Tribulations

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Romans 8:35

When Immanuel takes us back into memories that involve circumstances out of our control, our assessment of His heart toward us changes from blaming Him to clinging to Him. To know Him for who He really is no matter what has happened to us, assures us of His love, mercy and goodness.

Tribulations

- 1 Samuel 10:19 But you have today rejected your God, who Himself saved you from all your adversities and your <u>tribulations</u>; and you have said to Him, 'No, set a king over us!' Now therefore, present yourselves before the LORD by your tribes and by your clans.
- Acts 14:22 Strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting *them* to continue in the faith, and *saying*, "We must through many <u>tribulations</u> enter the kingdom of God."
- Acts 20:23 Except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me.
- Romans 5:3 And not only *that*, but we also glory in <u>tribulations</u>, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance.
- 2 Corinthians 6:4 But in all *things* we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in <u>tribulations</u>, in needs, in distresses.
- Ephesians 3:13 Therefore I ask that you do not lose heart at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:4 So that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and <u>tribulations</u> that you endure.
- Hebrews 10:33 Partly while you were made a spectacle both by reproaches and <u>tribulations</u>, and partly while you became companions of those who were so treated.

Tribulation

- 1 Samuel 26:24 And indeed, as your life was valued much this day in my eyes, so let my life be valued much in the eyes of the LORD, and let Him deliver me out of all <u>tribulation</u>.
- Matthew 13:21 Yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when <u>tribulation</u> or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles.
- Matthew 24:9 Then they will deliver you up to <u>tribulation</u> and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake.
- Matthew 24:21 For then there will be great <u>tribulation</u>, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.
- Matthew 24:29 Immediately after the <u>tribulation</u> of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.
- Mark 4:17 And they have no root in themselves, and so endure only for a time. Afterward, when <u>tribulation</u> or persecution arises for the word's sake, immediately they stumble.
- Mark 13:19 For *in* those days there will be <u>tribulation</u>, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be.
- Mark 13:24 But in those days, after that <u>tribulation</u>, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light.
- John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have <u>tribulation</u>; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.
- Romans 2:9 <u>Tribulation</u> and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek.
- Romans 5:3 And not only *that*, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that <u>tribulation</u> produces perseverance;
- Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* <u>tribulation</u>, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- Romans 12:12 Rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer.
- 2 Corinthians 1:4 Who comforts us in all our <u>tribulation</u>, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.
- 2 Corinthians 7:4 Great *is* my boldness of speech toward you, great *is* my boasting on your behalf. I am filled with comfort. I am exceedingly joyful in all our <u>tribulation</u>.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:4 For, in fact, we told you before when we were with you that we would suffer <u>tribulation</u>, just as it happened, and you know.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:6 since it is a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you.

- Revelation 1:9 I, John, both your brother and companion in the <u>tribulation</u> and kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was on the island that is called Patmos for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.
- Revelation 2:9 I know your works, <u>tribulation</u>, and poverty (but you are rich); and *I know* the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but *are* a synagogue of Satan.
- Revelation 2:10 Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw *some* of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have <u>tribulation</u> ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.
- Revelation 2:22 Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds.
- Revelation 7:14 And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great <u>tribulation</u>, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb."

Distress

- Genesis 35:3 Then let us arise and go up to Bethel; and I will make an altar there to God, who answered me in the day of my <u>distress</u> and has been with me in the way which I have gone.
- Genesis 42:21 Then they said to one another, "We *are* truly guilty concerning our brother, for we saw the anguish of his soul when he pleaded with us, and we would not hear; therefore this <u>distress</u> has come upon us."
- Deuteronomy 4:30 When you are in <u>distress</u>, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, when you turn to the LORD your God and obey His voice.
- Deuteronomy 28:53 You shall eat the fruit of your own body, the flesh of your sons and your daughters whom the LORD your God has given you, in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall distress you.
- Deuteronomy 28:55 So that he will not give any of them the flesh of his children whom he will eat, because he has nothing left in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall <u>distress</u> you at all your gates.
- Deuteronomy 28:57 Her placenta which comes out from between her feet and her children whom she bears; for she will eat them secretly for lack of everything in the siege and desperate straits in which your enemy shall <u>distress</u> you at all your gates.
- Judges 10:14 Go and cry out to the gods which you have chosen; let them deliver you in your time of distress.
- Judges 11:7 So Jephthah said to the elders of Gilead, "Did you not hate me, and expel me from my father's house? Why have you come to me now when you are in <u>distress</u>?"
- 1 Samuel 22:2 And everyone *who was* in <u>distress</u>, everyone who *was* in debt, and everyone *who was* discontented gathered to him. So he became captain over them. And there were about four hundred men with him.

