Most High God

Most High

- Genesis 14:18 Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he *was* the priest of God <u>Most High</u>.
- Genesis 14:19 And he blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth;
- Genesis 14:20 And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand." And he gave him a tithe of all.
- Genesis 14:22 But Abram said to the king of Sodom, "I have raised my hand to the LORD, God Most High, the Possessor of heaven and earth,
- Numbers 24:16 The utterance of him who hears the words of God, And has the knowledge of the Most High, Who sees the vision of the Almighty, Who falls down, with eyes wide open:
- Deuteronomy 32:8 When the Most High divided their inheritance to the nations, When He separated the sons of Adam, He set the boundaries of the peoples According to the number of the children of Israel.
- 2 Samuel 22:14 "The LORD thundered from heaven, And the Most High uttered His voice.
- Psalms 7:17 I will praise the LORD according to His righteousness, And will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.
- Psalms 9:2 I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High.
- Psalms 18:13 The LORD thundered from heaven, And the Most High uttered His voice, Hailstones and coals of fire.
- Psalms 21:7 For the king trusts in the LORD, And through the mercy of the Most High he shall not be moved.
- Psalms 46:4 *There is* a river whose streams shall make glad the city of God, The holy *place* of the tabernacle of the Most High.
- Psalms 47:2 For the LORD Most High is awesome; He is a great King over all the earth.
- Psalms 50:14 Offer to God thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High.
- Psalms 56:2 My enemies would hound me all day, For there are many who fight against me, O Most High.
- Psalms 57:2 I will cry out to God Most High, To God who performs all things for me.
- Psalms 73:11 And they say, "How does God know? And is there knowledge in the Most High?"
- Psalms 77:10 And I said, "This is my anguish; But I will remember the years of the right hand of the Most High."
- Psalms 78:17 But they sinned even more against Him By rebelling against the Most High in the wilderness.
- Psalms 78:35 Then they remembered that God was their rock, And the Most High God their Redeemer.
- Psalms 78:56 Yet they tested and provoked the Most High God, And did not keep His testimonies,
- Psalms 82:6 I said, "You are gods, And all of you are children of the Most High.
- Psalms 83:18 That they may know that You, whose name alone is the LORD, Are the Most High over all the earth.
- Psalms 87:5 And of Zion it will be said, "This *one* and that *one* were born in her; And the Most High Himself shall establish her."
- Psalms 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- Psalms 91:9 Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place,
- Psalms 92:1 A Psalm. A Song for the Sabbath day. *It is* good to give thanks to the LORD, And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High;
- Psalms 97:9 For You, LORD, are most high above all the earth; You are exalted far above all gods.
- Psalms 107:11 Because they rebelled against the words of God, And despised the counsel of the Most High,
- Isaiah 14:14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.'
- Lamentations 3:35 To turn aside the justice due a man Before the face of the Most High,

- Lamentations 3:38 Is it not from the mouth of the Most High That woe and well-being proceed?
- Daniel 3:26 Then Nebuchadnezzar went near the mouth of the burning fiery furnace *and* spoke, saying, "Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed–Nego, servants of the Most High God, come out, and come *here*." Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed–Nego came from the midst of the fire.
- Daniel 4:2 I thought it good to declare the signs and wonders that the Most High God has worked for me.
- Daniel 4:17 'This decision is by the decree of the watchers, And the sentence by the word of the holy ones, In order that the living may know That the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, Gives it to whomever He will, And sets over it the lowest of men.'
- Daniel 4:24 this is the interpretation, O king, and this is the decree of the Most High, which has come upon my lord the king:
- Daniel 4:25 They shall drive you from men, your dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make you eat grass like oxen. They shall wet you with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over you, till you know that the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, and gives it to whomever He chooses.
- Daniel 4:32 And they shall drive you from men, and your dwelling *shall be* with the beasts of the field. They shall make you eat grass like oxen; and seven times shall pass over you, until you know that the <u>Most High</u> rules in the kingdom of men, and gives it to whomever He chooses."
- Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the time I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my understanding returned to me; and I blessed the Most High and praised and honored Him who lives forever: For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His kingdom is from generation to generation.
- Daniel 5:18 "O king, the Most High God gave Nebuchadnezzar your father a kingdom and majesty, glory and honor.
- Daniel 5:21 "Then he was driven from the sons of men, his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling was with the wild donkeys. They fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till he knew that the Most High God rules in the kingdom of men, and appoints over it whomever He chooses.
- Daniel 7:18 'But the saints of the Most High shall receive the kingdom, and possess the kingdom forever, even forever and ever.'
- Daniel 7:22 "until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made *in favor* of the saints of the <u>Most High</u>, and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom.
- Daniel 7:25 He shall speak *pompous* words against the <u>Most High</u>, Shall persecute the saints of the <u>Most High</u>, And shall intend to change times and law. Then *the saints* shall be given into his hand For a time and times and half a time.
- Daniel 7:27 Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him.'
- Hosea 7:16 They return, *but* not to the Most High; They are like a treacherous bow. Their princes shall fall by the sword For the cursings of their tongue. This *shall be* their derision in the land of Egypt.
- Hosea 11:7 My people are bent on backsliding from Me. Though they call to the Most High, None at all exalt Him.
- Mark 5:7 And he cried out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God that You do not torment me."
- Luke 6:35 "But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the <u>Most High</u>. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.
- Luke 8:28 When he saw Jesus, he cried out, fell down before Him, and with a loud voice said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me!"
- Acts 7:48 "However, the Most High does not dwell in temples made with hands, as the prophet says:
- Acts 16:17 This girl followed Paul and us, and cried out, saying, "These men are the servants of the Most High God, who proclaim to us the way of salvation."
- Hebrews 7:1 For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him,

