Perfect Lord

- Deuteronomy 32:4 *He is* the Rock, His work *is* perfect; For all His ways *are* justice, A God of truth and without injustice; Righteous and upright *is* He.
- 2 Samuel 22:31 As for God, His way is perfect; The word of the LORD is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him.
- Job 36:4 For truly my words are not false; One who is perfect in knowledge is with you.
- Job 37:16 Do you know how the clouds are balanced, Those wondrous works of Him who is <u>perfect</u> in knowledge?
- Matthew 5:48 Therefore you shall be <u>perfect</u>, just as your Father in heaven is <u>perfect</u>.
- Ephesians 4:13 Till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a <u>perfect</u> man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.
- Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom *are* all things and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation <u>perfect</u> through sufferings.

Perfect Human

- Genesis 6:9 This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, <u>perfect</u> in his generations. Noah walked with God.
- Song of Solomon 5:2 THE SHULAMITE I sleep, but my heart is awake; *It is* the voice of my beloved! He knocks, *saying*, "Open for me, my sister, my love, My dove, my <u>perfect</u> one; For my head is covered with dew, My locks with the drops of the night."
- Song of Solomon 6:9 My dove, my <u>perfect</u> one, Is the only one, The only one of her mother, The favorite of the one who bore her. The daughters saw her And called her blessed, The queens and the concubines, And they praised her.

- Isaiah 42:19 Who *is* blind but My servant, Or deaf as My messenger *whom* I send? Who *is* blind as *he who is* perfect, And blind as the LORD'S servant?
- Matthew 19:21 Jesus said to him, "If you want to be <u>perfect</u>, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me."
- John 17:23 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made <u>perfect</u> in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.
- Colossians 4:12 Epaphras, who is *one* of you, a bondservant of Christ, greets you, always laboring fervently for you in prayers, that you may stand <u>perfect</u> and complete in all the will of God.
- James 1:4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.
- James 3:2 For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in word, he *is* a <u>perfect</u> man, able also to bridle the whole body.
- Hebrews 12:23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn *who are* registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made <u>perfect</u>,

Perfect Sacrifice/Gift

- Leviticus 22:21 'And whoever offers a <u>sacrifice</u> of a peace offering to the LORD, to fulfill *his* vow, or a freewill offering from the cattle or the sheep, it must be <u>perfect</u> to be accepted; there shall be no defect in it.
- James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.
- Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom *are* all things and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.
- Hebrews 9:9 It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience—

Perfect Way

- 2 Samuel 22:33 God is my strength and power, And He makes my way perfect.
- Psalms 18:30 As for God, His way is perfect; The word of the LORD is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him.
- Psalms 18:32 It is God who arms me with strength, And makes my way perfect.
- Psalms 101:2 I will behave wisely in a <u>perfect</u> way. Oh, when will You come to me? I will walk within my house with a <u>perfect</u> heart.
- Psalms 101:6 My eyes *shall be* on the faithful of the land, That they may dwell with me; He who walks in a <u>perfect</u> way, He shall serve me.

Ezekiel 28:15 You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, Till iniquity was found in you.

Colossians 1:28 Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man <u>perfect</u> in Christ Jesus.

Perfect Law

Psalms 19:7 The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.

James 1:25 But he who looks into the <u>perfect</u> law of liberty and continues *in it*, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.

Perfect Peace

Ezra 7:12 Artaxerxes, king of kings, To Ezra the priest, a scribe of the Law of the God of heaven: <u>Perfect</u> *peace*, and so forth.

Isaiah 26:3 You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.

Perfect Beauty

Ezekiel 16:14 "Your fame went out among the nations because of your beauty, for it *was* <u>perfect</u> through My splendor which I had bestowed on you," says the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 27:3 And say to Tyre, 'You who are situated at the entrance of the sea, merchant of the peoples on many coastlands, thus says the Lord GOD: "O Tyre, you have said, 'I *am* <u>perfect</u> in beauty.'

Ezekiel 27:11 Men of Arvad with your army were on your walls all around, And the men of Gammad were in your towers; They hung their shields on your walls all around; They made your beauty perfect.

Ezekiel 28:12 Son of man, take up a lamentation for the king of Tyre, and say to him, "Thus says the Lord GOD: "You were the seal of perfection, Full of wisdom and perfect in beauty."

Perfect Love/Hate

Psalms 139:22 I hate them with <u>perfect</u> hatred; I count them my enemies.

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but <u>perfect</u> love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made <u>perfect</u> in love.

Perfect (v.)