- 2 Samuel 22:7 In my distress I called upon the LORD, And cried out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry *entered* His ears.
- 2 Samuel 24:14 And David said to Gad, "I am in great distress. Please let us fall into the hand of the LORD, for His mercies *are* great; but do not let me fall into the hand of man."
- 1 Kings 1:29 And the king took an oath and said, "As the LORD lives, who has redeemed my life from every distress.
- 2 Kings 4:27 Now when she came to the man of God at the hill, she caught him by the feet, but Gehazi came near to push her away. But the man of God said, "Let her alone; for her soul *is* in deep <u>distress</u>, and the LORD has hidden *it* from me, and has not told me."
- 1 Chronicles 21:13 And David said to Gad, "I am in great <u>distress</u>. Please let me fall into the hand of the LORD, for His mercies *are* very great; but do not let me fall into the hand of man."
- 2 Chronicles 28:22 Now in the time of his <u>distress</u> King Ahaz became increasingly unfaithful to the LORD. This *is that* King Ahaz.
- Nehemiah 1:3 And they said to me, "The survivors who are left from the captivity in the province *are* there in great <u>distress</u> and reproach. The wall of Jerusalem *is* also broken down, and its gates are burned with fire."
- Nehemiah 2:17 Then I said to them, "You see the <u>distress</u> that we *are* in, how Jerusalem *lies* waste, and its gates are burned with fire. Come and let us build the wall of Jerusalem, that we may no longer be a reproach."
- Nehemiah 9:37 And it yields much increase to the kings You have set over us, Because of our sins; Also they have dominion over our bodies and our cattle At their pleasure; And we *are* in great <u>distress</u>.
- Job 20:22 In his self-sufficiency he will be in distress; Every hand of misery will come against him.
- Job 36:16 "Indeed He would have brought you out of dire <u>distress</u>, *Into* a broad place where *there is* no restraint; And what is set on your table *would be* full of richness.
- Job 36:19 Will your riches, Or all the mighty forces, Keep you from distress?
- Psalms 2:5 Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure.
- Psalms 4:1 To the Chief Musician. With stringed instruments. A Psalm of David. Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in *my* distress; Have mercy on me, and hear my prayer.
- Psalms 18:6 In my <u>distress</u> I called upon the LORD, And cried out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry came before Him, *even* to His ears.
- Psalms 118:5 I called on the LORD in distress; The LORD answered me and set me in a broad place.
- Psalms 120:1 A Song of Ascents. In my distress I cried to the LORD, And He heard me.
- Proverbs 1:27 When your terror comes like a storm, And your destruction comes like a whirlwind, When <u>distress</u> and anguish come upon you.

- Isaiah 21:15 For they fled from the swords, from the drawn sword, From the bent bow, and from the distress of war.
- Isaiah 25:4 For You have been a strength to the poor, A strength to the needy in his <u>distress</u>, A refuge from the storm, A shade from the heat; For the blast of the terrible ones *is* as a storm *against* the wall.
- Isaiah 29:2 Yet I will distress Ariel; There shall be heaviness and sorrow, And it shall be to Me as Ariel.
- Isaiah 29:7 The multitude of all the nations who fight against Ariel, Even all who fight against her and her fortress, And distress her, Shall be as a dream of a night vision.
- Jeremiah 10:18 For thus says the LORD: "Behold, I will throw out at this time The inhabitants of the land, And will distress them, That they may find it so."
- Lamentations 1:20 See, O LORD, that I *am* in <u>distress</u>; My soul is troubled; My heart is overturned within me, For I have been very rebellious. Outside the sword bereaves, At home *it is* like death.
- Ezekiel 30:16 And set a fire in Egypt; Sin shall have great pain, No shall be split open, And Noph *shall be in* distress daily.
- Obadiah 1:12 But you should not have gazed on the day of your brother In the day of his captivity; Nor should you have rejoiced over the children of Judah In the day of their destruction; Nor should you have spoken proudly In the day of distress.
- Obadiah 1:14 You should not have stood at the crossroads To cut off those among them who escaped; Nor should you have delivered up those among them who remained In the day of <u>distress</u>.
- Zephaniah 1:15 That day is a day of wrath, A day of trouble and distress, A day of devastation and desolation, A day of darkness and gloominess, A day of clouds and thick darkness.
- Zephaniah 1:17 I will bring <u>distress</u> upon men, And they shall walk like blind men, Because they have sinned against the LORD; Their blood shall be poured out like dust, And their flesh like refuse.
- Luke 21:23 But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great <u>distress</u> in the land and wrath upon this people.
- Luke 21:25 And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth <u>distress</u> of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring.
- Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or <u>distress</u>, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- 1 Corinthians 7:26 I suppose therefore that this is good because of the present <u>distress</u>—that *it is* good for a man to remain as he is.
- Philippians 4:14 Nevertheless you have done well that you shared in my distress.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:7 Therefore, brethren, in all our affliction and <u>distress</u> we were comforted concerning you by your faith.

