

Works of God

Listen to this, O Job; Stand still and consider the wondrous works of God. Job 37:14

The practice of formulating and sharing the Immanuel story helps us to emphasize Immanuel's wonderful work instead of our previous troubles. At the end of an Immanuel session, the coach and receiver talk over what Jesus just did step by step. The idea is to spend a short time mentioning our troubles and then give full attention to His character and work to bring about His solution and our healing. Works of God

Job 37:14 Listen to this, O Job; Stand still and consider the wondrous works of God.

Psalms 66:5 Come and see the works of God; He is awesome in His doing toward the sons of men.

Psalms 78:7 That they may set their hope in God, And not forget the works of God, But keep His commandments.

Ecclesiastes 11:5 As you do not know what *is* the way of the wind, Or how the bones *grow* in the womb of her who is with child, So you do not know the works of God who makes everything.

John 6:28 Then they said to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?"

John 9:3 Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him."

Acts 2:11 "Cretans and Arabs—we hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God."

Work of God

Exodus 24:10 And they saw the God of Israel. And *there was* under His feet as it were a paved work of sapphire stone, and it was like the very heavens in *its* clarity.

Exodus 32:16 Now the tablets *were* the work of God, and the writing *was* the writing of God engraved on the tablets.

Psalms 64:9 All men shall fear, And shall declare the work of God; For they shall wisely consider His doing.

Ecclesiastes 3:11 He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end.

Ecclesiastes 7:13 Consider the work of God; For who can make straight what He has made crooked?

Ecclesiastes 8:17 Then I saw all the work of God, that a man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun. For though a man labors to discover *it*, yet he will not find *it*; moreover, though a wise *man* attempts to know *it*, he will not be able to find *it*.

Isaiah 29:23 But when he sees his children, The work of My hands, in his midst, They will hallow My name, And hallow the Holy One of Jacob, And fear the God of Israel.

Isaiah 49:4 Then I said, 'I have labored in vain, I have spent my strength for nothing and in vain; Yet surely my just reward *is* with the LORD, And my work with my God.'

John 6:29 Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent."

Romans 14:20 Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food. All things indeed *are* pure, but *it is* evil for the man who eats with offense.

Job 36:24 Remember to magnify His work, Of which men have sung.

Job 37:7 He seals the hand of every man, That all men may know His work.

Psalms 33:4 For the word of the LORD *is* right, And all His work *is done* in truth.

Psalms 111:3 His work *is* honorable and glorious, And His righteousness endures forever.

Proverbs 16:11 Honest weights and scales *are* the LORD'S; All the weights in the bag *are* His work.

Isaiah 5:19 That say, "Let Him make speed *and* hasten His work, That we may see *it*; And let the counsel of the Holy One of Israel draw near and come, That we may know *it*."

Isaiah 10:12 Therefore it shall come to pass, when the Lord has performed all [His work](#) on Mount Zion and on Jerusalem, *that He will say*, "I will punish the fruit of the arrogant heart of the king of Assyria, and the glory of his haughty looks."

Isaiah 28:21 For the LORD will rise up as *at* Mount Perazim, He will be angry as in the Valley of Gibeon— That He may do [His work](#), His awesome work, And bring to pass His act, His unusual act.

Isaiah 40:10 Behold, the Lord GOD shall come with a strong *hand*, And His arm shall rule for Him; Behold, His reward *is* with Him, And [His work](#) before Him.

Isaiah 62:11 Indeed the LORD has proclaimed To the end of the world: "Say to the daughter of Zion, 'Surely your salvation is coming; Behold, His reward *is* with Him, And [His work](#) before Him.'"

John 4:34 Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish [His work](#)."

Work of the Lord

Exodus 34:10 And He said: "Behold, I make a covenant. Before all your people I will do marvels such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation; and all the people among whom you *are* shall see the [work of the LORD](#). For it *is* an awesome thing that I will do with you."

Numbers 8:11 And Aaron shall offer the Levites before the LORD, *like* a wave offering from the children of Israel, that they may perform the [work of the LORD](#).

Isaiah 5:12 The harp and the strings, The tambourine and flute, And wine are in their feasts; But they do not regard the [work of the LORD](#), Nor consider the operation of His hands.

Jeremiah 48:10 Cursed *is* he who does the [work of the LORD](#) deceitfully, And cursed *is* he who keeps back his sword from blood.

