Genesis 49:19 Gad, a troop shall tramp upon him, But he shall **triumph** at last.

2 Samuel 1:20 Tell *it* not in Gath, Proclaim *it* not in the streets of Ashkelon—Lest the daughters of the Philistines rejoice, Lest the daughters of the uncircumcised **triumph**.

1 Chronicles 16:35 And say, "Save us, O God of our salvation; Gather us together, and deliver us from the Gentiles, To give thanks to Your holy name, To **triumph** in Your praise."

Psalms 25:2 O my God, I trust in You; Let me not be ashamed; Let not my enemies **triumph** over me.

Psalms 41:11 By this I know that You are well pleased with me, Because my enemy does not **triumph** over me.

Psalms 47:1 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of the sons of Korah. Oh, clap your hands, all you peoples! Shout to God with the voice of **triumph**!

## Victory

Exodus 32:18 But he said: "*It is* not the noise of the shout of victory, Nor the noise of the cry of defeat, *But* the sound of singing I hear."

2 Samuel 19:2 So the victory that day was *turned* into mourning for all the people. For the people heard it said that day, "The king is grieved for his son."

2 Samuel 23:10 He arose and attacked the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand stuck to the sword. The LORD brought about a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to plunder.

2 Samuel 23:12 But he stationed himself in the middle of the field, defended it, and killed the Philistines. And the LORD brought about a great victory.

2 Kings 5:1 Now Naaman, commander of the army of the king of Syria, was a great and honorable man in the eyes of his master, because by him the LORD had given victory to Syria. He was also a mighty man of valor, *but* a leper.

1 Chronicles 11:14 But they stationed themselves in the middle of *that* field, defended it, and killed the Philistines. So the LORD brought about a great victory.

1 Chronicles 29:11 Yours, O LORD, *is* the greatness, The power and the glory, The victory and the majesty; For all *that is* in heaven and in earth *is Yours*; Yours *is* the kingdom, O LORD, And You are exalted as head over all.

Psalms 98:1 A Psalm. Oh, sing to the LORD a new song! For He has done marvelous things; His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him the victory.

Matthew 12:20 A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench, Till He sends forth justice to victory.

1 Corinthians 15:54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory."

1 Corinthians 15:55 "O Death, where *is* your sting? O Hades, where *is* your victory?"

1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks *be* to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Proverbs 18:19 A brother offended *is harder to win* than a strong city, And contentions *are* like the bars of a castle.

Matthew 23:15 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel land and sea to win one proselyte, and when he is won, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

1 Corinthians 9:19 For though I am free from all *men*, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win the more.

1 Corinthians 9:20 And to the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might win Jews; to those *who are* under the law, as under the law, that I might win those *who are* under the law.

1 Corinthians 9:21 to those *who are* without law, as without law (not being without law toward God, but under law toward Christ), that I might win those *who are* without law;

1 Corinthians 9:22 To the weak I became as weak, that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all *men*, that I might by all means save some.

2 Samuel 23:18 Now Abishai the brother of Joab, the son of Zeruiah, was chief of *another* three. He lifted his spear against three hundred *men*, killed *them*, and won a name among *these* three.

2 Samuel 23:22 These *things* Benaiah the son of Jehoiada did, and won a name among three mighty men.

1 Chronicles 11:20 Abishai the brother of Joab was chief of *another* three. He had lifted up his spear against three hundred *men*, killed *them*, and won a name among *these* three.

1 Chronicles 11:24 These *things* Benaiah the son of Jehoiada did, and won a name among three mighty men.

1 Chronicles 26:27 Some of the spoils won in battles they dedicated to maintain the house of the LORD.

Matthew 23:15 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel land and sea to win one proselyte, and when he is won, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves.

1 Peter 3:1 Wives, likewise, *be* submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives.

## Conquer

Deuteronomy 7:2 And when the LORD your God delivers them over to you, you shall conquer them *and* utterly destroy them. You shall make no covenant with them nor show mercy to them.

Revelation 6:2 And I looked, and behold, a white horse. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

## Prevail

Genesis 32:25 Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him.

1 Samuel 2:9 He will guard the feet of His saints, But the wicked shall be silent in darkness. "For by strength no man shall prevail.

1 Samuel 17:9 If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your servants. But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our servants and serve us.

1 Samuel 26:25 Then Saul said to David, "*May* you *be* blessed, my son David! You shall both do great things and also still prevail." So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.