Distressed

- Genesis 32:7 So Jacob was greatly afraid and <u>distressed</u>; and he divided the people that *were* with him, and the flocks and herds and camels, into two companies.
- Judges 2:15 Wherever they went out, the hand of the LORD was against them for calamity, as the LORD had said, and as the LORD had sworn to them. And they were greatly <u>distressed</u>.
- Judges 10:9 Moreover the people of Ammon crossed over the Jordan to fight against Judah also, against Benjamin, and against the house of Ephraim, so that Israel was severely <u>distressed</u>.
- 1 Samuel 13:6 When the men of Israel saw that they were in danger (for the people were <u>distressed</u>), then the people hid in caves, in thickets, in rocks, in holes, and in pits.
- 1 Samuel 14:24 And the men of Israel were <u>distressed</u> that day, for Saul had placed the people under oath, saying, "Cursed *is* the man who eats *any* food until evening, before I have taken vengeance on my enemies." So none of the people tasted food.
- 1 Samuel 28:15 Now Samuel said to Saul, "Why have you disturbed me by bringing me up?" And Saul answered, "I am deeply <u>distressed</u>; for the Philistines make war against me, and God has departed from me and does not answer me anymore, neither by prophets nor by dreams. Therefore I have called you, that you may reveal to me what I should do."
- 1 Samuel 30:6 Now David was greatly <u>distressed</u>, for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the LORD his God.
- 2 Samuel 1:26 I am <u>distressed</u> for you, my brother Jonathan; You have been very pleasant to me; Your love to me was wonderful, Surpassing the love of women.
- 2 Samuel 13:2 Amnon was so <u>distressed</u> over his sister Tamar that he became sick; for she *was* a virgin. And it was improper for Amnon to do anything to her.
- 2 Chronicles 28:20 Also Tiglath–Pileser king of Assyria came to him and <u>distressed</u> him, and did not assist him.
- Esther 4:4 So Esther's maids and eunuchs came and told her, and the queen was deeply <u>distressed</u>. Then she sent garments to clothe Mordecai and take his sackcloth away from him, but he would not accept *them*.
- Psalms 143:4 Therefore my spirit is overwhelmed within me; My heart within me is distressed.
- Isaiah 9:1 Nevertheless the gloom *will* not *be* upon her who *is* <u>distressed</u>, As when at first He lightly esteemed The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, And afterward more heavily oppressed *her*, *By* the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, In Galilee of the Gentiles.
- Isaiah 21:3 Therefore my loins are filled with pain; Pangs have taken hold of me, like the pangs of a woman in labor. I was <u>distressed</u> when *I* heard *it*; I was dismayed when *I* saw *it*.
- Matthew 26:37 And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and He began to be sorrowful and deeply <u>distressed</u>.

- Mark 14:33 And He took Peter, James, and John with Him, and He began to be troubled and deeply distressed.
- Luke 12:50 But I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how distressed I am till it is accomplished!
- Philippians 2:26 Since he was longing for you all, and was distressed because you had heard that he was sick.

Persecution

- Matthew 13:21 Yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles.
- Mark 4:17 And they have no root in themselves, and so endure only for a time. Afterward, when tribulation or <u>persecution</u> arises for the word's sake, immediately they stumble.
- Acts 8:1 Now Saul was consenting to his death. At that time a great <u>persecution</u> arose against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.
- Acts 11:19 Now those who were scattered after the <u>persecution</u> that arose over Stephen traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to no one but the Jews only.
- Acts 13:50 But the Jews stirred up the devout and prominent women and the chief men of the city, raised up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region.
- Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress, or <u>persecution</u>, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- Galatians 5:11 And I, brethren, if I still preach circumcision, why do I still suffer persecution? Then the offense of the cross has ceased.
- Galatians 6:12 As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these *would* compel you to be circumcised, only that they may not suffer <u>persecution</u> for the cross of Christ.

