

# On Faith: Paul

---

***For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from [faith](#) to [faith](#); as it is written, "The just shall [live by faith](#)."* Romans 1:17**

## **The Faith (Corporate)**

Romans 1:5 By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the [faith](#) among all nations, for his name.

Romans 4:11 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the [faith](#) which *he had while still* uncircumcised, that he might be the father of all those who believe, though they are uncircumcised, that righteousness might be imputed to them also.

Romans 14:1 Receive one who is weak in the [faith](#), *but* not to disputes over doubtful things.

Romans 4:12 And the father of circumcision to those who not only *are* of the circumcision, but who also walk in the steps of the [faith](#) which our father Abraham *had while still* uncircumcised.

Romans 4:16 Therefore *it is* of [faith](#) that *it might be* according to grace, so that the promise might be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the [faith](#) of Abraham, who is the father of us all.

Galatians 1:23 But they were hearing only, "He who formerly persecuted us now preaches the [faith](#) which he once *tried to* destroy."

Galatians 3:7 Therefore know that *only* those who are of [faith](#) are sons of Abraham.

Galatians 3:9 So Then those who *are* of [faith](#) are blessed with believing Abraham.

Galatians 6:10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of [faith](#).

Ephesians 4:5 One Lord, one [faith](#), one baptism.

Ephesians 4:13 Till we all come to the unity of the [faith](#) and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

Philippians 1:27 Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the [faith](#) of the gospel.

Colossians 1:23 If indeed you continue in the [faith](#), grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.

Colossians 2:7 Rooted and built up in Him and established in the [faith](#), as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.

1 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, a true son in the [faith](#): Grace, mercy, *and* peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 Timothy 3:9 Holding the mystery of the [faith](#) with a pure conscience.

1 Timothy 3:13 For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a good standing and great boldness in the [faith](#) which is in Christ Jesus.

1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the [faith](#), giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons.

1 Timothy 5:8 But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the [faith](#) and is worse than an unbeliever.

1 Timothy 5:12 Having condemnation because they have cast off their first [faith](#).

1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all *kinds of* evil, for which some have strayed from the [faith](#) in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

1 Timothy 6:21 By professing it some have strayed concerning the [faith](#). Grace *be* with you. Amen.

2 Timothy 3:8 Now as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the [faith](#).

2 Timothy 4:7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the [faith](#).

Titus 1:4 To Titus, a true son in *our* common [faith](#): Grace, mercy, *and* peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior.

Titus 1:13 This testimony is true. Therefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the [faith](#).

Titus 3:15 All who *are* with me greet you. Greet those who love us in the [faith](#). Grace *be* with you all. Amen.

## **The Grace of Faith (Personal )**

Romans 1:8 First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your [faith](#) is spoken of throughout the whole world.

Romans 1:12 That is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual [faith](#) both of you and me.

Romans 4:5 But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his [faith](#) is accounted for righteousness.

Romans 4:9 *Does* this blessedness then *come* upon the circumcised *only*, or upon the uncircumcised also? For we say that [faith](#) was accounted to Abraham for righteousness.

Romans 4:14 For if those who are of the law *are* heirs, [faith](#) is made void and the promise made of no effect.

Romans 10:8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of [faith](#) which we preach).

2 Corinthians 1:24 Not that we have dominion over your [faith](#), but are fellow workers for your joy; for by faith you stand.

2 Corinthians 8:7 Therefore, as ye abound in every *thing*, *in* [faith](#), and utterance, and knowledge, and *in* all diligence, and *in* your love to us, *see* that ye abound in this grace also.

Ephesians 1:15 Therefore I also, after I heard of your [faith](#) in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints.

Ephesians 6:23 Peace to the brethren, and love with [faith](#), from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Philippians 1:25 And being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of [faith](#).

Philippians 2:17 Yes, and if I am being poured out *as a drink offering* on the sacrifice and service of your [faith](#), I am glad and rejoice with you all.