1 Kings 22:22 "The LORD said to him, 'In what way?' So he said, 'I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets.' And the LORD said, 'You shall persuade *him*, and also prevail. Go out and do so.'

2 Chronicles 14:11 And Asa cried out to the LORD his God, and said, "LORD, *it is* nothing for You to help, whether with many or with those who have no power; help us, O LORD our God, for we rest on You,

and in Your name we go against this multitude. O LORD, You *are* our God; do not let man [prevail](#) against You!"

2 Chronicles 18:21 So he said, 'I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets.' And *the* LORD said, 'You shall persuade *him* and also [prevail](#); go out and do so.'

Esther 6:13 When Haman told his wife Zeresh and all his friends everything that had happened to him, his wise men and his wife Zeresh said to him, "If Mordecai, before whom you have begun to fall, is of Jewish descent, you will not [prevail](#) against him but will surely fall before him."

Job 14:20 You [prevail](#) forever against him, and he passes on; You change his countenance and send him away.

Psalms 9:19 Arise, O LORD, Do not let man [prevail](#); Let the nations be judged in Your sight.

Psalms 12:4 Who have said, "With our tongue we will [prevail](#); Our lips *are* our own; Who *is* lord over us?"

Psalms 65:3 Iniquities [prevail](#) against me; *As for* our transgressions, You will provide atonement for them.

Isaiah 7:1 Now it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, *that* Rezin king of Syria and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up to Jerusalem to *make* war against it, but could not [prevail](#) against it.

Isaiah 16:12 And it shall come to pass, When it is seen that Moab is weary on the high place, That he will come to his sanctuary to pray; But he will not [prevail](#).

Isaiah 42:13 The LORD shall go forth like a mighty man; He shall stir up *His* zeal like a man of war. He shall cry out, yes, shout aloud; He shall [prevail](#) against His enemies.

Isaiah 47:12 Stand now with your enchantments And the multitude of your sorceries, In which you have labored from your youth—Perhaps you will be able to profit, Perhaps you will [prevail](#).

Jeremiah 1:19 They will fight against you, But they shall not [prevail](#) against you. For I *am* with you," says the LORD, "to deliver you."

Jeremiah 5:22 'Do you not fear Me?' says the LORD. 'Will you not tremble at My presence, Who have placed the sand as the bound of the sea, By a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass beyond it? And though its waves toss to and fro, Yet they cannot [prevail](#); Though they roar, yet they cannot pass over it.'

Jeremiah 15:20 "And I will make you to this people a fortified bronze wall; And they will fight against you, But they shall not [prevail](#) against you; For I *am* with you to save you And deliver you," says the LORD.

Jeremiah 20:10 For I heard many mocking: "Fear on every side!" "Report," *they say*, "and we will report it!" All my acquaintances watched for my stumbling, *saying*, "Perhaps he can be induced; Then we will [prevail](#) against him, And we will take our revenge on him."

Jeremiah 20:11 But the LORD *is* with me as a mighty, awesome One. Therefore my persecutors will stumble, and will not [prevail](#). They will be greatly ashamed, for they will not prosper. *Their* everlasting confusion will never be forgotten.

Daniel 11:7 But from a branch of her roots *one* shall arise in his place, who shall come with an army, enter the fortress of the king of the North, and deal with them and [prevail](#).

Daniel 11:12 When he has taken away the multitude, his heart will be lifted up; and he will cast down tens of thousands, but he will not [prevail](#).

Obadiah 1:7 All the men in your confederacy Shall force you to the border; The men at peace with you Shall deceive you *and* [prevail](#) against you. *Those who eat* your bread shall lay a trap for you. No one is aware of it.

Matthew 16:18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not [prevail](#) against it.

Matthew 27:24 When Pilate saw that he could not [prevail](#) at all, but rather *that* a tumult was rising, he took water and washed *his* hands before the multitude, saying, "I am innocent of the blood of this just Person. You see *to it*."

Revelation 12:8 But they did not [prevail](#), nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer.

## Prevailed

Genesis 7:18-20 The waters [prevailed](#) and greatly increased on the earth, and the ark moved about on the surface of the waters. And the waters [prevailed](#) exceedingly on the earth, and all the high hills under the whole heaven were covered. The waters [prevailed](#) fifteen cubits upward, and the mountains were covered.

Genesis 7:24 And the waters [prevailed](#) on the earth one hundred and fifty days.

Genesis 30:8 Then Rachel said, "With great wrestlings I have wrestled with my sister, *and* indeed I have [prevailed](#)." So she called his name Naphtali.

