# Voice of The Lord

The LORD your God will make you abound in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For the LORD will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers, if you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which are written in this Book of the Law, *and* if you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Deuteronomy 30:9-10

There is ample evidence, including multiple examples, of the Lord speaking to people --His and others. The obvious conclusion as we examine Old Testament verses is that the voice of the Lord is a call to obedience and judgment. God is giving the boundaries of conduct for a good life. He reveals that His desire is our good. We must turn to Him with all our hearts and souls. In the New Testament, the complete picture comes to light. Here the voice of the Lord is about loving direction and intimacy. In Immanuel sessions, we hear the voice of the Lord throughout our time with Him with a coach. Having built capacity to face difficult situations, with Immanuel present, He guides us into righteousness, peace and joy.

### Voice of the Lord

- Exodus 15:26 And said, If you diligently heed the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I *am* the LORD who heals you."
- Deuteronomy 5:25 Now therefore, why should we die? For this great fire will consume us; if we hear the voice of the LORD our God anymore, then we shall die.
- Deuteronomy 8:20 As the nations which the LORD destroys before you, so you shall perish, because you would not be obedient to the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God.
- Deuteronomy 13:18 Because you have listened to the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, to keep all His commandments which I command you today, to do *what is* right in the eyes of the LORD your God.
- Deuteronomy 15:5 Only if you carefully obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, to observe with care all these commandments which I command you today.

- Deuteronomy 18:16 According to all you desired of the LORD your God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, 'Let me not hear again the <u>voice of the LORD</u> my God, nor let me see this great fire anymore, lest I die.'
- Deuteronomy 26:14 'I have not eaten any of it when in mourning, nor have I removed *any* of it for an unclean *use*, nor given *any* of it for the dead. I have obeyed the <u>voice of the LORD</u> my God, and have done according to all that You have commanded me.
- Deuteronomy 27:10 Therefore you shall obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, and observe His commandments and His statutes which I command you today.
- Deuteronomy 28:1 Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the LORD your God will set you high above all nations of the earth.
- Deuteronomy 28:2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God:
- Deuteronomy 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, to observe carefully all His commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you.
- Deuteronomy 28:45 Moreover all these curses shall come upon you and pursue and overtake you, until you are destroyed, because you did not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which He commanded you.
- Deuteronomy 28:62 You shall be left few in number, whereas you were as the stars of heaven in multitude, because you would not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God.
- Deuteronomy 30:8 And you will again obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> and do all His commandments which I command you today.
- Deuteronomy 30:10 If you obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which are written in this Book of the Law, *and* if you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- Joshua 5:6 For the children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people *who were* men of war, who came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they did not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u>—to whom the LORD swore that He would not show them the land which the LORD had sworn to their fathers that He would give us, "a land flowing with milk and honey."
- 1 Samuel 12:15 However, if you do not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u>, but rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then the hand of the LORD will be against you, as *it was* against your fathers.
- 1 Samuel 15:19 Why then did you not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u>? Why did you swoop down on the spoil, and do evil in the sight of the LORD?
- 1 Samuel 15:20 And Saul said to Samuel, "But I have obeyed the <u>voice of the LORD</u>, and gone on the mission on which the LORD sent me, and brought back Agag king of Amalek; I have utterly destroyed the Amalekites."

- 1 Samuel 15:22 Then Samuel said: "Has the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the <u>voice of the LORD</u>? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, *And* to heed than the fat of rams."
- 1 Samuel 28:18 Because you did not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> nor execute His fierce wrath upon Amalek, therefore the LORD has done this thing to you this day.
- 1 Kings 20:36 Then he said to him, "Because you have not obeyed the <u>voice of the LORD</u>, surely, as soon as you depart from me, a lion shall kill you." And as soon as he left him, a lion found him and killed him.
- 2 Kings 18:12 because they did not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> their God, but transgressed His covenant *and* all that Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded; and they would neither hear nor do *them*."
- Psalms 29:3 The voice of the LORD is over the waters; The God of glory thunders; The LORD is over many waters.
- Psalms 29:4 The voice of the LORD is powerful; The voice of the LORD is full of majesty.
- Psalms 29:5 The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars, Yes, the LORD splinters the cedars of Lebanon.
- Psalms 29:7 The voice of the LORD divides the flames of fire.
- Psalms 29:8 The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; The LORD shakes the Wilderness of Kadesh.
- Psalms 29:9 The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth, And strips the forests bare; And in His temple everyone says, "Glory!"
- Psalms 106:25 But complained in their tents, And did not heed the voice of the LORD.
- Isaiah 6:8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here *am* I! Send me."
- Isaiah 30:31 For through the voice of the LORD Assyria will be beaten down, As He strikes with the rod.
- Isaiah 66:6 The sound of noise from the city! A voice from the temple! The <u>voice of the LORD</u>, Who fully repays His enemies!
- Jeremiah 3:25 We lie down in our shame, And our reproach covers us. For we have sinned against the LORD our God, We and our fathers, From our youth even to this day, And have not obeyed the <u>voice</u> of the LORD our God.
- Jeremiah 7:28 So you shall say to them, 'This *is* a nation that does not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> their God nor receive correction. Truth has perished and has been cut off from their mouth.'
- Jeremiah 26:13 Now therefore, amend your ways and your doings, and obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God; then the LORD will relent concerning the doom that He has pronounced against you.
- Jeremiah 38:20 But Jeremiah said, "They shall not deliver *you*. Please, obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> which I speak to you. So it shall be well with you, and your soul shall live."
- Jeremiah 42:6 Whether *it is* pleasing or displeasing, we will obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> our God to whom we send you, that it may be well with us when we obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u> our God.

