

Remember Not

*Thus the children of Israel did **not remember** the LORD their God, who had delivered them from the hands of all their enemies on every side. Judges 8:34*

*Do **not remember** the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions; According to Your mercy remember me, For Your goodness' sake, O LORD. Psalms 25:7*

Often we do not remember good things. We need to be intentional to not forget them. It seems so easy to not remember that Immanuel, God is with us, always was with us, and always will be with us. We forget His presence, His kindnesses, His wonderful works toward us. We simply forget Him so often. Abiding with Him can be so far away in our busy lives or sometimes angry/sad world view. On the other hand, God remembers everything. Thankfully, He puts our sins under the blood of Jesus and does not deal with us on our own merit if we too are washed in that same blood. Those things He chooses to "remember" no more.

Not Remember God

Judges 8:34 Thus the children of Israel did **not remember** the LORD their God, who had delivered them from the hands of all their enemies on every side.

Psalms 78:42 They did **not remember** His power: The day when He redeemed them from the enemy.

Psalms 106:7 Our fathers in Egypt did not understand Your wonders; They did **not remember** the multitude of Your mercies, But rebelled by the sea—the Red Sea.

God Not Remembered

Isaiah 57:11 And of whom have you been afraid, or feared, That you have lied And not **remembered** Me,
Nor taken *it* to your heart? Is it not because I have held My peace from of old That you do not fear Me?

Not Remember

Genesis 40:23 Yet the chief butler did **not remember** Joseph, but forgot him.

2 Chronicles 24:22 Thus Joash the king did not remember the kindness which Jehoiada his father had done to him, but killed his son; and as he died, he said, "The LORD look on *it*, and repay!"

Psalms 109:16 Because he did not remember to show mercy, But persecuted the poor and needy man, That he might even slay the broken in heart.

Psalms 137:6 If I do not remember you, Let my tongue cling to the roof of my mouth—If I do not exalt Jerusalem Above my chief joy.

Isaiah 43:18 Do not remember the former things, Nor consider the things of old.

Isaiah 54:4 Do not fear, for you will not be ashamed; Neither be disgraced, for you will not be put to shame; For you will forget the shame of your youth, And will not remember the reproach of your widowhood anymore.

Ezekiel 16:22 And in all your abominations and acts of harlotry you did not remember the days of your youth, when you were naked and bare, struggling in your blood.

Ezekiel 16:43 "Because you did not remember the days of your youth, but agitated Me with all these *things*, surely I will also recompense your deeds on *your own* head," says the Lord GOD. "And you shall not commit lewdness in addition to all your abominations".

Amos 1:9 Thus says the LORD: "For three transgressions of Tyre, and for four, I will not turn away its *punishment*, Because they delivered up the whole captivity to Edom, And did not remember the covenant of brotherhood."

Matthew 16:9 Do you not yet understand, or remember the five loaves of the five thousand and how many baskets you took up?

Mark 8:18 Having eyes, do you not see? And having ears, do you not hear? And do you not remember?

2 Thessalonians 2:5 Do you not remember that when I was still with you I told you these things?

God Does Not Remember (Remembers With Mercy)

Psalms 25:7 Do not remember the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions; According to Your mercy remember me, For Your goodness' sake, O LORD.

Psalms 79:8 Oh, do not remember former iniquities against us! Let Your tender mercies come speedily to meet us, For we have been brought very low.

Isaiah 43:25 I, *even I, am* He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; And I will not remember your sins.

Lamentations 2:1 How the Lord has covered the daughter of Zion With a cloud in His anger! He cast down from heaven to the earth The beauty of Israel, And did not remember His footstool In the day of His anger.

Ezekiel 18:22 None of the transgressions which he has committed shall be remembered against him; because of the righteousness which he has done, he shall live.

Ezekiel 33:16 None of his sins which he has committed shall be remembered against him; he has done what is lawful and right; he shall surely live.

God Remembers In Judgment

Ezekiel 18:24 But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked *man* does, shall he live? All the righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; because of the unfaithfulness of which he is guilty and the sin which he has committed, because of them he shall die.

Ezekiel 21:24 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: 'Because you have made your iniquity to be remembered, in that your transgressions are uncovered, so that in all your doings your sins appear—because you have come to remembrance, you shall be taken in hand.

Ezekiel 33:13 When I say to the righteous *that* he shall surely live, but he trusts in his own righteousness and commits iniquity, none of his righteous works shall be remembered; but because of the iniquity that he has committed, he shall die.

