Primary Goal of Immanuel Prayer

Our goal is to see Jesus for who He really is. We learn to experience Him in the past and in the present. The other goal is to gain a secure attachment with the Lord. Secure attachment is:

- When I look for Him, I can *always* find Him.
- When I find Him,
 He is *always* happy to see me.
- He is my solution, not He has my solution.
- When we get separated, we can *always* come back together.

What does Immanuel mean?

Immanuel means "God with us" and the Immanuel Approach to Intimacy and Life is a prayer method and lifestyle that deepens our intimacy with God. With Immanuel, as we focus on and engage directly with Jesus, past pain is permanently resolved and barriers between our hearts and the Lord are removed.

Immanuel isn't just a teaching on inner healing: it's a pathway of practical hope whereby we can see Jesus as He is and be changed.

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"But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord." 2 Corinthians 3:18

Jesus came to be Immanuel, God with us.