Joshua 24:31 Israel served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had known all the [works of the LORD](#) which He had done for Israel.

Judges 2:7 So the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great [works of the LORD](#) which He had done for Israel.

Psalms 28:5 Because they do not regard the works of the LORD, Nor the operation of His hands, He shall destroy them And not build them up.

Psalms 46:8 Come, behold the works of the LORD, Who has made desolations in the earth.

Psalms 77:11 I will remember the works of the LORD; Surely I will remember Your wonders of old.

Psalms 107:24 They see the works of the LORD, And His wonders in the deep.

Psalms 111:2 The works of the LORD are great, Studied by all who have pleasure in them.

Psalms 118:17 I shall not die, but live, And declare the works of the LORD.

Work In the Lord

1 Corinthians 9:1 Am I not an apostle? Am I not free? Have I not seen Jesus Christ our Lord? Are you not my work in the Lord?

Handiwork For the Tabernacle

Numbers 16:9 *Is it* a small thing to you that the God of Israel has separated you from the congregation of Israel, to bring you near to Himself, to do the work of the tabernacle of the LORD, and to stand before the congregation to serve them.

1 Chronicles 6:49 But Aaron and his sons offered sacrifices on the altar of burnt offering and on the altar of incense, for all the work of the Most Holy *Place*, and to make atonement for Israel, according to all that Moses the servant of God had commanded.

1 Chronicles 9:13 And their brethren, heads of their fathers' houses—one thousand seven hundred and sixty. *They were* very able men for the work of the service of the house of God.

1 Chronicles 23:28 Because their duty *was* to help the sons of Aaron in the service of the house of the LORD, in the courts and in the chambers, in the purifying of all holy things and the work of the service of the house of God.

Handiwork For the Temple

1 Chronicles 28:20 And David said to his son Solomon, "Be strong and of good courage, and do *it*; do not fear nor be dismayed, for the LORD God—my God—*will be* with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you, until you have finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD."

1 Chronicles 29:1 Furthermore King David said to all the assembly: "My son Solomon, whom alone God has chosen, *is* young and inexperienced; and the work *is* great, because the temple *is* not for man but for the LORD God."

1 Chronicles 29:7 They gave for the work of the house of God five thousand talents and ten thousand darics of gold, ten thousand talents of silver, eighteen thousand talents of bronze, and one hundred thousand talents of iron.

2 Chronicles 4:11 Then Hiram made the pots and the shovels and the bowls. So Hiram finished doing the work that he was to do for King Solomon for the house of God:

2 Chronicles 5:1 So all the work that Solomon had done for the house of the LORD was finished; and Solomon brought in the things which his father David had dedicated: the silver and the gold and all the furnishings. And he put *them* in the treasuries of the house of God.

2 Chronicles 24:13 So the workmen labored, and the work was completed by them; they restored the house of God to its original condition and reinforced it.

2 Chronicles 31:21 And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, in the law and in the commandment, to seek his God, he did *it* with all his heart. So he prospered.

Ezra 3:8 Now in the second month of the second year of their coming to the house of God at Jerusalem, Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and the rest of their brethren the priests and the Levites, and all those who had come out of the captivity to Jerusalem, began work and appointed the Levites from twenty years old and above to oversee the work of the house of the LORD.

Ezra 4:24 Thus the work of the house of God which *is* at Jerusalem ceased, and it was discontinued until the second year of the reign of Darius king of Persia.

Ezra 5:8 Let it be known to the king that we went into the province of Judea, to the temple of the great God, which is being built with heavy stones, and timber is being laid in the walls; and this work goes on diligently and prospers in their hands.

Ezra 6:7 Let the work of this house of God alone; let the governor of the Jews and the elders of the Jews build this house of God on its site.

Ezra 6:22 And they kept the Feast of Unleavened Bread seven days with joy; for the LORD made them joyful, and turned the heart of the king of Assyria toward them, to strengthen their hands in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel.

Work of Your/Our Hands

Deuteronomy 2:7 For the LORD your God has blessed you in all the work of your hand. He knows your trudging through this great wilderness. These forty years the LORD your God *has been* with you; you have lacked nothing.

Deuteronomy 14:29 And the Levite, because he has no portion nor inheritance with you, and the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who *are* within your gates, may come and eat and be satisfied, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hand which you do.

