Thanksgiving

Enter into His gates with <u>thanksgiving</u>, *And* into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, *and* bless His name. Psalms 100:4

One of the unique aspects of Immanuel prayer, is that we start with a positive connection with God. Step number one is to remember a time when Jesus and I as the receiver had a positive connection. We ask Holy Spirit's help to remember. Step number two is thanking Jesus or appreciating Him for who He is as well as what He has done. When we do this thanking and appreciating out loud, we are actually setting our brains to receive from Him. Step number three is to locate Jesus, Immanuel, Who has always been with you. Step number 4 is to establish an interactive connection with Him. Because we have thanked and appreciated Him, we can more easily "behold His beauty" and "inquire of Him" as David desired in Psalm 27.

- 2 Samuel 22:50 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name.
- 1 Chronicles 16:35 And say, "Save us, O God of our salvation; Gather us together, and deliver us from the Gentiles, To give thanks to Your holy name, To triumph in Your praise."
- 1 Chronicles 25:3 Of Jeduthun, the sons of Jeduthun: Gedaliah, Zeri, Jeshaiah, *Shimei,* Hashabiah, and Mattithiah, six, under the direction of their father Jeduthun, who prophesied with a harp to give thanks and to praise the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 31:2 And Hezekiah appointed the divisions of the priests and the Levites according to their divisions, each man according to his service, the priests and Levites for burnt offerings and peace offerings, to serve, to give thanks, and to praise in the gates of the camp of the LORD.
- Nehemiah 12:24 And the heads of the Levites *were* Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with their brothers across from them, to praise *and* give thanks, group alternating with group, according to the command of David the man of God.
- Psalms 18:49 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name.
- Psalms 30:4 Sing praise to the LORD, You saints of His, And give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name.

- Romans 16:4 Who risked their own necks for my life, to whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the Gentiles.
- Ephesians 1:16 Do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers.
- Colossians 1:3 We give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:2 We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth.

Giving Thanks

- Ezra 3:11 And they sang responsively, praising and giving thanks to the LORD: "For *He is* good, For His mercy *endures* forever toward Israel." Then all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid.
- Ephesians 5:20 Giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- Nehemiah 11:17 Mattaniah the son of Micha, the son of Zabdi, the son of Asaph, the leader *who* began the <u>thanksgiving</u> with prayer; Bakbukiah, the second among his brethren; and Abda the son of Shammua, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun.
- Nehemiah 12:8 Moreover the Levites *were* Jeshua, Binnui, Kadmiel, Sherebiah, Judah, *and* Mattaniah *who led* the <u>thanksgiving</u> *psalms*, he and his brethren.
- Nehemiah 12:31 So I brought the leaders of Judah up on the wall, and appointed two large <u>thanksgiving</u> choirs. *One* went to the right hand on the wall toward the Refuse Gate.

- Nehemiah 12:38 The other <u>thanksgiving</u> choir went the opposite *way*, and I *was* behind them with half of the people on the wall, going past the Tower of the Ovens as far as the Broad Wall.
- Nehemiah 12:40 So the two <u>thanksgiving</u> choirs stood in the house of God, likewise I and the half of the rulers with me.
- Nehemiah 12:46 For in the days of David and Asaph of old *there were* chiefs of the singers, and songs of praise and <u>thanksgiving</u> to God.
- Psalms 26:7 That I may proclaim with the voice of *thanksgiving*, And tell of all Your wondrous works.
- Psalms 50:14 Offer to God thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High.

Gave Thanks

- Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went home. And in his upper room, with his windows open toward Jerusalem, he knelt down on his knees three times that day, and prayed and gave thanks before his God, as was his custom since early days.
- Luke 2:38 And coming in that instant she <u>gave thanks</u> to the Lord, and spoke of Him to all those who looked for redemption in Jerusalem.

Thanksgiving For Food

- Matthew 15:36 And He took the seven loaves and the fish and <u>gave thanks</u>, broke *them* and gave *them* to His disciples; and the disciples *gave* to the multitude.
- Matthew 26:27 Then He took the cup, and <u>gave thanks</u>, and gave *it* to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you.
- Mark 8:6 So He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground. And He took the seven loaves and <u>gave thanks</u>, broke *them* and gave *them* to His disciples to set before *them*; and they set *them* before the multitude.
- Luke 22:17 Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, "Take this and divide *it* among yourselves;
- Luke 22:19 And He took bread, <u>gave thanks</u> and broke *it*, and gave *it* to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
- Acts 27:35 And when he had said these things, he took bread and <u>gave thanks</u> to God in the presence of them all; and when he had broken *it* he began to eat.
- 1 Corinthians 10:30 But if I partake with thanks, why am I evil spoken of for *the food* over which I give thanks?
- 1 Timothy 4:3 Forbidding to marry, *and commanding* to abstain from foods which God created to be received with <u>thanksgiving</u> by those who believe and know the truth.
- 1 Timothy 4:4 For every creature of God *is* good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with <u>thanksgiving</u>.

Thanksgiving and Sacrifice

- Leviticus 7:12 'If he offers it for a <u>thanksgiving</u>, then he shall offer, with the <u>sacrifice</u> of <u>thanksgiving</u>, unleavened cakes mixed with oil, unleavened wafers anointed with oil, or cakes of blended flour mixed with oil.
- Leviticus 7:13 Besides the cakes, *as* his offering he shall offer leavened bread with the <u>sacrifice</u> of <u>thanksgiving</u> of his peace offering.
- Leviticus 7:15 'The flesh of the <u>sacrifice</u> of his peace offering for <u>thanksgiving</u> shall be eaten the same day it is offered. He shall not leave any of it until morning.

Leviticus 22:29 "And when you offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the LORD, offer it of your own free will.

Psalms 107:22 Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, And declare His works with rejoicing.

Psalms 116:17 I will offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving, And will call upon the name of the LORD.

- Amos 4:5 Offer a <u>sacrifice</u> of <u>thanksgiving</u> with leaven, Proclaim *and* announce the freewill offerings; For this you love, *You* children of Israel!" Says the Lord GOD.
- Jonah 2:9 But I will <u>sacrifice</u> to You With the voice of <u>thanksgiving</u>; I will pay what I have vowed. Salvation *is* of the LORD.

Praise and Sacrifice

Psalms 54:6 I will freely sacrifice to You; I will praise Your name, O LORD, for it is good.

- Jeremiah 33:11 'the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "<u>Praise</u> the LORD of hosts, For the LORD *is* good, For His mercy *endures* forever" —*and* of those *who will* bring the <u>sacrifice</u> of <u>praise</u> into the house of the LORD. For I will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first,' says the LORD.
