# Lie Not

That by two immutable things, in which it *is* impossible for God to <u>lie</u>, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before *us*.

Hebrews 6:18

You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a <u>liar</u> and the father of it. John 8:44

Immanuel will never lie to you, but a false Jesus may appear or speak to you. One reason for doing Immanuel with a Coach is discernment. Not every spirit is holy or will tell you the truth. False Jesus' can have several sources including demons and old religious tapes speaking within you. False Jesus are easily recognized and banished. After getting rid of the false witness, the Coach can again turn you (the Receiver) back to the True Lord Jesus.

#### Lie

Leviticus 19:11 'You shall not steal, nor deal falsely, nor <u>lie</u> to one another.

- Numbers 23:19 God is not a man, that He should <u>lie</u>, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?
- 1 Samuel 15:29 And also the Strength of Israel will not <u>lie</u> nor relent. For He *is* not a man that He should relent.
- 2 Kings 4:16 Then he said, "About this time next year you shall embrace a son." And she said, "No, my lord. Man of God, do not <u>lie</u> to your maidservant [Sarah]!"
- 2 Kings 9:12 And they said, "A <u>lie!</u> Tell us now." So he said, "Thus and thus he spoke to me, saying, "Thus says the LORD: "I have anointed you king over Israel."
- Job 6:28 Now therefore, be pleased to look at me; For I would never <u>lie</u> to your face.
- Job 34:6 Should I lie concerning my right? My wound is incurable, though I am without transgression.
- Psalms 62:9 Surely men of low degree *are* a vapor, Men of high degree *are* a <u>lie</u>; If they are weighed on the scales, They *are* altogether *lighter* than vapor.

- Psalms 89:35 Once I have sworn by My holiness; I will not lie to David.
- Psalms 119:69 The proud have forged a <u>lie</u> against me, But I will keep Your precepts with my whole heart.
- Proverbs 14:5 A faithful witness does not lie, But a false witness will utter lies.
- Isaiah 44:20 He feeds on ashes; A deceived heart has turned him aside; And he cannot deliver his soul, Nor say, "Is there not a <u>lie</u> in my right hand?"
- Isaiah 63:8 For He said, "Surely they are My people, Children who will not lie." So He became their Savior.
- Jeremiah 27:10 For they prophesy a <u>lie</u> to you, to remove you far from your land; and I will drive you out, and you will perish.
- Jeremiah 27:14 Therefore do not listen to the words of the prophets who speak to you, saying, 'You shall not serve the king of Babylon,' for they prophesy a <u>lie</u> to you.
- Jeremiah 27:15 "For I have not sent them," says the LORD, "yet they prophesy a <u>lie</u> in My name, that I may drive you out, and that you may perish, you and the prophets who prophesy to you."
- Jeremiah 27:16 Also I spoke to the priests and to all this people, saying, "Thus says the LORD: 'Do not listen to the words of your prophets who prophesy to you, saying, "Behold, the vessels of the LORD'S house will now shortly be brought back from Babylon"; for they prophesy a <u>lie</u> to you.
- Jeremiah 28:15 Then the prophet Jeremiah said to Hananiah the prophet, "Hear now, Hananiah, the LORD has not sent you, but you make this people trust in a <u>lie</u>.
- Jeremiah 29:21 Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, concerning Ahab the son of Kolaiah, and Zedekiah the son of Maaseiah, who prophesy a <u>lie</u> to you in My name: Behold, I will deliver them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and he shall slay them before your eyes.
- Jeremiah 29:31 Send to all those in captivity, saying, Thus says the LORD concerning Shemaiah the Nehelamite: Because Shemaiah has prophesied to you, and I have not sent him, and he has caused you to trust in a <u>lie</u>—
- Ezekiel 21:29 While they see false visions for you, While they divine a <u>lie</u> to you, To bring you on the necks of the wicked, the slain Whose day has come, Whose iniquity *shall* end.
- Micah 1:14 Therefore you shall give presents to Moresheth Gath; The houses of Achzib *shall be* a <u>lie</u> to the kings of Israel.
- Micah 2:11 If a man should walk in a false spirit And speak a <u>lie</u>, *saying*, 'I will prophesy to you of wine and drink,' Even he would be the prattler of this people.
- Habakkuk 2:3 For the vision *is* yet for an appointed time; But at the end it will speak, and it will not <u>lie</u>. Though it tarries, wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry.
- John 8:44 You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a <u>lie</u>, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a liar and the father of it.