Most Holy Place

- Exodus 26:33 And you shall hang the veil from the clasps. Then you shall bring the ark of the Testimony in there, behind the veil. The veil shall be a divider for you between the holy *place* and the <u>Most Holy</u>.
- Exodus 26:34 You shall put the mercy seat upon the ark of the Testimony in the Most Holy.
- Numbers 18:10 In a most holy place you shall eat it; every male shall eat it. It shall be holy to you.
- 1 Kings 6:16 Then he built the twenty–cubit room at the rear of the temple, from floor to ceiling, with cedar boards; he built *it* inside as the inner sanctuary, as the Most Holy Place.
- 1 Kings 7:50 The basins, the trimmers, the bowls, the ladles, and the censers of pure gold; and the hinges of gold, *both* for the doors of the inner room (the Most Holy Place) and for the doors of the main hall of the temple.
- 1 Kings 8:6 Then the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD to its place, into the inner sanctuary of the temple, to the Most Holy Place, under the wings of the cherubim.
- 1 Chronicles 6:49 But Aaron and his sons offered sacrifices on the altar of burnt offering and on the altar of incense, for all the work of the Most Holy Place, and to make atonement for Israel, according to all that Moses the servant of God had commanded.
- 2 Chronicles 3:8 And he made the Most Holy Place. Its length was according to the width of the house, twenty cubits, and its width twenty cubits. He overlaid it with six hundred talents of fine gold.
- 2 Chronicles 3:10 In the Most Holy Place he made two cherubim, fashioned by carving, and overlaid them with gold.
- 2 Chronicles 4:22 The trimmers, the bowls, the ladles, and the censers of pure gold. As for the entry of the sanctuary, its inner doors to the Most Holy Place, and the doors of the main hall of the temple, were gold.
- 2 Chronicles 5:7 Then the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD to its place, into the inner sanctuary of the temple, to the Most Holy Place, under the wings of the cherubim.
- 2 Chronicles 5:11 And it came to pass when the priests came out of the <u>Most Holy Place</u> (for all the priests who were present had sanctified themselves, without keeping to their divisions),
- Daniel 9:24 "Seventy weeks are determined For your people and for your holy city, To finish the transgression, To make an end of sins, To make reconciliation for iniquity, To bring in everlasting righteousness, To seal up vision and prophecy, And to anoint the Most Holy.
- Ezekiel 41:4 He measured the length, twenty cubits; and the width, twenty cubits, beyond the sanctuary; and he said to me, "This *is* the Most Holy Place."
- Ezekiel 44:13 "And they shall not come near Me to minister to Me as priest, nor come near any of My holy things, nor into the Most Holy Place; but they shall bear their shame and their abominations which they have committed.
- Ezekiel 45:3 "So this is the district you shall measure: twenty–five thousand *cubits* long and ten thousand wide; in it shall be the sanctuary, the <u>Most Holy</u> *Place*.

