The difference between practicing Immanuel's presence and abiding with Him is having to remember Him versus encountering Him all the time. Remembering The Lord

Psalms 22:27 All the ends of the world Shall <u>remember</u> and turn to the LORD, And all the families of the nations Shall worship before You.

Psalms 42:6 O my God, my soul is cast down within me; Therefore I will <u>remember</u> You from the land of the Jordan, And from the heights of Hermon, From the Hill Mizar.

Psalms 63:6 When I <u>remember</u> You on my bed, I meditate on You in the *night* watches.

Psalms 77:10 And I said, "This is my anguish; But I will <u>remember</u> the years of the right hand of the Most High."

Romans 11:18 Do not boast against the branches. But if you do boast, <u>remember</u> that you do not support the root, but the root <u>supports</u> you.

Remembering His Name

Psalms 20:7 Some *trust* in chariots, and some in horses; But we will <u>remember</u> the name of the LORD our God.

Psalms 119:55 I remember Your name in the night, O LORD, And I keep Your law.

Remembering His Works

- Psalms 42:4 When I <u>remember</u> these *things*, I pour out my soul within me. For I used to go with the multitude; I went with them to the house of God, With the voice of joy and praise, With a multitude that kept a pilgrim feast.
- Psalms 77:11 I will remember the works of the LORD; Surely I will remember Your wonders of old.
- Psalms 105:5 Remember His marvelous works which He has done, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth.
- Psalms 143:5 I remember the days of old; I meditate on all Your works; I muse on the work of Your hands.
- Mark 8:18 Having eyes, do you not see? And having ears, do you not hear? And do you not remember?
- 2 Timothy 2:8 Remember that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David, was raised from the dead according to my gospel.

Remembering His Words

- Psalms 103:18 To such as keep His covenant, And to those who remember His commandments to do them.
- Luke 1:72 To perform the mercy promised to our fathers And to remember His holy covenant.
- Luke 24:6 He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee.
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.
- John 16:4 But these things I have told you, that when the time comes, you may <u>remember</u> that I told you of them. And these things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you.

- Psalms 45:17 I will make Your name to be <u>remembered</u> in all generations; Therefore the people shall praise You forever and ever.
- Psalms 77:3 I remembered God, and was troubled; I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed. Selah
- Psalms 78:35 Then they remembered that God was their rock, And the Most High God their Redeemer
- Psalms 119:52 I remembered Your judgments of old, O LORD, And have comforted myself.
- Psalms 137:1 By the rivers of Babylon, There we sat down, yea, we wept When we remembered Zion.
- Jonah 2:7 "When my soul fainted within me, I <u>remembered</u> the LORD; And my prayer went *up* to You, Into Your holy temple.

Remember Me

- Ezekiel 6:9 Then those of you who escape will <u>remember Me</u> among the nations where they are carried captive, because I was crushed by their adulterous heart which has departed from Me, and by their eyes which play the harlot after their idols; they will loathe themselves for the evils which they committed in all their abominations.
- Zechariah 10:9 I will sow them among the peoples, And they shall <u>remember Me</u> in far countries; They shall live, together with their children, And they shall return.

Remembrance

- Psalms 6:5 For in death there is no remembrance of You; In the grave who will give You thanks?
- Psalms 30:4 Sing praise to the LORD, You saints of His, And give thanks at the <u>remembrance</u> of His holy name
- Psalms 38:1 A Psalm of David. To bring to <u>remembrance</u>. O LORD, do not rebuke me in Your wrath, Nor chasten me in Your hot displeasure!
- Psalms 70:1 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. To bring to remembrance. Make haste, O God, to deliver me! Make haste to help me, O LORD!
- Psalms 77:6 I call to <u>remembrance</u> my song in the night; I meditate within my heart, And my spirit makes diligent search.
- Psalms 97:12 Rejoice in the LORD, you righteous, And give thanks at the <u>remembrance</u> of His holy name.
- Psalms 102:12 But You, O LORD, shall endure forever, And the <u>remembrance</u> of Your name to all generations.
- Psalms 112:6 Surely he will never be shaken; The righteous will be in everlasting remembrance.
- Isaiah 26:8 Yes, in the way of Your judgments, O LORD, we have waited for You; The desire of *our* soul *is* for Your name And for the <u>remembrance</u> of You.
- Malachi 3:16 Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, And the LORD listened and heard *them*; So a book of <u>remembrance</u> was written before Him For those who fear the LORD And who meditate on His name.
- Luke 1:54 He has helped His servant Israel, In <u>remembrance</u> of *His* mercy.
- Luke 22:19 And He took bread, gave thanks and broke *it*, and gave *it* to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in <u>remembrance</u> of Me."
- John 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your <u>remembrance</u> all things that I said to you.
- 1 Corinthians 11:24 And when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in <u>remembrance</u> of Me."