- Acts 5:3 But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to <u>lie</u> to the Holy Spirit and keep back *part* of the price of the land for yourself?
- Acts 23:21 But do not yield to them, for more than forty of them <u>lie</u> in wait for him, men who have bound themselves by an oath that they will neither eat nor drink till they have killed him; and now they are ready, waiting for the promise from you.
- Romans 1:25 Who exchanged the truth of God for the <u>lie</u>, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.
- Romans 3:7 For if the truth of God has increased through my <u>lie</u> to His glory, why am I also still judged as a sinner?
- Galatians 1:20 (Now concerning the things which I write to you, indeed, before God, I do not lie.)
- Colossians 3:9 Do not <u>lie</u> to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:11 And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the <u>lie</u>.
- Titus 1:2 In hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began.
- Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it is impossible for God to <u>lie</u>, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us.
- James 3:14 But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth.
- James 3:14 But if you have bitter envy and self–seeking in your hearts, do not boast and <u>lie</u> against the truth.
- 1 John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we <u>lie</u> and do not practice the truth.
- 1 John 2:21 I have not written to you because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and that no <u>lie</u> is of the truth.
- 1 John 2:27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a <u>lie</u>, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.
- Revelation 3:9 "Indeed I will make *those* of the synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews and are not, but lie—indeed I will make them come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you.
- Revelation 21:27 But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a <u>lie</u>, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.
- Revelation 22:15 But outside *are* dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a <u>lie</u>.

#### Liar

Job 24:25 Now if it is not so, who will prove me a liar, And make my speech worth nothing?

- Proverbs 17:4 An evildoer gives heed to false lips; A liar listens eagerly to a spiteful tongue.
- Proverbs 19:22 What is desired in a man is kindness, And a poor man is better than a liar.
- Proverbs 30:6 Do not add to His words, Lest He rebuke you, and you be found a liar.
- John 8:44 You are of *your* father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own *resources*, for he is a <u>liar</u> and the father of it.
- John 8:55 Yet you have not known Him, but I know Him. And if I say, 'I do not know Him,' I shall be a <u>liar</u> like you; but I do know Him and keep His word.
- Romans 3:4 Certainly not! Indeed, let God be true but every man a <u>liar</u>. As it is written: "That You may be justified in Your words, And may overcome when You are judged."
- 1 John 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a <u>liar</u>, and His word is not in us.
- 1 John 2:4 He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a <u>liar</u>, and the truth is not in him.
- 1 John 2:22 Who is a <u>liar</u> but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son.
- 1 John 4:20 If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a <u>liar</u>; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen?
- 1 John 5:10 He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself; he who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son.

#### Lies

- Leviticus 6:3 Or if he has found what was lost and <u>lies</u> concerning it, and swears falsely—in any one of these things that a man may do in which he sins:
- Judges 16:10 Then Delilah said to Samson, "Look, you have mocked me and told me <u>lies</u>. Now, please tell me what you may be bound with."
- Judges 16:13 Delilah said to Samson, "Until now you have mocked me and told me <u>lies</u>. Tell me what you may be bound with." And he said to her, "If you weave the seven locks of my head into the web of the loom" —
- Job 13:4 But you forgers of lies, You are all worthless physicians.
- Psalms 40:4 Blessed is that man who makes the LORD his trust, And does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to <u>lies</u>.
- Psalms 41:6 And if he comes to see *me*, he speaks <u>lies</u>; His heart gathers iniquity to itself; *When* he goes out, he tells *it*.
- Psalms 58:3 The wicked are estranged from the womb; They go astray as soon as they are born, speaking <u>lies</u>.

