O God: Prayers of the Heart

I have called upon You, for You will hear me, \underline{O} God; Incline Your ear to me, and hear my speech. Is alms 17:6

Most often we find "O God", "O LORD God", and "O my God" in the Psalms. These are used in an intimate sense by those who know their God. They can be used as expressions of praise or explanations of who He is. In Immanuel sessions, we most often translate them into a childlike, "Jesus, I need help!"

Studies included in this article are: O God; O LORD God; O My God.

O God

- Psalms 55:1 To the Chief Musician. With stringed instruments. A Contemplation of David. Give ear to my prayer, O God, And do not hide Yourself from my supplication.
- Psalms 55:23 But You, O God, shall bring them down to the pit of destruction; Bloodthirsty and deceitful men shall not live out half their days; But I will trust in You.
- Psalms 56:1 To the Chief Musician. Set to "The Silent Dove in Distant Lands." A Michtam of David when the Philistines captured him in Gath. Be merciful to me, <u>O God</u>, for man would swallow me up; Fighting all day he oppresses me.
- Psalms 56:7 Shall they escape by iniquity? In anger cast down the peoples, O God!
- Psalms 56:12 Vows made to You are binding upon me, O God; I will render praises to You,
- Psalms 57:1 To the Chief Musician. Set to "Do Not Destroy." A Michtam of David when he fled from Saul into the cave. Be merciful to me, <u>O God</u>, be merciful to me! For my soul trusts in You; And in the shadow of Your wings I will make my refuge, Until *these* calamities have passed by.
- Psalms 57:5 Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; Let Your glory be above all the earth.
- Psalms 57:7 My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and give praise.
- Psalms 57:11 Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; Let Your glory be above all the earth.
- Psalms 58:6 Break their teeth in their mouth, O God! Break out the fangs of the young lions, O LORD!
- Psalms 60:1 To the Chief Musician. Set to "Lily of the Testimony." A Michtam of David. For teaching. When he fought against Mesopotamia and Syria of Zobah, and Joab returned and killed twelve thousand Edomites in the Valley of Salt. O God, You have cast us off; You have broken us down; You have been displeased; Oh, restore us again!
- Psalms 60:10 Is it not You, O God, who cast us off? And You, O God, who did not go out with our armies?
- Psalms 61:1 To the Chief Musician. On a stringed instrument. *A Psalm* of David. Hear my cry, <u>O God</u>; Attend to my prayer.
- Psalms 61:5 For You, O God, have heard my vows; You have given me the heritage of those who fear Your name.
- Psalms 63:1 A Psalm of David when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, You are my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You In a dry and thirsty land Where there is no water.
- Psalms 64:1 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. Hear my voice, <u>O</u> <u>God</u>, in my meditation; Preserve my life from fear of the enemy.
- Psalms 65:1 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. A Song. Praise is awaiting You, O God, in Zion; And to You the vow shall be performed.

- Psalms 88:1 A Song. A Psalm of the sons of Korah. To the Chief Musician. Set to "Mahalath Leannoth." A Contemplation of Heman the Ezrahite. O LORD, God of my salvation, I have cried out day and night before You.
- Psalms 89:8 O LORD God of hosts, Who is mighty like You, O LORD? Your faithfulness also surrounds You.
- Psalms 94:1 O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongs—O God, to whom vengeance belongs, shine forth!
- Jeremiah 15:16 Your words were found, and I ate them, And Your word was to me the joy and rejoicing of my heart; For I am called by Your name, O LORD God of hosts.

- Jeremiah 32:25 And You have said to me, O Lord GOD, "Buy the field for money, and take witnesses"! yet the city has been given into the hand of the Chaldeans."
- Ezekiel 37:3 And He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" So I answered, "O Lord GOD, You know."

O My God

- 1 Chronicles 11:19 And he said, "Far be it from me, O my God, that I should do this! Shall I drink the blood of these men *who have put* their lives *in jeopardy*? For at the risk of their lives they brought it." Therefore he would not drink it. These things were done by the three mighty men."
- 1 Chronicles 17:25 For You, O my God, have revealed to Your servant that You will build him a house. Therefore Your servant has found it *in his heart* to pray before You.
- Ezra 9:6 And I said: "O my God, I am too ashamed and humiliated to lift up my face to You, my God; for our iniquities have risen higher than *our* heads, and our guilt has grown up to the heavens."
- Nehemiah 13:14 Remember me, O my God, concerning this, and do not wipe out my good deeds that I have done for the house of my God, and for its services!
- Nehemiah 13:22 And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and that they should go and guard the gates, to sanctify the Sabbath day. Remember me, O my God, concerning this also, and spare me according to the greatness of Your mercy!
- Nehemiah 13:29 Remember them, O my God, because they have defiled the priesthood and the covenant of the priesthood and the Levites.
- Nehemiah 13:31 And *to bringing* the wood offering and the firstfruits at appointed times. Remember me, O my God, for good!
- Psalms 3:7 Arise, O LORD; Save me, O my God! For You have struck all my enemies on the cheekbone; You have broken the teeth of the ungodly.
- Psalms 22:2 O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; And in the night season, and am not silent.
- Psalms 25:2 O my God, I trust in You; Let me not be ashamed; Let not my enemies triumph over me.
- Psalms 38:21 Do not forsake me, O LORD; O my God, be not far from me!

- Psalms 40:8 I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart.
- Psalms 40:17 But I *am* poor and needy; *Yet* the Lord thinks upon me. You *are* my help and my deliverer; Do not delay, O my God.
- Psalms 42:6 O my God, my soul is cast down within me; Therefore I will remember You from the land of the Jordan, And from the heights of Hermon, From the Hill Mizar.
- Psalms 59:1 To the Chief Musician. Set to "Do Not Destroy." A Michtam of David when Saul sent men, and they watched the house in order to kill him. Deliver me from my enemies, <u>O my God</u>; Defend me from those who rise up against me.
- Psalms 71:4 Deliver me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked, Out of the hand of the unrighteous and cruel man.
- Psalms 71:12 O God, do not be far from me; O my God, make haste to help me!
- Psalms 71:22 Also with the lute I will praise you—And Your faithfulness, O my God! To You I will sing with the harp, O Holy One of Israel.
- Psalms 83:13 O my God, make them like the whirling dust, Like the chaff before the wind!
- Psalms 102:24 I said, "O my God, Do not take me away in the midst of my days; Your years are throughout all generations."
- Daniel 9:18 O my God, incline Your ear and hear; open Your eyes and see our desolations, and the city which is called by Your name; for we do not present our supplications before You because of our righteous deeds, but because of Your great mercies.