1 Corinthians 11:25 In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in <u>remembrance</u> of Me."

Altars of Remembering God

- Genesis 8:20 Then **Noah** built an <u>altar to the LORD</u>, and took of every clean animal and of every clean bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.
- Genesis 12:7-8 Then the LORD appeared to **Abram** and said, "To your descendants I will give this land." And there he built an <u>altar to the LORD</u>, who had appeared to him. And he moved from there to the mountain east of Bethel, and he pitched his tent *with* Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; there he built an altar to the LORD and called on the name of the LORD.
- Genesis 13:18 Then **Abram** moved *his* tent, and went and dwelt by the terebinth trees of Mamre, which *are* in Hebron, and built <u>an altar there to the LORD.</u>
- Genesis 26:25 So he [Isaac] built an altar there and called on the name of the LORD, and he pitched his tent there; and there Isaac's servants dug a well.
- Genesis 33:18, 20 Then **Jacob** came safely to the city of Shechem, which *is* in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padan Aram; and he pitched his tent before the city...Then he erected an altar there and called it El Elohe Israel.
- Genesis 35:1, 3, 7 Then God said to **Jacob**, "Arise, go up to Bethel and dwell there; and make an <u>altar</u> there to God, who appeared to you when you fled from the face of Esau your brother"... "Then let us arise and go up to Bethel; and I will make an <u>altar</u> there to God, who answered me in the day of my distress and has been with me in the way which I have gone...And he built an <u>altar</u> there and called the place El Bethel, because there God appeared to him when he fled from the face of his brother.
- Exodus 17:15-16 And **Moses** built an altar and called its name, The-LORD-Is-My-Banner, for he said, "Because the LORD has sworn: the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation."
- Exodus 20:24-25 'An <u>altar</u> of earth you [**Moses**] shall make for Me, and you shall sacrifice on it your burnt offerings and your peace offerings, your sheep and your oxen. In every place where I record My name I will come to you, and I will bless you. And if you make Me an <u>altar</u> of stone, you shall not build it of hewn stone; for if you use your tool on it, you have profaned it.
- Exodus 24:4 And **Moses** wrote all the words of the LORD. And he rose early in the morning, and built an altar at the foot of the mountain, and twelve pillars according to the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Leviticus 22:22 'Those *that are* blind or broken or maimed, or have an ulcer or eczema or scabs, you [Aaron and his sons and all the children of Israel] shall not offer to the LORD, nor make an offering by fire of them on the <u>altar to the LORD</u>.
- Deuteronomy 27:5 And there you [the children of Israel] shall build an <u>altar to the LORD</u> your God, an altar of stones; you shall not use an iron *tool* on them.
- Joshua 8:30 Now Joshua built an altar to the LORD God of Israel in Mount Ebal,