Persecutions

- 2 Timothy 3:12 Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.
- Mark 10:30 Who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with <u>persecutions</u>—and in the age to come, eternal life.
- 2 Corinthians 12:10 Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in <u>persecutions</u>, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:4 So that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your <u>persecutions</u> and tribulations that you endure.

2 Timothy 3:10-11 But you have carefully followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, love, perseverance, <u>persecutions</u>, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra—what <u>persecutions</u> I endured. And out of *them* all the Lord delivered me.

Famine (with "Lord")

- Genesis 42:33 Then the man, the <u>lord</u> of the country, said to us, 'By this I will know that you *are* honest *men*: Leave one of your brothers *here* with me, take *food for* the <u>famine</u> of your households, and be gone.
- 2 Samuel 21:1 Now there was a <u>famine</u> in the days of David for three years, year after year; and David inquired of the <u>LORD</u>. And the <u>LORD</u> answered, "*It is* because of Saul and *his* bloodthirsty house, because he killed the Gibeonites."
- 2 Kings 8:1 Then Elisha spoke to the woman whose son he had restored to life, saying, "Arise and go, you and your household, and stay wherever you can; for the <u>LORD</u> has called for a <u>famine</u>, and furthermore, it will come upon the land for seven years."
- 1 Chronicles 21:12 Either three years of <u>famine</u>, or three months to be defeated by your foes with the sword of your enemies overtaking *you*, or else for three days the sword of the <u>LORD</u>—the plague in the land, with the angel of the <u>LORD</u> destroying throughout all the territory of Israel.' Now consider what answer I should take back to Him who sent me.
- 2 Chronicles 32:11 'Does not Hezekiah persuade you to give yourselves over to die by <u>famine</u> and by thirst, saying, "The <u>LORD</u> our God will deliver us from the hand of the king of Assyria"?
- Jeremiah 5:12 They have lied about the <u>LORD</u>, And said, "*It is* not He. Neither will evil come upon us, Nor shall we see sword or <u>famine</u>."
- Jeremiah 11:22 Therefore thus says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts: Behold, I will punish them. The young men shall die by the sword, their sons and their daughters shall die by <u>famine</u>.
- Jeremiah 14:13 Then I said, "Ah, <u>Lord</u> GOD! Behold, the prophets say to them, 'You shall not see the sword, nor shall you have <u>famine</u>, but I will give you assured peace in this place."
- Jeremiah 14:15 Therefore thus says the <u>LORD</u> concerning the prophets who prophesy in My name, whom I did not send, and who say, 'Sword and <u>famine</u> shall not be in this land' —'By sword and <u>famine</u> those prophets shall be consumed!
- Jeremiah 15:2 And it shall be, if they say to you, 'Where should we go?' then you shall tell them, 'Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: "Such as *are* for death, to death; And such as *are* for the sword, to the sword; And such as *are* for the <u>famine</u>, to the <u>famine</u>; And such as *are* for the captivity, to the captivity.'
- Jeremiah 21:7 "And afterward," says the <u>LORD</u>, "I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, his servants and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence and the sword and the <u>famine</u>, into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those who seek their life; and he shall strike them with the edge of the sword. He shall not spare them, or have pity or mercy."