- Hebrews 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.
- Hebrews 9:25 Not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another—

Most Holy (To Humans)

- Exodus 29:37 Seven days you shall make atonement for the altar and sanctify it. And the altar shall be <u>most holy</u>. Whatever touches the altar must be holy.
- Exodus 30:10 And Aaron shall make atonement upon its horns once a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonement; once a year he shall make atonement upon it throughout your generations. It is most holy to the LORD.
- Exodus 30:29 You shall consecrate them, that they may be most holy; whatever touches them must be holy.
- Exodus 30:36 And you shall beat *some* of it very fine, and put some of it before the Testimony in the tabernacle of meeting where I will meet with you. It shall be <u>most holy</u> to you.
- Exodus 40:10 You shall anoint the altar of the burnt offering and all its utensils, and consecrate the altar. The altar shall be <u>most holy</u>.
- Leviticus 2:3 The rest of the grain offering *shall be* Aaron's and his sons'. *It is* most holy of the offerings to the LORD made by fire.
- Leviticus 2:10 And what is left of the grain offering *shall be* Aaron's and his sons'. *It is* most holy of the offerings to the LORD made by fire.
- Leviticus 6:17 It shall not be baked with leaven. I have given it *as* their portion of My offerings made by fire; it *is* most holy, like the sin offering and the trespass offering.
- Leviticus 6:25 Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, 'This *is* the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed, the sin offering shall be killed before the LORD. It *is* most holy.
- Leviticus 6:29 All the males among the priests may eat it. It is most holy.
- Leviticus 7:1 Likewise this is the law of the trespass offering (it is most holy).
- Leviticus 7:6 Every male among the priests may eat it. It shall be eaten in a holy place. It is most holy.
- Leviticus 10:12 And Moses spoke to Aaron, and to Eleazar and Ithamar, his sons who were left: "Take the grain offering that remains of the offerings made by fire to the LORD, and eat it without leaven beside the altar; for it is most holy.
- Leviticus 10:17 Why have you not eaten the sin offering in a holy place, since it *is* most holy, and *God* has given it to you to bear the guilt of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD?
- Leviticus 14:13 Then he shall kill the lamb in the place where he kills the sin offering and the burnt offering, in a holy place; for as the sin offering *is* the priest's, so *is* the trespass offering. It *is* most holy.

- Leviticus 21:22 He may eat the bread of his God, *both* the <u>most holy</u> and the holy.
- Leviticus 24:9 And it shall be for Aaron and his sons, and they shall eat it in a holy place; for it *is* most holy to him from the offerings of the LORD made by fire, by a perpetual statute.
- Leviticus 27:28 Nevertheless no devoted *offering* that a man may devote to the LORD of all that he has, *both* man and beast, or the field of his possession, shall be sold or redeemed; every devoted *offering is* most holy to the LORD.
- Ezekiel 42:13 Then he said to me, "The north chambers *and* the south chambers, which *are* opposite the separating courtyard, *are* the holy chambers where the priests who approach the LORD shall eat the <u>most holy</u> offerings. There they shall lay the <u>most holy</u> offerings—the grain offering, the sin offering, and the trespass offering—for the place *is* holy.
- Ezekiel 43:12 This is the law of the temple: The whole area surrounding the mountaintop is most holy. Behold, this is the law of the temple.
- Ezekiel 48:12 And *this* district of land that is set apart shall be to them a thing <u>most holy</u> by the border of the Levites.
- Jude 1:20 But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit.

Most Holy Things

- Numbers 4:4 "This *is* the service of the sons of Kohath in the tabernacle of meeting, *relating to* the <u>most holy</u> things:
- Numbers 4:19 "but do this in regard to them, that they may live and not die when they approach the <u>most holy things</u>: Aaron and his sons shall go in and appoint each of them to his service and his task.
- Numbers 18:9 "This shall be yours of the <u>most holy things</u> reserved from the fire: every offering of theirs, every grain offering and every sin offering and every trespass offering which they render to Me, *shall be* most holy for you and your sons.
- 1 Chronicles 23:13 The sons of Amram: Aaron and Moses; and Aaron was set apart, he and his sons forever, that he should sanctify the <u>most holy things</u>, to burn incense before the LORD, to minister to Him, and to give the blessing in His name forever.
- 2 Chronicles 31:14 Kore the son of Imnah the Levite, the keeper of the East Gate, *was* over the freewill offerings to God, to distribute the offerings of the LORD and the <u>most holy things</u>.
- Ezra 2:63 And the governor said to them that they should not eat of the <u>most holy things</u> till a priest could consult with the Urim and Thummim.
- Nehemiah 7:65 And the governor said to them that they should not eat of the <u>most holy things</u> till a priest could consult with the Urim and Thummim.

Most Blessed

- Deuteronomy 33:24 And of Asher he said: "Asher is most blessed of sons; Let him be favored by his brothers, And let him dip his foot in oil.
- Judges 5:24 "Most blessed among women is Jael, The wife of Heber the Kenite; Blessed is she among women in tents.
- Psalms 21:6 For You have made him <u>most blessed</u> forever; You have made him exceedingly glad with Your presence.
