## God Remembered

Genesis 8:1 Then God **remembered** Noah, and every living thing, and all the animals that *were* with him in the ark. And God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided.

Genesis 19:29 And it came to pass, when God destroyed the cities of the plain, that God **remembered** Abraham, and sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow, when He overthrew the cities in which Lot had dwelt.

Genesis 30:22 Then God **remembered** Rachel, and God listened to her and opened her womb.

Exodus 2:24 So God heard their groaning, and God **remembered** His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.

Exodus 6:5 And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel whom the Egyptians keep in bondage, and I have **remembered** My covenant.

Numbers 10:9 When you go to war in your land against the enemy who oppresses you, then you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets, and **you** will be **remembered** before the LORD your God, and you will be saved from your enemies.

1 Samuel 1:19 Then they rose early in the morning and worshiped before the LORD, and returned and came to their house at Ramah. And Elkanah knew Hannah his wife, and the LORD **remembered** her.

Psalms 78:39 For He **remembered** that they *were but* flesh, A breath that passes away and does not come again.

Psalms 98:3 He has **remembered** His mercy and His faithfulness to the house of Israel; All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.

Psalms 105:42 For He **remembered** His holy promise, *And* Abraham His servant.

Psalms 106:45 And for their sake He remembered His covenant, And relented according to the multitude of His mercies.

Psalms 111:4 He has made His wonderful works to be remembered; The LORD *is* gracious and full of compassion.

Psalms 136:23 Who remembered us in our lowly state, For His mercy *endures* forever.

Isaiah 63:11 Then he remembered the days of old, **Moses and his people**, *saying*: "Where *is* He who brought them up out of the sea With the shepherd of His flock? Where *is* He who put His Holy Spirit within them."

## Remember Me

Judges 16:28 Then Samson called to the LORD, saying, "O Lord GOD, remember me, I pray! Strengthen me, I pray, just this once, O God, that I may with one *blow* take vengeance on the Philistines for my two eyes!"

1 Samuel 1:11 Then she made a vow and said, "O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life, and no razor shall come upon his head."

Nehemiah 5:19 Remember me, my God, for good, *according to* all that I have done for this people.

Nehemiah 13:14 Remember me, O my God, concerning this, and do not wipe out my good deeds that I have done for the house of my God, and for its services!

Nehemiah 13:22 And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and that they should go and guard the gates, to sanctify the Sabbath day. Remember me, O my God, *concerning* this also, and spare me according to the greatness of Your mercy!

Nehemiah 13:31 and *to bringing* the wood offering and the firstfruits at appointed times. Remember me, O my God, for good!

Job 14:13 Oh, that You would hide me in the grave, That You would conceal me until Your wrath is past, That You would appoint me a set time, and remember me!

Psalms 25:7 Do not remember the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions; According to Your mercy remember me, For Your goodness' sake, O LORD.

Psalms 106:4 Remember me, O LORD, with the favor *You have toward* Your people; Oh, visit me with Your salvation,

Jeremiah 15:15 O LORD, You know; Remember me and visit me, And take vengeance for me on my persecutors. In Your enduring patience, do not take me away. Know that for Your sake I have suffered rebuke.

Ezekiel 6:9 Then those of you who escape will remember Me among the nations where they are carried captive, because I was crushed by their adulterous heart which has departed from Me, and by their eyes

which play the harlot after their idols; they will loathe themselves for the evils which they committed in all their abominations.

Zechariah 10:9 I will sow them among the peoples, And they shall remember Me in far countries; They shall live, together with their children, And they shall return.

Luke 23:42 Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom."

### **God Will Not Forget (Mercy)**

Deuteronomy 4:31 (For the LORD your God *is* a merciful God), He will not forsake you nor destroy you, nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore to them.

1 Samuel 1:11 Then she made a vow and said, "O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life, and no razor shall come upon his head."

Psalms 9:12 When He avenges blood, He remembers them; He does not forget the cry of the humble.

Psalms 10:12 Arise, O LORD! O God, lift up Your hand! Do not forget the humble.

Psalms 13:1 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. How long, O LORD? Will You forget me forever? How long will You hide Your face from me?

Psalms 74:19 Oh, do not deliver the life of Your turtledove to the wild beast! Do not forget the life of Your poor forever.

Psalms 74:23 Do not forget the voice of Your enemies; The tumult of those who rise up against You increases continually.

Isaiah 49:15 Can a woman forget her nursing child, And not have compassion on the son of her womb? Surely they may forget, Yet I will not forget you.

Jeremiah 23:27 Who try to make My people forget My name by their dreams which everyone tells his neighbor, as their fathers forgot My name for Baal.

Hebrews 6:10 For God *is* not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, *in that* you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

### **God Will Not Forget (Judgment)**

Psalms 44:24 Why do You hide Your face, *And* forget our affliction and our oppression?

psalms 109:14 Let **the iniquity of his fathers** be remembered before the LORD, And let not **the sin of his mother** be blotted out.

Jeremiah 23:39 Therefore behold, I, even I, will utterly forget you and forsake you, and the city that I gave you and your fathers, and *will cast you* out of My presence.

Lamentations 5:20 Why do You forget us forever, *And* forsake us for so long a time?

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.

Amos 8:7 The LORD has sworn by the pride of Jacob: "Surely I will never forget any of their works".
