The Man

For *there is* one God and one Mediator between God and men, <u>the Man</u> Christ Jesus. 1 Timothy 2:5

It always astounds me when people ask me if Immanuel Practicum is good for the difficult emotional situations like DID or SRA. I have even had someone say that some of the other inner healing models go "deeper" because they are mechanical, complicated, and (for the most part) counselor led. Immanuel Practicum, on the other hand, is simple and spontaneous because Jesus is running things. And because Jesus is smarter than any earthly counselor, His ways are far better than any way we can come up with. Let me state the obvious: Jesus is good at everything. The Man (Old Testament)

Genesis 32:24 Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.

- Judges 13:8 Then Manoah prayed to the LORD, and said, "O my Lord, please let <u>the Man</u> of God whom You sent come to us again and teach us what we shall do for the child who will be born."
- Judges 13:10 Then the woman ran in haste and told her husband, and said to him, "Look, <u>the Man</u> who came to me the *other* day has just now appeared to me!"
- Judges 13:11 So Manoah arose and followed his wife. When he came to <u>the Man</u>, he said to Him, "Are You <u>the Man</u> who spoke to this woman?" And He said, "I *am*."
- Joshua 5:13 And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a <u>Man</u> stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, "*Are* You for us or for our adversaries?"
- Isaiah 53:3 He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.
- Zechariah 6:12 Then speak to him, saying, "Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying: "Behold, the <u>Man</u> whose name *is* the BRANCH! From His place He shall branch out, And He shall build the temple of the LORD;"
- Zechariah 13:7 "Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, Against the <u>Man</u> who is My Companion," Says the LORD of hosts. "Strike the Shepherd, And the sheep will be scattered; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones."

- Matthew 9:3 And at once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes!"
- Matthew 13:56 And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then did this Man get all these things?
- Matthew 26:72 But again he denied with an oath, "I do not know the Man!"
- Matthew 26:74 Then he began to curse and swear, *saying*, "I do not know <u>the Man</u>!" Immediately a rooster crowed.
- Matthew 27:19 While he was sitting on the judgment seat, his wife sent to him, saying, "Have nothing to do with that just <u>Man</u>, for I have suffered many things today in a dream because of Him."
- Matthew 27:47 Some of those who stood there, when they heard that, said, "This Man is calling for Elijah!"
- Mark 6:2 And when the Sabbath had come, He began to teach in the synagogue. And many hearing *Him* were astonished, saying, "Where *did* this <u>Man</u> *get* these things? And what wisdom *is* this which is given to Him, that such mighty works are performed by His hands!"
- Mark 14:71 Then he began to curse and swear, "I do not know this Man of whom you speak!"
- Mark 15:39 So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this <u>Man</u> was the Son of God!"
- Luke 15:2 And the Pharisees and scribes complained, saying, "This Man receives sinners and eats with them."
- Luke 23:4 So Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowd, "I find no fault in this Man."
- Luke 23:6 When Pilate heard of Galilee, he asked if the Man were a Galilean.
- Luke 23:14 Said to them, "You have brought this <u>Man</u> to me, as one who misleads the people. And indeed, having examined *Him* in your presence, I have found no fault in this <u>Man</u> concerning those things of which you accuse Him;"
- Luke 23:18 And they all cried out at once, saying, "Away with this Man, and release to us Barabbas" —
- Luke 23:41 And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong.
- Luke 23:47 So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God, saying, "Certainly this was a righteous <u>Man</u>!"
- Luke 23:6 When Pilate heard of Galilee, he asked if the Man were a Galilean.
- John 4:29 Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?
- John 5:12 Then they asked him, "Who is the Man who said to you, 'Take up your bed and walk'?"
- John 6:52 The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this <u>Man</u> give us *His* flesh to eat?"