- Joshua 22:10 And when they came to the region of the Jordan which is in the land of Canaan, the children of Reuben, the children of Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh built an altar there by the Jordan—a great, impressive altar.
- Joshua 22:34 The **children of Reuben and the children of Gad** called the altar, *Witness*, "For *it is* a witness between us that the LORD *is* God."
- Judges 6:26-27 And [**Gideon**] build an <u>altar to the LORD</u> your God on top of this rock in the proper arrangement, and take the second bull and offer a burnt sacrifice with the wood of the image which you shall cut down. So Gideon took ten men from among his servants and did as the LORD had said to him. But because he feared his father's household and the men of the city too much to do *it* by day, he did *it* by night.
- Judges 13:19-20 So **Manoah** took the young goat with the grain offering, and offered it upon the rock to the LORD. And He did a wondrous thing while Manoah and his wife looked on— it happened as the flame went up toward heaven from the altar—the Angel of the LORD ascended in the flame of the altar! When Manoah and his wife saw *this*, they fell on their faces to the ground.
- 1 Samuel 7:17 But he [**Samuel**] always returned to Ramah, for his home *was* there. There he judged Israel, and there he built an <u>altar to the LORD</u>.
- 1 Samuel 14:35 Then **Saul** built an <u>altar to the LORD</u>. This was the first altar that he built to the LORD.
- 2 Samuel 24:18 And Gad came that day to **David** and said to him, "Go up, erect an <u>altar to the LORD</u> on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite."
- 2 Samuel 24:21 Then Araunah said, "Why has my lord the king come to his servant?" And **David** said, "To buy the threshing floor from you, to build an <u>altar to the LORD</u>, that the plague may be withdrawn from the people."
- 2 Samuel 24:25 And **David** built there an <u>altar to the LORD</u>, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. So the LORD heeded the prayers for the land, and the plague was withdrawn from Israel.
- 1 Kings 18:31-32 And **Elijah** took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, to whom the word of the LORD had come, saying, "Israel shall be your name." "Then with the stones he built an altar in the name of the LORD; and he made a trench around the altar large enough to hold two seahs of seed."
- 1 Chronicles 21:18 Therefore, the angel of the LORD commanded Gad to say to David that **David** should go and erect an <u>altar to the LORD</u> on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.
- 1 Chronicles 21:26 And **David** built there an <u>altar to the LORD</u>, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called on the LORD; and He answered him from heaven by fire on the altar of burnt offering.
- 2 Chronicles 4:1 Moreover he [Solomon] made a bronze altar: twenty cubits was its length, twenty cubits its width, and ten cubits its height.
- Isaiah 19:19 In that day there will be an <u>altar to the LORD</u> in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to the LORD at its border.

Hebrews 13:10 We have <u>an altar</u> [the sacrifice of Jesus Christ] from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat.

Feasts of Remembering

- Exodus 23:14 Three times you shall keep a feast to Me in the year:
- Exodus 23:17 Three times in the year all your males shall appear before the Lord GOD.
- Exodus 34:23-24 <u>Three times</u> in the year all your men shall appear before the Lord, the LORD God of Israel. For I will cast out the nations before you and enlarge your borders; neither will any man covet your land when you go up to appear before the LORD your God <u>three times</u> in the year.
- Leviticus 23:2-4 Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: "The <u>feasts</u> of the LORD, which you shall proclaim *to be* holy convocations, these *are* My <u>feasts</u>. Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day *is* a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work *on it*; it *is* the Sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings. These *are* the <u>feasts</u> of the LORD, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times.'
- Leviticus 23:37 These *are* the <u>feasts</u> of the LORD which you shall proclaim *to be* holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire to the LORD, a burnt offering and a grain offering, a sacrifice and drink offerings, everything on its day—
- Leviticus 23:44 So Moses declared to the children of Israel the feasts of the LORD.
- Numbers 10:10 Also in the day of your gladness, in your appointed <u>feasts</u>, and at the beginning of your months, you shall blow the trumpets over your burnt offerings and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; and they shall be a memorial for you before your God: I *am* the LORD your God.
- Numbers 15:3 And you make an offering by fire to the LORD, a burnt offering or a sacrifice, to fulfill a vow or as a freewill offering or in your appointed <u>feasts</u>, to make a sweet aroma to the LORD, from the herd or the flock.
- Numbers 29:39 These you shall present to the LORD at your appointed <u>feasts</u> (besides your vowed offerings and your freewill offerings) as your burnt offerings and your grain offerings, as your drink offerings and your peace offerings.
- Deuteronomy 16:16 <u>Three times</u> a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses: at the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles; and they shall not appear before the LORD empty—handed.
- 1 Chronicles 23:31 And at every presentation of a burnt offering to the LORD on the Sabbaths and on the New Moons and on the set <u>feasts</u>, by number according to the ordinance governing them, regularly before the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 2:4 Behold, I am building a temple for the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate *it* to Him, to burn before Him sweet incense, for the continual showbread, for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the Sabbaths, on the New Moons, and on the set <u>feasts</u> of the LORD our God. This *is an ordinance* forever to Israel.

