All My Heart

Psalm 86:12 I will praise You, O Lord my God, with <u>all my heart</u>, And I will glorify Your name forevermore.

Jeremiah 32:41 'Yes, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will assuredly plant them in this land, with <u>all My heart</u> and with all My soul.'

All Your Heart

- Deuteronomy 4:29 But from there you will seek the LORD your God, and you will find *Him* if you seek Him with <u>all your heart</u> and with all your soul.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 You shall love the LORD your God with <u>all your heart</u>, with all your soul, and with all your strength.
- Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with <u>all your heart</u> and with all your soul.
- Deuteronomy De 11:13 And it shall be that if you earnestly obey My commandments which I command you today, to love the LORD your God and serve Him with <u>all your heart</u> and with all your soul.
- Deuteronomy 13:3 You shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the LORD your God is testing you to know whether you love the LORD your God with <u>all your heart</u> and with all your soul.

One Heart

- 2 Chronicles 30:12 Also the hand of God was on Judah to give them <u>singleness</u> of heart to obey the command of the king and the leaders, at the word of the LORD.
- Jeremiah 32:39 Then I will give them <u>one heart</u> and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them.
- Ezekiel 11:19 Then I will give them <u>one heart</u>, and I will put a new spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them a heart of flesh.
- Acts4:32 Now the multitude of those who believed were of <u>one heart</u> and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common.

United Heart

- 1 Chronicles 12:17 And David went out to meet them, and answered and said to them, "If you have come peaceably to me to help me, my heart will be <u>united</u> with you; but if to betray me to my enemies, since *there is* no wrong in my hands, may the God of our fathers look and bring judgment."