- John 7:15 And the Jews marveled, saying, "How does this Man know letters, having never studied?"
- John 7:27 However, we know where this Man is from; but when the Christ comes, no one knows where He is from.
- John 7:31 And many of the people believed in Him, and said, "When the Christ comes, will He do more signs than these which this <u>Man</u> has done?"
- John 7:46 The officers answered, "No man ever spoke like this Man!"
- John 8:28 Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of <u>Man</u>, then you will know that I am *He*, and *that* I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things."
- John 8:40 But now you seek to kill Me, a <u>Man</u> who has told you the truth which I heard from God. Abraham did not do this.
- John 9:11 He answered and said, "A <u>Man</u> called Jesus made clay and anointed my eyes and said to me, 'Go to the pool of Siloam and wash.' So I went and washed, and I received sight."
- John 9:16 Therefore some of the Pharisees said, "This <u>Man</u> is not from God, because He does not keep the Sabbath." Others said, "How can a <u>man</u> who is a sinner do such signs?" And there was a division among them."
- John 9:33 If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing.
- John 10:33 The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God."
- John 10:41 Then many came to Him and said, "John performed no sign, but all the things that John spoke about this <u>Man</u> were true."
- John 11:37 And some of them said, "Could not this <u>Man</u>, who opened the eyes of the blind, also have kept this <u>man</u> from dying?"
- John 11:47 Then the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered a council and said, "What shall we do? For this <u>Man</u> works many signs.
- John 18:14 Now it was Caiaphas who advised the Jews that it was expedient that one man (Man) should die for the people.
- John 18:17 Then the servant girl who kept the door said to Peter, "You are not also *one* of this Man's disciples, are you?" He said, "I am not."
- John 18:29 Pilate then went out to them and said, "What accusation do you bring against this Man?"
- John 18:40 Then they all cried again, saying, "Not this Man, but Barabbas!" Now Barabbas was a robber.
- John 19:5 Then Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. And *Pilate* said to them, "Behold the Man!"

- John 19:12 From then on Pilate sought to release Him, but the Jews cried out, saying, "If you let this <u>Man</u> go, you are not Caesar's friend. Whoever makes himself a king speaks against Caesar."
- Acts 5:28 Saying, "Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this <u>Man</u>'s blood on us!"
- Acts 8:10 To whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, "This man (Man) is the great power of God."
- Acts 13:38 Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that through this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins;
- Acts 17:31 Because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by <u>the Man</u> whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead.
- Acts 2:22 Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a <u>Man</u> attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know—
- Romans 5:18 Therefore, as through one man's offense *judgment came* to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act *the free gift came* to all men, resulting in justification of life.
- 1 Corinthians 15:21 For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.
- 1 Corinthians 15:45 And so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam *became* a life–giving spirit.
- 1 Corinthians 15:47 The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.
- 1 Corinthians 15:48 As *was* the *man* of dust, so also *are* those *who are made* of dust; and as *is* the heavenly *Man*, so also *are* those *who are* heavenly.
- 1 Corinthians 15:49 And as we have borne the image of the *man* of dust, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly *Man*.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus.
- Hebrews 10:12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God.

- Deuteronomy 33:1 Now this *is* the blessing with which Moses <u>the man of God</u> blessed the children of Israel before his death.
- Joshua 14:6 Then the children of Judah came to Joshua in Gilgal. And Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite said to him: "You know the word which the LORD said to Moses <u>the man of God</u> concerning you and me in Kadesh Barnea.
- Judges 13:8 Then Manoah prayed to the LORD, and said, "O my Lord, please let <u>the Man of God</u> whom You sent come to us again and teach us what we shall do for the child who will be born."

