Majesty of God

- Deuteronomy 33:29 Happy *are* you, O Israel! Who *is* like you, a people saved by the LORD, The shield of your help And the sword of your <u>majesty!</u> Your enemies shall submit to you, And you shall tread down their high places.
- 1 Chronicles 16:27 Honor and majesty are before Him; Strength and gladness are in His place.
- 1 Chronicles 29:11 Yours, O LORD, *is* the greatness, The power and the glory, The victory and the <u>majesty</u>; For all *that is* in heaven and in earth *is Yours*; Yours *is* the kingdom, O LORD, And You are exalted as head over all.
- Job 37:22 He comes from the north as golden splendor, With God is awesome majesty.
- Job 40:10 Then adorn yourself with majesty and splendor, and array yourself with glory and beauty.
- Psalms 29:4 The voice of the LORD is powerful; The voice of the LORD is full of majesty.
- Psalms 45:3 Gird Your sword upon Your thigh, O Mighty One, With Your glory and Your majesty.

- Micah 5:4 And He shall stand and feed *His flock* In the strength of the LORD, In the <u>majesty</u> of the name of the LORD His God; And they shall abide, For now He shall be great To the ends of the earth.
- Luke 9:43 And they were all amazed at the <u>majesty</u> of God. But while everyone marveled at all the things which Jesus did, He said to His disciples.
- Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of *His* glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.
- Hebrews 8:1 Now *this is* the main point of the things we are saying: We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the <u>Majesty</u> in the heavens.
- 2 Peter 1:16 For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His <u>majesty</u>.
- Jude 1:25 To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, Be glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen.

Majesty Given To Men By God

- 1 Chronicles 29:25 So the LORD exalted Solomon exceedingly in the sight of all Israel, and bestowed on him *such* royal <u>majesty</u> as had not been on any king before him in Israel.
- Esther 1:4 When he showed the riches of his glorious kingdom and the splendor of his excellent <u>majesty</u> for many days, one hundred and eighty days *in all*.

- Psalms 21:5 His glory is great in Your salvation; Honor and majesty You have placed upon him.
- Daniel 4:30 The king spoke, saying, "Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for a royal dwelling by my mighty power and for the honor of my majesty?"
- Daniel 4:36 At the same time my reason returned to me, and for the glory of my kingdom, my honor and splendor returned to me. My counselors and nobles resorted to me, I was restored to my kingdom, and excellent <u>majesty</u> was added to me.
- Daniel 5:18 O king, the Most High God gave Nebuchadnezzar your father a kingdom and <u>majesty</u>, glory and honor.
- Daniel 5:19 And because of the <u>majesty</u> that He gave him, all peoples, nations, and languages trembled and feared before him. Whomever he wished, he executed; whomever he wished, he kept alive; whomever he wished, he set up; and whomever he wished, he put down.