- Jeremiah 27:8 'And it shall be, *that* the nation and kingdom which will not serve Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and which will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation I will punish,' says the <u>LORD</u>, 'with the sword, the <u>famine</u>, and the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.
- Jeremiah 27:13 Why will you die, you and your people, by the sword, by the <u>famine</u>, and by the pestilence, as the <u>LORD</u> has spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?
- Jeremiah 29:17 thus says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts: Behold, I will send on them the sword, the <u>famine</u>, and the pestilence, and will make them like rotten figs that cannot be eaten, they are so bad.
- Jeremiah 32:36 Now therefore, thus says the <u>LORD</u>, the God of Israel, concerning this city of which you say, 'It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon by the sword, by the <u>famine</u>, and by the pestilence'.
- Jeremiah 34:17 Therefore thus says the <u>LORD</u>: 'You have not obeyed Me in proclaiming liberty, every one to his brother and every one to his neighbor. Behold, I proclaim liberty to you,' says the <u>LORD</u>—'to the sword, to pestilence, and to <u>famine!</u> And I will deliver you to trouble among all the kingdoms of the earth.
- Jeremiah 38:2 Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: 'He who remains in this city shall die by the sword, by <u>famine</u>, and by pestilence; but he who goes over to the Chaldeans shall live; his life shall be as a prize to him, and he shall live.'
- Ezekiel 5:17 'So I will send against you <u>famine</u> and wild beasts, and they will bereave you. Pestilence and blood shall pass through you, and I will bring the sword against you. I, the <u>LORD</u>, have spoken.'
- Ezekiel 6:11 'Thus says the <u>Lord GOD</u>: "Pound your fists and stamp your feet, and say, 'Alas, for all the evil abominations of the house of Israel! For they shall fall by the sword, by <u>famine</u>, and by pestilence."
- Ezekiel 12:16 But I will spare a few of their men from the sword, from <u>famine</u>, and from pestilence, that they may declare all their abominations among the Gentiles wherever they go. Then they shall know that I *am* the <u>LORD</u>.
- Ezekiel 14:21 For thus says the <u>Lord</u> GOD: "How much more it shall be when I send My four severe judgments on Jerusalem—the sword and <u>famine</u> and wild beasts and pestilence—to cut off man and beast from it?"
- Amos 8:11 "Behold, the days are coming," says the <u>Lord GOD</u>, "That I will send a <u>famine</u> on the land, Not a <u>famine</u> of bread, Nor a thirst for water, But of hearing the words of the <u>LORD</u>."

Famine (New Testament)

- Luke 4:25 But I tell you truly, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, and there was a great <u>famine</u> throughout all the land.
- Luke 15:14 But when he had spent all, there arose a severe famine in that land, and he began to be in want.
- Acts 7:11 Now a <u>famine</u> and great trouble came over all the land of Egypt and Canaan, and our fathers found no sustenance.

- Acts 11:28 Then one of them, named Agabus, stood up and showed by the Spirit that there was going to be a great <u>famine</u> throughout all the world, which also happened in the days of Claudius Caesar.
- Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or <u>famine</u>, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
- Revelation 18:8 Therefore her plagues will come in one day—death and mourning and <u>famine</u>. And she will be utterly burned with fire, for strong *is* the Lord God who judges her.

Nakedness (with "Lord")

- Leviticus 18:6 'None of you shall approach anyone who is near of kin to him, to uncover his <u>nakedness</u>: I *am* the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 28:48 Therefore you shall serve your enemies, whom the <u>LORD</u> will send against you, in hunger, in thirst, in <u>nakedness</u>, and in need of everything; and He will put a yoke of iron on your neck until He has destroyed you.
- Ezekiel 16:8 When I passed by you again and looked upon you, indeed your time *was* the time of love; so I spread My wing over you and covered your <u>nakedness</u>. Yes, I swore an oath to you and entered into a covenant with you, and you became Mine," says the <u>Lord GOD</u>.
- Ezekiel 16:36 'Thus says the <u>Lord GOD</u>: "Because your filthiness was poured out and your <u>nakedness</u> uncovered in your harlotry with your lovers, and with all your abominable idols, and because of the blood of your children which you gave to them.
- Nahum 3:5 "Behold, I *am* against you," says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts; "I will lift your skirts over your face, I will show the nations your <u>nakedness</u>, And the kingdoms your shame."

Nakedness (with "Lord")

- Leviticus 18:6 None of you shall approach anyone who is near of kin to him, to uncover his <u>nakedness</u>: I *am* the <u>LORD</u>.
- Deuteronomy 28:48 Therefore you shall serve your enemies, whom the <u>LORD</u> will send against you, in hunger, in thirst, in <u>nakedness</u>, and in need of everything; and He will put a yoke of iron on your neck until He has destroyed you.
- Ezekiel 16:8 When I passed by you again and looked upon you, indeed your time *was* the time of love; so I spread My wing over you and covered your <u>nakedness</u>. Yes, I swore an oath to you and entered into a covenant with you, and you became Mine," says the <u>Lord GOD</u>.
- Ezekiel 16:36 Thus says the <u>Lord</u> GOD: "Because your filthiness was poured out and your <u>nakedness</u> uncovered in your harlotry with your lovers, and with all your abominable idols, and because of the blood of your children which you gave to them.
- Nahum 3:5 "Behold, I am against you," says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts; "I will lift your skirts over your face, I will show the nations your <u>nakedness</u>, And the kingdoms your shame."

Nakedness (New Testament)

- Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or <u>nakedness</u>, or peril, or sword?
- 2 Corinthians 11:27 In weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.
- Revelation 3:18 I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, *that* the shame of your <u>nakedness</u> may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.