- 1 Samuel 9:7 Then Saul said to his servant, "But look, *if* we go, what shall we bring the man? For the bread in our vessels is all gone, and *there is* no present to bring to <u>the man of God</u>. What do we have?"
- 1 Samuel 9:8 And the servant answered Saul again and said, "Look, I have here at hand one fourth of a shekel of silver. I will give *that* to <u>the man of God</u>, to tell us our way."
- 1 Samuel 9:10 Then Saul said to his servant, "Well said; come, let us go." So they went to the city where the man of God was.
- 1 Kings 12:22 But the word of God came to Shemaiah the man of God, saying,
- 1 Kings 13:4 So it came to pass when King Jeroboam heard the saying of <u>the man of God</u>, who cried out against the altar in Bethel, that he stretched out his hand from the altar, saying, "Arrest him!" Then his hand, which he stretched out toward him, withered, so that he could not pull it back to himself.
- 1 Kings 13:5 The altar also was split apart, and the ashes poured out from the altar, according to the sign which the man of God had given by the word of the LORD.
- 1 Kings 13:6 Then the king answered and said to <u>the man of God</u>, "Please entreat the favor of the LORD your God, and pray for me, that my hand may be restored to me." So <u>the man of God</u> entreated the LORD, and the king's hand was restored to him, and became as before.
- 1 Kings 13:7 Then the king said to the man of God, "Come home with me and refresh yourself, and I will give you a reward."
- 1 Kings 13:8 But the man of God said to the king, "If you were to give me half your house, I would not go in with you; nor would I eat bread nor drink water in this place.
- 1 Kings 13:11 Now an old prophet dwelt in Bethel, and his sons came and told him all the works that <u>the</u> <u>man of God</u> had done that day in Bethel; they also told their father the words which he had spoken to the king.
- 1 Kings 13:12 And their father said to them, "Which way did he go?" For his sons had seen which way the man of God went who came from Judah.
- 1 Kings 13:14 and went after the man of God, and found him sitting under an oak. Then he said to him, "Are you the man of God who came from Judah?" And he said, "I am."
- 1 Kings 13:21 and he cried out to <u>the man of God</u> who came from Judah, saying, "Thus says the LORD: Because you have disobeyed the word of the LORD, and have not kept the commandment which the LORD your God commanded you,
- 1 Kings 13:26 Now when the prophet who had brought him back from the way heard *it*, he said, "It *is* <u>the</u> <u>man of God</u> who was disobedient to the word of the LORD. Therefore the LORD has delivered him to the lion, which has torn him and killed him, according to the word of the LORD which He spoke to him."
- 1 Kings 13:29 And the prophet took up the corpse of <u>the man of God</u>, laid it on the donkey, and brought it back. So the old prophet came to the city to mourn, and to bury him.
- 1 Kings 13:31 So it was, after he had buried him, that he spoke to his sons, saying, "When I am dead, then bury me in the tomb where the man of God *is* buried; lay my bones beside his bones.

- 2 Kings 4:7 Then she came and told <u>the man of God</u>. And he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debt; and you *and* your sons live on the rest."
- 2 Kings 4:21 And she went up and laid him on the bed of <u>the man of God</u>, shut *the door* upon him, and went out.
- 2 Kings 4:22 Then she called to her husband, and said, "Please send me one of the young men and one of the donkeys, that I may run to the man of God and come back."
- 2 Kings 4:25 And so she departed, and went to <u>the man of God</u> at Mount Carmel. So it was, when <u>the man</u> <u>of God</u> saw her afar off, that he said to his servant Gehazi, "Look, the Shunammite woman!.
- 2 Kings 4:27 Now when she came to <u>the man of God</u> at the hill, she caught him by the feet, but Gehazi came near to push her away. But <u>the man of God</u> said, "Let her alone; for her soul *is* in deep distress, and the LORD has hidden *it* from me, and has not told me."
- 2 Kings 4:42 Then a man came from Baal Shalisha, and brought <u>the man of God</u> bread of the firstfruits, twenty loaves of barley bread, and newly ripened grain in his knapsack. And he said, "Give *it* to the people, that they may eat."
- 2 Kings 5:8 So it was, when Elisha <u>the man of God</u> heard that the king of Israel had torn his clothes, that he sent to the king, saying, "Why have you torn your clothes? Please let him come to me, and he shall know that there is a prophet in Israel."
- 2 Kings 5:14 So he went down and dipped seven times in the Jordan, according to the saying of <u>the man of</u> <u>God</u>; and his flesh was restored like the flesh of a little child, and he was clean.
- 2 Kings 5:15 And he returned to <u>the man of God</u>, he and all his aides, and came and stood before him; and he said, "Indeed, now I know that *there is* no God in all the earth, except in Israel; now therefore, please take a gift from your servant."
- 2 Kings 5:20 But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha <u>the man of God</u>, said, "Look, my master has spared Naaman this Syrian, while not receiving from his hands what he brought; but *as* the LORD lives, I will run after him and take something from him."
- 2 Kings 6:6 So the man of God said, "Where did it fall?" And he showed him the place. So he cut off a stick, and threw *it* in there; and he made the iron float.
- 2 Kings 6:9 And <u>the man of God</u> sent to the king of Israel, saying, "Beware that you do not pass this place, for the Syrians are coming down there."
- 2 Kings 6:10 Then the king of Israel sent *someone* to the place of which <u>the man of God</u> had told him. Thus he warned him, and he was watchful there, not just once or twice.
- 2 Kings 6:15 And when the servant of <u>the man of God</u> arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?"
- 2 Kings 7:2 So an officer on whose hand the king leaned answered <u>the man of God</u> and said, "Look, *if* the LORD would make windows in heaven, could this thing be?" And he said, "In fact, you shall see *it* with your eyes, but you shall not eat of it."