Deuteronomy 16:15 Seven days you shall keep a sacred feast to the LORD your God in the place which the LORD chooses, because the LORD your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you surely rejoice.

Deuteronomy 24:19 When you reap your harvest in your field, and forget a sheaf in the field, you shall not go back to get it; it shall be for the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands.

Deuteronomy 30:9 The LORD your God will make you abound in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For the LORD will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers.

Ruth 2:12 The LORD repay your work, and a full reward be given you by the LORD God of Israel, under whose wings you have come for refuge.

2 Chronicles 32:19 And they spoke against the God of Jerusalem, as against the gods of the people of the earth—the work of men's hands.

Psalms 90:17 And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us, And establish the work of our hands for us; Yes, establish the work of our hands.

Ecclesiastes 5:6 Do not let your mouth cause your flesh to sin, nor say before the messenger of God that it *was* an error. Why should God be angry at your excuse and destroy the work of your hands?

Work of Building the Walls of Jerusalem

Nehemiah 2:18 And I told them of the hand of my God which had been good upon me, and also of the king's words that he had spoken to me. So they said, "Let us rise up and build." Then they set their hands to *this* good work.

Nehemiah 4:15 And it happened, when our enemies heard that it was known to us, and *that* God had brought their plot to nothing, that all of us returned to the wall, everyone to his work.

Nehemiah 6:9 For they all *were trying to* make us afraid, saying, "Their hands will be weakened in the work, and it will not be done." Now therefore, O God, strengthen my hands.

Nehemiah 6:16 And it happened, when all our enemies heard *of it*, and all the nations around us saw *these things*, that they were very disheartened in their own eyes; for they perceived that this work was done by our God.

Nehemiah 10:33 for the showbread, for the regular grain offering, for the regular burnt offering of the Sabbaths, the New Moons, and the set feasts; for the holy things, for the sin offerings to make atonement for Israel, and all the work of the house of our God.

Work (Occupational)

Ecclesiastes 2:26 For God gives wisdom and knowledge and joy to a man who *is* good in His sight; but to the sinner He gives the work of gathering and collecting, that he may give to *him who is* good before God. This also *is* vanity and grasping for the wind.

Works As Deeds

Ecclesiastes 3:17 I said in my heart, "God shall judge the righteous and the wicked, For *there is* a time there for every purpose and for every work."

Ecclesiastes 12:14 For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.

Work for God

Acts 14:26 From there they sailed to Antioch, where they had been commended to the grace of God for the work which they had completed.

2 Thessalonians 1:11 Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of *this* calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of *His* goodness and the work of faith with power.

Hebrews 6:10 For God *is* not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, *in that* you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Work (Verb)

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose.

Good Work

John 10:33 The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself God."

2 Corinthians 9:8 And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may have an abundance for every good work.

Colossians 1:10 That you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing *Him*, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

1 Thessalonians 1:3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,

2 Timothy 3:17 That the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Titus 1:16 They profess to know God, but in works they deny *Him*, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.

Good Works

Matthew 5:16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

John 10:32 Jesus answered them, "Many [good works](#) I have shown you from My Father. For which of those works do you stone Me?"

Acts 9:36 At Joppa there was a certain disciple named Tabitha, which is translated Dorcas. This woman was full of [good works](#) and charitable deeds which she did.

Romans 13:3 For rulers are not a terror to [good works](#), but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for [good works](#), which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

1 Timothy 2:10 but, which is proper for women professing godliness, with [good works](#).

1 Timothy 5:10 well reported for [good works](#): if she has brought up children, if she has lodged strangers, if she has washed the saints' feet, if she has relieved the afflicted, if she has diligently followed every good work.

1 Timothy 5:25 Likewise, the [good works](#) of some are clearly evident, and those that are otherwise cannot be hidden.

1 Timothy 6:18 *Let them* do good, that they be rich in [good works](#), ready to give, willing to share,

Titus 2:7 in all things showing yourself *to be* a pattern of [good works](#); in doctrine *showing* integrity, reverence, incorruptibility,

Titus 2:14 who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself *His* own special people, zealous for [good works](#).

Titus 3:8 This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly, that those who have believed in God should be careful to maintain [good works](#). These things are good and profitable to men.