Jeremiah 42:13 But if you say, 'We will not dwell in this land,' disobeying the voice of the LORD your God,

- Jeremiah 42:21 And I have this day declared *it* to you, but you have not obeyed the <u>voice of the LORD</u> your God, or anything which He has sent you by me.
- Jeremiah 43:4 So Johanan the son of Kareah, all the captains of the forces, and all the people would not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u>, to remain in the land of Judah.
- Jeremiah 43:7 So they went to the land of Egypt, for they did not obey the <u>voice of the LORD</u>. And they went as far as Tahpanhes.
- Jeremiah 44:23 Because you have burned incense and because you have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed the <u>voice of the LORD</u> or walked in His law, in His statutes or in His testimonies, therefore this calamity has happened to you, as *at* this day.
- Daniel 9:10 We have not obeyed the <u>voice of the LORD</u> our God, to walk in His laws, which He set before us by His servants the prophets.
- Haggai 1:12 Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the <u>voice of the LORD</u> their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him; and the people feared the presence of the LORD.
- Zechariah 6:15 Even those from afar shall come and build the temple of the LORD. Then you shall know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me to you. And *this* shall come to pass if you diligently obey the <u>voice</u> of the LORD your God.
- Acts 7:31 When Moses saw *it*, he marveled at the sight; and as he drew near to observe, the <u>voice of the Lord</u> came to him.

#### Lord's Voice

Micah 6:9 The <u>LORD'S voice</u> cries to the city—Wisdom shall see Your name: "Hear the Rod! Who has appointed it?"

#### Voice of God

Deuteronomy 4:33 Did *any* people *ever* hear the <u>voice of God</u> speaking out of the midst of the fire, as you have heard, and live?

#### Voice of the Almighty

- Ezekiel 1:24 When they went, I heard the noise of their wings, like the noise of many waters, like the <u>voice</u> of the <u>Almighty</u>, a tumult like the noise of an army; and when they stood still, they let down their wings.
- Ezekiel 10:5 And the sound of the wings of the cherubim was heard *even* in the outer court, like the <u>voice</u> of <u>Almighty</u> God when He speaks.

#### My Voice

- Genesis 22:18 In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.
- Genesis 26:5 Because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws.
- Exodus 19:5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey <u>My voice</u> and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth *is* Mine.
- Numbers 14:22 Because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have put Me to the test now these ten times, and have not heeded <u>My voice</u>.
- Judges 2:2 And you shall make no covenant with the inhabitants of this land; you shall tear down their altars.' But you have not obeyed My voice. Why have you done this?
- Judges 2:20 Then the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and He said, "Because this nation has transgressed My covenant which I commanded their fathers, and has not heeded <u>My voice</u>"
- Judges 6:10 'Also I said to you, "I am the LORD your God; do not fear the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell." But you have not obeyed <u>My voice</u>."
- Psalms 5:3 My voice You shall hear in the morning, O LORD; In the morning I will direct *it* to You, And I will look up.
- Psalms 81:11 But My people would not heed My voice, And Israel would have none of Me.
- Jeremiah 3:13 'Only acknowledge your iniquity, That you have transgressed against the LORD your God, And have scattered your charms To alien deities under every green tree, And you have not obeyed <u>My</u> <u>voice</u>,' says the LORD.
- Jeremiah 7:23 "But this is what I commanded them, saying, 'Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people. And walk in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you.'
- Jeremiah 9:13 And the LORD said, "Because they have forsaken My law which I set before them, and have not obeyed My voice, nor walked according to it."
- Jeremiah 11:4 Which I commanded your fathers in the day I brought them out of the land of Egypt, from the iron furnace, saying, 'Obey <u>My voice</u>, and do according to all that I command you; so shall you be My people, and I will be your God.'
- Jeremiah 11:7 For I earnestly exhorted your fathers in the day I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, until this day, rising early and exhorting, saying, "Obey My voice."
- Jeremiah 18:10 If it does evil in My sight so that it does not obey My voice, then I will relent concerning the good with which I said I would benefit it.
- Jeremiah 22:21 I spoke to you in your prosperity, *But* you said, 'I will not hear.' This *has been* your manner from your youth, That you did not obey My voice.
- John 10:16 And other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them also I must bring, and they will hear My voice; and there will be one flock *and* one shepherd.