Genesis 32:28 And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have [prevailed](#)."

Exodus 17:11 And so it was, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel [prevailed](#); and when he let down his hand, Amalek [prevailed](#).

Judges 3:10 The Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel. He went out to war, and the LORD delivered Cushan–Rishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand; and his hand [prevailed](#) over Cushan–Rishathaim.

Judges 6:2 And the hand of Midian [prevailed](#) against Israel. Because of the Midianites, the children of Israel made for themselves the dens, the caves, and the strongholds which *are* in the mountains.

1 Samuel 17:50 So David [prevailed](#) over the Philistine with a sling and a stone, and struck the Philistine and killed him. But *there was* no sword in the hand of David.

2 Samuel 11:23 And the messenger said to David, "Surely the men [prevailed](#) against us and came out to us in the field; then we drove them back as far as the entrance of the gate.

2 Samuel 24:4 Nevertheless the king's word [prevailed](#) against Joab and against the captains of the army. Therefore Joab and the captains of the army went out from the presence of the king to count the people of Israel.

1 Kings 16:22 But the people who followed Omri prevailed over the people who followed Tibni the son of Ginath. So Tibni died and Omri reigned.

1 Chronicles 5:2 Yet Judah prevailed over his brothers, and from him *came* a ruler, although the birthright was Joseph's—

1 Chronicles 21:4 Nevertheless the king's word prevailed against Joab. Therefore Joab departed and went throughout all Israel and came to Jerusalem.

2 Chronicles 13:18 Thus the children of Israel were subdued at that time; and the children of Judah prevailed, because they relied on the LORD God of their fathers.

Psalms 13:4 Lest my enemy say, "I have prevailed against him"; *Lest* those who trouble me rejoice when I am moved.

Psalms 129:2 Many a time they have afflicted me from my youth; Yet they have not prevailed against me.

Jeremiah 20:7 O LORD, You induced me, and I was persuaded; You are stronger than I, and have prevailed. I am in derision daily; Everyone mocks me.

Jeremiah 38:22 'Now behold, all the women who are left in the king of Judah's house *shall be* surrendered to the king of Babylon's princes, and those *women* shall say: "Your close friends have set upon you And prevailed against you; Your feet have sunk in the mire, *And* they have turned away again."

Lamentations 1:16 For these *things* I weep; My eye, my eye overflows with water; Because the comforter, who should restore my life, Is far from me. My children are desolate Because the enemy prevailed.

Hosea 12:4 Yes, he struggled with the Angel and prevailed; He wept, and sought favor from Him. He found Him *in* Bethel, And there He spoke to us—

Luke 23:23 But they were insistent, demanding with loud voices that He be crucified. And the voices of these men and of the chief priests prevailed.

Acts 19:16 Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.

Acts 19:20 So the word of the Lord grew mightily and prevailed.

Revelation 5:5 But one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals."

## Prevailing

Daniel 7:21-22 I was watching; and the same horn was making war against the saints, and prevailing against them, until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made *in favor* of the saints of the Most High, and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom.

## Attain

2 Samuel 23:19 Was he not the most honored of three? Therefore he became their captain. However, he did not [attain](#) to the *first* three.

2 Samuel 23:23 He was more honored than the thirty, but he did not [attain](#) to the *first* three. And David appointed him over his guard.

1 Chronicles 11:21 Of the three he was more honored than the other two men. Therefore he became their captain. However he did not [attain](#) to the *first* three.

1 Chronicles 11:25 Indeed he was more honored than the thirty, but he did not [attain](#) to the *first* three. And David appointed him over his guard.

Psalms 139:6 *Such* knowledge *is* too wonderful for me; It is high, I cannot [attain](#) it.

Proverbs 1:5 A wise *man* will hear and increase learning, And a man of understanding will [attain](#) wise counsel.

Hosea 8:5 Your calf is rejected, O Samaria! My anger is aroused against them—How long until they [attain](#) to innocence?

Luke 20:35 But those who are counted worthy to [attain](#) that age, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry nor are given in marriage.

Acts 26:7 To this *promise* our twelve tribes, earnestly serving *God* night and day, hope to [attain](#). For this hope's sake, King Agrippa, I am accused by the Jews.

Philippians 3:11 If, by any means, I may [attain](#) to the resurrection from the dead.

## **Attained**

Genesis 47:9 And Jacob said to Pharaoh, "The days of the years of my pilgrimage *are* one hundred and thirty years; few and evil have been the days of the years of my life, and they have not [attained](#) to the days of the years of the life of my fathers in the days of their pilgrimage."

