Passed By

Then He said, "Go out, and stand on the mountain before the LORD." And behold, the LORD <u>passed by</u>, and a great and strong wind tore into the mountains and broke the rocks in pieces before the LORD, *but* the LORD *was* not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, *but* the LORD *was* not in the earthquake. 1 Kings 19:11

"And when I <u>passed by</u> you and saw you struggling in your own blood, I said to you in your blood, 'Live!' Yes, I said to you in your blood, 'Live!'"..."When I passed by you again and looked upon you, indeed your time *was* the time of love; so I spread My wing over you and covered your nakedness. Yes, I swore an oath to you and entered into a covenant with you, and you became Mine," says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 16:6, 8

Immanuel was with Elijah as He was with so many others. Elijah, here, was depressed to the point of giving up his commission and God passed by. Israel, the picture of object helplessness, was "laying in her blood" as an abandoned infant, and God passed by. Both of these examples, along with all of the bolded passages below, tell us that God is with us even in our weakest moments.

Passed By

- Genesis 37:28 Then Midianite traders <u>passed</u> by; so *the brothers* pulled Joseph up and lifted him out of the pit, and sold him to the Ishmaelites for twenty *shekels* of silver. And they took Joseph to Egypt.
- Deuteronomy 2:8 And when we passed beyond our brethren, the descendants of Esau who dwell in Seir, away from the road of the plain, away from Elath and Ezion Geber, we turned and <u>passed by</u> way of the Wilderness of Moab.
- Deuteronomy 29:16 For you know that we dwelt in the land of Egypt and that we came through the nations which you <u>passed by</u>.
- Joshua 16:6 And the border went out toward the sea on the north side of Michmethath; then the border went around eastward to Taanath Shiloh, and <u>passed by</u> it on the east of Janohah.
- Judges 9:25 And the men of Shechem set men in ambush against him on the tops of the mountains, and they robbed all who <u>passed by</u> them along that way; and it was told Abimelech.
- Judges 19:14 And they <u>passed by</u> and went their way; and the sun went down on them near Gibeah, which belongs to Benjamin.

- 1 Samuel 15:12 So when Samuel rose early in the morning to meet Saul, it was told Samuel, saying, "Saul went to Carmel, and indeed, he set up a monument for himself; and he has gone on around, <u>passed by</u>, and gone down to Gilgal."
- 1 Kings 13:25 And there, men <u>passed by</u> and saw the corpse thrown on the road, and the lion standing by the corpse. Then they went and told *it* in the city where the old prophet dwelt.
- 1 Kings 19:11 Then He said, "Go out, and stand on the mountain before the LORD." And behold, the LORD <u>passed by</u>, and a great and strong wind tore into the mountains and broke the rocks in pieces before the LORD, *but* the LORD *was* not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, *but* the LORD *was* not in the earthquake.
- 1 Kings 19:19 So he departed from there, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who *was* plowing *with* twelve yoke *of oxen* before him, and he was with the twelfth. Then Elijah <u>passed by</u> him and threw his mantle on him.
- 1 Kings 20:39 Now as the king <u>passed by</u>, he cried out to the king and said, "Your servant went out into the midst of the battle; and there, a man came over and brought a man to me, and said, 'Guard this man; if by any means he is missing, your life shall be for his life, or else you shall pay a talent of silver.'
- 2 Kings 4:8 Now it happened one day that Elisha went to Shunem, where there *was* a notable woman, and she persuaded him to eat some food. So it was, as often as he <u>passed by</u>, he would turn in there to eat some food.
- 2 Kings 6:30 Now it happened, when the king heard the words of the woman, that he tore his clothes; and as he <u>passed by</u> on the wall, the people looked, and there underneath *he had* sackcloth on his body.
- 2 Kings 14:9 And Jehoash king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah, saying, "The thistle that *was* in Lebanon sent to the cedar that *was* in Lebanon, saying, 'Give your daughter to my son as wife'; and a wild beast that *was* in Lebanon passed by and trampled the thistle.
- 2 Chronicles 25:18 And Joash king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah, saying, "The thistle that *was* in Lebanon sent to the cedar that was in Lebanon, saying, 'Give your daughter to my son as wife'; and a wild beast that *was* in Lebanon passed by and trampled the thistle.
- Psalms 48:4 For behold, the kings assembled, They passed by together.
- Psalms 57:1 To the Chief Musician. Set to "Do Not Destroy." A Michtam of David when he fled from Saul into the cave. Be merciful to me, O God, be merciful to me! For my soul trusts in You; And in the shadow of Your wings I will make my refuge, Until *these* calamities have <u>passed by</u>.
- Song of Solomon 3:4 Scarcely had I <u>passed by</u> them, When I found the one I love. I held him and would not let him go, Until I had brought him to the house of my mother, And into the chamber of her who conceived me.
- Jeremiah 46:17 They cried there, 'Pharaoh, king of Egypt, *is but* a noise. He has <u>passed by</u> the appointed time!'
- Ezekiel 16:6 And when I <u>passed by</u> you and saw you struggling in your own blood, I said to you in your blood, 'Live!' Yes, I said to you in your blood, 'Live!'