- Psalms 62:4 They only consult to cast *him* down from his high position; They delight in <u>lies</u>; They bless with their mouth, But they curse inwardly. Selah
- Psalms 63:11 But the king shall rejoice in God; Everyone who swears by Him shall glory; But the mouth of those who speak <u>lies</u> shall be stopped.
- Psalms 101:7 He who works deceit shall not dwell within my house; He who tells <u>lies</u> shall not continue in my presence.
- Proverbs 6:19 A false witness who speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren.
- Proverbs 14:5 A faithful witness does not lie, But a false witness will utter <u>lies</u>.
- Proverbs 14:25 A true witness delivers souls, But a deceitful *witness* speaks <u>lies</u>.
- Proverbs 19:5 A false witness will not go unpunished, And he who speaks <u>lies</u> will not escape.
- Proverbs 19:9 A false witness will not go unpunished, And he who speaks lies shall perish.
- Proverbs 29:12 If a ruler pays attention to lies, All his servants become wicked.
- Proverbs 30:8 Remove falsehood and <u>lies</u> far from me; Give me neither poverty nor riches—Feed me with the food allotted to me.
- Isaiah 9:15 The elder and honorable, he is the head; The prophet who teaches lies, he is the tail.
- Isaiah 16:6 We have heard of the pride of Moab—He is very proud—Of his haughtiness and his pride and his wrath; But his lies shall not be so.
- Isaiah 28:15 Because you have said, "We have made a covenant with death, And with Sheol we are in agreement. When the overflowing scourge passes through, It will not come to us, For we have made <u>lies</u> our refuge, And under falsehood we have hidden ourselves."
- Isaiah 28:17 Also I will make justice the measuring line, And righteousness the plummet; The hail will sweep away the refuge of <u>lies</u>, And the waters will overflow the hiding place.
- Isaiah 59:3 For your hands are defiled with blood, And your fingers with iniquity; Your lips have spoken <u>lies</u>, Your tongue has muttered perversity.
- Isaiah 59:4 No one calls for justice, Nor does *any* plead for truth. They trust in empty words and speak <u>lies</u>; They conceive evil and bring forth iniquity.
- Jeremiah 9:3 "And *like* their bow they have bent their tongues *for* <u>lies</u>. They are not valiant for the truth on the earth. For they proceed from evil to evil, And they do not know Me," says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 9:5 Everyone will deceive his neighbor, And will not speak the truth; They have taught their tongue to speak <u>lies</u>; They weary themselves to commit iniquity.
- Jeremiah 14:14 And the LORD said to me, "The prophets prophesy <u>lies</u> in My name. I have not sent them, commanded them, nor spoken to them; they prophesy to you a false vision, divination, a worthless thing, and the deceit of their heart.

- Jeremiah 16:19 O LORD, my strength and my fortress, My refuge in the day of affliction, The Gentiles shall come to You From the ends of the earth and say, "Surely our fathers have inherited <u>lies</u>, Worthlessness and unprofitable *things*."
- Jeremiah 20:6 'And you, Pashhur, and all who dwell in your house, shall go into captivity. You shall go to Babylon, and there you shall die, and be buried there, you and all your friends, to whom you have prophesied <u>lies</u>.'
- Jeremiah 23:14 Also I have seen a horrible thing in the prophets of Jerusalem: They commit adultery and walk in <u>lies</u>; They also strengthen the hands of evildoers, So that no one turns back from his wickedness. All of them are like Sodom to Me, And her inhabitants like Gomorrah.
- Jeremiah 23:25 I have heard what the prophets have said who prophesy <u>lies</u> in My name, saying, 'I have dreamed, I have dreamed!'
- Jeremiah 23:26 How long will *this* be in the heart of the prophets who prophesy <u>lies</u>? Indeed *they are* prophets of the deceit of their own heart.
- Jeremiah 23:32 "Behold, I *am* against those who prophesy false dreams," says the LORD, "and tell them, and cause My people to err by their <u>lies</u> and by their recklessness. Yet I did not send them or command them; therefore they shall not profit this people at all," says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 48:30 "I know his wrath," says the LORD, "But it is not right; His lies have made nothing right".
- Ezekiel 13:8 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "Because you have spoken nonsense and envisioned <u>lies</u>, therefore I *am* indeed against you," says the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 13:9 "My hand will be against the prophets who envision futility and who divine <u>lies</u>; they shall not be in the assembly of My people, nor be written in the record of the house of Israel, nor shall they enter into the land of Israel. Then you shall know that I *am* the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 13:19 "And will you profane Me among My people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, killing people who should not die, and keeping people alive who should not live, by your lying to My people who listen to <u>lies</u>?"
- Ezekiel 13:22 "Because with <u>lies</u> you have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and you have strengthened the hands of the wicked, so that he does not turn from his wicked way to save his life.
- Ezekiel 22:28 "Her prophets plastered them with untempered *mortar*, seeing false visions, and divining <u>lies</u> for them, saying, 'Thus says the Lord GOD,' when the LORD had not spoken.
- Ezekiel 24:12 She has grown weary with <u>lies</u>, And her great scum has not gone from her. *Let* her scum *be* in the fire!
- Daniel 11:27 "Both these kings' hearts *shall be* bent on evil, and they shall speak <u>lies</u> at the same table; but it shall not prosper, for the end *will* still *be* at the appointed time.
- Hosea 7:3 They make a king glad with their wickedness, And princes with their <u>lies</u>.