Ecclesiastes 1:16 I communed with my heart, saying, "Look, I have [attained](#) greatness, and have gained more wisdom than all who were before me in Jerusalem. My heart has understood great wisdom and knowledge."

Romans 9:30 What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have [attained](#) to righteousness, even the righteousness of faith.

Romans 9:31 But Israel, pursuing the law of righteousness, has not [attained](#) to the law of righteousness.

Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already [attained](#), or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

Philippians 3:16 Nevertheless, to *the degree* that we have already [attained](#), let us walk by the same rule, let us be of the same mind.



## Attaining

Colossians 2:2 that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and *attaining* to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ.

## Success

Genesis 24:12 Then he said, "O LORD God of my master Abraham, please give me *success* this day, and show kindness to my master Abraham.

Joshua 1:8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good *success*.

Job 6:13 *Is my help not within me? And is success* driven from me?

Job 30:22 You lift me up to the wind and cause me to ride *on it*; You spoil my *success*.

Ecclesiastes 10:10 If the ax is dull, And one does not sharpen the edge, Then he must use more strength; But wisdom brings *success*.

Genesis 39:2 The LORD was with Joseph, and he was a *successful* man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.

## Succeed

Numbers 14:41 And Moses said, "Now why do you transgress the command of the LORD? For this will not *succeed*.

Deuteronomy 25:6 And it shall be *that* the firstborn son which she bears will *succeed* to the name of his dead brother, that his name may not be blotted out of Israel.

Jeremiah 32:5 "Then he shall lead Zedekiah to Babylon, and there he shall be until I visit him," says the LORD; "though you fight with the Chaldeans, you shall not *succeed*?"

## Under Your Feet

Mark 6:11 And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust *under your feet* as a testimony against them. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!

Romans 16:20 And the God of peace will crush Satan *under your feet* shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.

## Under His Feet

Exodus 24:10 and they saw the God of Israel. And *there was* under His feet as it were a paved work of sapphire stone, and it was like the very heavens in *its* clarity.

2 Samuel 22:10 He bowed the heavens also, and came down With darkness under His feet.

Psalms 8:6 You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all *things* under his feet.

Psalms 18:9 He bowed the heavens also, and came down With darkness under His feet.

1 Corinthians 15:25 For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet.

1 Corinthians 15:27 For "He has put all things under His feet." But when He says "all things are put under *Him*," *it is* evident that He who put all things under Him is excepted.

Ephesians 1:22 And He put all *things* under His feet, and gave Him *to be* head over all *things* to the church.

1 Chronicles 28:2 Then King David rose to his feet and said, "Hear me, my brethren and my people: I *had* it in my heart to build a house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made preparations to build it.

2 Chronicles 9:18 The throne *had* six steps, with a footstool of gold, *which were* fastened to the throne; there were armrests on either side of the place of the seat, and two lions stood beside the armrests.

Psalms 99:5 Exalt the LORD our God, And worship at His [footstool](#)—He *is* holy.

Psalms 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your [footstool](#)."

Psalms 132:7 Let us go into His tabernacle; Let us worship at His [footstool](#).

Isaiah 66:1 Thus says the LORD: "Heaven *is* My throne, And earth *is* My [footstool](#). Where *is* the house that you will build Me? And where *is* the place of My rest?"

Lamentations 2:1 How the Lord has covered the daughter of Zion With a cloud in His anger! He cast down from heaven to the earth The beauty of Israel, And did not remember His [footstool](#) In the day of His anger.

Matthew 5:35 Nor by the earth, for it is His [footstool](#); nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King.

Matthew 22:44 "The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your [footstool](#)!"?"

Mark 12:36 For David himself said by the Holy Spirit: "The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your [footstool](#)."

Luke 20:43 Till I make Your enemies Your [footstool](#).

Acts 2:35 Till I make Your enemies Your [footstool](#).

Acts 7:49 "Heaven *is* My throne, And earth *is* My [footstool](#). What house will you build for Me? says the LORD, Or what *is* the place of My rest?"

Hebrews 1:13 But to which of the angels has He ever said: "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your [footstool](#)!"?"

Hebrews 10:13 From that time waiting till His enemies are made His [footstool](#).

James 2:3 And you pay attention to the one wearing the fine clothes and say to him, "You sit here in a good place," and say to the poor man, "You stand there," or, "Sit here at my [footstool](#)."