- Ezekiel 16:8 When I <u>passed by</u> you again and looked upon you, indeed your time *was* the time of love; so I spread My wing over you and covered your nakedness. Yes, I swore an oath to you and entered into a covenant with you, and you became Mine," says the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 16:25 You built your high places at the head of every road, and made your beauty to be abhorred. You offered yourself to everyone who <u>passed by</u>, and multiplied your acts of harlotry.
- Habakkuk 3:10 The mountains saw You *and* trembled; The overflowing of the water <u>passed by</u>. The deep uttered its voice, *And* lifted its hands on high.
- Matthew 27:39 And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads

Mark 2:14 As He <u>passed by</u>, He saw Levi the *son* of Alphaeus sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "Follow Me." So he arose and followed Him.

- Mark 11:20 Now in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.
- Mark 15:29 And those who <u>passed by</u> blasphemed Him, wagging their heads and saying, "Aha! *You* who destroy the temple and build *it* in three days.
- Luke 10:31 Now by chance a certain priest came down that road. And when he saw him, he <u>passed by</u> on the other side.
- Luke 10:32 Likewise a Levite, when he arrived at the place, came and looked, and <u>passed by</u> on the other side.
- John 8:59 Then they took up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so <u>passed by</u>.
- John 9:1 Now as Jesus passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth.

Passed Through

- Genesis 12:6 Abram <u>passed through</u> the land to the place of Shechem, as far as the terebinth tree of Moreh. And the Canaanites *were* then in the land.
- Numbers 14:7 and they spoke to all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying: "The land we <u>passed</u> <u>through</u> to spy out *is* an exceedingly good land.
- Numbers 20:17 'Please let us pass through your country. We will not pass through fields or vineyards, nor will we drink water from wells; we will go along the King's Highway; we will not turn aside to the right hand or to the left until we have passed through your territory.'
- Numbers 21:22 Let me pass through your land. We will not turn aside into fields or vineyards; we will not drink water from wells. We will go by the King's Highway until we have passed through your territory.
- Numbers 33:8 They departed from before Hahiroth and <u>passed through</u> the midst of the sea into the wilderness, went three days' journey in the Wilderness of Etham, and camped at Marah.
- Joshua 18:9 So the men went, <u>passed through</u> the land, and wrote the survey in a book in seven parts by cities; and they came to Joshua at the camp in Shiloh.

- Jeremiah 34:18 'And I will give the men who have transgressed My covenant, who have not performed the words of the covenant which they made before Me, when they cut the calf in two and <u>passed between</u> the parts of it—
- Jeremiah 34:19 'the princes of Judah, the princes of Jerusalem, the eunuchs, the priests, and all the people of the land who <u>passed between</u> the parts of the calf—

Passed Over

Exodus 12:27 That you shall say, 'It *is* the Passover sacrifice of the LORD, who <u>passed</u> <u>over</u> the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt when He struck the Egyptians and delivered our households.'" So the people bowed their heads and worshiped.

Job 28:8 The proud lions have not trodden it, Nor has the fierce lion passed over it.

- Isaiah 40:27 Why do you say, O Jacob, And speak, O Israel: "My way is hidden from the LORD, And my just claim is <u>passed over</u> by my God"?
- Jonah 2:3 For You cast me into the deep, Into the heart of the seas, And the floods surrounded me; All Your billows and Your waves <u>passed over</u> me.
- Romans 3:25 Whom God set forth *as* a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had <u>passed over</u> the sins that were previously committed.

Passed Before

- Exodus 34:6 And the LORD <u>passed before</u> him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth,
- 2 Samuel 15:18 Then all his servants <u>passed before</u> him; and all the Cherethites, all the Pelethites, and all the Gittites, six hundred men who had followed him from Gath, <u>passed before</u> the king.
- Job 4:15 Then a spirit passed before my face; The hair on my body stood up.

Passed Away

- Job 11:16 Because you would forget your misery, And remember it as waters that have passed away.
- Psalms 37:36 Yet he <u>passed away</u>, and behold, he *was* no *more*; Indeed I sought him, but he could not be found.
- Psalms 90:9 For all our days have passed away in Your wrath; We finish our years like a sigh.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have <u>passed away</u>; behold, all things have become new.
- Revelation 21:1 Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had <u>passed</u> <u>away</u>. Also there was no more sea.