Titus 3:14 And let our *people* also learn to maintain [good works](#), to *meet* urgent needs, that they may not be unfruitful.

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and [good works](#),

1 Peter 2:12 having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by *your* [good works](#) which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.

Finish His Work (God's)

John 4:34 Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to [finish](#) His [work](#)."

Romans 9:28 For He will [finish](#) the [work](#) and cut *it* short in righteousness, Because the LORD will make a short [work](#) upon the earth."

Finished (God)

Genesis 2:1 Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were [finished](#).

Genesis 17:22 Then He [finished](#) talking with him, and God went up from Abraham.

Genesis 18:33 So the LORD went His way as soon as He had [finished](#) speaking with Abraham; and Abraham returned to his place.

Daniel 5:26 This *is* the interpretation of *each* word. MENE: God has numbered your kingdom, and [finished](#) it.

Matthew 11:1 Now it came to pass, when Jesus [finished](#) commanding His twelve disciples, that He departed from there to teach and to preach in their cities.

Matthew 13:53 Now it came to pass, when Jesus had [finished](#) these parables, that He departed from there.

Matthew 19:1 Now it came to pass, when Jesus had [finished](#) these sayings, *that* He departed from Galilee and came to the region of Judea beyond the Jordan.

Matthew 26:1 Now it came to pass, when Jesus had [finished](#) all these sayings, *that* He said to His disciples,

John 17:4 I have glorified You on the earth. I have [finished](#) the work which You have given Me to do.

John 19:30 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is [finished](#)!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

Hebrews 4:3 For we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said: "So I swore in My wrath, "They shall not enter My rest," although the works were [finished](#) from the foundation of the world."

Finished the Work

Exodus 40:33 And he raised up the court all around the tabernacle and the altar, and hung up the screen of the court gate. So Moses [finished the work](#).

John 17:4 "I have glorified You on the earth. I have [finished the work](#) which You have given Me to do.

God Is Working

Psalms 74:12 For God *is* my King from of old, [Working](#) salvation in the midst of the earth.

Mark 16:20 And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord [working](#) with *them* and confirming the word through the accompanying signs. Amen.

John 5:17 But Jesus answered them, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working."

Philippians 3:21 who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

Colossians 1:29 To this *end* I also labor, striving according to His working which works in me mightily.

Hebrews 13:21 Make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* glory forever and ever. Amen.

1 Kings 7:14 He *was* the son of a widow from the tribe of Naphtali, and his father *was* a man of Tyre, a bronze worker; he was filled with wisdom and understanding and skill in working with all kinds of bronze work. So he came to King Solomon and did all his work.

1 Chronicles 22:16 Of gold and silver and bronze and iron *there is* no limit. Arise and begin working, and the LORD be with you.

Ezra 3:9 Then Jeshua *with* his sons and brothers, Kadmiel *with* his sons, and the sons of Judah, arose as one to oversee those working on the house of God: the sons of Henadad *with* their sons and their brethren the Levites.

Nehemiah 4:22 At the same time I also said to the people, "Let each man and his servant stay at night in Jerusalem, that they may be our guard by night and a working party by day."

Psalms 52:2 Your tongue devises destruction, Like a sharp razor, working deceitfully.

Ezekiel 46:1 "Thus says the Lord GOD: "The gateway of the inner court that faces toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the Sabbath it shall be opened, and on the day of the New Moon it shall be opened.

Working With Our Hands

1 Corinthians 4:12 And we labor, working with our own hands. Being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we endure;

1 Corinthians 9:6 Or *is it* only Barnabas and I *who* have no right to refrain from working?

1 Corinthians 12:10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another *different* kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.

2 Corinthians 4:12 So then death is working in us, but life in you.

2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding *and* eternal weight of glory,

Galatians 5:6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.

Ephesians 1:19 and what *is* the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power

Ephesians 3:7 of which I became a minister according to the gift of the grace of God given to me by the effective working of His power.

Ephesians 4:16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

Ephesians 4:28 Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with *his* hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need.

Colossians 2:12 Buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with *Him* through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

2 Thessalonians 2:9 The coming of the *lawless one* is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders,

2 Thessalonians 3:11 For we hear that there are some who walk among you in a disorderly manner, not working at all, but are busybodies.

2 Timothy 2:6 The hard-working farmer must be first to partake of the crops.

James 2:22 Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect?