- 2 Kings 7:17 Now the king had appointed the officer on whose hand he leaned to have charge of the gate. But the people trampled him in the gate, and he died, just as <u>the man of God</u> had said, who spoke when the king came down to him.
- 2 Kings 7:18 So it happened just as <u>the man of God</u> had spoken to the king, saying, "Two seahs of barley for a shekel, and a seah of fine flour for a shekel, shall be *sold* tomorrow about this time in the gate of Samaria."
- 2 Kings 7:19 Then that officer had answered <u>the man of God</u>, and said, "Now look, *if* the LORD would make windows in heaven, could such a thing be?" And he had said, "In fact, you shall see *it* with your eyes, but you shall not eat of it."
- 2 Kings 8:2 So the woman arose and did according to the saying of <u>the man of God</u>, and she went with her household and dwelt in the land of the Philistines seven years.
- 2 Kings 8:4 Then the king talked with Gehazi, the servant of <u>the man of God</u>, saying, "Tell me, please, all the great things Elisha has done."
- 2 Kings 8:7 Then Elisha went to Damascus, and Ben–Hadad king of Syria was sick; and it was told him, saying, "The man of God has come here."
- 2 Kings 8:8 And the king said to Hazael, "Take a present in your hand, and go to meet the man of God, and inquire of the LORD by him, saying, 'Shall I recover from this disease?"
- 2 Kings 8:11 Then he set his countenance in a stare until he was ashamed; and the man of God wept.
- 2 Kings 13:19 And the man of God was angry with him, and said, "You should have struck five or six times; then you would have struck Syria till you had destroyed *it*! But now you will strike Syria *only* three times."
- 2 Kings 23:16 As Josiah turned, he saw the tombs that *were* there on the mountain. And he sent and took the bones out of the tombs and burned *them* on the altar, and defiled it according to the word of the LORD which the man of God proclaimed, who proclaimed these words.
- 2 Kings 23:17 Then he said, "What gravestone *is* this that I see?" So the men of the city told him, "*It is* the tomb of <u>the man of God</u> who came from Judah and proclaimed these things which you have done against the altar of Bethel."
- 1 Chronicles 23:14 Now the sons of Moses the man of God were reckoned to the tribe of Levi.
- 2 Chronicles 8:14 And, according to the order of David his father, he appointed the divisions of the priests for their service, the Levites for their duties (to praise and serve before the priests) as the duty of each day required, and the gatekeepers by their divisions at each gate; for so David <u>the man of God</u> had commanded.
- 2 Chronicles 11:2 But the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah the man of God, saying.
- 2 Chronicles 25:9 Then Amaziah said to <u>the man of God</u>, "But what *shall we* do about the hundred talents which I have given to the troops of Israel?" And <u>the man of God</u> answered, "The LORD is able to give you much more than this."

- 2 Chronicles 30:16 They stood in their place according to their custom, according to the Law of Moses the man of God; the priests sprinkled the blood *received* from the hand of the Levites.
- Ezra 3:2 Then Jeshua the son of Jozadak and his brethren the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and his brethren, arose and built the altar of the God of Israel, to offer burnt offerings on it, as *it is* written in the Law of Moses the man of God.
- Nehemiah 12:24 And the heads of the Levites *were* Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with their brothers across from them, to praise *and* give thanks, group alternating with group, according to the command of David the man of God.
- Nehemiah 12:36 and his brethren, Shemaiah, Azarel, Milalai, Gilalai, Maai, Nethanel, Judah, *and* Hanani, with the musical instruments of David <u>the man of God</u>. Ezra the scribe *went* before them.
- Psalms 90:1 A Prayer of Moses the man of God. Lord, You have been our dwelling place in all generations.