- Hosea 7:13 "Woe to them, for they have fled from Me! Destruction to them, Because they have transgressed against Me! Though I redeemed them, Yet they have spoken <u>lies</u> against Me.
- Hosea 10:13 You have plowed wickedness; You have reaped iniquity. You have eaten the fruit of <u>lies</u>, Because you trusted in your own way, In the multitude of your mighty men.
- Hosea 11:12 "Ephraim has encircled Me with <u>lies</u>, And the house of Israel with deceit; But Judah still walks with God, Even with the Holy One *who is* faithful.
- Hosea 12:1 "Ephraim feeds on the wind, And pursues the east wind; He daily increases <u>lies</u> and desolation. Also they make a covenant with the Assyrians, And oil is carried to Egypt.
- Amos 2:4 Thus says the LORD: For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away its *punishment*, Because they have despised the law of the LORD, And have not kept His commandments. Their <u>lies</u> lead them astray, <u>Lies</u> which their fathers followed.
- Micah 6:12 For her rich men are full of violence, Her inhabitants have spoken <u>lies</u>, And their tongue is deceitful in their mouth.
- Micah 7:5 Do not trust in a friend; Do not put your confidence in a companion; Guard the doors of your mouth From her who <u>lies</u> in your bosom.
- Nahum 3:1 Woe to the bloody city! It is all full of lies and robbery. Its victim never departs.
- Habakkuk 2:18 What profit is the image, that its maker should carve it, The molded image, a teacher of <u>lies</u>, That the maker of its mold should trust in it, To make mute idols?
- Zephaniah 3:13 The remnant of Israel shall do no unrighteousness And speak no <u>lies</u>, Nor shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth; For they shall feed *their* flocks and lie down, And no one shall make *them* afraid.
- Zechariah 10:2 For the idols speak delusion; The diviners envision <u>lies</u>, And tell false dreams; They comfort in vain. Therefore *the people* wend their way like sheep; They are in trouble because *there is* no shepherd.
- Zechariah 13:3 It shall come to pass *that* if anyone still prophesies, then his father and mother who begot him will say to him, 'You shall not live, because you have spoken <u>lies</u> in the name of the LORD.' And his father and mother who begot him shall thrust him through when he prophesies.
- 1 Timothy 4:1-3 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons, speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron, forbidding to marry, *and commanding* to abstain from foods which God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth.

### Lied

- Psalms 78:36 Nevertheless they flattered Him with their mouth, And they lied to Him with their tongue.
- Isaiah 57:11 And of whom have you been afraid, or feared, That you have <u>lied</u> And not remembered Me, Nor taken *it* to your heart? Is it not because I have held My peace from of old That you do not fear Me?

- Jeremiah 5:12 They have <u>lied</u> about the LORD, And said, "*It is* not He. Neither will evil come upon us, Nor shall we see sword or famine.
- Acts 5:4 While it remained, was it not your own? And after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? You have not <u>lied</u> to men but to God.

