And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we **beheld** His glory,
the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

See

For now we **see** in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face.
Now I know in part, but then I shall know just as I also am known.

Saw

Now I [saw](#) a new heaven and a new earth,
for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away.

Then I, John, [saw](#) the holy city, New Jerusalem,

Seen

When Simon Peter saw *it*, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying,
"Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!"
Luke 5:8

Departed
