Pride

In that day you shall not be shamed for any of your deeds In which you transgress against Me; For then I will take away from your midst Those who rejoice in your pride, And you shall no longer be haughty In My holy mountain. Zephaniah 3:11

Pride seems to intersect with Immanuel Prayer at two points. The first (as Receivers) is our own resistance to present ourselves to Immanuel for His help. We want to heal ourselves by ourselves or deny our problems or deny that there are solutions. The second (as Coaches) is our reluctance to let Jesus drive. Many of us have learned our own brand of ministry and want to be the "main man." If we continue to seek the Lord and allow Him to take His rightful place in our sessions, our boast becomes in Him alone. Only Immanuel can rid us of our pride in order to bless us.

Pride

- Leviticus 26:19 I will break the <u>pride</u> of your power; I will make your heavens like iron and your earth like bronze.

- James 4:6 But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the <u>proud</u>, But gives grace to the humble."

Boast

- 1 Kings 20:11 So the king of Israel answered and said, "Tell him, 'Let not the one who puts on his armor boast like the one who takes it off."
- 2 Chronicles 25:19 "Indeed you say that you have defeated the Edomites, and your heart is lifted up to <u>boast</u>. Stay at home now; why should you meddle with trouble, that you should fall—you and Judah with you?"
- Psalms 49:6 Those who trust in their wealth And boast in the multitude of their riches.
- Psalms 52:1 To the Chief Musician. A Contemplation of David when Doeg the Edomite went and told Saul, and said to him, "David has gone to the house of Ahimelech." Why do you <u>boast</u> in evil, O mighty man? The goodness of God *endures* continually.
- Psalms 90:10 The days of our lives *are* seventy years; And if by reason of strength *they are* eighty years, Yet their <u>boast</u> *is* only labor and sorrow; For it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

- 2 Corinthians 1:14 (As also you have understood us in part), that we are your <u>boast</u> as you also *are* ours, in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- 2 Corinthians 5:12 For we do not commend ourselves again to you, but give you opportunity to <u>boast</u> on our behalf, that you may have *an answer* for those who <u>boast</u> in appearance and not in heart.
- 2 Corinthians 9:2 For I know your willingness, about which I <u>boast</u> of you to the Macedonians, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal has stirred up the majority.
- 2 Corinthians 10:8 For even if I should <u>boast</u> somewhat more about our authority, which the Lord gave us for edification and not for your destruction, I shall not be ashamed—
- 2 Corinthians 10:13 We, however, will not <u>boast</u> beyond measure, but within the limits of the sphere which God appointed us—a sphere which especially includes you.
- 2 Corinthians 10:16 To preach the gospel in the *regions* beyond you, *and* not to <u>boast</u> in another man's sphere of accomplishment.
- 2 Corinthians 11:12 But what I do, I will also continue to do, that I may cut off the opportunity from those who desire an opportunity to be regarded just as we are in the things of which they <u>boast</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 11:16 I say again, let no one think me a fool. If otherwise, at least receive me as a fool, that I also may boast a little.
- 2 Corinthians 11:18 Seeing that many boast according to the flesh, I also will boast.
- 2 Corinthians 11:30 If I must boast, I will boast in the things which concern my infirmity.
- 2 Corinthians 12:1 It is doubtless not profitable for me to <u>boast</u>. I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 12:5 Of such a one I will boast; yet of myself I will not boast, except in my infirmities.
- 2 Corinthians 12:6 For though I might desire to <u>boast</u>, I will not be a fool; for I will speak the truth. But I refrain, lest anyone should think of me above what he sees me *to be* or hears from me.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather <u>boast</u> in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Galatians 6:13 For not even those who are circumcised keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may <u>boast</u> in your flesh.
- Ephesians 2:9 Not of works, lest anyone should boast.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:4 So that we ourselves <u>boast</u> of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure.
- James 3:14 But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth.
- James 4:16 But now you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil.

Boast In The Lord

Psalms 34:2 My soul shall make its boast in the LORD; The humble shall hear of it and be glad.

Psalms 44:8 In God we boast all day long, And praise Your name forever. Selah

Romans 2:17 Indeed you are called a Jew, and rest on the law, and make your boast in God.

Galatians 6:14 But God forbid that I should <u>boast</u> except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Boasts

Psalms 10:3 For the wicked boasts of his heart's desire; He blesses the greedy and renounces the LORD.

Proverbs 20:14 "It is good for nothing," cries the buyer; But when he has gone his way, then he boasts.