- 2 Chronicles 8:13 According to the daily rate, offering according to the commandment of Moses, for the Sabbaths, the New Moons, and the three appointed yearly <u>feasts</u>—the Feast of Unleavened Bread, the Feast of Weeks, and the Feast of Tabernacles.
- 2 Chronicles 31:3 The king also *appointed* a portion of his possessions for the burnt offerings: for the morning and evening burnt offerings, the burnt offerings for the Sabbaths and the New Moons and the set <u>feasts</u>, as *it is* written in the Law of the LORD.
- Ezra 3:5 Afterwards *they offered* the regular burnt offering, and *those* for New Moons and for all the appointed <u>feasts</u> of the LORD that were consecrated, and *those* of everyone who willingly offered a freewill offering to the LORD.
- Nehemiah 10:33 For the showbread, for the regular grain offering, for the regular burnt offering of the Sabbaths, the New Moons, and the set <u>feasts</u>; for the holy things, for the sin offerings to make atonement for Israel, and all the work of the house of our God.
- Esther 9:28 That these days should be <u>remembered</u> and kept throughout every generation, every family, every province, and every city, that these days of Purim should not fail to be observed among the Jews, and that the memory of them should not perish among their descendants.
- Isaiah 33:20 Look upon Zion, the city of our appointed <u>feasts</u>; Your eyes will see Jerusalem, a quiet home, A tabernacle *that* will not be taken down; Not one of its stakes will ever be removed, Nor will any of its cords be broken.
- Ezekiel 45:17 Then it shall be the prince's part *to give* burnt offerings, grain offerings, and drink offerings, at the <u>feasts</u>, the New Moons, the Sabbaths, and at all the appointed seasons of the house of Israel. He shall prepare the sin offering, the grain offering, the burnt offering, and the peace offerings to make atonement for the house of Israel.
- Nahum 1:15 Behold, on the mountains The feet of him who brings good tidings, Who proclaims peace! O Judah, keep your appointed <u>feasts</u>, Perform your vows. For the wicked one shall no more pass through you; He is utterly cut off.
- Zechariah 8:19 Thus says the LORD of hosts: 'The fast of the fourth *month*, The fast of the fifth, The fast of the seventh, And the fast of the tenth, Shall be joy and gladness and cheerful <u>feasts</u> For the house of Judah. Therefore love truth and peace.'
- 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

Teach Your Children

Deuteronomy 4:9-10 Only take heed to yourself, and diligently keep yourself, lest you forget the things your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. And teach them to your children and your grandchildren, especially concerning the day you stood before the LORD your God in Horeb, when the LORD said to me, 'Gather the people to Me, and I will let them hear My words, that they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children.'

- Deuteronomy 6:5-9 You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. "You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
- Deuteronomy 11:19 You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

Clothing of Remembrance

- Exodus 13:16 It shall be as a sign on your hand and as <u>frontlets</u> between your eyes, for by strength of hand the LORD brought us out of Egypt.
- Deuteronomy 6:8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as <u>frontlets</u> between your eyes.
- Deuteronomy 11:18 Therefore you shall lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as <u>frontlets</u> between your eyes.
- Matthew 9:20 And suddenly, a woman who had a flow of blood for twelve years came from behind and touched the <u>hem of His garment</u>.
- Matthew 14:36 and begged Him that they might only touch the <u>hem of His garment</u>. And as many as touched *it* were made perfectly well.
- Mark 6:56 Wherever He entered into villages, cities, or in the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the <u>hem of</u> His garment. And as many as touched Him were made well.