John 10:27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.

- John 18:37 Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say *rightly* that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears <u>My voice</u>."
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears <u>My voice</u> and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.

#### **His Voice**

- Exodus 5:2 And Pharaoh said, "Who *is* the LORD, that I should obey <u>His voice</u> to let Israel go? I do not know the LORD, nor will I let Israel go."
- Exodus 23:21 Beware of Him and obey <u>His voice</u>; do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your transgressions; for My name *is* in Him.
- Exodus 23:22 But if you indeed obey <u>His voice</u> and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries.
- Deuteronomy 4:30 When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, when you turn to the LORD your God and obey <u>His voice</u>
- Deuteronomy 4:36 Out of heaven He let you hear <u>His voice</u>, that He might instruct you; on earth He showed you His great fire, and you heard His words out of the midst of the fire.
- Deuteronomy 5:24 And you said: 'Surely the LORD our God has shown us His glory and His greatness, and we have heard <u>His voice</u> from the midst of the fire. We have seen this day that God speaks with man; yet he *still* lives.'
- Deuteronomy 9:23 Likewise, when the LORD sent you from Kadesh Barnea, saying, 'Go up and possess the land which I have given you,' then you rebelled against the commandment of the LORD your God, and you did not believe Him nor obey <u>His voice</u>.
- Deuteronomy 13:4 You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear Him, and keep His commandments and obey <u>His voice</u>, and you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him.
- Deuteronomy 26:17 Today you have proclaimed the LORD to be your God, and that you will walk in His ways and keep His statutes, His commandments, and His judgments, and that you will obey <u>His voice</u>.
- Deuteronomy 30:2 And you return to the LORD your God and obey <u>His voice</u>, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul.
- Deuteronomy 30:20 That you may love the LORD your God, that you may obey <u>His voice</u>, and that you may cling to Him, for He *is* your life and the length of your days; and that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them."
- Joshua 24:24 And the people said to Joshua, "The LORD our God we will serve, and <u>His voice</u> we will obey!"

- 1 Samuel 12:14 If you fear the LORD and serve Him and obey <u>His voice</u>, and do not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then both you and the king who reigns over you will continue following the LORD your God.
- 2 Samuel 22:14 The LORD thundered from heaven, And the Most High uttered His voice.
- Job 37:2 Hear attentively the thunder of His voice, And the rumbling that comes from His mouth.
- Job 37:4 After it a voice roars; He thunders with His majestic voice, And He does not restrain them when <u>His voice</u> is heard.
- Job 37:5 God thunders marvelously with His voice; He does great things which we cannot comprehend.
- Psalms 18:13 The LORD thundered from heaven, And the Most High uttered <u>His voice</u>, Hailstones and coals of fire.
- Psalms 46:6 The nations raged, the kingdoms were moved; He uttered His voice, the earth melted.
- Psalms 68:33 To Him who rides on the heaven of heavens, *which were* of old! Indeed, He sends out <u>His voice</u>, a mighty voice.
- Psalms 95:7 For He *is* our God, And we *are* the people of His pasture, And the sheep of His hand. Today, if you will hear <u>His voice</u>.
- Isaiah 42:2 He will not cry out, nor raise His voice, Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street.
- Jeremiah 10:13 When He utters <u>His voice</u>, *There is* a multitude of waters in the heavens: "And He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth. He makes lightning for the rain, He brings the wind out of His treasuries."
- Jeremiah 25:30 Therefore prophesy against them all these words, and say to them: 'The LORD will roar from on high, And utter <u>His voice</u> from His holy habitation; He will roar mightily against His fold. He will give a shout, as those who tread *the grapes*, Against all the inhabitants of the earth.'
- Jeremiah 40:3 Now the LORD has brought *it*, and has done just as He said. Because you *people* have sinned against the LORD, and not obeyed <u>His voice</u>, therefore this thing has come upon you.
- Jeremiah 51:16 When He utters <u>*His* voice</u>—*There is* a multitude of waters in the heavens: "He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes lightnings for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasuries."
- Ezekiel 43:2 And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east. <u>His voice</u> *was* like the sound of many waters; and the earth shone with His glory.
- Daniel 9:14 Therefore the LORD has kept the disaster in mind, and brought it upon us; for the LORD our God *is* righteous in all the works which He does, though we have not obeyed <u>His voice</u>.
- Joel 3:16 The LORD also will roar from Zion, And utter <u>His voice</u> from Jerusalem; The heavens and earth will shake; But the LORD will be a shelter for His people, And the strength of the children of Israel.
- Amos 1:2 And he said: "The LORD roars from Zion, And utters <u>His voice</u> from Jerusalem; The pastures of the shepherds mourn, And the top of Carmel withers."

