Overcoming

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have <u>overcome</u> the world. John 16:33

When healing of a negative memory occurs, the R no longer feels the negative emotions which have been swallowed up by the Presence of Immanuel. No longer is R worried about the things of this world, but feels perfect peace and satisfaction because Jesus has overcome the world and thereby has made R an overcomer.

Overcome (Jesus' doing)

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have <u>overcome</u> the world.

Revelation 17:14 These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will <u>overcome</u> them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those *who are* with Him *are* called, chosen, and faithful.

Overcomes

- Luke 11:22 But when a stronger than he comes upon him and <u>overcomes</u> him, he takes from him all his armor in which he trusted, and divides his spoils.
- 1 John 5:4-5 For whatever is born of God <u>overcomes</u> the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. Who is he who <u>overcomes</u> the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- Revelation 2:7 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who <u>overcomes</u> I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.
- Revelation 2:11 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who <u>overcomes</u> shall not be hurt by the second death.
- Revelation 2:17 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who <u>overcomes</u> I will give some of the hidden manna to eat. And I will give him a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except him who receives *it*.

- Revelation 2:26 And he who overcomes, and keeps My works until the end, to him I will give power over the nations—
- Revelation 3:5 He who <u>overcomes</u> shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.
- Revelation 3:12 He who <u>overcomes</u>, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. And I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And *I will write on him* My new name.
- Revelation 3:21 To him who <u>overcomes</u> I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.
- Revelation 21:7 He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.

Overcome

- Numbers 13:30 Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to <u>overcome</u> it."
- Romans 3:4 Certainly not! Indeed, let God be true but every man a liar. As it is written: "That You may be justified in Your words, And may <u>overcome</u> when You are judged."
- Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
- 1 John 2:13 I write to you, fathers, Because you have known Him *who is* from the beginning. I write to you, young men, Because you have <u>overcome</u> the wicked one. I write to you, little children, Because you have known the Father.
- 1 John 2:14 I have written to you, fathers, Because you have known Him *who is* from the beginning. I have written to you, young men, Because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, And you have overcome the wicked one.
- 1 John 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have <u>overcome</u> them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
- 1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has <u>overcome</u> the world—our faith.

Overcome With Wine

- Isaiah 28:1 Woe to the crown of pride, to the drunkards of Ephraim, Whose glorious beauty *is* a fading flower Which *is* at the head of the verdant valleys, To those who are <u>overcome</u> with wine!
- Jeremiah 23:9 My heart within me is broken Because of the prophets; All my bones shake. I am like a drunken man, And like a man whom wine has <u>overcome</u>, Because of the LORD, And because of His holy words.

Overcome By Enemies

- 1 Samuel 7:10 Now as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel. But the LORD thundered with a loud thunder upon the Philistines that day, and so confused them that they were <u>overcome</u> before Israel.
- 2 Kings 16:5 Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, came up to Jerusalem to *make* war; and they besieged Ahaz but could not <u>overcome</u> *him*.
- Acts 20:9 And in a window sat a certain young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep. He was <u>overcome</u> by sleep; and as Paul continued speaking, he fell down from the third story and was taken up dead.
- 2 Peter 2:19-20 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are slaves of corruption; for by whom a person is <u>overcome</u>, by him also he is brought into bondage. For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and <u>overcome</u>, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning.
- Revelation 11:7 When they finish their testimony, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit will make war against them, <u>overcome</u> them, and kill them.
- Revelation 13:7 It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to <u>overcome</u> them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation.

Overcome With Emotion

- Song of Solomon 6:5 Turn your eyes away from me, For they have <u>overcome</u> me. Your hair *is* like a flock of goats Going down from Gilead.
- Mark 5:42 Immediately the girl arose and walked, for she was twelve years *of age*. And they were <u>overcome</u> with great amazement.

Overcoming

Job 41:9 Indeed, any hope of overcoming him is false; Shall one not be overwhelmed at the sight of him?

Overcame

Revelation 3:21 To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also <u>overcame</u> and sat down with My Father on His throne.

Revelation 12:11 And they <u>overcame</u> him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

Overwhelmed

- Job 41:9 Indeed, any hope of overcoming him is false; Shall one not be overwhelmed at the sight of him?
- Psalms 55:5 Fearfulness and trembling have come upon me, And horror has overwhelmed me.
- Psalms 61:2 From the end of the earth I will cry to You, When my heart is <u>overwhelmed</u>; Lead me to the rock that is higher than I.
- Psalms 77:3 I remembered God, and was troubled; I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed. Selah
- Psalms 78:53 And He led them on safely, so that they did not fear; But the sea overwhelmed their enemies.
- Psalms 102:1 A Prayer of the afflicted when he is <u>overwhelmed</u> and pours out his complaint before the LORD. Hear my prayer, O LORD, And let my cry come to You.
- Psalms 124:4 Then the waters would have <u>overwhelmed</u> us, The stream would have gone over our soul.
- Psalms 142:3 When my spirit was <u>overwhelmed</u> within me, Then You knew my path. In the way in which I walk They have secretly set a snare for me.
- Psalms 143:4 Therefore my spirit is overwhelmed within me; My heart within me is distressed.
- Daniel 10:16 And suddenly, *one* having the likeness of the sons of men touched my lips; then I opened my mouth and spoke, saying to him who stood before me, "My lord, because of the vision my sorrows have <u>overwhelmed</u> me, and I have retained no strength.

Overwhelm

- Job 6:27 Yes, you <u>overwhelm</u> the fatherless, And you undermine your friend.
- Job 12:15 If He withholds the waters, they dry up; If He sends them out, they overwhelm the earth.
- Daniel 11:10 However his sons shall stir up strife, and assemble a multitude of great forces; and *one* shall certainly come and <u>overwhelm</u> and pass through; then he shall return to his fortress and stir up strife.
- Daniel 11:40 At the time of the end the king of the South shall attack him; and the king of the North shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter the countries, overwhelm them, and pass through.