Colossians 1:4 Since we heard of your [faith](#) in Christ Jesus and of your love for all the saints.

Colossians 2:5 For though I am absent in the flesh, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your *good* order and the steadfastness of your [faith](#) in Christ.

1 Thessalonians 1:8 For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place. Your [faith](#) toward God has gone out, so that we do not need to say anything.

1 Thessalonians 3:2 And sent Timothy, our brother and minister of God, and our fellow laborer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you and encourage you concerning your [faith](#).

1 Thessalonians 3:5 For this reason, when I could no longer endure it, I sent to know your [faith](#), lest by some means the tempter had tempted you, and our labor might be in vain.

1 Thessalonians 3:6 But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and brought us good news of your [faith](#) and love, and that you always have good remembrance of us, greatly desiring to see us, as we also *to see* you—

- 1 Thessalonians 3:7 Therefore, brethren, in all our affliction and distress we were comforted concerning you by your [faith](#).
- 2 Thessalonians 1:4 So that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and [faith](#) in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:2 And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have [faith](#).
- 1 Timothy 1:5 Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, *from* a good conscience, and *from* sincere [faith](#).
- 1 Timothy 1:19 Having [faith](#) and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the [faith](#) have suffered shipwreck.
- 1 Timothy 2:7 For which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle—I am speaking the truth in Christ *and* not lying—a teacher of the Gentiles in [faith](#) and truth.
- 1 Timothy 2:15 Nevertheless she will be saved in childbearing if they continue in [faith](#), love, and holiness, with self-control.
- 1 Timothy 4:12 Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in [faith](#), in purity.
- 1 Timothy 6:11 But you, O man of God, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, [faith](#), love, patience, gentleness.
- 2 Timothy 1:5 when I call to remembrance the genuine [faith](#) that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.
- 2 Timothy 1:13 Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in [faith](#) and love which are in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Timothy 2:18 Who have strayed concerning the truth, saying that the resurrection is already past; and they overthrow the [faith](#) of some.
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, [faith](#), love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- 2 Timothy 3:10 But you have carefully followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, [faith](#), longsuffering, love, perseverance.
- Titus 1:1 Paul, A bondservant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the [faith](#) of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which accords with godliness.
- Titus 2:2 That the older men be sober, reverent, temperate, sound in [faith](#), in love, in patience.
- Philemon 1:5 Hearing of your love and [faith](#) which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints.
- Philemon 1:6 That the sharing of your [faith](#) may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.

## The Work of Faith (by/through)

Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from [faith](#) to [faith](#): as it is written, The just shall live by [faith](#).

Romans 3:3 For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the [faith](#) of God without effect?

Romans 3:22 Even the righteousness of God *which is* by [faith](#) of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

Romans 3:25 Whom God has set forth *to be* a propitiation through [faith](#) in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

Romans 3:27-28 Where *is* boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? No: but by the law of [faith](#). Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by [faith](#) without the deeds of the law.

Romans 3:30-31 Seeing *it is* one God, which shall justify the circumcision by [faith](#), and uncircumcision through [faith](#). Do we then make void the law through [faith](#)? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.

Romans 5:1-2 Therefore, having been justified by [faith](#), we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through whom also we have access by [faith](#) into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 9:32 Why? Because *they did* not *seek it* by [faith](#), but as it were, by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone.

Romans 11:20 Well *said*. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by [faith](#). Do not be haughty, but fear.

Romans 16:26 But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of [faith](#).

2 Corinthians 5:7 (For we walk by [faith](#), not by sight:)

Galatians 3:2 This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of [faith](#)?

Galatians 3:5 Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, *does He do it* by the works of the law, or by the hearing of [faith](#)? —

Galatians 3:8 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by [faith](#), preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, *saying*, "In you all the nations shall be blessed."

Galatians 3:14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through [faith](#).

Galatians 3:22 But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by [faith](#) in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.

Galatians 3:24 Therefore the law was our tutor *to bring us* to Christ, that we might be justified by [faith](#).

Galatians 3:26 For you are all sons of God through [faith](#) in Christ Jesus.

