## Jesus Is The Rock

- Exodus 17:6 Behold, I will stand before you there on **the rock in Horeb**; and you shall strike the rock, and water will come out of it, that the people may drink." And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.
- Exodus 33:21-22 And the LORD said, "Here is a place by Me, and you shall stand on the rock. So it shall be, while My glory passes by, that I will put you in the cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by.
- Numbers 20:8 Take the rod; you and your brother Aaron gather the congregation together. **Speak to the rock** before their eyes, and it will yield its water; thus you shall bring water for them out of the rock, and give drink to the congregation and their animals."
- Numbers 20:10 And Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly together **before the rock**; and he said to them, "Hear now, you rebels! Must we bring water **for you out of this rock**?"
- Numbers 20:11 Then Moses lifted his hand and **struck the rock** twice with his rod; **and water came out abundantly**, and the congregation and their animals drank.
- Numbers 24:21 Then he looked on the Kenites, and he took up his oracle and said: "Firm is your dwelling place, And your nest is set in the rock.
- Deuteronomy 8:15 Who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, in which were fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty land where there was no water; who brought water for you out of **the flinty rock**.
- Deuteronomy 32:4 **He is the Rock**, His work is perfect; For all His ways are justice, A God of truth and without injustice; Righteous and upright is He.
- Deuteronomy 32:13 He made him ride in the heights of the earth, That he might eat the produce of the fields; He made him **draw honey from the rock**, And **oil from the flinty rock**.

- Deuteronomy 32:15 But Jeshurun grew fat and kicked; You grew fat, you grew thick, You are obese! Then he forsook God who made him, And scornfully esteemed the Rock of his salvation.
- Deuteronomy 32:18 **Of the Rock who begot you**, you are unmindful, And have forgotten the God who fathered you.
- Deuteronomy 32:30 How could one chase a thousand, And two put ten thousand to flight, Unless **their Rock** had sold them, And the LORD had surrendered them?
- Deuteronomy 32:31 For their rock is not like our Rock, Even our enemies themselves being judges.
- Deuteronomy 32:37 He will say: Where are their gods, The rock in which they sought refuge?
- 1 Samuel 2:2 No one is holy like the LORD, For there is none besides You, **Nor is there any rock like our God.**
- 2 Samuel 22:2 And he said: "The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer;
- 2 Samuel 22:32 "For who is God, except the LORD? And who is a rock, except our God?
- 2 Samuel 22:47 "The LORD lives! Blessed be my Rock! Let God be exalted, The Rock of my salvation!
- 2 Samuel 23:3 The God of Israel said, **The Rock of Israel** spoke to me: 'He who rules over men must be just, Ruling in the fear of God.
- Nehemiah 9:15 You gave them bread from heaven for their hunger, **And brought them water out of the rock** for their thirst, And told them to go in to possess the land Which You had sworn to give them.
- Psalm 18:2 **The LORD is my rock** and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.
- Psalm 18:31 For who is God, except the LORD? And who is a rock, except our God?
- Psalm 18:46 The LORD lives! Blessed be my Rock! Let the God of my salvation be exalted.
- Psalm 27:5 For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; In the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me; **He shall set me high upon a rock**.
- Psalm 28:1 A Psalm of David. To You I will cry, **O LORD my Rock**: Do not be silent to me, Lest, if You are silent to me, I become like those who go down to the pit.
- Psalm 31:2 Bow down Your ear to me, Deliver me speedily; **Be my rock of refuge**, A fortress of defense to save me.
- Psalm 31:3 For You are my rock and my fortress; Therefore, for Your name's sake, Lead me and guide me.
- Psalm 40:2 He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, **Out of the miry clay, And set my feet upon a rock**, And established my steps.
- Psalm 42:9 I will say to **God my Rock**, "Why have You forgotten me? Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?