Peril

Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or <u>nakedness</u>, or peril, or sword?

Sword (Isaiah)

- Isaiah 1:20 But if you refuse and rebel, You shall be devoured by the <u>sword</u>"; For the mouth of the <u>LORD</u> has spoken.
- Isaiah 27:1 In that day the <u>LORD</u> with His severe <u>sword</u>, great and strong, Will punish Leviathan the fleeing serpent, Leviathan that twisted serpent; And He will slay the reptile that *is* in the sea.
- Isaiah 34:6 The <u>sword</u> of the <u>LORD</u> is filled with blood, It is made overflowing with fatness, With the blood of lambs and goats, With the fat of the kidneys of rams. For the <u>LORD</u> has a sacrifice in Bozrah, And a great slaughter in the land of Edom.
- Isaiah 66:16 For by fire and by His sword The LORD will judge all flesh; And the slain of the LORD shall be many.

Sword (Jeremiah and Lamentations)

- Jeremiah 4:10 Then I said, "Ah, <u>Lord</u> GOD! Surely You have greatly deceived this people and Jerusalem, Saying, 'You shall have peace,' Whereas the <u>sword</u> reaches to the heart."
- Jeremiah 5:12 They have lied about the <u>LORD</u>, And said, "*It is* not He. Neither will evil come upon us, Nor shall we see <u>sword</u> or famine."
- Jeremiah 11:22 Therefore thus says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts: 'Behold, I will punish them. The young men shall die by the <u>sword</u>, their sons and their daughters shall die by famine;
- Jeremiah 12:12 The plunderers have come On all the desolate heights in the wilderness, For the <u>sword</u> of the <u>LORD</u> shall devour From *one* end of the land to the *other* end of the land; No flesh shall have peace.
- Jeremiah 14:13 Then I said, "Ah, <u>Lord</u> GOD! Behold, the prophets say to them, 'You shall not see the <u>sword</u>, nor shall you have famine, but I will give you assured peace in this place."

- Jeremiah 14:15 Therefore thus says the <u>LORD</u> concerning the prophets who prophesy in My name, whom I did not send, and who say, '<u>Sword</u> and famine shall not be in this land' —'By <u>sword</u> and famine those prophets shall be consumed!
- Jeremiah 15:2 "And it shall be, if they say to you, 'Where should we go?' then you shall tell them, 'Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: "Such as *are* for death, to death; And such as *are* for the <u>sword</u>, to the <u>sword</u>; And such as *are* for the famine, to the famine; And such as *are* for the captivity, to the captivity."'
- Jeremiah 15:3 And I will appoint over them four forms *of destruction*," says the <u>LORD</u>: "the <u>sword</u> to slay, the dogs to drag, the birds of the heavens and the beasts of the earth to devour and destroy.
- Jeremiah 15:9 "She languishes who has borne seven; She has breathed her last; Her sun has gone down While *it was* yet day; She has been ashamed and confounded. And the remnant of them I will deliver to the sword Before their enemies," says the <u>LORD</u>.
- Jeremiah 20:4 For thus says the <u>LORD</u>: 'Behold, I will make you a terror to yourself and to all your friends; and they shall fall by the <u>sword</u> of their enemies, and your eyes shall see *it*. I will give all Judah into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall carry them captive to Babylon and slay them with the <u>sword</u>.
- Jeremiah 21:7 "And afterward," says the <u>LORD</u>, "I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, his servants and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence and the <u>sword</u> and the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those who seek their life; and he shall strike them with the edge of the <u>sword</u>. He shall not spare them, or have pity or mercy."
- Jeremiah 25:27 "Therefore you shall say to them, 'Thus says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts, the God of Israel: "Drink, be drunk, and vomit! Fall and rise no more, because of the <u>sword</u> which I will send among you."'
- Jeremiah 25:29 For behold, I begin to bring calamity on the city which is called by My name, and should you be utterly unpunished? You shall not be unpunished, for I will call for a <u>sword</u> on all the inhabitants of the earth," says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts.'
- Jeremiah 25:31 A noise will come to the ends of the earth—For the <u>LORD</u> has a controversy with the nations; He will plead His case with all flesh. He will give those *who are* wicked to the <u>sword</u>,' says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 27:8 'And it shall be, *that* the nation and kingdom which will not serve Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and which will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation I will punish,' says the <u>LORD</u>, 'with the <u>sword</u>, the famine, and the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.
- Jeremiah 27:13 Why will you die, you and your people, by the <u>sword</u>, by the famine, and by the pestilence, as the LORD has spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?
- Jeremiah 29:17 Thus says the <u>LORD</u> of hosts: Behold, I will send on them the <u>sword</u>, the famine, and the pestilence, and will make them like rotten figs that cannot be eaten, they are so bad.
- Jeremiah 31:2 Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: "The people who survived the <u>sword</u> Found grace in the wilderness— Israel, when I went to give him rest."
- Jeremiah 32:36 Now therefore, thus says the <u>LORD</u>, the God of Israel, concerning this city of which you say, 'It shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon by the <u>sword</u>, by the famine, and by the pestilence'.

