Once

Who once was unprofitable to you, but now is profitable to you and to me. Thilemon 1:11

Good fruit is a major indicator of Immanuel's work in us. We are changed when we first believe in Him. Once (At One Time)

- Ezekiel 32:15 'When I make the land of Egypt desolate, And the country is destitute of all that <u>once</u> filled it, When I strike all who dwell in it, Then they shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- Zechariah 10:8 I will whistle for them and gather them, For I will redeem them; And they shall increase as they <u>once</u> increased.
- Romans 7:9 I was alive <u>once</u> without the law, but when the commandment came, sin revived and I died.
- Romans 11:30 For as you were <u>once</u> disobedient to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience.
- Galatians 1:23 But they were hearing only, "He who formerly persecuted us now preaches the faith which he once tried to destroy."
- Ephesians 2:2 In which you <u>once</u> walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience.
- Ephesians 2:3 Among whom also we all <u>once</u> conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.
- Ephesians 2:11 Therefore remember that you, <u>once</u> Gentiles in the flesh—who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made in the flesh by hands—
- Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus you who <u>once</u> were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.
- Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light

- Colossians 1:21 And you, who <u>once</u> were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled.
- Colossians 3:7 In which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them.
- Titus 3:3 For we ourselves were also <u>once</u> foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.
- Philemon 1:11 Who once was unprofitable to you, but now is profitable to you and to me.
- Hebrews 6:4 For *it is* impossible for those who were <u>once</u> enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit.
- Hebrews 10:2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, <u>once</u> purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins.
- 1 Peter 2:10 Who <u>once</u> were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.
- Jude 1:5 But I want to remind you, though you <u>once</u> knew this, that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed those who did not believe.

Once (One Time Only)

- Exodus 10:17 Now therefore, please forgive my sin <u>only</u> this <u>once</u>, and entreat the LORD your God, that He may take away from me this death <u>only</u>.
- Joshua 6:3 You shall march around the city, all *you* men of war; you shall go all around the city <u>once</u>. This you shall do six days.
- Joshua 6:11 So he had the ark of the LORD circle the city, going around *it* <u>once</u>. Then they came into the camp and lodged in the camp.
- Joshua 6:14 And the second day they marched around the city <u>once</u> and returned to the camp. So they did six days.
- 2 Corinthians 11:25 Three times I was beaten with rods; <u>once</u> I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been in the deep.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment.
- Hebrews 9:26 He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, <u>once</u> at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.
- Hebrews 9:28 So Christ was offered <u>once</u> to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also suffered <u>once</u> for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit.

Once For All

- Romans 6:10 For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.
- Hebrews 7:27 Who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did <u>once for all</u> when He offered up Himself.
- Hebrews 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.
- Hebrews 10:10 By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for* all.
- Jude 1:3 Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was <u>once for all</u> delivered to the saints.

Once More

- Genesis 18:32 Then he said, "Let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak but <u>once more</u>: Suppose ten should be found there?" And He said, "I will not destroy *it* for the sake of ten."
- Judges 6:39 Then Gideon said to God, "Do not be angry with me, but let me speak just <u>once more</u>: Let me test, I pray, just <u>once more</u> with the fleece; let it now be dry only on the fleece, but on all the ground let there be dew."
- Judges 16:18 When Delilah saw that he had told her all his heart, she sent and called for the lords of the Philistines, saying, "Come up <u>once more</u>, for he has told me all his heart." So the lords of the Philistines came up to her and brought the money in their hand.
- Haggai 2:6 For thus says the LORD of hosts: 'Once more (it is a little while) I will shake heaven and earth, the sea and dry land.
- Hebrews 12:26 Whose voice then shook the earth; but now He has promised, saying, "Yet <u>once more I</u> shake not only the earth, but also heaven."
- Hebrews 12:27 Now this, "Yet <u>once more</u>," indicates the removal of those things that are being shaken, as of things that are made, that the things which cannot be shaken may remain."

Once Again

Numbers 32:15 For if you turn away from following Him, He will <u>once again</u> leave them in the wilderness, and you will destroy all these people.

- 1 Samuel 23:4 Then David inquired of the LORD <u>once again</u>. And the LORD answered him and said, "Arise, go down to Keilah. For I will deliver the Philistines into your hand."
- 2 Samuel 5:22 Then the Philistines went up once again and deployed themselves in the Valley of Rephaim.
- 1 Chronicles 14:13 Then the Philistines once again made a raid on the valley.
- Philippians 4:16 For even in Thessalonica you sent aid once and again for my necessities.

