But declared first to those in Damascus and in Jerusalem, and throughout all the region of Judea, and *then* to the Gentiles, that they should repent, turn to God, and do works befitting repentance. Acts 26:20

Turn To The Lord

- Deuteronomy 4:30 When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, when you <u>turn to</u> the LORD your God and obey His voice.
- Deuteronomy 30:10 If you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which are written in this Book of the Law, *and* if you <u>turn to</u> the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- Psalms 22:27 All the ends of the world Shall remember and <u>turn to</u> the LORD, And all the families of the nations Shall worship before You.
- Isaiah 9:13 For the people do not turn to Him who strikes them, Nor do they seek the LORD of hosts.
- Acts 26:20 But declared first to those in Damascus and in Jerusalem, and throughout all the region of Judea, and *then* to the Gentiles, that they should repent, <u>turn to</u> God, and do works befitting repentance.

Turn To Idols

Leviticus 19:4 Do not turn to idols, nor make for yourselves molded gods: I am the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 31:20 When I have brought them to the land flowing with milk and honey, of which I swore to their fathers, and they have eaten and filled themselves and grown fat, then they will <u>turn to</u> other gods and serve them; and they will provoke Me and break My covenant.

Turn To Me

- Psalms 69:16 Hear me, O LORD, for Your lovingkindness *is* good; <u>Turn to</u> me according to the multitude of Your tender mercies.
- Psalms 86:16 Oh, <u>turn to</u> me, and have mercy on me! Give Your strength to Your servant, And save the son of Your maidservant.
- Psalms 119:79 Let those who fear You turn to me, Those who know Your testimonies.
- Joel 2:12 "Now, therefore," says the LORD, "<u>Turn to</u> Me with all your heart, With fasting, with weeping, and with mourning."
- Haggai 2:17 'I struck you with blight and mildew and hail in all the labors of your hands; yet you did not <u>turn</u> to Me,' says the LORD.

Turn To the Right or the Left

- Genesis 24:49 Now if you will deal kindly and truly with my master, tell me. And if not, tell me, that I may <u>turn to</u> the right hand or to the left.
- 2 Samuel 2:19 So Asahel pursued Abner, and in going he did not <u>turn to</u> the right hand or to the left from following Abner.
- 2 Samuel 14:19 So the king said, "*Is* the hand of Joab with you in all this?" And the woman answered and said, "*As* you live, my lord the king, no one can <u>turn to</u> the right hand or to the left from anything that my lord the king has spoken. For your servant Joab commanded me, and he put all these words in the mouth of your maidservant."

Proverbs 4:27 Do not turn to the right or the left; Remove your foot from evil.

Isaiah 30:21 Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This *is* the way, walk in it," Whenever you <u>turn</u> to the right hand Or whenever you <u>turn</u> to the left.

Turn To Iniquity

Job 36:21 Take heed, do not turn to iniquity, For you have chosen this rather than affliction.

Turn To His Own People

Isaiah 13:14 It shall be as the hunted gazelle, And as a sheep that no man takes up; Every man will <u>turn to</u> his own people, And everyone will flee to his own land.

Jeremiah 50:16 Cut off the sower from Babylon, And him who handles the sickle at harvest time. For fear of the oppressing sword Everyone shall <u>turn to</u> his own people, And everyone shall flee to his own land.

Turn To You

Ezekiel 36:9 For indeed I am for you, and I will turn to you, and you shall be tilled and sown.

Turn To the Gentiles

Acts 13:46 Then Paul and Barnabas grew bold and said, "It was necessary that the word of God should be spoken to you first; but since you reject it, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, behold, we <u>turn to</u> the Gentiles."

Turns To

- Leviticus 20:6 And the person who <u>turns to</u> mediums and familiar spirits, to prostitute himself with them, I will set My face against that person and cut him off from his people.
- Job 23:9 When He works on the left hand, I cannot behold *Him*; When He <u>turns to</u> the right hand, I cannot see *Him*.
- Jeremiah 49:24 Damascus has grown feeble; She <u>turns to</u> flee, And fear has seized *her*. Anguish and sorrows have taken her like a woman in labor.
- 2 Corinthians 3:16 Nevertheless when one <u>turns to</u> the Lord, the veil is taken away.

Turning To

- 2 Chronicles 36:13 And he also rebelled against King Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear *an oath* by God; but he stiffened his neck and hardened his heart against <u>turning to</u> the LORD God of Israel.
- Hosea 5:4 They do not direct their deeds Toward <u>turning to</u> their God, For the spirit of harlotry is in their midst, And they do not know the LORD.
- Luke 23:28 But Jesus, <u>turning to</u> them, said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and for your children."
- Acts 9:40 But Peter put them all out, and knelt down and prayed. And <u>turning to</u> the body he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter she sat up.

Acts 15:19 Therefore I judge that we should not trouble those from among the Gentiles who are <u>turning to</u> God.

Turned To The Lord

- 2 Kings 23:25 Now before him there was no king like him, who <u>turned to</u> the LORD with all his heart, with all his soul, and with all his might, according to all the Law of Moses; nor after him did *any* arise like him.
- 2 Chronicles 15:4 But when in their trouble they <u>turned to</u> the LORD God of Israel, and sought Him, He was found by them.

Acts 9:35 So all who dwelt at Lydda and Sharon saw him and turned to the Lord.

- Acts 11:21 And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number believed and <u>turned to</u> the Lord.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:9 For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you <u>turned to</u> God from idols to serve the living and true God.

Turned To Me

- Jeremiah 3:10 "And yet for all this her treacherous sister Judah has not <u>turned to</u> Me with her whole heart, but in pretense," says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 32:33 'And they have <u>turned to</u> Me the back, and not the face; though I taught them, rising up early and teaching *them*, yet they have not listened to receive instruction.

Turned To His Own Way

Jeremiah 8:6 I listened and heard, *But* they do not speak aright. No man repented of his wickedness, Saying, 'What have I done?' Everyone <u>turned to</u> his own course, As the horse rushes into the battle.

Turned To Other Gods

- Deuteronomy 31:18 And I will surely hide My face in that day because of all the evil which they have done, in that they have <u>turned to</u> other gods.
- Ezekiel 29:16 No longer shall it be the confidence of the house of Israel, but will remind them of *their* iniquity when they <u>turned to</u> follow them. Then they shall know that I *am* the Lord GOD.

Turned To His Disciples

Luke 10:23 Then He <u>turned to</u> *His* disciples and said privately, "Blessed *are* the eyes which see the things you see."