- Jeremiah 33:4 For thus says the <u>LORD</u>, the God of Israel, concerning the houses of this city and the houses of the kings of Judah, which have been pulled down *to fortify* against the siege mounds and the <u>sword</u>.
- Jeremiah 34:4 Yet hear the word of the <u>LORD</u>, O Zedekiah king of Judah! Thus says the <u>LORD</u> concerning you: You shall not die by the <u>sword</u>.
- Jeremiah 34:17 Therefore thus says the <u>LORD</u>: 'You have not obeyed Me in proclaiming liberty, every one to his brother and every one to his neighbor. Behold, I proclaim liberty to you,' says the <u>LORD</u>—'to the <u>sword</u>, to pestilence, and to famine! And I will deliver you to trouble among all the kingdoms of the earth.
- Jeremiah 38:2 Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: 'He who remains in this city shall die by the <u>sword</u>, by famine, and by pestilence; but he who goes over to the Chaldeans shall live; his life shall be as a prize to him, and he shall live.'
- Jeremiah 39:18 "For I will surely deliver you, and you shall not fall by the <u>sword</u>; but your life shall be as a prize to you, because you have put your trust in Me," says the <u>LORD</u>.
- Jeremiah 46:10 For this *is* the day of the <u>Lord</u> GOD of hosts, A day of vengeance, That He may avenge Himself on His adversaries. The <u>sword</u> shall devour; It shall be satiated and made drunk with their blood; For the <u>Lord</u> GOD of hosts has a sacrifice In the north country by the River Euphrates.
- Jeremiah 47:6 O you sword of the LORD, How long until you are quiet? Put yourself up into your scabbard, Rest and be still!
- Jeremiah 48:10 Cursed *is* he who does the work of the <u>LORD</u> deceitfully, And cursed *is* he who keeps back his <u>sword</u> from blood.
- Jeremiah 49:37 For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies And before those who seek their life. I will bring disaster upon them, My fierce anger,' says the <u>LORD</u>; 'And I will send the <u>sword</u> after them Until I have consumed them.
- Jeremiah 50:35 "A <u>sword</u> is against the Chaldeans," says the <u>LORD</u>, "Against the inhabitants of Babylon, And against her princes and her wise men."
- Jeremiah 51:50 You who have escaped the <u>sword</u>, Get away! Do not stand still! Remember the <u>LORD</u> afar off, And let Jerusalem come to your mind.
- Lamentations 1:20 See, O <u>LORD</u>, that I *am* in distress; My soul is troubled; My heart is overturned within me, For I have been very rebellious. Outside the <u>sword</u> bereaves, At home *it is* like death.

Sword (Ezekiel)

- Ezekiel 5:17 So I will send against you famine and wild beasts, and they will bereave you. Pestilence and blood shall pass through you, and I will bring the <u>sword</u> against you. I, the <u>LORD</u>, have spoken.
- Ezekiel 6:3 "and say, 'O mountains of Israel, hear the word of the <u>Lord GOD!</u>' Thus says the <u>Lord GOD</u> to the mountains, to the hills, to the ravines, and to the valleys: "Indeed I, even I, will bring a <u>sword</u> against you, and I will destroy your high places.