Remember No More

Psalms 88:5 Adrift among the dead, Like the slain who lie in the grave, Whom You remember no more, And who are cut off from Your hand.

Jeremiah 31:34 "No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

Hebrews 8:12 "For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."

Hebrews 10:17 *then He adds*, "Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."

Remembered No More

Ecclesiastes 9:15 Now there was found in it a poor wise man, and he by his wisdom delivered the city. Yet no one remembered that same poor man.

Isaiah 23:16 Take a harp, go about the city, You forgotten harlot; Make sweet melody, sing many songs, That you may be remembered.

Isaiah 65:17 For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.

Jeremiah 11:19 But I *was* like a docile lamb brought to the slaughter; and I did not know that they had devised schemes against me, *saying*, "Let us destroy the tree with its fruit, and let us cut him off from the land of the living, that his name may be remembered no more."

Ezekiel 21:32 You shall be fuel for the fire; Your blood shall be in the midst of the land. You shall not be remembered, For I the LORD have spoken.

Ezekiel 25:10 To the men of the East I will give it as a possession, together with the Ammonites, that the Ammonites may not be remembered among the nations.

Hosea 2:17 For I will take from her mouth the names of the Baals, And they shall be remembered by their name no more.

Forget God

Deuteronomy 6:12 *Then* beware, lest you forget the LORD who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

Job 8:13 So *are* the paths of all who forget God; And the hope of the hypocrite shall perish.

Psalms 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, *And* all the nations that forget God.

Psalms 50:22 Now consider this, you who forget God, Lest I tear *you* in pieces, And *there be* none to deliver:

Isaiah 51:13 And you forget the LORD your Maker, Who stretched out the heavens And laid the foundations of the earth; You have feared continually every day Because of the fury of the oppressor, When *he has* prepared to destroy. And where *is* the fury of the oppressor?

Isaiah 65:11 But you *are* those who forsake the LORD, Who forget My holy mountain, Who prepare a table for Gad, And who furnish a drink offering for Meni.

Jeremiah 2:32 Can a virgin forget her ornaments, Or a bride her attire? Yet My people have forgotten Me days without number.

Forget

Genesis 41:51 Joseph called the name of the firstborn Manasseh: "For God has made me forget all my toil and all my father's house."

Deuteronomy 4:9 Only take heed to yourself, and diligently keep yourself, lest you forget the things your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. And teach them to your children and your grandchildren.

Deuteronomy 8:11 Beware that you do not forget the LORD your God by not keeping His commandments, His judgments, and His statutes which I command you today.

Deuteronomy 8:14 When your heart is lifted up, and you forget the LORD your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

Deuteronomy 8:19 Then it shall be, if you by any means [forget](#) the LORD your God, and follow other gods, and serve them and worship them, I testify against you this day that you shall surely perish.

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember! Do not [forget](#) how you provoked the LORD your God to wrath in the wilderness. From the day that you departed from the land of Egypt until you came to this place, you have been rebellious against the LORD.

Deuteronomy 24:19 When you reap your harvest in your field, and [forget](#) a sheaf in the field, you shall not go back to get it; it shall be for the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands.

Deuteronomy 25:19 Therefore it shall be, when the LORD your God has given you rest from your enemies all around, in the land which the LORD your God is giving you to possess *as* an inheritance, *that* you will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven. You shall not [forget](#).

2 Kings 17:38 And the covenant that I have made with you, you shall not [forget](#), nor shall you fear other gods.

Job 9:27 If I say, 'I will [forget](#) my complaint, I will put off my sad face and wear a smile.'

Job 11:16 Because you would [forget](#) *your* misery, And remember *it* as waters *that have* passed away,

Job 24:20 The womb *should* [forget](#) him, The worm *should* feed sweetly on him; He *should* be remembered no more, And wickedness *should* be broken like a tree.

Psalms 45:10 Listen, O daughter, Consider and incline your ear; [Forget](#) your own people also, and your father's house.

Psalms 59:11 Do not slay them, lest my people [forget](#); Scatter them by Your power, And bring them down, O Lord our shield.

Psalms 102:4 My heart is stricken and withered like grass, So that I [forget](#) to eat my bread.

Psalms 103:2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, And [forget](#) not all His benefits:

Psalms 137:5 If I [forget](#) you, O Jerusalem, Let my right hand [forget](#) *its skill*

Proverbs 31:7 Let him drink and [forget](#) his poverty, And remember his misery no more.

Isaiah 54:4 Do not fear, for you will not be ashamed; Neither be disgraced, for you will not be put to shame; For you will [forget](#) the shame of your youth, And will not remember the reproach of your widowhood anymore.