Galatians 5:5-6 For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by [faith](#). For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but [faith](#) working through love.

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through [faith](#), and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God.

Ephesians 3:12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence through [faith](#) in Him.

Ephesians 3:17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts through [faith](#); that you, being rooted and grounded in love.

Philippians 3:9 And be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which *is* from the law, but that which *is* through [faith](#) in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by [faith](#);

Colossians 2:12 Buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with *Him* through [faith](#) in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

1 Thessalonians 1:3 Remembering without ceasing your work of [faith](#), labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father.

2 Thessalonians 1:11 Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of *this* calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of *His* goodness and the work of [faith](#) with power.

2 Timothy 3:15 and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through [faith](#) which is in Christ Jesus.

## Live By Faith

[Habakkuk 2:4 "Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his [faith](#).]

Romans 1:17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from [faith](#) to [faith](#); as it is written, "The just shall [live by faith](#)."

Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I [live by faith](#) in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Galatians 3:11-12 But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God *is* evident, for "the just shall [live by faith](#). Yet the law is not of [faith](#), but "the man who does them shall live by them."

Hebrews 10:38 Now the just shall [live by faith](#); But if *anyone* draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him."

## Righteousness of Faith

Romans 4:13 For the promise that he would be the heir of the world *was* not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the [righteousness of faith](#).

Romans 9:30 What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the [righteousness of faith](#);

Romans 10:6 But the [righteousness of faith](#) speaks in this way, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down *from above*)

## Faith And Sin

Romans 14:22-23 Do you have [faith](#)? Have *it* to yourself before God. Happy *is* he who does not condemn himself in what he approves. But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because *he does* not *eat* from [faith](#); for whatever *is* not from [faith](#) is sin.

1 Corinthians 15:14, 17 And if Christ be not risen, then *is* our preaching vain, and your [faith](#) *is* also vain... And if Christ be not raised, your [faith](#) *is* vain; ye are yet in your sins.

## Strong In Faith

Romans 4:19 And being not weak in [faith](#), he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb.

Romans 4:20 He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in [faith](#), giving glory to God.

1 Corinthians 16:13 Watch, stand fast in the [faith](#), be brave, be strong.

## Source of Faith

Romans 10:17 So then [faith](#) *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

1 Corinthians 2:5 That your [faith](#) should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

Galatians 3:23 But before [faith](#) came, we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the [faith](#) which would afterward be revealed.

Galatians 3:25 But after [faith](#) has come, we are no longer under a tutor.

1 Timothy 1:14 And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with [faith](#) and love which are in Christ Jesus.

## Portion of Faith

Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think *of himself* more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of [faith](#).

Romans 12:6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, *let us prophesy* according to the proportion of [faith](#).

### **Gift of Faith**

1 Corinthians 12:9 To another [faith](#) by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit.

1 Corinthians 13:2 And though I have *the gift of* prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all [faith](#), so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abide [faith](#), hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these *is* love.

2 Corinthians 4:13 We having the same spirit of [faith](#), according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak.

Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the [faith](#) of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the [faith](#) of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

### **Increase In Faith**

2 Corinthians 10:15 Not boasting of things beyond measure, *that is*, in other men's labors, but having hope, *that* as your [faith](#) is increased, we shall be greatly enlarged by you in our sphere.

1 Thessalonians 3:10 Night and day praying exceedingly that we may see your face and perfect what is lacking in your [faith](#)?

1 Timothy 1:4 Nor give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which cause disputes rather than godly edification which is in [faith](#).

1 Timothy 4:6 If you instruct the brethren in these things, you will be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished in the words of [faith](#) and of the good doctrine which you have carefully followed.

### **Weapon of Faith**

Ephesians 6:16 Above all, taking the shield of [faith](#) with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

1 Thessalonians 5:8 But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of [faith](#) and love, and *as* a helmet the hope of salvation.



2 Thessalonians 1:3 We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your [faith](#) grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other,

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of [faith](#), lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.