- Psalms 138:8 The LORD will <u>perfect</u> that which concerns me; Your mercy, O LORD, endures forever; Do not forsake the works of Your hands.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:10 Night and day praying exceedingly that we may see your face and <u>perfect</u> what is lacking in your faith?
- 1 Peter 5:10 But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, <u>perfect</u>, establish, strengthen, and settle *you*.

Made Perfect

- Hebrews 11:40 God having provided something better for us, that they should not be <u>made perfect</u> apart from us.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is <u>made perfect</u> in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Galatians 3:3 Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?
- James 2:22 Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect?
- Hebrews 7:19 For the law <u>made</u> nothing <u>perfect</u>; on the other hand, *there is the* bringing in of a better hope, through which we draw near to God.

Make Perfect

- Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom *are* all things and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to <u>make</u> the captain of their salvation <u>perfect</u> through sufferings.
- Hebrews 9:9 It *was* symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience—
- Hebrews 10:1 For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, <u>make</u> those who approach <u>perfect</u>.

Perfect Works

Revelation 3:2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works <u>perfect</u> before God.

Perfect

Deuteronomy 25:15 You shall have a <u>perfect</u> and just weight, a <u>perfect</u> and just measure, that your days may be lengthened in the land which the LORD your God is giving you.

- 1 Samuel 14:41 Therefore Saul said to the LORD God of Israel, "Give a <u>perfect</u> *lot*." So Saul and Jonathan were taken, but the people escaped.
- Proverbs 4:18 But the path of the just is like the shining sun, That shines ever brighter unto the perfect day.
- Isaiah 18:5 For before the harvest, when the bud is <u>perfect</u> And the sour grape is ripening in the flower, He will both cut off the sprigs with pruning hooks And take away *and* cut down the branches.
- Luke 1:3 It seemed good to me also, having had <u>perfect</u> understanding of all things from the very first, to write to you an orderly account, most excellent Theophilus,
- Acts 3:16 And His name, through faith in His name, has made this man strong, whom you see and know. Yes, the faith which *comes* through Him has given him this <u>perfect</u> soundness in the presence of you all.
- Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and <u>perfect</u> will of God.
- 1 Corinthians 13:10 But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away.

More Perfect

Hebrews 9:11 But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.

Perfectly

- 1 Kings 7:35 On the top of the cart, at the height of half a cubit, *it was* <u>perfectly</u> round. And on the top of the cart, its flanges and its panels *were* of the same casting.
- Jeremiah 23:20 The anger of the LORD will not turn back Until He has executed and performed the thoughts of His heart. In the latter days you will understand it <u>perfectly</u>.
- Matthew 14:36 and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched *it* were made perfectly well.
- Luke 6:40 "A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher.
- 1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and *that* there be no divisions among you, but *that* you be <u>perfectly</u> joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:2 For you yourselves know <u>perfectly</u> that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.

Perfected

- Psalms 64:6 They devise iniquities: "We have <u>perfected</u> a shrewd scheme." Both the inward thought and the heart of man are deep.
- Ezekiel 27:4 Your borders are in the midst of the seas. Your builders have perfected your beauty.
- Matthew 21:16 And said to Him, "Do You hear what these are saying?" And Jesus said to them, "Yes. Have you never read, 'Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have <u>perfected</u> praise'?"
- Luke 13:32 And He said to them, "Go, tell that fox, Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and the third *day* I shall be <u>perfected</u>.'
- Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already attained, or am already <u>perfected</u>; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.
- Hebrews 5:9 And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him.
- Hebrews 7:28 For the law appoints as high priests men who have weakness, but the word of the oath, which came after the law, *appoints* the Son who has been <u>perfected</u> forever.
- Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.
- 1 John 2:5 But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is <u>perfected</u> in him. By this we know that we are in Him.
- 1 John 4:12 No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been <u>perfected</u> in us.
- 1 John 4:17 Love has been <u>perfected</u> among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.

Perfection

- Psalms 50:2 Out of Zion, the <u>perfection</u> of beauty, God will shine forth.
- Psalms 119:96 I have seen the consummation of all <u>perfection</u>, *But* Your commandment *is* exceedingly broad.
- Lamentations 2:15 All who pass by clap *their* hands at you; They hiss and shake their heads At the daughter of Jerusalem: "Is this the city that is called 'The <u>perfection</u> of beauty, The joy of the whole earth'?"
- Ezekiel 28:12 "Son of man, take up a lamentation for the king of Tyre, and say to him, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "You were the seal of perfection, Full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.
- Colossians 3:14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.
- Hebrews 6:1 Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary *principles* of Christ, let us go on to <u>perfection</u>, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God.
- Hebrews 7:11 Therefore, if <u>perfection</u> were through the Levitical priesthood (for under it the people received the law), what further need *was there* that another priest should rise according to the order of Melchizedek, and not be called according to the order of Aaron?