Genesis 39:11 But it happened about this time, when Joseph went into the house to do his work, and none of the men of the house *was* inside,

Judges 13:12 Manoah said, "Now let Your words come *to pass*! What will be the boy's rule of life, and his work?"

Judges 19:16 Just then an old man came in from his work in the field at evening, who also *was* from the mountains of Ephraim; he was staying in Gibeah, whereas the men of the place *were* Benjamites.

1 Samuel 8:16 "And he will take your male servants, your female servants, your finest young men, and your donkeys, and put *them* to his work.

1 Kings 7:14 He *was* the son of a widow from the tribe of Naphtali, and his father *was* a man of Tyre, a bronze worker; he was filled with wisdom and understanding and skill in working with all kinds of bronze work. So he came to King Solomon and did all his work.

1 Chronicles 4:23 These *were* the potters and those who dwell at Netaim and Gederah; there they dwelt with the king for his work.

2 Chronicles 8:9 But Solomon did not make the children of Israel servants for his work. Some *were* men of war, captains of his officers, captains of his chariots, and his cavalry.

2 Chronicles 16:5 Now it happened, when Baasha heard *it*, that he stopped building Ramah and ceased [his work](#).

Nehemiah 4:15 And it happened, when our enemies heard that it was known to us, and *that* God had brought their plot to nothing, that all of us returned to the wall, everyone to [his work](#).

Job 34:11 For He repays man *according to* [his work](#), And makes man to find a reward according to *his* way.

Psalms 62:12 Also to You, O Lord, *belongs* mercy; For You render to each one according to [his work](#).

Psalms 104:23 Man goes out to [his work](#) And to his labor until the evening.

Proverbs 18:9 He who is slothful in [his work](#) Is a brother to him who is a great destroyer.

Proverbs 21:8 The way of a guilty man *is* perverse; But *as for* the pure, [his work](#) *is* right.

Proverbs 22:29 Do you see a man *who* excels in [his work](#)? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknown *men*.

Proverbs 24:29 Do not say, "I will do to him just as he has done to me; I will render to the man according to [his work](#)."

Ecclesiastes 2:23 For all his days *are* sorrowful, and [his work](#) burdensome; even in the night his heart takes no rest. This also is vanity.

Isaiah 54:16 Behold, I have created the blacksmith Who blows the coals in the fire, Who brings forth an instrument for [his work](#); And I have created the spoiler to destroy.

Jeremiah 22:13 Woe to him who builds his house by unrighteousness And his chambers by injustice, *Who* uses his neighbor's service without wages And gives him nothing for [his work](#).

Mark 13:34 *It is* like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and to each [his work](#), and commanded the doorkeeper to watch.

Revelation 22:12 And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward *is* with Me, to give to every one according to [his work](#).

No Work

Exodus 20:10 But the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of the LORD your [God](#). *In it* you shall do no [work](#); you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates.

Leviticus 16:29 *This* shall be a statute forever for you: In the seventh month, on the tenth *day* of the month, you shall afflict your souls, and do [no work](#) at all, *whether* a native of your own country or a stranger who dwells among you.

Leviticus 23:3 Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day *is* a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work on it; it *is* the Sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings.

Leviticus 23:28 And you shall do no work on that same day, for it *is* the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 5:14 But the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of the LORD your God. *In it* you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your ox, nor your donkey, nor any of your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates, that your male servant and your female servant may rest as well as you.

Deuteronomy 15:19 All the firstborn males that come from your herd and your flock you shall sanctify to the LORD your God; you shall do no work with the firstborn of your herd, nor shear the firstborn of your flock.

Deuteronomy 16:8 Six days you shall eat unleavened bread, and on the seventh day there *shall be* a sacred assembly to the LORD your God. You shall do no work on it.

Numbers 8:26 They may minister with their brethren in the tabernacle of meeting, to attend to needs, but they *themselves* shall do no work. Thus you shall do to the Levites regarding their duties.

Ecclesiastes 9:10 Whatever your hand finds to do, do *it* with your might; for *there is* no work or device or knowledge or wisdom in the grave where you are going.

Jeremiah 17:24 And it shall be, if you heed Me carefully," says the LORD, "to bring no burden through the gates of this city on the Sabbath day, but hallow the Sabbath day, to do no work in it.
