminated with **his glory**.

Give God Glory

- Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!
- Acts 12:23 Then immediately an angel of the Lord struck him [Herod], because he did not give **glory to God**. And he was eaten by worms and died.
- Romans 4:20 He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God.
- Ephesians 1:6 To the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made us accepted in the Beloved.
- Ephesians 1:12 That we who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory.
- Ephesians 1:14 Who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.

- 1 Peter 1:7 That the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and **glory** at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
- 1 Peter 1:8 Whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and **full of glory**.
- 1 Peter 4:13 But rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when **His glory is** revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.
- Revelation 4:11 You are worthy, O Lord, **To receive glory** and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created.
- Revelation 5:12 Saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain **To receive** power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and **glory** and blessing!"
- Revelation 11:13 In the same hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell. In the earthquake seven thousand people were killed, and the rest were afraid and gave glory to the God of heaven.
- Revelation 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and **give glory to Him**, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."
- Revelation 16:9 And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give **Him glory**.
- Revelation 19:1 After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and **glory** and honor and power belong to the Lord our God!"
- Revelation 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give **Him glory**, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.

Glory To God Forever

- Romans 11:36 For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen.
- Romans 16:27 To God, alone wise, be **glory** through Jesus Christ **forever**. Amen.
- Galatians 1:5 To whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.
- Ephesians 3:21 To Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.
- Philippians 4:20 Now to our God and Father be glory forever and ever. Amen.
- 1 Timothy 1:17 Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and **glory forever and ever**. Amen.
- 2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with **eternal glory**.

- 2 Timothy 4:18 And the Lord will deliver me from every evil work and preserve me for His heavenly kingdom. To Him be **glory forever and ever.** Amen!
- 2 Thessalonians 1:9 These shall be punished with **everlasting destruction** from the presence of the Lord and **from the glory of His power**.
- Hebrews 13:21 Make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.
- 1 Peter 1:21 Who through Him believe in **God, who** raised Him from the dead and **gave Him glory**, so that your faith and hope are in God.
- 1 Peter 4:11 If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, **to whom belong the glory** and the dominion **forever and ever**. Amen.
- 1 Peter 5:11 **To Him be the glory** and the dominion **forever and ever**. Amen.
- 2 Peter 3:18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. **To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.**
- Jude 1:25 To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, **Be glory** and majesty, Dominion and power, **Both now** and forever. Amen.
- Revelation 1:6 And has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.
- Revelation 4:9 Whenever the living creatures **give glory** and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives **forever and ever**.

- Exodus 15:11 Who *is* like You, O LORD, among the gods? Who *is* like You, **glorious in holiness**, Fearful in praises, doing wonders?
- Deuteronomy 28:58 If you do not carefully observe all the words of this law that are written in this book, that you may fear this glorious and awesome name, THE LORD YOUR GOD.

- 1 Chronicles 22:5 Now David said, "Solomon my son is young and inexperienced, and the house to be built for the LORD *must be* exceedingly magnificent, famous and glorious throughout all countries. I will now make preparation for it." So David made abundant preparations before his death.
- 1 Chronicles 29:13 Now therefore, our God, We thank You And praise Your glorious name.
- Nehemiah 9:5 And the Levites, Jeshua, Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, and Pethahiah, said: "Stand up and bless the LORD your God Forever and ever! "Blessed be **Your glorious** name, Which is exalted above all blessing and praise!
- Psalms 45:13 The royal daughter is all glorious within the palace; Her clothing is woven with gold.
- Psalms 66:2 Sing out the honor of His name; Make His praise glorious.
- Psalms 72:19 And blessed *be* **His** glorious name forever! And let the whole earth be filled *with* His glory. Amen and Amen.
- Psalms 76:4 You are more glorious and excellent Than the mountains of prey.
- Psalms 87:3 Glorious things are spoken of you, O city of God! Selah
- Psalms 111:3 His work is honorable and glorious, And His righteousness endures forever.
- Psalms 145:5 I will meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty, And on Your wondrous works.
- Psalms 145:12 To make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, And the glorious majesty of His kingdom.
- Isaiah 4:2 In that day the Branch of the LORD shall be beautiful and glorious; And the fruit of the earth *shall be* excellent and appealing For those of Israel who have escaped.

- Isaiah 63:15 Look down from heaven, And see from **Your habitation**, holy and glorious. Where *are* Your zeal and Your strength, The yearning of Your heart and Your mercies toward me? Are they restrained?
- Jeremiah 17:12 A glorious high throne from the beginning Is the place of our sanctuary.
- Ezekiel 27:25 The ships of Tarshish were carriers of your merchandise. You were filled and very glorious in the midst of the seas.
- Daniel 8:9 And out of one of them came a little horn which grew exceedingly great toward the south, toward the east, and toward the <u>Glorious</u> *Land*.
- Daniel 11:16 But he who comes against him shall do according to his own will, and no one shall stand against him. He shall stand in the **Glorious Land** with destruction in his power.
- Daniel 11:20 There shall arise in his place one who imposes taxes *on* the **glorious kingdom**; but within a few days he shall be destroyed, but not in anger or in battle.
