## Revelation to Friends

But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him." But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. 1 Corinthians 2:9-10

God loves to reveal Himself in order to be known by us. That is why He paid such a enormously large price to send His Son, Jesus. That is why Jesus paid such a enormously large price to come and die for us. That is one reason why the Holy Spirit is with us.

- Genesis 18:17-18 And the LORD said, "Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?"
- Numbers 12:8 **I speak with him face to face**, Even plainly, and not in dark sayings; And he sees the form of the LORD. Why then were you not afraid To speak against **My servant Moses**?
- Deuteronomy 29:29 The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.
- 1 Samuel 3:7, 21 (Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, nor was the word of the LORD yet revealed to him.)...Then the LORD appeared again in Shiloh. For the LORD revealed Himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.
- 2 Samuel 7:27 For You, O LORD of hosts, **God of Israel, have revealed this to Your servant**, saying, I will build you a house.' Therefore Your servant has found it in his heart to pray this prayer to You.
- 1 Chronicles 17:25 For You, O my God, have revealed to Your servant that You will build him a house. Therefore Your servant has found it in his heart to pray before You.
- Psalm 25:14 The secret of the LORD is with those who fear Him, And He will show them His covenant.
- Proverbs 3:32 For the perverse person is an abomination to the LORD, But **His secret counsel is with the upright.**
- Jeremiah 33:3 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'
- Daniel 2:19 Then **the secret was revealed to Daniel** in a night vision. So Daniel blessed the God of heaven.
- Daniel 2:30 But as for me, this secret has not been revealed to me because I have more wisdom than anyone living, but for our sakes who make known the interpretation to the king, and that you may know the thoughts of your heart.

- Daniel 10:1 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a message was revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar. The message was true, but the appointed time was long; and he understood the message, and had understanding of the vision.
- Amos 3:7 Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, Unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.
- Matthew 16:17 Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, **Simon Bar–Jonah**, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but **My Father who is in heaven.**
- John 14:21 **He who has My commandments and keeps them**, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and **manifest Myself to him**. Cp John 15:14 **You are My friends if you do whatever I command you**.
- John 15:15 No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.
- 1 Corinthians 2:9-10 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him." But **God has revealed them to us** through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.
- Ephesians 3:5 Which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been **revealed by** the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets.
- Colossians 1:26 The mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints.
- 1 Peter 1:12 To them it was **revealed** that, not to themselves, but **to us** they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into.
- Revelation 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which **God gave Him to show His servants**—things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified it by His angel to His servant John.
- Revelation 10:7 But in the days of the sounding of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, the mystery of God would be finished, as **He declared to His servants the prophets**.