Man of God (New Testament)

- 1 Timothy 6:11 But you, O man of God, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness.
- 2 Timothy 3:17 That the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Son of God (Old Testament)

Daniel 3:25 "Look!" he answered, "I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire; and they are not hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the <u>Son of God</u>."

Son of God (New Testament)

- Matthew 4:3 Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the <u>Son of God</u>, command that these stones become bread."
- Matthew 4:6 And said to Him, "If You are the <u>Son of God</u>, throw Yourself down. For it is written: 'He shall give His angels charge over you,' and, 'In *their* hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.'"
- Matthew 8:29 And suddenly they cried out, saying, "What have we to do with You, Jesus, You Son of God? Have You come here to torment us before the time?"
- Matthew 14:33 Then those who were in the boat came and worshiped Him, saying, "Truly You are the <u>Son</u> <u>of God</u>."
- Matthew 26:63 But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, "I put You under oath by the living God: Tell us if You are the Christ, the <u>Son of God</u>!"

- Matthew 27:40 And saying, "You who destroy the temple and build *it* in three days, save Yourself! If You are the <u>Son of God</u>, come down from the cross."
- Matthew 27:43 "He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said, T am the <u>Son</u> <u>of God</u>."
- Matthew 27:54 So when the centurion and those with him, who were guarding Jesus, saw the earthquake and the things that had happened, they feared greatly, saying, "Truly this was the <u>Son of God</u>!"
- Mark 1:1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.
- Mark 3:11 And the unclean spirits, whenever they saw Him, fell down before Him and cried out, saying, "You are the <u>Son of God</u>."
- Mark 15:39 So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the <u>Son of God</u>!"
- Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said to her, "*The* Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the <u>Son of God</u>."
- Luke 3:38 The son of Enos, the son of Seth, the son of Adam, the son of God.
- Luke 4:3 And the devil said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread."
- Luke 4:9 Then he brought Him to Jerusalem, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, "If You are the <u>Son of God</u>, throw Yourself down from here.
- Luke 4:41 And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, "You are the Christ, the <u>Son of God</u>!" And He, rebuking *them*, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Christ.
- Luke 22:70 Then they all said, "Are You then the <u>Son of God</u>?" So He said to them, "You *rightly* say that I am."
- John 1:34 And I have seen and testified that this is the Son of God.
- John 1:49 Nathanael answered and said to Him, "Rabbi, You are the <u>Son of God</u>! You are the King of Israel!"
- John 3:18 He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten <u>Son of God</u>.
- John 5:25 Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the <u>Son of God</u>; and those who hear will live.
- John 9:35 Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, "Do you believe in the Son of God?"
- John 10:36 Do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, I am the <u>Son of God</u>?

- John 11:4 When Jesus heard *that*, He said, "This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it."
- John 11:27 She said to Him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the <u>Son of God</u>, who is to come into the world."
- John 19:7 The Jews answered him, "We have a law, and according to our law He ought to die, because He made Himself the <u>Son of God</u>."
- John 20:31 But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the <u>Son of God</u>, and that believing you may have life in His name.
- Acts 8:37 Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the <u>Son of God</u>."
- Acts 9:20 Immediately he preached the Christ in the synagogues, that He is the Son of God.
- Romans 1:4 *and* declared *to be* the <u>Son of God</u> with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.
- 2 Corinthians 1:19 For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us—by me, Silvanus, and Timothy—was not Yes and No, but in Him was Yes.
- Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the <u>Son of God</u>, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
- Ephesians 4:13 Till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the <u>Son of God</u>, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;
- Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* confession.
- Hebrews 6:6 If they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put *Him* to an open shame.
- Hebrews 7:3 Without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the <u>Son of God</u>, remains a priest continually.
- Hebrews 10:29 Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the <u>Son of God</u> underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?
- 1 John 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the <u>Son</u> <u>of God</u> was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- 1 John 4:15 Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.
- 1 John 5:5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?
- 1 John 5:10 He who believes in the <u>Son of God</u> has the witness in himself; he who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son.