At Once

- Numbers 13:30 Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it."
- Numbers 22:6 Therefore please come <u>at once</u>, curse this people for me, for they *are* too mighty for me. Perhaps I shall be able to defeat them and drive them out of the land, for I know that he whom you bless *is* blessed, and he whom you curse is cursed.
- Deuteronomy 7:22 And the LORD your God will drive out those nations before you little by little; you will be unable to destroy them at once, lest the beasts of the field become too numerous for you.
- Judges 7:3 "Now therefore, proclaim in the hearing of the people, saying, "Whoever is fearful and afraid, let him turn and depart at once from Mount Gilead." And twenty—two thousand of the people returned, and ten thousand remained.
- 1 Samuel 26:8 Then Abishai said to David, "God has delivered your enemy into your hand this day. Now therefore, please, let me strike him at once with the spear, right to the earth; and I will not *have to strike* him a second time!"
- 2 Chronicles 2:7 Therefore send me at once a man skillful to work in gold and silver, in bronze and iron, in purple and crimson and blue, who has skill to engrave with the skillful men who are with me in Judah and Jerusalem, whom David my father provided.
- Psalms 74:6 And now they break down its carved work, all at once, With axes and hammers.
- Proverbs 12:16 A fool's wrath is known at once, But a prudent man covers shame.
- Isaiah 42:14 I have held My peace a long time, I have been still and restrained Myself. *Now* I will cry like a woman in labor, I will pant and gasp <u>at once</u>.
- Isaiah 66:8 Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to give birth in one day? *Or* shall a nation be born <u>at once</u>? For as soon as Zion was in labor, She gave birth to her children.
- Matthew 9:3 And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes!"
- Mark 1:30 But Simon's wife's mother lay sick with a fever, and they told Him about her at once.
- Mark 1:43 And He strictly warned him and sent him away at once,

- Mark 5:13 And <u>at once</u> Jesus gave them permission. Then the unclean spirits went out and entered the swine (there were about two thousand); and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and drowned in the sea.
- Mark 6:25 Immediately she came in with haste to the king and asked, saying, "I want you to give me at once the head of John the Baptist on a platter."
- Luke 17:7 And which of you, having a servant plowing or tending sheep, will say to him when he has come in from the field, 'Come <u>at once</u> and sit down to eat'?
- Luke 23:18 And they all cried out at once, saying, "Away with this Man, and release to us Barabbas" —
- Acts 9:18 Immediately there fell from his eyes *something* like scales, and he received his sight <u>at once</u>; and he arose and was baptized."
- 1 Corinthians 15:6 After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren <u>at once</u>, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep.
- Philippians 2:23 Therefore I hope to send him at once, as soon as I see how it goes with me.

This Once

- Exodus 10:17 Now therefore, please forgive my sin only this <u>once</u>, and entreat the LORD your God, that He may take away from me this death only.
- Judges 16:28 Then Samson called to the LORD, saying, "O Lord GOD, remember me, I pray! Strengthen me, I pray, just this <u>once</u>, O God, that I may with one *blow* take vengeance on the Philistines for my two eyes!"
- Jeremiah 16:21 "Therefore behold, I will this <u>once</u> cause them to know, I will cause them to know My hand and My might; And they shall know that My name *is* the LORD.

Once and/or Twice

- 2 Kings 6:10 Then the king of Israel sent *someone* to the place of which the man of God had told him. Thus he warned him, and he was watchful there, not just <u>once or twice</u>.
- Nehemiah 13:20 Now the merchants and sellers of all kinds of wares lodged outside Jerusalem once or twice.
- Job 40:5 Once I have spoken, but I will not answer; Yes, twice, but I will proceed no further."
- Psalms 62:11 God has spoken once, Twice I have heard this: That power belongs to God.

Once A Year

- Exodus 30:10 And Aaron shall make atonement upon its horns <u>once a year</u> with the blood of the sin offering of atonement; <u>once a year</u> he shall make atonement upon it throughout your generations. It *is* most holy to the LORD.
- Leviticus 16:34 This shall be an everlasting statute for you, to make atonement for the children of Israel, for all their sins, <u>once a year</u>." And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.
- Hebrews 9:7 But into the second part the high priest *went* alone <u>once a year</u>, not without blood, which he offered for himself and *for* the people's sins *committed* in ignorance.

Once Every

- 1 Kings 10:22 For the king had merchant ships at sea with the fleet of Hiram. <u>Once</u> every three years the merchant ships came bringing gold, silver, ivory, apes, and monkeys.
- 2 Chronicles 9:21 For the king's ships went to Tarshish with the servants of Hiram. <u>Once</u> every three years the merchant ships came, bringing gold, silver, ivory, apes, and monkeys.
- Nehemiah 5:18 Now *that* which was prepared daily *was* one ox *and* six choice sheep. Also fowl were prepared for me, and <u>once</u> every ten days an abundance of all kinds of wine. Yet in spite of this I did not demand the governor's provisions, because the bondage was heavy on this people.
- Judges 9:8 The trees <u>once</u> went forth to anoint a king over them. And they said to the olive tree, 'Reign over us!'
- Job 33:21 His flesh wastes away from sight, And his bones stick out which once were not seen.

Once Spoken

Job 40:5 Once I have spoken, but I will not answer; Yes, twice, but I will proceed no further."

Psalms 62:11 God has spoken once, Twice I have heard this: That power belongs to God.

Psalms 89:35 Once I have sworn by My holiness; I will not lie to David:

Once (When)

Psalms 76:7 You, Yourself, *are* to be feared; And who may stand in Your presence When <u>once</u> You are angry?

Luke 13:25 When <u>once</u> the Master of the house has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from,'

1 Peter 3:20 Who formerly were disobedient, when <u>once</u> the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while <i>the</i> ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water	er.