## Lying

- Leviticus 6:2 If a person sins and commits a trespass against the LORD by lying to his neighbor about what was delivered to him for safekeeping, or about a pledge, or about a robbery, or if he has extorted from his neighbor.
- 1 Kings 13:18 He said to him, "I too *am* a prophet as you *are*, and an angel spoke to me by the word of the LORD, saying, 'Bring him back with you to your house, that he may eat bread and drink water." (He was <u>lying</u> to him.)
- Psalms 52:3 You love evil more than good, Lying rather than speaking righteousness. Selah
- Psalms 59:12 For the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips, Let them even be taken in their pride, And for the cursing and lying which they speak.
- Psalms 119:29 Remove from me the way of lying, And grant me Your law graciously.
- Psalms 119:163 I hate and abhor lying, But I love Your law.
- Proverbs 13:5 A righteous man hates lying, But a wicked man is loathsome and comes to shame.
- Hosea 4:2 By swearing and lying, Killing and stealing and committing adultery, They break all restraint, With bloodshed upon bloodshed.
- Romans 9:1 I tell the truth in Christ, I am not <u>lying</u>, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 11:31 The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who is blessed forever, knows that I am not <u>lying</u>.
- Ephesians 4:25 Therefore, putting away <u>lying</u>, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another.
- 1 Timothy 2:7 for which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle—I am speaking the truth in Christ *and* not lying—a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

#### Lying Children

- Isaiah 30:9 That this is a rebellious people, Lying children, Children who will not hear the law of the LORD.
- Isaiah 63:8 For He said, "Surely they are My people, Children who will not lie." So He became their Savior.

## Lying Lips

- Psalms 31:18 Let the <u>lying</u> lips be put to silence, Which speak insolent things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous.
- Psalms 120:2 Deliver my soul, O LORD, from lying lips And from a deceitful tongue.
- Proverbs 10:18 Whoever hides hatred has lying lips, And whoever spreads slander is a fool.
- Proverbs 17:7 Excellent speech is not becoming to a fool, Much less lying lips to a prince.
- Proverbs 12:22 Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, But those who deal truthfully are His delight.
- Isaiah 59:13 In transgressing and <u>lying</u> against the LORD, And departing from our God, Speaking oppression and revolt, Conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood.
- Ezekiel 13:19 And will you profane Me among My people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, killing people who should not die, and keeping people alive who should not live, by your lying to My people who listen to lies?

### Lying Tongue

- Psalms 109:2 For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful Have opened against me; They have spoken against me with a <u>lving</u> tongue.
- Proverbs 6:16-19 These six *things* the LORD hates, Yes, seven *are* an abomination to Him: A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood, A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil, A false witness *who* speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren.
- Proverbs 12:19 The truthful lip shall be established forever, But a lying tongue is but for a moment.
- Proverbs 21:6 Getting treasures by a lying tongue Is the fleeting fantasy of those who seek death.
- Proverbs 26:28 A lying tongue hates those who are crushed by it, And a flattering mouth works ruin.

## Lying Words

- Psalms 144:11 Rescue me and deliver me from the hand of foreigners, Whose mouth speaks <u>lying</u> words, And whose right hand *is* a right hand of falsehood—
- Isaiah 32:7 Also the schemes of the schemer *are* evil; He devises wicked plans To destroy the poor with <u>lying</u> words, Even when the needy speaks justice.
- Jeremiah 7:4 Do not trust in these <u>lying</u> words, saying, 'The temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD are these.'
- Jeremiah 7:8 Behold, you trust in lying words that cannot profit.

- Jeremiah 29:23 Because they have done disgraceful things in Israel, have committed adultery with their neighbors' wives, and have spoken <u>lying</u> words in My name, which I have not commanded them. Indeed I know, and *am* a witness, says the LORD.
- Daniel 2:9 If you do not make known the dream to me, *there is only* one decree for you! For you have agreed to speak <u>lying</u> and corrupt words before me till the time has changed. Therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that you can give me its interpretation."

## Lying Wonders

2 Thessalonians 2:9 The coming of the *lawless one* is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and <u>lving</u> wonders.

## Lying Spirit

- 1 Kings 22:22 The LORD said to him, 'In what way?' So he said, 'I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets.' And the LORD said, 'You shall persuade him, and also prevail. Go out and do so.'
- 1 Kings 22:23 Therefore look! The LORD has put a <u>lying</u> spirit in the mouth of all these prophets of yours, and the LORD has declared disaster against you.
- 2 Chronicles 18:21 So he said, 'I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets.' And the LORD said, 'You shall persuade him and also prevail; go out and do so.'
- 2 Chronicles 18:22 Therefore look! The LORD has put a <u>lying</u> spirit in the mouth of these prophets of yours, and the LORD has declared disaster against you.
- Micah 2:11 If a man should walk in a <u>false spirit</u> And speak a lie, *saying*, 'I will prophesy to you of wine and drink,' Even he would be the prattler of this people.