- Psalm 61:2 From the end of the earth I will cry to You, When my heart is overwhelmed; **Lead me to the rock that is higher than I.**
- Psalm 62:2 He only is my rock and my salvation; He is my defense; I shall not be greatly moved.
- Psalm 62:6 He only is my rock and my salvation; He is my defense; I shall not be moved.
- Psalm 62:7 In God is my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, And my refuge, is in God.
- Psalm 71:3 Be my strong refuge, To which I may resort continually; You have given the commandment to save me, For **You are my rock** and my fortress.
- Psalm 78:16 He also brought streams out of the rock, And caused waters to run down like rivers.
- Psalm 78:20 Behold, **He struck the rock**, So that the waters gushed out, And the streams overflowed. Can He give bread also? Can He provide meat for His people?"
- Psalm 78:35 Then they remembered that God was their rock, And the Most High God their Redeemer.
- Psalm 81:16 He would have fed them also with the finest of wheat; And with honey from the rock I would have satisfied you.
- Psalm 89:26 He shall cry to Me, 'You are my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation.'
- Psalm 92:15 To declare that the LORD is upright; **He is my rock**, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.
- Psalm 94:22 But the LORD has been my defense, And my God the rock of my refuge.
- Psalm 95:1 Oh come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation.
- Psalm 105:41 He opened the rock, and water gushed out; It ran in the dry places like a river.
- Psalm 114:8 Who turned the rock into a pool of water, The flint into a fountain of waters.
- Psalm 144:1 A Psalm of David. Blessed be **the LORD my Rock**, Who trains my hands for war, And my fingers for battle—
- Isaiah 8:14 He will be as a sanctuary, But a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense To both the houses of Israel, As a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.
- Isaiah 17:10 Because you have forgotten the God of your salvation, And have not been mindful of **the Rock of your stronghold**, Therefore you will plant pleasant plants And set out foreign seedlings.
- Isaiah 44:8 Do not fear, nor be afraid; Have I not told you from that time, and declared it? You are My witnesses. Is there a God besides Me? Indeed **there is no other Rock**; I know not one.'
- Isaiah 48:21 And they did not thirst When He led them through the deserts; **He caused the waters to flow** from the rock for them; **He also split the rock, and the waters gushed out.**
- Isaiah 51:1 Listen to Me, you who follow after righteousness, You who seek the LORD: **Look to the rock from which you were hewn**, And to the hole of the pit from which you were dug.

- Habakkuk 1:12 Are You not from everlasting, O LORD my God, my Holy One? We shall not die. O LORD, You have appointed them for judgment; **O Rock**, You have marked them for correction.
- Romans 9:33 As it is written: "Behold, I lay in Zion a stumbling stone and rock of offense, And whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."
- 1 Peter 2:8 and "A stone of stumbling And a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed.

## Jesus Is The Stone

- Genesis 49:24 But his bow remained in strength, And the arms of his hands were made strong By the hands of the Mighty God of Jacob (From there is the Shepherd, **the Stone of Israel**).
- Psalm 118:22 The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone.
- Isaiah 8:14 He will be as a sanctuary, But a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense To both the houses of Israel, As a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.
- Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation, A tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation; Whoever believes will not act hastily.
- Daniel 2:34 "You watched while a stone was cut out without hands, which struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces.
- Daniel 2:35 "Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. And the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.
- Daniel 2:45 Inasmuch as you saw that **the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands**, and that it broke in pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold—the great God has made known to the king what will come to pass after this. The dream is certain, and its interpretation is sure.
- Zechariah 4:7 'Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain! And he shall bring forth **the capstone** With shouts of "Grace, grace to it!""
- Matthew 21:42 Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. This was the LORD'S doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes'?
- Matthew 21:44 And whoever falls on **this stone** will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder."
- Mark 12:10 Have you not even read this Scripture: 'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone.
- Luke 20:17 Then He looked at them and said, "What then is this that is written: 'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone'?

- Luke 20:18 Whoever falls on **that stone** will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder.
- Acts 4:11 This is the 'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.'
- Romans 9:32 Why? Because they did not seek it by faith, but as it were, by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone.
- Romans 9:33 As it is written: "Behold, I lay in Zion a stumbling stone and rock of offense, And whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."
- 1 Peter 2:4 Coming to **Him as to a living stone**, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious.
- 1 Peter 2:7 Therefore, to you who believe, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone."
- 1 Peter 2:8 And "A stone of stumbling And a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed.
