He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to <u>walk</u> just as He walked. I John 2:6

And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people." 2 Corinthians 6:16

Walk In The Light

- Mark 7:5 Then the Pharisees and scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands?"
- John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."
- John 12:35 Then Jesus said to them, "A little while longer the light is with you. Walk while you have the light, lest darkness overtake you; he who walks in darkness does not know where he is going.
- Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light.
- 1 John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.
- Revelation 21:24 And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.

Walk In Their Own Ways

Acts 14:16 Who in bygone generations allowed all nations to walk in their own ways.

- Acts 21:21 But they have been informed about you that you teach all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise *their* children nor to <u>walk</u> according to the customs.
- Ephesians 4:17 This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer <u>walk</u> as the rest of the Gentiles <u>walk</u>, in the futility of their mind.
- Philippians 3:18 For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:11 For we hear that there are some who <u>walk</u> among you in a disorderly manner, not working at all, but are busybodies.
- 2 Peter 2:10 And especially those who <u>walk</u> according to the flesh in the lust of uncleanness and despise authority. *They are* presumptuous, self–willed. They are not afraid to speak evil of dignitaries.
- Jude 1:18 how they told you that there would be mockers in the last time who would walk according to their own ungodly lusts.

Walk In the Law of God

- Acts 21:24 Take them and be purified with them, and pay their expenses so that they may shave *their* heads, and that all may know that those things of which they were informed concerning you are nothing, but *that* you yourself also <u>walk</u> orderly and keep the law.
- Romans 13:13 Let us <u>walk</u> properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy.
- Galatians 6:16 And as many as walk according to this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:12 That you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and *that* you may lack nothing.
- 2 John 1:6 This is love, that we <u>walk</u> according to His commandments. This is the commandment, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should <u>walk</u> in it.
- Revelation 16:15 Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed *is* he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.

Walk In Faith

- Romans 4:12 And the father of circumcision to those who not only *are* of the circumcision, but who also walk in the steps of the faith which our father Abraham *had while still* uncircumcised.
- 2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Walk In New Life

Romans 6:4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should <u>walk</u> in newness of life.

Walk In The Spirit

- Romans 8:1 *There is* therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.
- Romans 8:4 That the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.
- Galatians 5:16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.
- Galatians 5:25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Walk On Earth

- 1 Corinthians 7:17 But as God has distributed to each one, as the Lord has called each one, so let him <u>walk</u>. And so I ordain in all the churches.
- 2 Corinthians 6:16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."
- 2 Corinthians 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh.
- Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
- Revelation 9:20 But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk.

Walk In Agreement

- 2 Corinthians 12:18 I urged Titus, and sent our brother with *him*. Did Titus take advantage of you? Did we not <u>walk</u> in the same spirit? Did *we* not <u>walk</u> in the same steps?
- Philippians 3:16 Nevertheless, to *the degree* that we have already attained, let us <u>walk</u> by the same rule, let us be of the same mind.
- Philippians 3:17 Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern.

Colossians 2:6 As you have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him.

1 Thessalonians 4:1 Finally then, brethren, we urge and exhort in the Lord Jesus that you should abound more and more, just as you received from us how you ought to <u>walk</u> and to please God.

1 John 2:6 He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

Walk In Love

Ephesians 5:2 And <u>walk</u> in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet–smelling aroma.

Walk Worthy

Ephesians 4:1 I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to <u>walk</u> worthy of the calling with which you were called.

Colossians 1:10 That you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

1 Thessalonians 2:12 That you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

Revelation 3:4 You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they shall <u>walk</u> with Me in white, for they are worthy.

Walk In Wisdom

Ephesians 5:15 See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise.

Colossians 4:5 Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time.

Walk In Truth

3 John 1:3 For I rejoiced greatly when brethren came and testified of the truth *that is* in you, just as you <u>walk</u> in the truth.

3 John 1:4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.