Proverbs 25:14 Whoever falsely boasts of giving Is like clouds and wind without rain.

James 3:5 Even so the tongue is a little member and <u>boasts</u> great things. See how great a forest a little fire kindles!

Boasted

Ezekiel 35:13 Thus with your mouth you have <u>boasted</u> against Me and multiplied your words against Me; I have heard *them*.

2 Corinthians 7:14 For if in anything I have <u>boasted</u> to him about you, I am not ashamed. But as we spoke all things to you in truth, even so our boasting to Titus was found true.

Boastful

Psalms 5:5 The boastful shall not stand in Your sight; You hate all workers of iniquity.

Psalms 73:3 For I was envious of the boastful, When I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

Psalms 75:4 I said to the boastful, 'Do not deal boastfully,' And to the wicked, 'Do not lift up the horn.

Boasting

Romans 3:27 Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No, but by the law of faith.

1 Corinthians 9:15 But I have used none of these things, nor have I written these things that it should be done so to me; for it *would be* better for me to die than that anyone should make my <u>boasting</u> void.

1 Corinthians 15:31 I affirm, by the boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily.

- 2 Corinthians 1:12 For our <u>boasting</u> is this: the testimony of our conscience that we conducted ourselves in the world in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom but by the grace of God, and more abundantly toward you.
- 2 Corinthians 7:4 Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my boasting on your behalf. I am filled with comfort. I am exceedingly joyful in all our tribulation.
- 2 Corinthians 7:14 For if in anything I have boasted to him about you, I am not ashamed. But as we spoke all things to you in truth, even so our <u>boasting</u> to Titus was found true.
- 2 Corinthians 8:24 Therefore show to them, and before the churches the proof of your love and of our boasting on your behalf.
- 2 Corinthians 9:3 Yet I have sent the brethren, lest our <u>boasting</u> of you should be in vain in this respect, that, as I said, you may be ready.
- 2 Corinthians 9:4 Lest if *some* Macedonians come with me and find you unprepared, we (not to mention you!) should be ashamed of this confident <u>boasting</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 10:15 Not boasting of things beyond measure, *that is*, in other men's labors, but having hope, *that* as your faith is increased, we shall be greatly enlarged by you in our sphere.
- 2 Corinthians 11:10 As the truth of Christ is in me, no one shall stop me from this <u>boasting</u> in the regions of Achaia.
- 2 Corinthians 11:17 What I speak, I speak not according to the Lord, but as it were, foolishly, in this confidence of boasting.
- 2 Corinthians 12:11 I have become a fool in <u>boasting</u>; you have compelled me. For I ought to have been commended by you; for in nothing was I behind the most eminent apostles, though I am nothing.
- James 4:16 But now you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil.

Lofty -

- Psalms 131:1 A Song of Ascents. Of David. LORD, my heart is not haughty, Nor my eyes <u>lofty</u>. Neither do I concern myself with great matters, Nor with things too profound for me.
- Proverbs 30:13 There is a generation—oh, how <u>lofty</u> are their eyes! And their eyelids are lifted up.
- Isaiah 2:11 The <u>lofty</u> looks of man shall be humbled, The haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, And the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.
- Isaiah 2:12 For the day of the LORD of hosts *Shall come* upon everything proud and <u>lofty</u>, Upon everything lifted up—And it shall be brought low—
- Isaiah 5:15 People shall be brought down, Each man shall be humbled, And the eyes of the <u>lofty</u> shall be humbled.

Isaiah 26:5 For He brings down those who dwell on high, The <u>lofty</u> city; He lays it low, He lays it low to the ground, He brings it down to the dust.

Isaiah 57:7 On a <u>lofty</u> and high mountain you [idolatrous Israel] have set your bed; Even there you went up To offer sacrifice.

Biblical Examples of Pride

Nebuchadnezzar:

Daniel 4:30 The king spoke, saying, "Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for a royal dwelling by my mighty power and for the honor of my majesty?"

Daniel 4:34 And at the end of the time I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my understanding returned to me; and I blessed the Most High and praised and honored Him who lives forever: For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His kingdom is from generation to generation.

Daniel 4:37 Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all of whose works *are* truth, and His ways justice. And those who walk in pride He is able to put down.

Herod:

Acts 12:21-22 So on a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat on his throne and gave an oration to them. And the people kept shouting, "The voice of a god and not of a man!"

Acts 12:23 Then immediately an angel of the Lord struck him, because he did not give glory to God. And he was eaten by worms and died.
