## Treasures In The Presence of God

One thing I have desired of the LORD, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the LORD, And to inquire in His temple. For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; In the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. Psalm 27:4

- Genesis 27:7 'Bring me game and make savory food for me, that I may eat it and bless you in the presence of the LORD before my death.' [Authority to Bless]
- Deuteronomy 4:37 And because He loved your fathers, therefore He chose their descendants after them; and He brought you out of Egypt with His Presence, with His mighty power. [Deliverance, Direction and Protection]
- Judges 18:6 And the priest said to them, "Go in peace. The presence of the LORD be with you on your way. [Peace]
- 2 Chronicles 20:9 'If disaster comes upon us—sword, judgment, pestilence, or famine—we will stand before this temple and in Your presence (for Your name is in this temple), and cry out to You in our affliction, and You will hear and save.' [Salvation]
- Job 1:12 And the LORD said to Satan, "Behold, all that he has is in your power; **only do not** lay a hand on his person." So Satan went out from the presence of the LORD. [Boundaries]
- Job 23:15 Therefore I am terrified at His presence; When I consider this, I am afraid of Him. **[Fear of the Lord]**
- Psalm 9:3 When my enemies turn back, They shall fall and perish at Your presence. [Protection]
- Psalm 16:11 You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore. **[Complete Joy]**
- Psalm 17:2 Let my vindication come from Your presence; Let Your eyes look on the things that are upright. [Vindication and Justification]

- Psalm 21:6 For You have made him most blessed forever; You have made him exceedingly glad with Your presence. [Blessedness]
- Psalm 27:4 One thing I have desired of the LORD, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the LORD All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the LORD, And to inquire in His temple. - Psalm 29:9 The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth, And strips the forests bare; And in His temple everyone says, "Glory!" [Glory and Worship]
- Psalm 31:20 You shall hide them in the secret place of Your presence From the plots of man; You shall keep them secretly in a pavilion From the strife of tongues. [Protection]
- Psalm 76:7 You, Yourself, are to be feared; And who may stand in Your presence When once You are angry? [Fear of the Lord]
- Psalm 95:2 Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms. **[Gratitude]**
- Psalm 97:5 The mountains melt like wax at the presence of the LORD, At the presence of the Lord of the whole earth. [Power and Might]
- Psalm 100:2 Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His presence with singing. [Gladness]
- Psalm 114:7 Tremble, O earth, at the presence of the Lord, At the presence of the God of Jacob. [Majesty]
- Psalm 140:13 Surely the righteous shall give thanks to Your name; The upright shall dwell in Your presence. [Peace and Safety]
- Isaiah 6:1, 7-8 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His [robe] filled the temple... And he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, And your sin purged." Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me." [Cleansing and Obedience]
- Isaiah 19:1 The burden against Egypt. Behold, the LORD rides on a swift cloud, And will come into Egypt; The idols of Egypt will totter at His presence, And the heart of Egypt will melt in its midst. [Divine Uniqueness]
- Isaiah 63:9 In all their affliction He was afflicted, And the Angel of His Presence saved them; In His love and in His pity He redeemed them; And He bore them and carried them All the days of old. [Salvation and Redemption]
- Isaiah 64:1-3 Oh, that You would rend the heavens! That You would come down! That the mountains might shake at Your presence—As fire burns brushwood, As fire causes water to boil—To make Your name known to Your adversaries, That the nations may tremble at Your presence! When You did awesome things for which we did not look, You came down, The mountains shook at Your presence. [Power and Majesty]

- Jeremiah 4:26 I beheld, and indeed the fruitful land was a wilderness, And all its cities were broken down At the presence of the LORD, By His fierce anger. [Judgment]
- Nahum 1:5 The mountains quake before Him, The hills melt, And the earth heaves at His presence, Yes, the world and all who dwell in it. [Power and Might]
- Zephaniah 1:7 Be silent in the presence of the Lord GOD; For the day of the LORD is at hand, For the LORD has prepared a sacrifice; He has invited His guests. **[Fear of the Lord]**
- Haggai 1:12 Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him; and the people feared the presence of the LORD. [Fear of the Lord]
- Acts 3:19 Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord. [Times of Refreshing]
- 1 Corinthians 1:29 That no flesh should glory in His presence. [Holiness]
- Acts 2:28 You have made known to me the ways of life; You will make me full of joy in Your presence.' [Complete Joy]