- Ezekiel 6:11 'Thus says the <u>Lord GOD</u>: "Pound your fists and stamp your feet, and say, 'Alas, for all the evil abominations of the house of Israel! For they shall fall by the <u>sword</u>, by famine, and by pestilence.
- Ezekiel 11:8 "You have feared the sword; and I will bring a sword upon you," says the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 11:10 "You shall fall by the <u>sword</u>. I will judge you at the border of Israel. Then you shall know that I *am* the <u>LORD</u>.
- Ezekiel 12:16 "But I will spare a few of their men from the <u>sword</u>, from famine, and from pestilence, that they may declare all their abominations among the Gentiles wherever they go. Then they shall know that I *am* the LORD."
- Ezekiel 14:21 For thus says the <u>Lord</u> GOD: "How much more it shall be when I send My four severe judgments on Jerusalem—the <u>sword</u> and famine and wild beasts and pestilence—to cut off man and beast from it?
- Ezekiel 17:21 "All his fugitives with all his troops shall fall by the <u>sword</u>, and those who remain shall be scattered to every wind; and you shall know that I, the <u>LORD</u>, have spoken."
- Ezekiel 21:3 "and say to the land of Israel, 'Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: "Behold, I *am* against you, and I will draw My <u>sword</u> out of its sheath and cut off both righteous and wicked from you.
- Ezekiel 21:5 "that all flesh may know that I, the <u>LORD</u>, have drawn My <u>sword</u> out of its sheath; it shall not return anymore."
- Ezekiel 21:9 Son of man, prophesy and say, 'Thus says the <u>LORD</u>!' Say: 'A <u>sword</u>, a <u>sword</u> is sharpened And also polished!'
- Ezekiel 21:13 "Because *it is* a testing, And what if *the <u>sword</u>* despises even the scepter? *The scepter* shall be no *more*," says the <u>Lord</u> GOD.
- Ezekiel 21:28 And you, son of man, prophesy and say, 'Thus says the <u>Lord GOD</u> concerning the Ammonites and concerning their reproach,' and say: 'A <u>sword</u>, a <u>sword</u> is drawn, Polished for slaughter, For consuming, for flashing.
- Ezekiel 24:21 'Speak to the house of Israel, "Thus says the <u>Lord</u> GOD: 'Behold, I will profane My sanctuary, your arrogant boast, the desire of your eyes, the delight of your soul; and your sons and daughters whom you left behind shall fall by the <u>sword</u>.
- Ezekiel 25:13 Therefore thus says the <u>Lord GOD</u>: "I will also stretch out My hand against Edom, cut off man and beast from it, and make it desolate from Teman; Dedan shall fall by the sword.
- Ezekiel 26:6 'Also her daughter *villages* which *are* in the fields shall be slain by the <u>sword</u>. Then they shall know that I *am* the LORD.'
- Ezekiel 28:23 For I will send pestilence upon her, And blood in her streets; The wounded shall be judged in her midst By the <u>sword</u> against her on every side; Then they shall know that I *am* the <u>LORD</u>.
- Ezekiel 29:8 Therefore thus says the <u>Lord</u> GOD: "Surely I will bring a <u>sword</u> upon you and cut off from you man and beast.

- Ezekiel 30:6 Thus says the <u>LORD</u>: "Those who uphold Egypt shall fall, And the pride of her power shall come down. From Migdol *to* Syene Those within her shall fall by the <u>sword</u>," Says the <u>Lord</u> GOD.
- Ezekiel 30:22 Therefore thus says the <u>Lord</u> GOD: 'Surely I *am* against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and will break his arms, both the strong one and the one that was broken; and I will make the <u>sword</u> fall out of his hand.
- Ezekiel 30:25 Thus I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, but the arms of Pharaoh shall fall down; they shall know that I *am* the <u>LORD</u>, when I put My <u>sword</u> into the hand of the king of Babylon and he stretches it out against the land of Egypt.
- Ezekiel 31:18 'To which of the trees in Eden will you then be likened in glory and greatness? Yet you shall be brought down with the trees of Eden to the depths of the earth; you shall lie in the midst of the uncircumcised, with *those* slain by the <u>sword</u>. This *is* Pharaoh and all his multitude,' says the <u>Lord GOD</u>."
- Ezekiel 32:11 For thus says the Lord GOD: 'The sword of the king of Babylon shall come upon you.
- Ezekiel 32:31 "Pharaoh will see them And be comforted over all his multitude, Pharaoh and all his army, Slain by the sword," Says the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 32:32 "For I have caused My terror in the land of the living; And he shall be placed in the midst of the uncircumcised With *those* slain by the <u>sword</u>, Pharaoh and all his multitude," Says the <u>Lord</u> GOD.
- Ezekiel 33:27 "Say thus to them, 'Thus says the <u>Lord</u> GOD: "As I live, surely those who *are* in the ruins shall fall by the <u>sword</u>, and the one who *is* in the open field I will give to the beasts to be devoured, and those who *are* in the strongholds and caves shall die of the pestilence."
- Ezekiel 38:21 "I will call for a <u>sword</u> against Gog throughout all My mountains," says the <u>Lord</u> GOD. "Every man's sword will be against his brother."