Passed Along

- Joshua 15:3 Then it went out to the southern side of the Ascent of Akrabbim, <u>passed along</u> to Zin, ascended on the south side of Kadesh Barnea, <u>passed along</u> to Hezron, went up to Adar, and went around to Karkaa.
- Joshua 15:10 Then the border turned westward from Baalah to Mount Seir, <u>passed along</u> to the side of Mount Jearim on the north (which *is* Chesalon), went down to Beth Shemesh, and passed on to Timnah.
- Joshua 15:11 And the border went out to the side of Ekron northward. Then the border went around to Shicron, passed along to Mount Baalah, and extended to Jabneel; and the border ended at the sea.
- Joshua 16:2 then went out from Bethel to Luz, passed along to the border of the Archites at Ataroth,
- Joshua 18:18 Then it passed along toward the north side of Arabah, and went down to Arabah.

Passed From

- Joshua 10:29 Then Joshua <u>passed from</u> Makkedah, and all Israel with him, to Libnah; and they fought against Libnah.
- Joshua 10:31 Then Joshua <u>passed from</u> Libnah, and all Israel with him, to Lachish; and they encamped against it and fought against it.
- Judges 18:13 And they passed from there to the mountains of Ephraim, and came to the house of Micah.
- 2 Chronicles 30:10 So the runners <u>passed from</u> city to city through the country of Ephraim and Manasseh, as far as Zebulun; but they laughed at them and mocked them.
- Jeremiah 11:15 What has My beloved to do in My house, Having done lewd deeds with many? And the holy flesh has <u>passed from</u> you. When you do evil, then you rejoice.

Passed

Passing Away

- 2 Corinthians 3:7 But if the ministry of death, written *and* engraved on stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of the glory of his countenance, which *glory* was passing away.
- 2 Corinthians 3:11 For if what is passing away was glorious, what remains is much more glorious.
- 2 Corinthians 3:13 Unlike Moses, *who* put a veil over his face so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the end of what was <u>passing away</u>.

Passing By

- 2 Kings 6:26 Then, as the king of Israel was <u>passing by</u> on the wall, a woman cried out to him, saying, "Help, my lord, O king!"
- Ezekiel 16:15 But you trusted in your own beauty, played the harlot because of your fame, and poured out your harlotry on everyone passing by who *would have* it.

Pass By

- Exodus 33:22 "So it shall be, while My glory passes by, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by.
- 1 Samuel 16:9 Then Jesse made Shammah pass by. And he said, "Neither has the LORD chosen this one."
- Job 9:26 They pass by like swift ships, Like an eagle swooping on its prey.
- Psalms 80:12 Why have You broken down her hedges, So that all who pass by the way pluck her fruit?
- Psalms 89:41 All who pass by the way plunder him; He is a reproach to his neighbors.
- Psalms 129:8 Neither let those who pass by them say, "The blessing of the LORD *be* upon you; We bless you in the name of the LORD!"

- Amos 8:2 And He said, "Amos, what do you see?" So I said, "A basket of summer fruit." Then the LORD said to me: "The end has come upon My people Israel; I will not <u>pass by</u> them anymore."
- Micah 1:11 Pass by in naked shame, you inhabitant of Shaphir; The inhabitant of Zaanan does not go out. Beth Ezel mourns; Its place to stand is taken away from you.
- Micah 2:8 Lately My people have risen up as an enemy—You pull off the robe with the garment From those who trust *you*, as they <u>pass by</u>, Like men returned from war.
- Luke 11:42 But woe to you Pharisees! For you tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and <u>pass by</u> justice and the love of God. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.
- 2 Corinthians 1:16 To pass by way of you to Macedonia, to come again from Macedonia to you, and be helped by you on my way to Judea.

Passes By

- Exodus 33:22 So it shall be, while My glory <u>passes</u> by, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by.
- 1 Kings 9:8 And *as for* this house, *which* is exalted, everyone who <u>passes by</u> it will be astonished and will hiss, and say, 'Why has the LORD done thus to this land and to this house?'
- 2 Kings 4:9 And she said to her husband, "Look now, I know that this *is* a holy man of God, who <u>passes by</u> us regularly."
- 2 Chronicles 7:21 And *as for* this house, which is exalted, everyone who <u>passes by</u> it will be astonished and say, 'Why has the LORD done thus to this land and this house?'

Job 11:10 If He passes by, imprisons, and gathers to judgment, Then who can hinder Him?

Proverbs 10:25 When the whirlwind passes by, the wicked *is* no *more*, But the righteous *has* an everlasting foundation.

- Proverbs 26:17 He who passes by and meddles in a quarrel not his own Is like one who takes a dog by the ears.
- Jeremiah 18:16 To make their land desolate *and* a perpetual hissing; Everyone who <u>passes</u> by it will be astonished And shake his head.
- Jeremiah 19:8 I will make this city desolate and a hissing; everyone who <u>passes by</u> it will be astonished and hiss because of all its plagues.
- Zephaniah 2:15 This is the rejoicing city That dwelt securely, That said in her heart, "I *am it*, and *there is* none besides me." How has she become a desolation, A place for beasts to lie down! Everyone who <u>passes by</u> her Shall hiss and shake his fist.
- Zechariah 9:8 I will camp around My house Because of the army, Because of him who passes by and him who returns. No more shall an oppressor pass through them, For now I have seen with My eyes.