Hebrews 13:2 Do not [forget](#) to entertain strangers, for by so *doing* some have unwittingly entertained angels.

Hebrews 13:16 But do not [forget](#) to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

2 Peter 3:5 For this they willfully [forget](#): that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water.

2 Peter 3:8 But, beloved, do not [forget](#) this one thing, that with the Lord one day *is* as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

Do Not Forget Your Law

Deuteronomy 4:23 Take heed to yourselves, lest you [forget](#) the covenant of the LORD your God which He made with you, and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of anything which the LORD your God has forbidden you.

Psalms 78:7 That they may set their hope in God, And not [forget](#) the works of God, But keep His commandments.

Psalms 119:16 I will delight myself in Your statutes; I will not [forget](#) Your word.

Psalms 119:83 For I have become like a wineskin in smoke, *Yet* I do not [forget](#) Your statutes.

Psalms 119:93 I will never [forget](#) Your precepts, For by them You have given me life.

Psalms 119:109 My life *is* continually in my hand, Yet I do not [forget](#) Your law.

Psalms 119:141 I *am* small and despised, *Yet* I do not [forget](#) Your precepts.

Psalms 119:153 RESH. Consider my affliction and deliver me, For I do not [forget](#) Your law.

Psalms 119:176 I have gone astray like a lost sheep; Seek Your servant, For I do not [forget](#) Your commandments.

Proverbs 3:1 My son, do not [forget](#) my law, But let your heart keep my commands;

Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom! Get understanding! Do not [forget](#), nor turn away from the words of my mouth.

Proverbs 31:5 Lest they drink and [forget](#) the law, And pervert the justice of all the afflicted.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will [forget](#) your children.

Forgot God

Judges 3:7 So the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD. They [forgot](#) the LORD their God, and served the Baals and Asherahs.

1 Samuel 12:9 And when they [forgot](#) the LORD their God, He sold them into the hand of Sisera, commander of the army of Hazor, into the hand of the Philistines, and into the hand of the king of Moab; and they fought against them.

Psalms 78:11 And [forgot](#) His works And His wonders that He had shown them.

Psalms 106:13 They soon [forgot](#) His works; They did not wait for His counsel,

Psalms 106:21 They [forgot](#) God their Savior, Who had done great things in Egypt,

Jeremiah 23:27 Who try to make My people forget My name by their dreams which everyone tells his neighbor, as their fathers [forgot](#) My name for Baal.

Hosea 2:13 I will punish her For the days of the Baals to which she burned incense. She decked herself with her earrings and jewelry, And went after her lovers; But Me she forgot," says the LORD.

Hosea 13:6 When they had pasture, they were filled; They were filled and their heart was exalted; Therefore they forgot Me.

Forgotten God

Deuteronomy 32:18 Of the Rock *who* begot you, you are unmindful, And have forgotten the God who fathered you.

Psalms 119:139 My zeal has consumed me, Because my enemies have forgotten Your words.

Isaiah 17:10-11 Because you have forgotten the God of your salvation, And have not been mindful of the Rock of your stronghold, Therefore you will plant pleasant plants And set out foreign seedlings... *But* the harvest *will be* a heap of ruins In the day of grief and desperate sorrow.

Jeremiah 2:32 Can a virgin forget her ornaments, *Or* a bride her attire? Yet My people have forgotten Me days without number.

Jeremiah 3:21 A voice was heard on the desolate heights, Weeping *and* supplications of the children of Israel. For they have perverted their way; They have forgotten the LORD their God.

Jeremiah 13:25 "This is your lot, The portion of your measures from Me," says the LORD, "Because you have forgotten Me And trusted in falsehood."

Jeremiah 18:15 Because My people have forgotten Me, They have burned incense to worthless idols. And they have caused themselves to stumble in their ways, *From* the ancient paths, To walk in pathways and not on a highway.

Ezekiel 22:12 "In you they take bribes to shed blood; you take usury and increase; you have made profit from your neighbors by extortion, and have forgotten Me," says the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 23:35 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: 'Because you have forgotten Me and cast Me behind your back, Therefore you shall bear the *penalty* Of your lewdness and your harlotry.'

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.

Hosea 8:14 For Israel has forgotten his Maker, And has built temples; Judah also has multiplied fortified cities; But I will send fire upon his cities, And it shall devour his palaces.

Forgetfulness

Psalms 88:12 Shall Your wonders be known in the dark? And Your righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?