- Zephaniah 3:2 She has not obeyed <u>*His* voice</u>, She has not received correction; She has not trusted in the LORD, She has not drawn near to her God.
- Matthew 12:19 He will not quarrel nor cry out, Nor will anyone hear His voice in the streets.
- John 5:28 Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice
- John 5:37 And the Father Himself, who sent Me, has testified of Me. You have neither heard <u>His voice</u> at any time, nor seen His form.
- Hebrews 3:7 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you will hear His voice."
- Hebrews 3:15 While it is said: "Today, if you will hear <u>His voice</u>, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."
- Hebrews 4:7 Again He designates a certain day, saying in David, "Today," after such a long time, as it has been said: "Today, if you will hear <u>His voice</u>, Do not harden your hearts."
- Revelation 1:15 His feet *were* like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and <u>His voice</u> as the sound of many waters.

#### Your Voice

- Genesis 3:10 So he said, "I heard <u>Your voice</u> in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."
- Isaiah 29:4 You shall be brought down, You shall speak out of the ground; Your speech shall be low, out of the dust; <u>Your voice</u> shall be like a medium's, out of the ground; And your speech shall whisper out of the dust.
- Jeremiah 32:23 And they came in and took possession of it, but they have not obeyed <u>Your voice</u> or walked in Your law. They have done nothing of all that You commanded them to do; therefore You have caused all this calamity to come upon them.
- Daniel 9:11 Yes, all Israel has transgressed Your law, and has departed so as not to obey <u>Your voice</u>; therefore the curse and the oath written in the Law of Moses the servant of God have been poured out on us, because we have sinned against Him.

#### Voice And Many Waters

- Psalms 29:3 The <u>voice</u> of the LORD *is* over the <u>waters</u>; The God of glory thunders; The LORD *is* over many <u>waters</u>.
- Jeremiah 10:13 When He utters His <u>voice</u>, *There is* a multitude of <u>waters</u> in the heavens: "And He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth. He makes lightning for the rain, He brings the wind out of His treasuries."

- Jeremiah 48:34 From the cry of Heshbon to Elealeh and to Jahaz They have uttered their <u>voice</u>, From Zoar to Horonaim, *Like* a three–year–old heifer; For the <u>waters</u> of Nimrim also shall be desolate.
- Jeremiah 51:16 When He utters *His* <u>voice</u>—*There is* a multitude of <u>waters</u> in the heavens: "He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes lightnings for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasuries."
- Jeremiah 51:55 Because the LORD is plundering Babylon And silencing her loud <u>voice</u>, Though her waves roar like great <u>waters</u>, And the noise of their <u>voice</u> is uttered.
- Ezekiel 1:24 When they went, I heard the noise of their wings, like the noise of many <u>waters</u>, like the <u>voice</u> of the Almighty, a tumult like the noise of an army; and when they stood still, they let down their wings.
- Ezekiel 43:2 And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east. His <u>voice</u> *was* like the sound of many <u>waters</u>; and the earth shone with His glory.
- Revelation 1:15 His feet *were* like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His <u>voice</u> as the sound of many <u>waters</u>.
- Revelation 14:2 And I heard a <u>voice</u> from heaven, like the <u>voice</u> of many <u>waters</u>, and like the <u>voice</u> of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps.
- Revelation 19:6 And I heard, as it were, the <u>voice</u> of a great multitude, as the sound of many <u>waters</u> and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!"