Memorial

- Exodus 3:15 Moreover God said to Moses, Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: 'The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This *is* My name forever, and this *is* My memorial to all generations.'
- Exodus 12:14 'So this day shall be to you a <u>memorial</u>; and you shall keep it as a feast to the LORD throughout your generations. You shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance.
- Exodus 13:9 It shall be as a sign to you on your hand and as a <u>memorial</u> between your eyes, that the LORD'S law may be in your mouth; for with a strong hand the LORD has brought you out of Egypt.
- Exodus 28:12 And you shall put the two stones on the shoulders of the ephod *as* memorial stones for the sons of Israel. So Aaron shall bear their names before the LORD on his two shoulders as a memorial.
- Exodus 28:29 So Aaron shall bear the names of the sons of Israel on the breastplate of judgment over his heart, when he goes into the holy *place*, as a <u>memorial</u> before the LORD continually.

- Exodus 30:16 And you shall take the atonement money of the children of Israel, and shall appoint it for the service of the tabernacle of meeting, that it may be a memorial for the children of Israel before the LORD, to make atonement for yourselves."
- Exodus 39:7 He put them on the shoulders of the ephod *as* memorial stones for the sons of Israel, as the LORD had commanded Moses.
- Leviticus 2:2 'He shall bring it to Aaron's sons, the priests, one of whom shall take from it his handful of fine flour and oil with all the frankincense. And the priest shall burn *it as* a <u>memorial</u> on the altar, an offering made by fire, a sweet aroma to the LORD.
- Leviticus 2:9 'Then the priest shall take from the grain offering a memorial portion, and burn *it* on the altar. *It is* an offering made by fire, a sweet aroma to the LORD.
- Leviticus 2:16 'Then the priest shall burn the <u>memorial</u> portion: *part* of its beaten grain and *part* of its oil, with all the frankincense, as an offering made by fire to the LORD.
- Leviticus 5:12 'Then he shall bring it to the priest, and the priest shall take his handful of it as a memorial portion, and burn *it* on the altar according to the offerings made by fire to the LORD. It *is* a sin offering.
- Leviticus 6:15 'He shall take from it his handful of the fine flour of the grain offering, with its oil, and all the frankincense which *is* on the grain offering, and shall burn *it* on the altar *for* a sweet aroma, as a <u>memorial</u> to the LORD.
- Leviticus 23:24 Speak to the children of Israel, saying: In the seventh month, on the first *day* of the month, you shall have a sabbath–*rest*, a <u>memorial</u> of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.
- Leviticus 24:7 And you shall put pure frankincense on *each* row, that it may be on the bread for a <u>memorial</u>, an offering made by fire to the LORD.
- Numbers 5:26 'And the priest shall take a handful of the offering, as its <u>memorial</u> portion, burn *it* on the altar, and afterward make the woman drink the water.
- Numbers 10:10 Also in the day of your gladness, in your appointed feasts, and at the beginning of your months, you shall blow the trumpets over your burnt offerings and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; and they shall be a memorial for you before your God: I am the LORD your God."
- Numbers 16:40 *To be* a <u>memorial</u> to the children of Israel that no outsider, who *is* not a descendant of Aaron, should come near to offer incense before the LORD, that he might not become like Korah and his companions, just as the LORD had said to him through Moses.
- Numbers 31:54 And Moses and Eleazar the priest received the gold from the captains of thousands and of hundreds, and brought it into the tabernacle of meeting as a <u>memorial</u> for the children of Israel before the LORD.
- Joshua 4:7 Then you shall answer them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD; when it crossed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. And these stones shall be for a memorial to the children of Israel forever."
- Nehemiah 2:20 So I answered them, and said to them, "The God of heaven Himself will prosper us; therefore we His servants will arise and build, but you have no heritage or right or memorial in Jerusalem."

- Zechariah 6:14 Now the elaborate crown shall be for a <u>memorial</u> in the temple of the LORD for Helem, Tobijah, Jedaiah, and Hen the son of Zephaniah.
- Matthew 26:13 "Assuredly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done will also be told as a <u>memorial</u> to her."
- Mark 14:9 "Assuredly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done will also be told as a <u>memorial</u> to her."
- Acts 10:4 And when he observed him, he was afraid, and said, "What is it, lord?" So he said to him, "Your prayers and your alms have come up for a memorial before God."
